 - 2 **Populonia.** AR Ten-litra Pieces (2), Head of Apollo laureate to left, behind value x; R plain, wt. 65 grs., both in excellent condition and scarce 2
 - 3 **Hyria, B.C. 420-340.** AR Didrachm, Head of Hera nearly facing, wearing stephanos adorned with palmette, and at the sides, foreparts of winged griffins; and necklace, the hair long and flowing; R YPINA (in Oscan letters), Campanian bull to right, wt. 114 grs., very fine and scarce in this condition [Pl. I] 1
 - 4 **Cumae, B.C. 480-423.** AR Didrachms (2), Female head to right, hair rolled; R KYMAION. (retrograde), Mussel-shell with corn-grain above, fine and scarce, the second example reads KVM. only 2
 - 5 **Phistelia, B.C. 420-400.** AR Didrachm, Head of Hera, nearly full face, the hair loose; R ΦΙΣΤΛΥΣ., Man-headed bull to left, wt. 116 grs., fine and rare [Pl. I] 1
 - 6 **Tarentum, B.C. 500-470.** AR Didrachm, TARAS, Taras seated on dolphin to right, holding in right hand cuttle-fish, the whole within an ornamental border; R Winged sea-horse to right, below scallop shell, wt. 123½ grs., fine [Pl. I] 1
 - 7 **Tarentum, B.C. 470-460.** Taras on dolphin to left, below a dolphin swimming to right; R Taras (?) nude to waist, seated on chair with back to right, and holding a bird in right hand, wt. 115 grs. [Pl. I] 1

- 18 Metapontum, B.C. 350-330. *AR* Didrachms (2), Female head to right, hair waved over forehead, turned up at side and bound with simple diadem; *R* **[Μ]ΕΤ[Α]**, Ear of barley. Another with Head of Apollo to right, the hair very curly, and wreathed with ivy, on truncation **ΑΠΟΛ.**; *R* **ΜΕΤΑ.**, Ear of barley, *fine* 2
- 19 Metapontum, B.C. 350-330. *AR* Didrachms (3), Female Dionysiac head to left, wearing broad diadem ornamented with meander pattern, from which rises a row of ivy leaves; *R* **ΜΕΤΑ.**, Ear of barley. Female head to left, hair in sphendone ornamented with star; *R* **ΜΕΤΑ.**, Ear of barley, in field, left, conch. Head of Persephone, three-quarter face, wearing wreath of barley; *R* legend wanting, Ear of barley with leaf, upon which bucranium 3

- 21 Laus, B.C. 500-450, *AR* Didrachm, **ΛΑΣ.**, Bull looking back, border of dots; *R* **ΣΑΛ.**, Human headed bull to right, *wt.* 122 *grs.*, *fine and scarce*. Sybaris, B.C. 500, *AR* Didrachm, **ΜΥ.** retrograde, Bull with head reverted; *R* same type incuse but the letters not shewn, *wt.* 122½ *grs.* 2
- 22 Thurium, B.C. 390-350. *AR* Tetradrachm, Head of Pallas to right wearing crested helmet adorned with Scylla; *R* **ΘΟΥΡΙΩΝ.**, Bull butting to right, beneath, **ΑΡ** (mon.), in exergue a fish, *wt.* 238½ *grs.* 1
- 23 Thurium, B.C. 390-350. *AR* Didrachm, Head of Pallas in crested helmet adorned with Scylla; *R* **ΘΟΥΡΙΩΝ.**, Bull butting to right, in exergue a fish, *wt.* 119½ *grs.*, *very fine* [Pl. II] 1

