CHAPTER I.

DESCRIPTION.

The circle was formed in June 1885 out of the old Trichinopoly circle under the sanction conveyed in G.O. No. 1210, Revenue, dated 2nd November 1885, and consisted of three taluks, viz., Perambalur and Musiri of the Trichinopoly district and Nāmakkal of the Salem district. In 1890 the Udaiyarpālaiyam taluk was added to the circle under the sanction conveyed in G.O. No. 856, Revenue, dated 31st October 1890, and in 1891 the Nāmakkal taluk was transferred to the Salem circle (Vide G.O. No. 830, Revenue, dated 5th September 1891). As a result of Sir William Meyer's scheme regarding the redistribution of districts, the Nāmakkal taluk was retransferred to this circle—vide G.O. No. 2570, Revenue, dated 23rd August 1911. In G.O. No. 315, Home, dated 13th November 1916, the retransfer of the Nāmakkal taluk to the Salem district and the formation of two taluks in the Salem and Trichinopoly districts were decided on. This resulted in the rearrangement of the circles both in the Salem and Trichinopoly districts and in the formation of a new circle, viz., Sankaridrug circle with the Nāmakkal taluk except the Tattaiyangarpet firka, and Tiruchengōdu and Ōmalūr taluks—vide B.P. R. No. 2084, Salt, dated 23rd July 1917. In G.O. No. 850, Financial (Separate Revenue), dated 20th November 1917, the Trichinopoly circles were rearranged and this circle was reconstituted with the new Musiri taluk (with the Tattaiyangarpet firka), Perambalur taluk, newly formed Lalgudi taluk and the Udaiyarpālaiyam taluk. The above arrangements came into force from 1st April 1918—vide B.P. R. No. 565, Salt, dated 6th March 1918.

Extent and boundaries. 2. The circle has now an area of 2,486.25 square miles containing 640 villages of which 431 are Government, 139 zamin and 67 inam villages.

The circle is bounded on the north by Namakkal and Attur taluks of the Salem district and Vriddhachalam and Chidambaram taluks of the South Arcot district, on the east by Chidambaram taluk and the Coleroon river, on the south by the Coleroon and the Cauvery rivers, and on the west by the Cauvery river and Namakkal taluk.

As a result of the abolition of sub-section patrols, the preventive orderlies of ranges were revised and the present strength shown above was sanctioned in G.O. No. 1309, Revenue, dated 30th May 1919.

4. The circle is now divided into eight preventive ranges. Prior to the introduction of the tree-tax system, the constitution and strength of the circle were as shown below :—

On the introduction of the tree-tax system into the Nāmakkal and Musiri taluks, in October 1889, sanction was accorded for the entertainment of an extra establishment of two Sub-Inspectors and six peons for the former taluk and one Sub-Inspector and three peons for the latter. The Udaiyārpālaiyam taluk (formerly belonging to the Tanjore circle) was added to the circle in October 1890 with an establishment of two Sub-Inspectors and twelve peons, sanctioned for tree-tax work—vide G.O. No. 856, Revenue, dated 31st October 1890. One party consisting of one petty officer and five peons was transferred from the Perambalur to the Nāmakkal taluk which was itself transferred to the Salem circle on 1st October 1891—vide G.O. No. 830, Revenue, dated 5th September 1891. An additional establishment of one Sub-Inspector and three peons was sanctioned for the Perambalur taluk to which the tree-tax system was extended, so that on 1st October 1891 the constitution and strength of the circle stood as follows :—

In 1898, the jurisdiction of the Sub-Inspectors Perambalur and Vengalam ranges was rearranged. Owing to the decrease in salt crime in the Perambalur and Musiri taluks, the Veppanthattai and Yedumalai parties were abolished in 1904, the orderly of the Sub-Inspector, Vengalam range, was strengthened by one petty officer and three peons, and the area of the Perambalur and Vengalam ranges was once again re-adjusted—vide G.O. Mis. No. 1551, Revenue, dated 7th September 1904. In 1909 owing to the reduction of salt duty and the consequent cessation of salt crime, it was found unnecessary to keep the parties; all the four parties were accordingly abolished, the strength of the Sub-Inspector's orderlies in the ranges to which the parties were attached, being fixed at six peons—vide G.O. No. 1103, Revenue, dated 23rd April 1909. After these changes, the constitution and strength of the circle stood as follows :—

In October 1911, owing to the reconstitution of districts, the Nāmakkal taluk was transferred to this circle—vide G.O. No. 2570, Revenue, dated 23rd August 1911, communicated with B.P. No. 196/2465-R., Salt, dated 4th September 1911.

