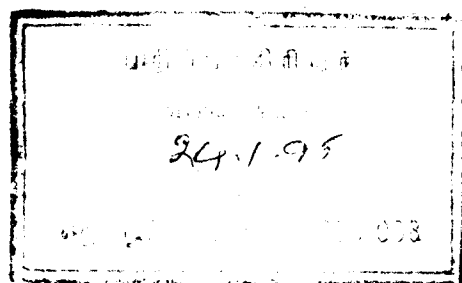
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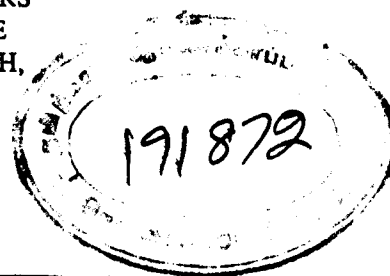
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PREFACE

It was in 1976 that the Government of India had decided to bringout Supplements for all ten year old district Gazetteers so that they can provide latest statistical information relating to the subjects discussed in their parent volume. Accordingly Directorate of Gazetteers has produced seven supplements so far. Narsimhapur is eighth in the series.

The District Gazetteers of Narsimhapur was published in 1971. There has been considerable development in the District over the past twentytwo years. In the meantime two new tahsils were also created i.e. Gotegaon on 11th February 1982 and Kareli on 24th May 1982. In the collection of statistical figures in many cases we had to remain satisfied with figures relating to select years only since some departments have eliminated old records after a certain period. The work was started during the tenure of former Director Shri K.R.R.C. Nair. In the preparation of this Supplement, a team of Officers, namely, Sarvshri Vijay Jain, A.M. Sharma, Nawal Kishore and S.C. Chaturvedi, all Deputy Directors, and Sarvshri S.S.C. Kerketta, Dr. Prabir Kumar Jha, Smt. Vandana Pandey, Dr. Suresh Tiwari and H.R. Ahirwar, all Assistant Directors did good work. Dr. Prabir Kumar Jha supervised the printing. Shri Yaduraj Singh, Artist and Photographer prepared the map of the District. I am thankful to all of them.

My thanks are also due to the Collector and Officers of the District Administration Narsimhapur, for arranging to supply the latest statistical data and to the Deputy Controller, Government Central Press, Bhopal for stisfactorily printing this volume in time.

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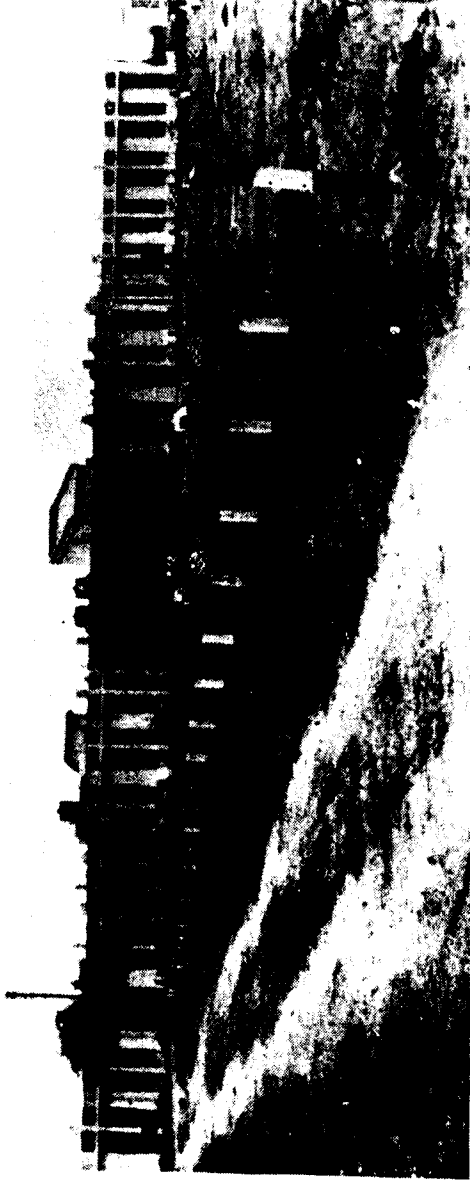
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ONE SKETCH MAP OF THE DISTRICT