- 24 **Heraclea**, B.C. 380-300. *AR* Didrachm [—] **HPAKΛHION.**, Head of Pallas to right wearing crested Corinthian helmet, behind head **H**; *℞* Herakles, naked, standing before lighted altar, holding club and lion's skin, and in right hand a one-handled vase, in field fulmen. **Velia**, B.C. 400-268. *AR* Didrachm, Head of Pallas *℞* right in crested helmet adorned with a griffin, in field **Δ**; *℞* **YEΛHTΩN.** (in exergue), Lion passant right above **Φ** - I. and pentagon. Another, similar, with triskelis; and two Didrachms of Thurium, *fine* 5
- 25 **Caulonia**, B.C. 480-388. *AR* Stater, Nude male figure to right, in up-lifted right hand a branch, and over the left arm a sacrificial fillet, in field, left, **Θ** -; *℞* **KAVAΩNIATAS.**, Stag to right, *wt.* 117 *grs.*, *fine* [Pl. II] 1
- 26 **Croton**. Before B.C. 420. *AR* Stater, Nude figure of Herakles seated on rock covered with lion's skin, he supports with left hand his club, and in his right hand holds a filleted branch, before him is a flaming altar, and behind him, to right, bow and quiver, in exergue two fish; *℞* **♀ POT.**, Tripod, grain of corn to left, and **E.** in exergue, *wt.* 119½ *grs.*, *fine and excessively rare* [Pl. II] 1
- 27 **Croton**, circa 420. *AR* Stater, **KPOTO.**, Head of Hera Lakinia nearly facing, with flowing hair, wearing necklace, with amphoraic pendants, and stephanos, adorned with honeysuckle design in centre, and on either side, foreparts of Griffins; *℞* Herakles, nude, seated, left, on rock covered with lion's skin, holding in right hand wine cup; in field above, his bow and club, *wt.* 119½ *grs.* (Carelli, *N.L.V.T.*, CLXXXIV, 38), *a charming coin in very fine condition* [Pl. II] 1
- 28 **Croton**, B.C. 480-420. **Eagle** standing on thunderbolt, looking back; above, **Φ** I., and in field terminal statuette of Hermes; *℞* **KPO.**, Tripod, to left, figure of Victory, *wt.* 103 *grs.*, *very fine* [Pl. II] 1
- 29 **Croton**, B.C. 390. *AR* Stater, **KPOTΩNIATAS.**, Head of Apollo laureate to right, the hair long and flowing; *℞* The Infant Herakles seated on cushion strangling two serpents, *wt.* 116 *grs.*, *very fine* [Pl. II] 1
- 30 **Locri Epizephyrii**, B.C. 280-268. *AR* Stater. Head of Zeus, **NE.** in monogram beneath; *℞* **ΛΟΚΡΩΝ.**, Roma (**ΡΩΜΑ**), seated, with sword and shield, crown by Fides (**ΠΙΣΤΙΣ**), who stands before her, *wt.* 114 *grs.*, *very fine and very rare* [Pl. II] 1
- 31 **Rhegium**, circa B.C. 466-415. Lion's head facing; *℞* **RECINOS.**, Male figure seated, naked to waist, resting on staff; in field, bunch of grapes, the whole in laurel wreath, *wt.* 264 *grs.*, *fine* [Pl. II] 1

- 32 **Rhegium**, B.C. 415-387. *AR* Tetradrachm, **PHGINON.**, Laureate head of Apollo to right; behind spray of olive; *℞* Lion's scalp facing, border of dots, *wt.* 260 *grs.*, *fine* [Pl. II] 1
- 33 **Terina**, B.C. 440-400. *AR* Stater [T] **EPINAIΩ[N].**, Head of the Nymph Terina of charming style, she wears sphendone, the back of which is decorated with crosses, having dots in the angles, the whole within dotted border; *℞* Winged Nike seated on square cippus, holding wreath, *wt.* 123 *grs.*, *in the most beautiful condition*, [Pl. II] 1
- 34 **Terina**, B.C. 440-400. *AR* Stater, **TEPINAION.**, Head of the Nymph Terina to right, hair bound with sphendone, and wearing necklace; *℞* Winged Nike seated on square cippus holding wreath, behind cippus **Π.**, *wt.* 118 *grs.*, *rev. very fine* [Pl. II] 1
- 35 **Terina**, B.C. 440-400. *AR* Staters (2) **TEPINAION.**, Head of the Nymph Terina of finest style to right, hair rolled and wearing ampyx; behind head **Φ**; the whole within wreath of olive; *℞* Winged Nike seated on four-legged stool, small bird beneath, *fine*. Head of the Nymph Terina, hair in sphendone; *℞* Winged Nike seated on square cippus holding upright caduceus 2

- 39 **Agrigentum**, B.C. 472-415. *AR* Tetradrachm, **AKPAOANTOΣ.**; *℞* Eagle, *wt.* 267 *grs.*, *very fine* 1
- 40 **Agrigentum**, B.C. 415-406. *AR* Tetradrachm, Two eagles to right, on supine hare upon rock; behind, head of bellowing bull; *℞* Nike in fast quadriga to left; above, on tablet, **ΑΓΡΑΓΑΝΤΙΝ.**, *boustrophedon*, and in field **NO.**; in the exergue a club, *wt.* 268 *grs.*, *very fine and exceedingly rare* [Pl. II] 1

