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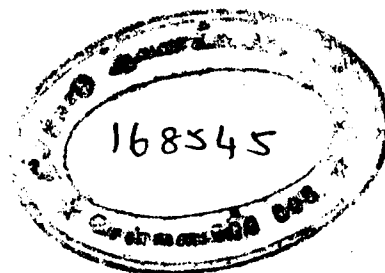
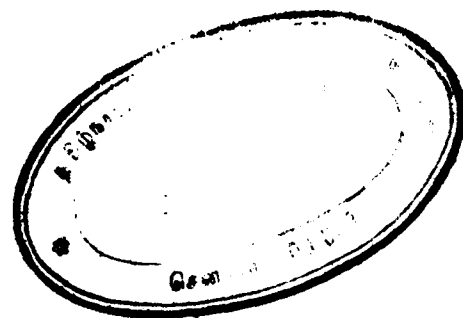
The present report on "Demographic Appraisal of Tamil Nadu" is the 2nd series on Analysis of Census conducted in Tamil Nadu 1991. The provisional data on the working characteristics of the population are analysed in this report with a view to enabling the data users to have a preliminary idea of the number of workers in some broad categories among the population. This report is based on the 1991 census released by the Registrar General and Census Commissioner of India under Series-1 Paper-3 of 1991 "PROVISIONAL POPULATION TOTALS WORKERS AND THEIR DISTRIBUTION".

The data relating to total workers classified into main workers and marginal workers and the distribution of main workers into the four broad categories of workers viz. 1) Cultivators, 2) Agricultural Labourers 3) Household Industry Workers and 4) Other workers are presented in this publication with a brief analysis. I hope that this publication will be useful to the Demographers, Research Scholars and those who seek information on working class in Tamil Nadu.

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1. ECONOMIC QUESTIONS IN THE INDIAN CENSUS

It has been the tradition in the population census of India to collect information on the economic activity of people. The census data forms as an inventory of human resources of the country/State showing their number, characteristic, occupation and distribution among the various branches of the economy.

The data on the economic activity of the people collected upto the 1951 census were based on income and dependency concepts. From the 1961 census onwards the concept of work measured in terms of time or the labour force concept has been followed. In the 1971 census every person was asked what his main activity was i.e. how he or she engaged himself mostly. On the basis of this question the population was divided into two broad streams of main activity as 'Workers' and 'non-workers'. The economic questions of the 1981 census were formulated so as to first divide the population into those who had worked anytime at all during the year preceding the census and those who had not worked at all during the year.

In order to ensure that the economic activity of unpaid workers on farm or in family enterprise (woman and children are the predominant constituents of this workforce) is properly enumerated in the 1991 census, the instructions to census enumerators were explained and emphasis was laid on the need to ask probing questions regarding the work done at any time at all last year or any of the season in the reference period especially in the case of woman.

The concepts adopted in the 1991 census are described below to facilitate ready reference.

1.1 Work

Work is defined as participation in any economically productive activity. Such participation may be physical or mental in nature. Work involves not only actual work but also effective supervision and directions of work. It also includes unpaid work as farm or in family enterprise.

1.2 Reference period

The reference period is one year preceding the data of enumeration.

1.3 Main Workers

Those who had worked for the major part of the year are termed as main workers. By major part of the year is meant 6 months (183 days) or more.

1.4 Marginal Workers

Those who had not worked for the major part of the year i.e. those who had worked for less than 6 months (183 days) in the year are termed as marginal workers.

1.5 Cultivator

For the purpose of the census a person is considered working as cultivator, if he or she is engaged either as employer, single worker or family worker in cultivation of land owned or held from Government or held from private persons or institutions for payment in money, kind or share. Cultivation includes supervision or direction of cultivation.

1.6 Agricultural Labourers

A person who works on another person's land for wages in money, kind or share is regarded as an agricultural labourer. He or she has no risk in cultivation, but he or she merely works on another person's land for wages. An agricultural labourer has no right of lease or contract on land on which he or she works.

1.7 Household Industry

Household industry is defined as an industry conducted by the head of the household himself or herself and/or by the members of the household at home or within the village in rural areas and only within the precincts of the house where the household lives in urban areas. The largest proportion of workers in household industry consists of the members of the household including the head. The industry is not run on the scale of registered factory which would qualify or has to be registered under the Indian Factory Act.

1.8 Other Workers

All workers i.e. those who have been engaged in some economic activity during the year preceding enumeration who are not cultivators or agricultural labourers or household industry workers are other workers. The type of workers that comes under this category includes factory workers, plantation workers, those in trade, commerce, business, transport, mining, construction, political or social work, all government servants, municipal employees, teachers, priests, entertainment artists etc. In effect, all those who work in any field of economic activity other than cultivation, agricultural labour or household industry are 'Other Workers'.

