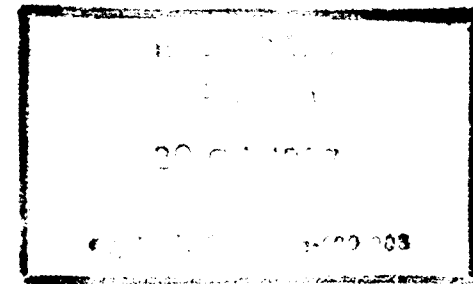

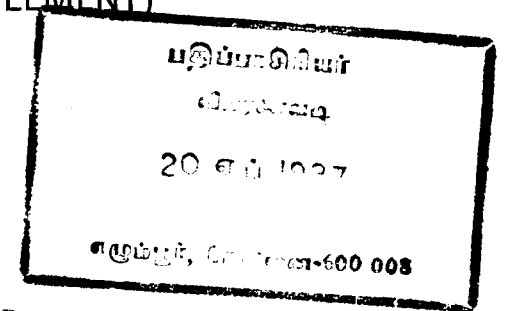

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PREFACE

The scheme of preparation of Supplements to District Gazetteers was sponsored by the erstwhile Central Gazetteers Unit of the Government of India in 1976 which envisaged updating of data of only those District Gazetteers which had completed ten years or more of their publication in that year. In Rajasthan, only four District Gazetteers, namely, Bundi, Barmer, Jhalawar and Ajmer conformed to that criterion and came within the ambit of this scheme. Bundi District Gazetteer having 19 chapters was published in 1964 and the present volume containing 14 chapters, up-dates its data upto the year 1976-77 in tabular form according to the synopsis laid down by the erstwhile Central Gazetteers Unit.

The draft of this Supplement was prepared under the supervision of my predecessor, Shri B. D. Agarwal, who also sent it to the Central Gazetteers Unit for approval. The onus of incorporation of the suggestions of the Central Gazetteers Unit as well as seeking approval of the State Government for its printing and seeing it through the press, devolved on me.

Various departments of the State and the Central Governments and semi-government institutions who helped in the preparation of this volume by making available the necessary information and data, deserve my thanks. I am also thankful to Dr. P.N. Chopra, till recently Editor of the erstwhile Central Gazetteers Unit of the Ministry of Education, Department of Culture, Government of India, New Delhi and his staff for scrutinising the draft and offering valuable suggestions for its improvement. It would not be out of place to mention that Central Gazetteers Unit released grant-in-aid for the compilation of this volume.

I am extremely grateful to Shri Shiv Charan Mathur, Chief Minister and Minister for Planning, Shri Pradyuman Singh, Minister of State (Planning) and Shri Govind Amaliya, Deputy Minister for Planning for their keen interest in the work. I also express my deep sense of gratitude to Shri M.M.K. Wali, Chief Secretary to the Government of Rajasthan and Shri Priyadarshi Thakur, Special Secretary, Planning Department, who amidst their numerous pre-occupations, gave valuable advice to improve the quality of the publication. I also wish to place on record my appreciation of the useful team work of the officers and staff of the District Gazetteers Department, in the compilation and printing of this volume.

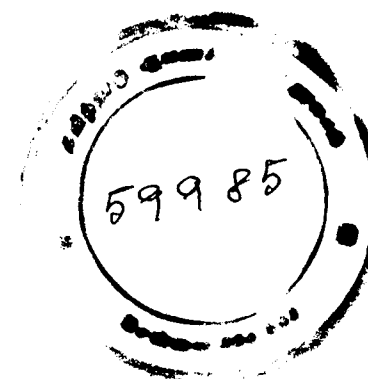
