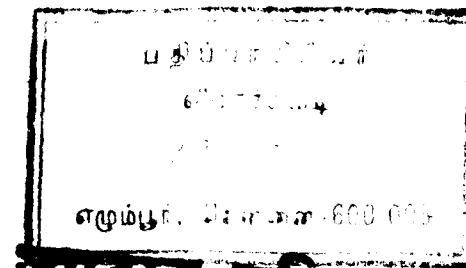

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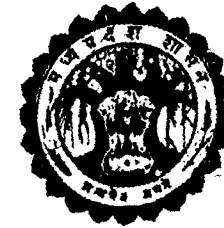

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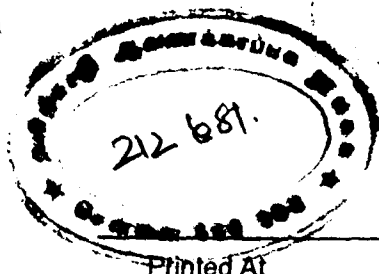
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At the instance of the Government of India, Supplements for all ten year old District Gazetteers are being prepared. This supplement is fifth in the series and an adjunct to its parent volume published in 1969. The volume will be of great use to all those who desire to refer the District Gazetteer of East Nimar. There has been considerable development in the District over the past twenty-five years or so especially in agriculture, irrigation, education, communication and other infra-structure facilities. During the subsequent period one Tahsil was created, namely Pandhana on August 15, 1987 and operation of Narmada (Indira) Sagar Project.

The work of preparation of this Supplement was started during the tenure of former Director Shri K.R.R.C. Nair except for a few tables that remained to be collected and finalised. The Officers who actively participated in this work include Sarvashri V.K. Jain, A.M. Sharma, Nawal Kishore and S.C. Chaturvedi, all Deputy Directors, and Sarvashri S.S.C.
