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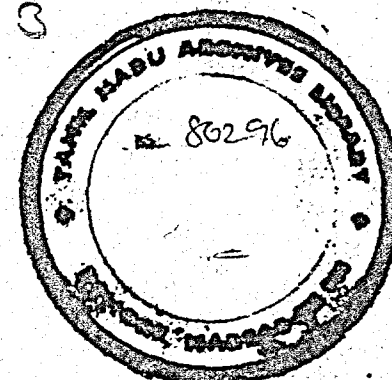
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ADMINISTRATIVE REPORT

ON THE

CENSUS OF BIHAR AND ORISSA, 1931.

CHAPTER I.—Enumeration.

SECTION I.—Introductory Remarks.

THIS report is intended primarily for the use of the Provincial Superintendent of the next census operations. As far as possible, it makes no mention of matters which are sufficiently dealt with in the Codes of Census Procedure for 1931 (Imperial and Provincial), and no further explanation is offered here of terms which are defined in those codes. When the word "Code" is used by itself in this report, the *Provincial Code* is meant.

2. The actual census was held on the night of the 26th February 1931. I was subsequently consulted on a suggestion that some date in the autumn would be a more suitable time for taking the next census. So far as this province is concerned, I am strongly of the opinion that this suggestion is unworkable. The date of the next census will of course have been fixed before the Provincial Superintendent takes over charge, and I only mention the matter here in case the local Government may wish to refer to the papers (which will be found in file no. 1C—160/31) when the question is under discussion.

3. A complete list of the census records which are being deposited in the Secretariat of the local Government will be found in file no. 1P/2 of 1931. They include the following:—

- (1) Imperial Code of Census Procedure, 1931, Parts I and II (two copies).
- (2) Code of the Census Procedure for Bihar and Orissa 1931 (seven copies).
- (3) Guard-file of important circulars and orders relating to the taking of the census and miscellaneous enquiries (six copies).
- (4) Guard-file of important circulars and orders relating to slip-copying, sorting and compilation (six copies).
- (5) A complete collection of all forms used in the course of the operations (six copies).
- (6) English and Vernacular indices of occupation.
- (7) Caste classification index.
- (8) The compilation registers prepared in the central offices.
- (9) Other papers relating to the central offices.
- (10) Miscellaneous literature and books of reference on subjects dealt with at the census.