By this transfer, the jurisdiction of the circle and the strength of the establishment were increased. In B.P. No. 37/534, dated 26th February 1912, a reduction of inferior servants was ordered and it was given effect to from 1st August 1912; and from that date, the strength of the circle stood as follows :—

From 1st April 1918, the circle was reconstituted with the transfer of the Nāmakkal taluk to the new Sankaridrug circle and the addition of the newly formed Lalgudi taluk to this circle from the South Trichinopoly circle; and at the same time, orders relating to the regrading of peons and the consequent enhancement of their pay from Rs. 8 to Rs. 10 and Rs. 7 to Rs. 9 for first and second-grade peons, respectively, came into force. Again there was a reduction from 1st February 1919 in the number of peons sanctioned for the circle from 42 to 35 as per G.O. No. 3009, Revenue, dated 30th May 1919; and the present establishment of the circle is as noted below:—

5. There are two Revenue and Magisterial divisions in the circle, with headquarters at Ariyalūr and Musiri. The Divisional Officer of Ariyalūr exercises jurisdiction over the Udaiyarpālaiyam and Perambalur taluks and the Divisional Officer of Musiri, over the Musiri and Lalgudi taluks. * There are Tahsildars for each of the four taluks with Deputy Tahsildars and Second-class Magistrates in addition, one at Ariyalūr and the other at Turaiyūr. Besides these officers, there are Stationary Second-class Magistrates at the headquarters of each taluk as given below:—

7. The soil is generally a mixture of sand and clay except near the Pachamalai and Kollimalai hills where it is rocky. In the northern portion of the circle the hills run for about 20 miles, the highest point being about 3,000 feet above the sea level. The Cauvery river runs along the southern boundary of the Musiri range of the Musiri taluk, while the Coleroon runs along the southern boundary of the Lalgudi and Udaiyarpalaiyam taluks, and the Vellar river along the northern boundary of the Perambalur taluk and a portion of Udaiyarpalaiyam taluk.

There are metalled roads connecting the headquarters of all the taluks, with each other, while numerous cart-tracks run across the interior portions of the taluks which are difficult of access either owing to the rocky soil or to black cotton soil, the latter becoming quite unpassable during rainy weather. There are ferry services across the rivers Cauvery and Coleroon, at important places, which render ready facilities of access to Musiri, Jayankondasholapuram and Ariyalur ranges direct from headquarters. There is no railway communication anywhere within the limits of the circle; but the stations on the South Indian Railway which run along the southern side of the Cauvery river from Aduturai to Kattalai, afford facilities of access to Jayankondasholapuram, Ariyalur, Lalgudi, Mannachanallur and Musiri ranges. Transport is easy in dry weather, but difficult across country in rainy weather. Ordinary camp supplies are available in most villages except in parts of Perambalur and Udaiyarpalaiyam taluks.

8. *Udaiyarpalaiyam taluk.*—(1) Udaiyarpalaiyam, (2) Ariyalur and (3) Jayankondasholapuram are the principal centres. Paddy and dry crops are generally sold. At Ariyalur, trade in cattle is briskly carried on. Groundnut trade is carried on to a great extent in this taluk.

Perambalur taluk.—Perambalur is the chief centre of trade in dry crops and cereals.

Musiri taluk.—(1) Musiri, (2) Thottiam, (3) Kattuputtur, (4) Turaiyur, (5) Mettupalaiyam and (6) Tattaiyangarpet are the chief centres of trade. Trade in cattle is carried on at Thottiam and Turaiyur and trade in paddy, dry crops and plantains at many centres.

Lalgudi taluk.—Lalgudi, 13 miles north-east of Trichinopoly. Paddy and rice are the chief articles sold here. Dry grains as cumbu, cholam, varagu, etc., are brought to the shandy here from the surrounding parts.

Samayapuram, 8 miles north of Trichinopoly, is a fairly large commercial centre for the dry grains. An annual cattle fair is held here in December during the Ekadasi festival at Srirangam.

Mannachanallur, 7 miles north-west of Trichinopoly, is a fairly important trading centre for paddy and other grains.

SALT SUPPLY AND TRADE.

10. *Source of supply.*—Only Madras salt is consumed in this circle. The sources of supply are the factories at Tuticorin, Kayalpatnam, Negapatam and Cuddalore. Negapatam and Cuddalore salt is not extensively consumed, preference being given to Tuticorin and Kayalpatnam salt as it is whiter.

