NOTE ON REGIONAL PLANNING

Since August 1973 a Regional Planning Board for Kolhapur-Ichalkaranji Region is looking after the town planning schemes in the district. Besides, the Board prepares layouts for Gaothan Extension Schemes, rehabilitation of project affected gaothans and project colonies. With a view to implement the development plan of Kolhapur, a separate office of the Special Land Acquisition Officer has been working since 1967. In addition the Kolhapur Municipal Corporation has created a separate town planning unit under the City Planning and Development Engineer.

As per the provisions of the Urban Land (Ceiling and Regulation) Act, 1976 the Kolhapur-Gandhinagar area is covered under the Kolhapur-Gandhinagar Urban Agglomeration Scheme.

With a view to enable the municipal councils in the district to implement the proposals of their development plans, financial assistance in the form of loan and grant-in-aid is granted to them by the Government of Maharashtra. The financial assistance granted during the Fifth Five Year Plan to the municipal councils in the district is as under :—