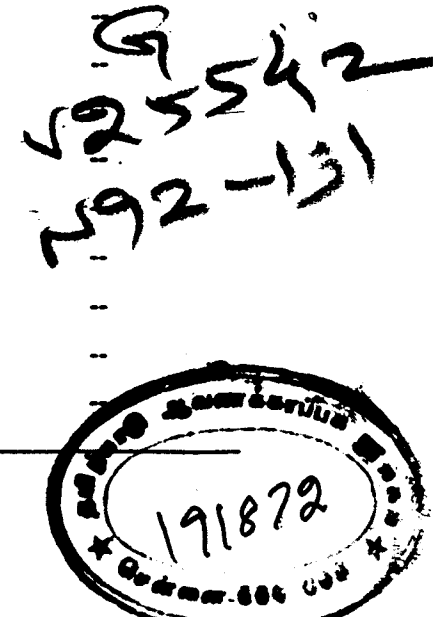

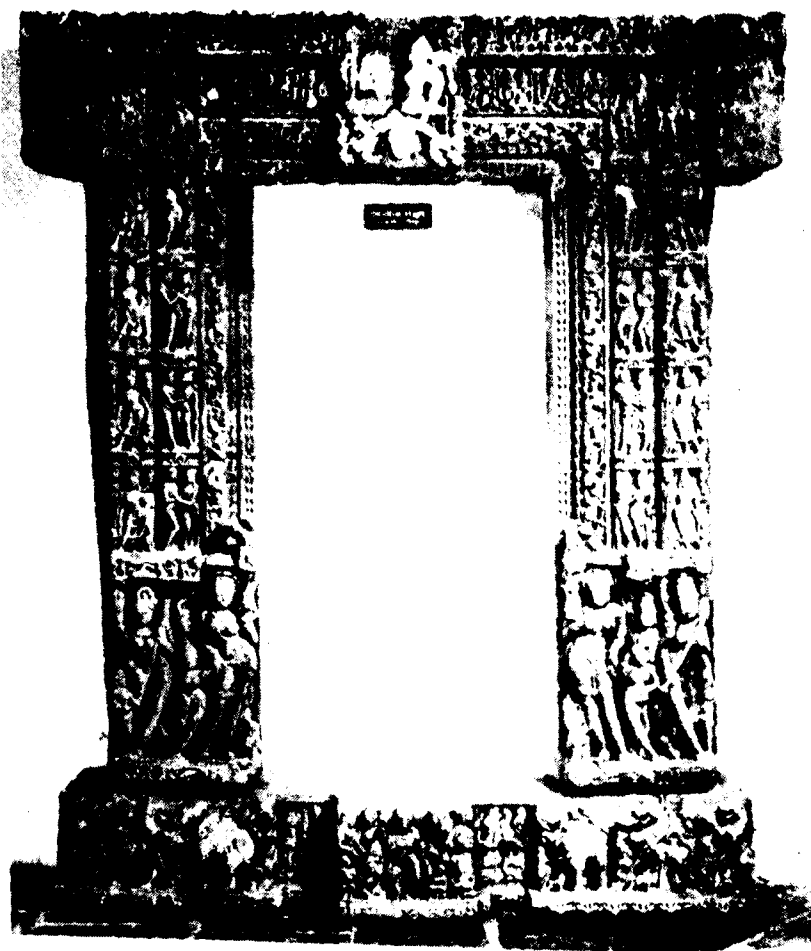