Distribution.—Salt from the above factories is generally sent by rail to the wholesale merchants at Trichinopoly, who in turn supply it to the merchants in the several towns and villages in this circle. The people in the interior and rural parts get their supply only in the weekly shandies. Negapatam and Cuddalore salt is a little cheaper than Tuticorin salt, but is of inferior quality.

CHAPTER II.

PREVENTIVE RANGES.

A.—Jayankondasholapuram Range.

The range is about 453.21 square miles in extent and is traversed by fairly good roads. It contains 56 ryotwari, 58 zamindari and 7 inam villages with a population of 158,048. It is bounded on the north by the Tittagudi and Vriddhaachalam ranges of the Tirukkoyilur circle, South Arcot district, on the east by the Kattumannargudi range of the Cuddalore circle, on the south by the Narasingampet and Kumbakonam ranges of the Tanjore Circle, and on the west by the Ariyalur range of this circle. There are 25 arrack and 17 toddy shops in the range besides one arrack wholesale vend depot at Jayankondasholapuram. There is no sweet juice industry in the range. The number of trees marked for fermented toddy averages about 900 coconuts for each year, while the number of trees marked for shops of the range averages about 2,750 coconuts. Jayankondasholapuram is the headquarters of a Tahsildar and a Stationary Second-class Magistrate. The range was for a long time patrolled by a Sub-Inspector with six orderlies. But in the year 1901, a party consisting of one petty officer and five peons was posted to this range, three of the Sub-Inspector's orderlies being simultaneously withdrawn—vide paragraph 2 of Board's Reference on Government R. No. 246, Salt, dated 14th July 1904, printed in B.P. R. No. 213/3610, Salt, dated 17th September 1904. The party was eventually abolished on 11th June 1909 as per B.P. R. No. 101/1905-R., Salt, dated 30th April 1909, and the strength of the Sub-Inspector's orderlies increased to six peons (1—5). In 1912 it was reduced to (1—2) the present strength. The headquarters of the range is Jayankondasholapuram.

(1) *Jayankondasholapuram.*—A Local Fund bungalow near the toll-gate and a Local Fund chattram in the heart of the town for Indian officers.

B.—Ariyalur Range.

Description.

This range is about 300 square miles in extent and is traversed by fairly good roads. It contains 60 ryotwari villages, 12 inam and 42 zamin villages with a population of 160,396.

It is bounded on the north by the Yesanai and the Jayankondasholapuram ranges, on the east by the Jayankondasholapuram range, on the south by the Papanasam and Tirukkattupalli ranges of the Tanjore circle, and on the west by the Lalgudi, Perambalur and Yesanai ranges. The Coleroon river separates this range from the ranges of the Tanjore circle. There are 18 arrack and 8 toddy shops in the range with one ganja shop and one arrack wholesale depot at Ariyalur. There is no sweet toddy tapping in the range. The number of trees marked in the range for fermented toddy averages about 400 coconuts, while the number marked for the shops of the range averages about 2,400 coconut trees every year. Ariyalur is the headquarters of a Deputy Tahsildar and Magistrate, and of the Divisional Officer, Ariyalur. It is an important place in the range and is the residence of a zamindar. Ever since the tree-tapping system was introduced, the range was patrolled by one Sub-Inspector and six peons (1—5). But in 1912, the strength of peons was reduced to three (1—2) its present strength. The headquarters of the range is Ariyalur.

(1) *Kilapalur*.—A Local Fund rest-house and a choultry for Indian officers. Good iluppai and mango topes are found near the toll-gate on the side of the Ariyalur road.

(2) *Ariyalur*.—A Local Fund rest-house for officers. Tents can be pitched in the market compound on all days except Sunday (market day).

(3) *Tirumanur*.—One rest-house on the Tanjore road, and one Local Fund choultry on the same road. Good iluppai topes are available along the bank of the Coleroon river. There is a village chavadi near the police station.

(4) *Tirumalavadi*.—A village chavadi and a chattram are available for Indians. Good iluppai topes are available along the bank of the Coleroon river.

(5) *Vilangudi*.—Good iluppai topes are available along the road half a mile west of the village.

C.—Perambalur Range.

Description.