2. WORKING POPULATION

2.1. Work Participation Rate 1991

An overall picture of total workers in the state is presented in this chapter. Total workers include both main and marginal workers. It may be reiterated that the term "workers participation rate" as used in the analysis in this report refers to the proportion of total workers in the population expressed as a percentage and not the proportion of labour force or the economically active population which is conventionally used.

Statement below depicts the provisional number of total workers in Tamil Nadu by sex with rural and urban break up as revealed by the 1991 census. The work participation in the state indicates that nearly half of our population forms the working force and among male more than half are workers while among females only one in three is engaged in some kind of work.

2.3 The work participation ratio is higher in rural than in the urban areas. This is true on both on males and females, the gap is more in the case of females.

2.4 The percentage of total workers in the rural areas among the total workers in the state is 73.14% while the percentage of population living in the rural areas is 65.80. Sex-wise 67.39 percent of the male workers and 84.06 percent of female workers in the state have been enumerated in the rural areas as 65.44 percent of the male population and 66.17 percent of the female population in the state have been counted in these areas.

The statement 2.4 reveals that the percentage of total workers is higher in urban areas (28.99) than in all areas (21.57). The same trend is seen in the case of males (25.52) and females (44.56) in urban areas as compared with all areas. Significant increase is seen in percentage of woman workers in rural areas (39.33) when compared with 1981 Census. The only decline in percentage of male workers was

seen in rural areas during 1991 census (58.71) compared to 1981 census (59.24). This may be due to migration of workers to urban areas in search of better opportunities and better Labour facilities.

Statement 2.5 depicts the female work participation ratio in the state. Tirunelveli Kattabomman district tops the list with 46.43 and Madras the least with 9.41. Eight districts has shown the rate lesser than the state average of 30.88.

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3. Main Workers and Marginal Workers

3.1 The main workers in the state increased from 19.02 million in 1981 to 22.97 million in 1991 registering a growth rate of 20.7%

3.2 Statement 3.2 shows the district-wise proportion of main workers by sex in 1981-1991. Kamaraj district tops to list (50.20) followed by Periyar (49.63) during 1991 in respect of total persons. As far as males are concerned Periyar district (64.78%) tops and followed by Coimbatore and Madurai Districts. (61.58) (61.16) respectively. Females proportion is higher again in Kamaraj District (43.06) followed by Tirunelveli District (35.59).

3.3 Statement 3.3 reveals the proportion of rural female Marginal workers in 1991 and 1981 census. Tirunelveli district reached the top rank (14.27) during 1991 when it was far behind in 12th rank during 1981. Thirteen districts are below the state average (6.35).

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4. Composition of Main Workers

4.1 Out of 22.97 million total workers 5.73 million or 24.94 percent were cultivators. The other categories are Agricultural labourers 34.16 percent, Household industry workers 4.66 percent and other workers 36.24 percent.

4.2 The proportion of cultivators, Agricultural labourers taken together in rural areas is shown in statement 4.2. Dharmapuri district tops the list with (88.20) followed by Pasumpon Muthuramalinga Thevar district (87.58) during 1991 census.

4.3 The Statement 4.3 reveals proportion of other workers of rural areas in the category of rural male main workers. In this category Nilgiris district registered (88.80) compared with other districts followed by a lower proportion of (37.69) by the Kanniyakumari district.

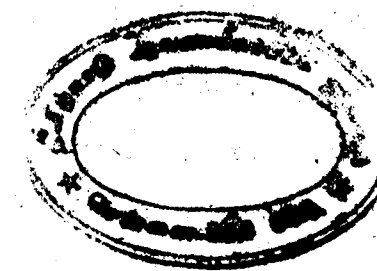
4.4 The Statement 4.4 reveals the proportion of other workers of rural female main workers. Again Nilgiris district stands first (89.01) followed by a lower proportion of (47.42) by Kanniyakumari district.

4.5 The Statement 4.5 shows the proportion of other workers of urban male main workers. Here Madras district stands first (97.98) followed by Coimbatore (89.80)

4.6 Proportion of other workers of urban female main workers again Madras district tops the list in the districts (95.26) followed by Nilgiris district (85.56).

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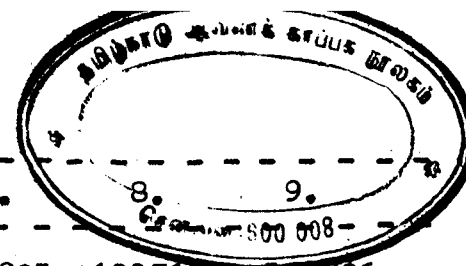

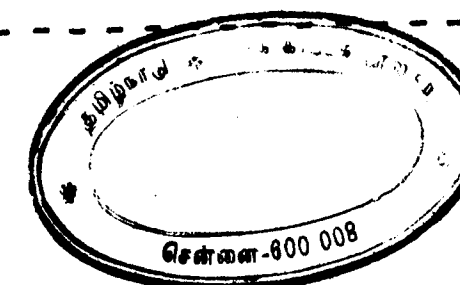