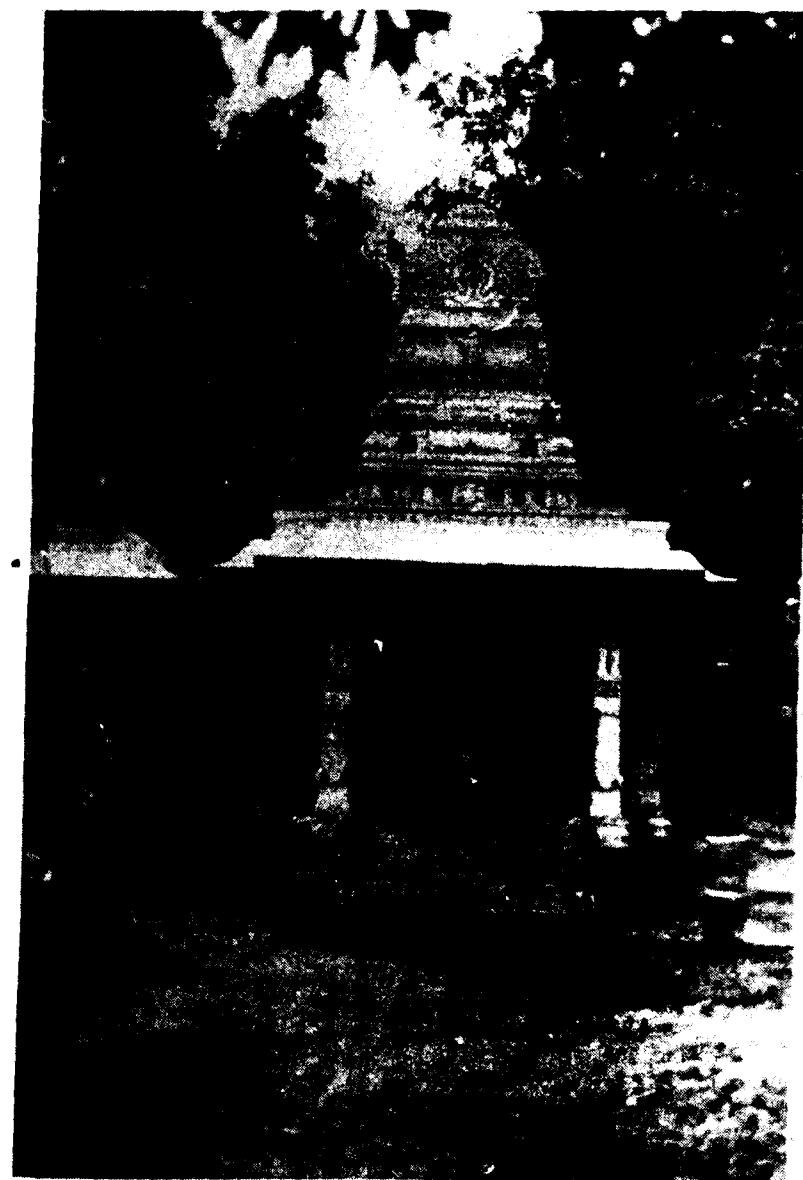

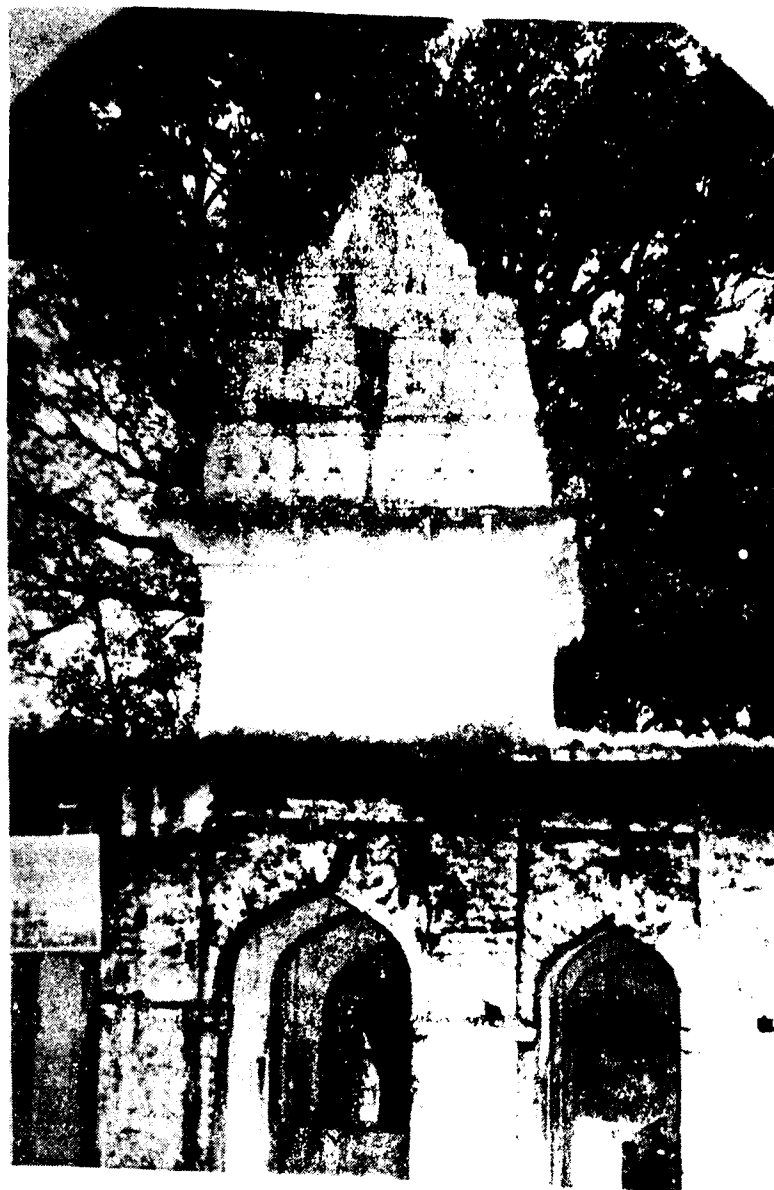