The range is about 275 square miles in extent, and is traversed by fairly good roads except in the interior, which consists of black cotton soil and saline tracts. It contains 44 ryotwari villages, 3 inam and 13 zamin villages with a total population of 101,079. It is bounded on the north by the Yesanai range, on the east by the Ariyalur range, on the south by the Lalgudi and Mannachanallur ranges, and on the west by the Turaiyur range. There are 14 arrack shops and 10 toddy shops in the range, with one opium shop and one arrack wholesale depot at Perambalur. There is no sweet toddy tapping in the range. The number of coconut trees marked in the range for fermented toddy averages about 600 while the number of trees marked for the shops of the range is about 900 coconuts. This range was formerly remarkable for salt crime which, however, became practically extinct from 1906 to 1915 due to the reclamation of saline soils for agricultural purposes and the reduction of salt duty. But there has been a recrudescence of crime from 1916–17 owing to the rise in price of salt in the rural parts in consequence of depletion of stocks during the war. Perambalur is the headquarters of the Tahsildar and a Stationary Sub-Magistrate. The area comprising the range was until 1901 patrolled by a Sub-Inspector and 3 orderlies, and 2 parties consisting of one petty officer and 5 peons each. Owing to the abnormal increase in salt crime in Jayankondasholapuram range one of the parties was transferred, as a tentative measure, in 1901 to that range in exchange for three men transferred to this range as Sub-Inspector's orderlies; and this arrangement was confirmed in 1904. In 1909, the other party was abolished; and in 1912, the number of second-grade peons was reduced from 5 to 2. The establishment now consists of 2 first-grade peons and 1 second-grade peon.

(9) *Kalattur*.—An iluppai tope to the east of the village chavadi.

(10) *Ammapalaiyam*.—An iluppai tope to the east of the village on the Turaiyur to Perambalur road.

Besides the above, there are Village Munsif's chavadies in many villages.

D.—*Yesanai Range*.

This range is about 409.28 square miles in extent and is traversed by two good roads. The interior portion of the range consists of black cotton soil. The range contains 60 ryotwari villages, 9 zamin villages, and 7 inam villages, with a total population of 131,092. It is bounded on the north by the Attur range of Salem circle and Tittagudi range of Tiruk-kōyilur circle, on the east by the Jayankondasholapuram and Ariyalur ranges, on the south by the Perambalur range, and on the west by the Pachamalai hills of the Turaiyur range. There are 16 toddy shops and 18 arrack shops in the range, sweet toddy industry is carried on on a small scale, and the sweet juice manufactured is converted into jaggery. About 1,650 coconut trees are marked in the range every year for fermented toddy, while the total number of trees marked for the shops of the range averages about 1,450 coconut trees, besides a few palmyra trees. The range was originally patrolled by one Sub-Inspector and three orderlies and a party consisting of one petty officer and five peons. The party was abolished in November 1904, and the strength of the Sub-Inspector was raised to one petty officer and six peons. In 1912 the petty officer was replaced by one first-grade peon and the number of second-grade peons was reduced to five. The strength of Sub-Inspector's orderly consists of two first-grade peons and two second-grade peons from 1st February 1919. The headquarters of the range is Yesanai which is 5 miles off Perambalur, the taluk headquarters.

B.—Turaiyur Range.

Description.

This range is about 450.49 square miles in extent and is traversed by fairly good roads. It contains 83 villages, of which 11 are inam, 12 zamin and 60 (plain and hill) ryotwari villages, with a total population of 174,669. It is bounded on the north by Attur taluk, on the east by the Yesanai and Perambalur ranges, on the south by the Mannachanallur and Musiri ranges and on the west by the Erumaipatti and Sendamangalam ranges of the Sankaridrug circle. There are 32 toddy shops, 19 arrack shops, one ganja and one opium shop in the range with two arrack wholesale depots, one at Turaiyur and the other at Mettupaliyam. The sweet toddy industry is conducted on a limited scale and the juice is partly used as a beverage and partly converted into jaggery. The number of trees tapped for sweet toddy is about 650 palmyra trees. About 5,200 coconut trees are marked in the range every year and about 4,800 coconut trees are marked for the shops of the range in the same period. The area comprising the old Turaiyur range was originally patrolled by one Sub-Inspector and three orderlies, and two parties, each consisting of one petty officer and 5 peons. One of the parties (the Edumalai party) was abolished in November 1904 and the other (the Turaiyur party) on 11th June 1909. On the abolition of the parties, the strength of the Sub-Inspector's orderlies was increased to 6 peons (1—5). The strength of the Sub-Inspector's orderlies was again reduced from 1st February 1919 to 4 peons (2—2). Turaiyur is the headquarters of the Sub-Inspector and the Deputy Tahsildar and second-class Magistrate, and is the residence of a zamindar. It has also a local fund dispensary.

