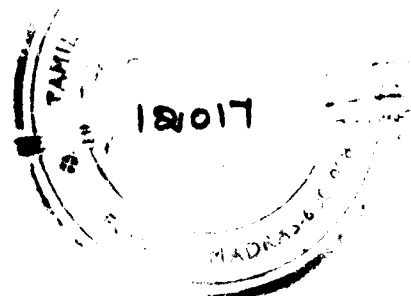

PREFATORY NOTE

The National Archives of India has been for some time past contemplating the publication of an account of the research theses prepared by scholars in India. Resolution No. V of the Research & Publication Committee passed at its 20th Meeting held at Bhopal in February 1953 gave us the necessary encouragement in this direction, and the bulletin is the result of our endeavours. It is by no means an exhaustive account of the theses prepared by Indian scholars : the shortcomings are inevitable because of the various difficulties in our way. But it is hoped that this bulletin which, so far as we are aware, is the first of its kind in India, will go a long way in co-ordinating research work in the modern period of Indian history in the various centres, and in preventing any duplication of work, if it exists.