- 41 **Agrigentum**, B.C. 415-406. $\mathcal{R}$ Tetradrachm, **AKPAΓ.**, Two eagles on supine hare; the farther, with spread wings, is about to tear the prey; the nearer, with closed wings, raising its head and screaming, the whole within dotted border; $\mathcal{B}$ **AKPA[ΓANTINON]**, Crab, and beneath Skylla, with flowing hair, and dogs springing from her waist, the right hand raised, *wt. 267 grs., fine, and of considerable rarity* [Pl. II] 1
- 42 **Agrigentum**, B.C. 415-406. $\mathcal{R}$ Tetradrachm, **AKPAΓANTINON.**, Eagle with wings spread, standing to left on supine hare and about to tear it, supporting the hare a rock, on which, a conch and scallop shell; $\mathcal{B}$ Crab and broad sea fish with open mouth, on either side of crab an scallop shell and conch, *wt. 263½ grs., very fine and rare* [Pl. II] 1
- 43 **Agrigentum**, B.C. 417-406. $\mathcal{R}$ Tetradrachm, **AKPA.**, Two eagles standing on supine hare; one with head raised; $\mathcal{B}$ Quadriga to right; above, Victory crowning charioteer; in exergue, a crab, *wt. 268 grs., very rare* [Pl. II] 1
- 44 **Agrigentum**, B.C. 415-406. $\mathcal{A}$ Hexas, *obv.* **AKP.**, Eagle about to attack serpent, beneath, two pellets, marks of value; $\mathcal{B}$ Crab, beneath, magistrate's name, **ΣΙΑΝΟΣ.**, *wt. 20 grs., fine and rare* 1
- 45 **Camarina**, B.C. 461-405. $\mathcal{R}$ Tetradrachm, traces of legend, Bearded head of Herakles wearing lion's skin to left; $\mathcal{B}$ Quadriga driven to left by Pallas, above, flying Nike about to crown charioteer, in exergue; crane flying, *wt. 264 grs., obv. fine, but double struck, rare* [Pl. II] 1
- 46 **Camarina**, B.C. 461-405. $\mathcal{R}$ Tetradrachm, Head of youthful Herakles wearing lion's skin to left; $\mathcal{B}$ **KAMAPINAION.** (in exergue), Quadriga driven to right by Pallas, above, flying Nike about to crown charioteer, in exergue two amphorae, *wt. 270 grs., very fine and rare* [Pl. III] 1
- 47 **Camarina**, circa B.C. 461-405. $\mathcal{R}$ Didrachm, **ΙΠΠΑΡΙΣ.**, Horned head of youthful River-god Hipparis, to left, on either side a fish; $\mathcal{B}$ **KAMAPINA.**, The Nymph Kamarina draped and seated on swan, to left; in field three fishes, *wt. 125 grs., excessively rare* [Pl. III] 1
- 48 **Catana**, B.C. 461-415, after the Restoration. $\mathcal{R}$ Tetradrachm, **KATANAION.**, Young male head with short hair laureate (perhaps the river god Amenanus), behind olive leaf with two berries; $\mathcal{B}$ Quadriga going to right, above Nike flying right carrying fillet, in exergue a winged thunderbolt, *wt. 255 grs., very fine* [Pl. III] 1

- 49 **Catana**, circa B.C. 415. Tetradrachm, by *Euænetos* **[KA]TANAION.**, Head of Apollo laureate to left; in front, a bell attached to a knotted fillet; behind, crayfish; $\mathcal{B}$ Victorious quadriga going at full speed to left; to right, meta; above, Nike flying towards charioteer bearing wreath and rectangular tablet inscribed **EYAIN.**, in exergue, crab, *wt. 259 grs., fine and very rare* [Pl. III] 1
- 50 **Catana** (after the Restoration), B.C. 461-415. $\mathcal{R}$ Tetradrachm, **KATANAION.**, Laureate head of Apollo to right, the hair at back waved and turned up under the tie of wreath; $\mathcal{B}$ Quadriga of walking horses to right, *wt. 254½ grs.* 1
- 51 **Gela**, B.C. before 466. $\mathcal{R}$ Tetradrachm, **ΓΕΛΑΣ.** in a line above, fore-part of man-headed bull (river Gelas); $\mathcal{B}$ Quadriga going to right, horses walking, in background Ionic column (meta), in exergue, ear of corn, *wt. 242½ grs., very fine* [Pl. III]; *from the Villabate find* 1
- 52 **Gela**, B.C. 400. $\mathcal{R}$ Tetradrachm, **ΓΕΛΑΣ.** over fore-part of man-headed bull of fine style to right; $\mathcal{B}$ Quadriga to right, above flying Victory about to crown horses, in exergue honeysuckle design with volutes, *wt. 268 grs., very fine and of exceptionally large module* [Pl. III]; *from the Villabate find* 1
- 53 **Gelas**, B.C. 466-415, early fine style. $\mathcal{R}$ Tetradrachm, **ΓΕΛΑΣ.** below fore-part of man-headed bull to right, above corn grain; $\mathcal{B}$ Fast Quadriga going to left, above flying to left, an eagle, in exergue stalk of barley, *wt. 265 grs., very fine and extremely rare* [Pl. III] 1
- 54 **Gela**, B.C. before 466. $\mathcal{R}$ Tetradrachms (2), **ΓΕΛΑΣ.** in a line above, fore-part of man-headed bull (river Gelas); $\mathcal{B}$ Quadriga to right, horses crowned by flying Nike, one example has palmette in exergue, *fine* 2
- 55 **Gela**, B.C. before 466. $\mathcal{R}$ Tetradrachms (2), somewhat similar to the preceding, but with legend in front of forepart of man-headed bull 2
- 56 **Himera**, B.C. 472-415. $\mathcal{R}$ Tetradrachm, **[IM]EPAION.**, Nymph Himera, sacrificing at altar, behind her, Silenus bathing under a fountain, which issues from a lion's head; $\mathcal{B}$ Quadriga to left, charioteer crowned by Nike, *wt. 264 grs., extremely fine and rare in this state* [Pl. III]; *from the Villabate find* 1
- 57 **Himera**, B.C. 472-415. $\mathcal{R}$ Tetradrachm, **ΙΜΕΡΑΙΟΝ.**, Nymph Himera sacrificing at altar, behind her, Silenus bathing under a fountain, which issues from a lion's head; $\mathcal{B}$ **ΙΜΕΡΑΙΟΝ.**, Quadriga to left, charioteer crowned by Nike, *wt. 268 grs., very fine* [Pl. III] 1
- 58 **Leontini**, B.C. 500-466. $\mathcal{R}$ Tetradrachm, **ΛΕΟΝΤΙΝΟΝ.**, Laureate Head of Apollo to right, beneath lion, around three leaves; $\mathcal{B}$ Victorious Quadriga to right, charioteer crowned by Nike, in exergue lion, *wt. 259 grs., well preserved and very rare* [Pl. III] 1