F.—Musiri Range.

Description.

The range is about 225 square miles in extent and is traversed by good roads. It contains 45 ryotwari, 5 zamin and 10 inam villages with a total population of 108,551. It is bounded on the north by the Erumaipatti and Turai ranges, on the east by the Turaiyur and Mannachanallur ranges, on the south by the Cauvery river and on the west by the Cauvery river and Erumaipatti range of the Namakkal taluk. There are 9 arrack and 27 toddy shops in the range, with one arrack wholesale depot at Kattuputhur. The sweet toddy industry is carried on, on a very small scale, about 200 palmyra trees being tapped for sweet juice every year and the juice is partly converted into jaggery and partly used as a beverage. About 4,750 coconut trees are marked in the range every year besides a few palmyras. The trees marked for the shops of the range average about 4,400 coconuts. Owing to reclamation of saline soils, salt crime is practically extinct now. There are about 42 crude saltpetre factories in the range. Musiri, which is the headquarters of the range Sub-Inspector, is also the headquarters of the Circle Inspector, Revenue Divisional Officer, Musiri Division, and Tahsildar and a Stationary Second-class Magistrate, Musiri taluk. It is two miles north of the Kulittalai railway station on the northern bank of the river Cauvery. The area comprising the range was originally patrolled by a Sub-Inspector and three orderlies and a party consisting of one petty officer and five peons. The party was abolished on 10th June 1909, and the orderlies of the Sub-Inspector increased to 6 (1—5). The present strength is two first-grade peons and two second-grade peons.

Description.

The range was formed on 1st April 1918 from the old Mannachanallur range [excepting three villages, viz., Vellithirumuttam, (2) Tiruvanaikaval, and (3) Melur of south Trichinopoly circle] with the addition of 19 villages comprised in the Yedumalai firka of the Musiri taluk transferred to the Lalgudi taluk from the above date. The range extends over an area of 165.04 square miles and contains 43 Government and 7 Inam villages with a total population of 84,912. It is bounded on the north by the Turaiyur and Perambalur ranges, on the east by the Lalgudi range, on the south by the Coleroon river and on the west by Musiri and Turaiyur ranges. There are 10 arrack shops and 13 toddy shops in the range. There are very extensive coconut topes in the range but the sweet juice industry is almost nil. The number of trees marked in the range averages about 8,000 coconuts and 200 palmyras. There are good roads traversing through the range excepting the Yedumalai firka. The establishment of the range has undergone several changes and now consists of one Sub-Inspector and four peons (two first grade—two second-grade). The headquarters of the range is Mannachanallur.

It is bounded on the north by the Perambalur range, on the east by the Ariyalur range, on the south by the Coleroon river and on the west by the Mannachanallur range. There are 13 arrack and 14 toddy shops, one ganja shop, one opium shop, and one arrack depot in the range. Coconut topes are extensive in the southern part of the range and in the northern and north-eastern parts there are extensive saline soils where salt was manufactured in former days and salt crime was rife but as these soils have been gradually reclaimed for agricultural purposes and the duty on salt has been considerably reduced, there is no great inducement for crime now, though, on account of the economical conditions produced by the great European War, there was a slight recrudescence of the crime recently. The important village in the range is Lalgudi, the headquarters of the Tahsildar of the taluk of the same name and Stationary Sub-Magistrate, besides being the headquarters of the range Sub-Inspector. The range is traversed by fairly good roads except in the interior. The average number of trees marked every year in the range is 9,100 coconuts and 30 palmyras. The range is now patrolled by a Sub-Inspector and four poens (Two first-grade, two second-grade).

EXISE REVENUE.

Country
spirits.

From 1st October 1884, the monopoly of manufacture and of supply of country spirits was abolished; and the "Free supply" system, under which all licensed vendors were free to obtain supplies from such licensed distilleries as were suitable to them on payment of duty, at prescribed rates on all issues from distilleries, was adopted. From 1st April 1901, the contract distillery supply system was reverted to, and the East India Distilleries and Sugar Factories Company, Limited, Nellikuppam, supplied molasses arrack through the warehouse opened at Trichinopoly and this continues up to date. The depots in the ranges get their supply from the Trichinopoly warehouse, except the depot at Jayankondasholapuram which gets its supply from the Tanjore warehouse. The rates of still head duty fixed from time to time are shown below :—

The privilege of vend was formerly sold in farms, each taluk, being a farm, and the independent system of selling shops came into force in the Lalgudi taluk from 1st April 1892 and in the other taluks from 1st April 1894. 30° U.P. liquor was originally consumed in this circle, but gradually the issue strength of the liquor was reduced to 32° U.P. from 1st April 1914 to 34° U.P. from 1st April 1917 and 35° U.P. from 1st April 1918.

