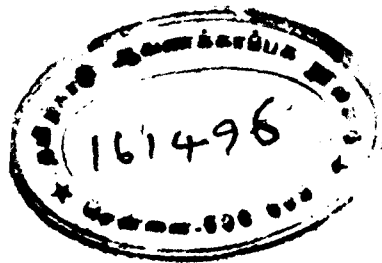

THE MADRAS LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL

The Thirteenth Session of the Legislative Council under
the Constitution of India.

Wednesday, the 29th October 1958.

The House met in the Council Chamber, Fort St. George, at three of the clock, the Deputy Chairman (SRI A. M. ALLAPICHAJ) in the Chair.

I.—CONDOLENCE RESOLUTION ON THE DEATH OF SRI C. PERUMALSWAMI REDDI, A MEMBER OF THE MADRAS LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL.

DEPUTY CHAIRMAN : It is my painful duty to announce to the House the death of Sri C. Perumalswami Reddi, a Member of this House, on the night of 23rd October 1958 at his residence in Nungambakkam, Madras. He was first elected to the Madras Legislative Council in 1936 and he continued to be a Member of the Council till his death.

Born in 1890, Sri Perumalswami Reddi entered politics early in life and became first the President of the Polur Taluk Board in 1925. He was chosen as Vice-President of the Tiruvannamalai District Board in 1936 and later in 1938 he became the President of the North Arcot District Board which position he held for several years. He was for some time a Member of the Constituent Assembly. An ardent Congressman, he took active part in the Civil Disobedience Movement in 1940-41 and in the "Quit India" Movement in 1942 and suffered imprisonment for nine months and detention for two and a half years, respectively. He was appointed Minister for Industries in Sri P. S. Kumaraswami Raja's Ministry in April 1949. Even after the resignation of the Ministry, he continued to be a Member of the Council.

Sri Perumalswami Reddi evinced keen interest in the administration of local bodies and took a leading part in the co-operative movement. He devoted most of his lifetime to the development of local bodies in our State. In his death, the North Arcot District in general and local authorities in particular have suffered a great loss.

I now move the following Condolence Resolution :—

" This House places on record its deep sense of sorrow at the demise of Sri C. Perumalswami Reddi, a Member of this House, and conveys its profound sympathy to the members of his bereaved family."

2 CONDOLENCE RESOLUTION ON THE DEATH OF SRI C. PERUMALSWAMI REDDI, A MEMBER OF THE MADRAS LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL

*The HON. SRI M. A. MANICKAVELU : Mr. Deputy Chairman, Sir, on behalf of the Government, I associate myself with what you have said. Sir, Mr. Reddi was a prominent figure in the political field in his district. For a few months recently he was not attending the meetings of the Council. We never thought that he would be snatched away in this fashion. I request you, Sir, to convey the feelings of the House in the form of the Resolution to the members of the bereaved family.

SRI K. BALASUBRAMANYA AYYAR : Mr. Deputy Chairman, Sir, I associate myself with the Resolution moved by you. I had known Sri Perumalswami Reddiar for some years. He took a leading part in the national struggle for freedom. He courted imprisonment and detention. He was a selfless worker. He took a keen interest in co-operation and he took a very keen interest in agriculture. I have special pride in saying that he shared with me some of the misgivings which I had about the various land reforms. He was not attending the meetings of the Council for a long time. A prominent and sober politician, he had considered views on many questions. He was singularly free from any bias in his views. That is a great thing. I beg to associate myself with the sentiments expressed by you and by the Hon. Minister Sri Manickavelu.

DEPUTY CHAIRMAN : I request the hon. Members to stand in silence for a few minutes and pass the Resolution unanimously.

The Resolution was passed *nem. con.*, all the Members standing in silence for a few minutes.

DEPUTY CHAIRMAN : As a mark of respect to the late Sri C. Perumalswami Reddi, I adjourn the House for the day.

The House will meet again at 3 p.m. to-morrow.

The House then adjourned.

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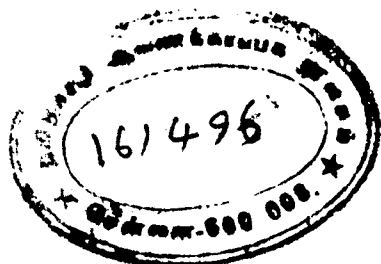