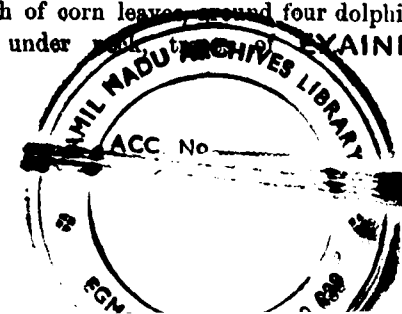
- 59 **Leontini**, B.C. 466-422. *AR* Tetradrachm, Laureate head of Apollo to right; *℞* **ΛΕΟΝΤΙΝΟΝ.**, Lion's head with open jaws to right, in field three grains of corn, and behind a tripod, *wt.* 268 *grs.*, *very fine* [Pl. III] 1
- 60 **Leontini**, circa B.C. 500-466. *AR* Tetradrachms (2), Quadriga going slowly to right, above Nike crowning horses; **ΛΕΟΝΤΙΝΟΝ.**, Lion's head, with open jaw, around four corn grains, *fine* 2
- 61 **Zancle**, *Vth century*, B.C. *AR* Drachm, **DANKLE.**, Dolphin to right, within a sickle, with border of dots on either side; *℞* Same type incuse but the legend is not shewn, *an extremely interesting type, the only example of an incuse coin issued in Sicily, wt.* 92½ *grs.*, *fine and of the highest rarity* [Pl. III] (*found near Messina*) 1
- 62 **Zancle**, circa B.C. 493. *AR* Didrachm, **DANK.**, and Dolphin to left, in the harbour of Zancle with its four forts, the whole within border of dots; *℞* Escallop shell in incuse of peculiar form, *wt.* 89 *grs.*, *very fine and a very rare variety* [Pl. III] (*found near Messina*) 1
- 63 **Zancle**, B.C. 493. *AR* Drachm, **DANKLE.**, Dolphin to left, within the harbour of Zancle, double lineal border with dots between; *℞* Shallow incuse, divided into several compartments, in the centre a shell, *wt.* 78 *grs.*, *very fine* [Pl. III] 1
- 64 **Messana**, circa B.C. 480. *AR* Tetradrachms (2), Biga of mules driven to right by seated charioteer, in exergue olive leaf; *℞* **MES-SENION** (retrograde), Hare running to right, *wt.* 268 *grs.* 1
- 65 Another, similar, having olive leaf and bud over hare, *wt.* 267 *grs.* 1
- 66 **Messana**, B.C. 420. *AR* Tetradrachm, Messana in mule car to right, above flying Nike about to crown the charioteer, in exergue two dolphins facing, dotted border; *℞* **ΜΕΣΣΑΝΙΟΝ.** (retrograde), Hare to left, below head of youthful Pan or river god to left, *wt.* 264 *grs.*, *very fine* [Pl. III] 1