The exclusive sale of 60° U.P. liquor was tried as an experimental measure from 1st April 1919 in two selected shops of the circle, viz., Mannachanallur of the Lalgudi taluk and Marudur of the Udaiyarpalaiyam taluk. The experiment was abolished from 1st April 1921.

There are seven arrack wholesale depots in this circle.—(1) Jayankondasholapuram, (2) Ariyalur, (3) Perambalur, (4) Turaiyur, (5) Mettupalaiyam, (6) Kattupputtur and (7) Lalgudi. All the independent shopkeepers get their supply from the depots near at hand. Such of the shops in Musiri and Lalgudi taluks as are very near the Kulittalai and Trichinopoly wholesale depots get their supply from those depots.

Retail selling price of arrack varies from 3 to 4 annas per dram of 85° U.P. and from 2 to 2½ annas per dram of 60° U.P.

The chief classes of consumers are agriculturists, petty traders and labourers.

The supply of toddy is adequate throughout the circle. All shops are dependent upon coconut toddy throughout the year excepting a few which mark a few palmyra trees during palmyra season. For want of sufficient number of trees, some of the shops mark trees in South Trichinopoly, Tanjore, Cuddalore, Tirukkōyilūr and Sankaridrug circles. Toddy is drawn only once in the morning from coconut trees and twice from palmyras. Tappers are poor and are paid at the rate varying from 1 to 1½ annas per gallon of toddy delivered at the topes. In some places, tappers are paid wages varying from Rs. 10 to Rs. 15 a month. Manufacture of sweet juice is carried on on a limited extent in Yesanai, Turaiyur, Musiri and Manachanallur ranges. The juice is partly converted into jaggery and partly used as beverage. Toddy is transported mostly by head-loads in pots, and by carts when the distance is long. The transport coolies are paid from 2 to 5 annas a day according to the distance. The shop-keepers enter into an agreement with the tree-owners directly for the leasing of the trees, and the tappers have no concern in the matter. The usual fee charged by the tree-owners varies from Rs. 5 to Rs. 8 per coconut tree per half year. Four annas is charged for each poramboke palmyra tree for a year and in the case of private topes, they are taken on a yearly lease, including usufruct cases of illicit tapping, mostly after payment of tree-tax, but before marking and of transport, sales, and diversion are prevalent in this circle. Besides the offences enumerated above, mixture of Padhani (sweet juice) with fermented toddy is rarely resorted to in the circle and the circle is not one of those listed for conducting boiling tests. The limit of private possession of toddy is one gallon. Toddy is consumed chiefly by working classes, and consumption is increasing on account of its cheapness and healthy qualities.

OPIUM.

Issue price
of opium.

There are three opium shops in the circle, one in each of the ranges noted below:—

- (1) C. Perambalur (temporarily closed, 1919-20).
- (2) E. Turaiyūr.
- (3) H. Lalgudi.

The shop-keepers procure their supply from the Taluk office, Trichinopoly. The retail selling price is Re. 8-0 to Re. 12-0 a tola. Many of the lower classes and some of the well-to-do classes use the drug. The latter use it exclusively for medical purposes. The consumption averages 22 seers per annum. Sometimes when minor shops fall into the hands of rival parties, underselling is the result. There are no smoking dens in the circle and smuggling is unknown.

GANJA.

Ganja

There are three ganja shops in the circle—

- (1) B. Ariyalūr.
- (2) E. Turaiyūr.
- (3) H. Lalgudi.

The shops get their supply from storehouse at Santavasal or at Veta-palem. Ganja is not consumed by respectable classes but only by the lower order and pilgrims from Northern India. Muhammadans and Byragies chiefly go in for this, and this habit is spreading.

The average annual consumption is 3 maunds. The retail selling prices have varied from time to time. The rates of duty per seer of 80 tolas of ganja, charas and bhang fixed from time to time, are given below.

The present retail selling price is As. 10 per tola.

There is no temptation to smuggle ganja and ganja crime is not prevalent to any appreciable extent. It is very difficult to say whether the taste for ganja has increased or decreased in any one class.
