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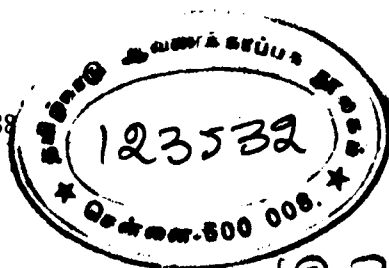
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P R E F A C E

Beed had been a part of the Ashokan kingdom, 3rd century B.C.

Beed district was included in the dominion of Satakarni I, 1st century B.C.

Rashtrakutas ruled over Beed, 780 A.D.

Later Chalukyas conquered Beed in 10th century.

Bijjala (Kalachuri dynasty), commander-in-chief of Chalukya King Tailapa III, conquered the area, 1157 A.D.

Yadavas of Devagiri occupied Beed in 12th century A.D.

Beed came under Kutubuddin Mubarak Shah (Khilji), 1317 A.D.

Muhammad-Bin-Tughluk renamed Champavati as Beed, 1326.

Murtaza Nizam Shah captured Dharur fort and killed Bijapur General Kishvar Khan, 1569.

Nehang Khan, the Ahmadnagar Minister, retook town of Beed from Moghals, 1598.

Azam Khan defeated Khan Jahan Lodi at Pimpalner, 1628.

Dharur fort captured by Moghals, 1630.

Moghals captured Beed, 1635.

Rav Dalpat Bundela fought with the Marathas at Deorai, 1690.

Parli-Vaijanath temple built by Rani Ahilyabai Holkar, 1706.

A major portion of the district handed over to Nemaji Shinde as a reward by the Emperor Shah Alam Bahadur Shah, 1709.

Battle of Rakshasbhuvan fought between Peshva and Nizam, 1763.

Conspiracy of Rang Rav (Kulkarni of Nalkhed) against British, 1858.

Revolt of Beed, 1898.

First ginning and pressing mill established at Parli-Vaijanath, 1905.

Beed district became a part of the former State of Bombay, 1956 and that of Maharashtra, 1960.

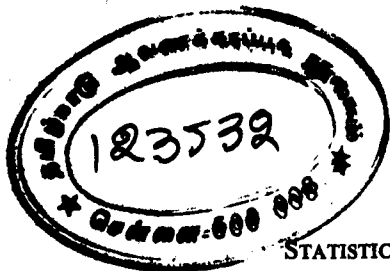
