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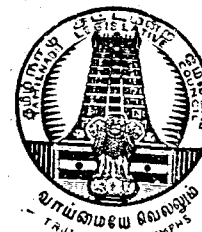

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திரு. தாமோதரன் அவர்கள் எழுப்பிய பிரச்சினையை இரு பகுதிகளாகப் பிரிக்கலாம். (1) வரி விதிப்பு குறித்த விவரங்களை அவைக்கு வெளியிடும் முன்பு செய்தித் தாளில் வெளியிடுவது, (2) நிதிநிலை அறிக்கை அவைக்கு அளிக்கப்படுவதற்கு முன்பாக அதில் காணப்படும் விபரம் வெளியானது குறித்து.

அவை நடந்துகொண்டிருக்கும்போது கொள்கை குறித்த அறிக்கைகளை அவைக்கு முதலில் அளிக்கவேண்டுமென்பது மாய. மாண்புமிகு வருவாய்த் துறை அமைச்சர், அவரோ அல்லது அரசோ அல்லது அரசு அதிகாரிகளோ இந்த விவரத்தைச் செய்தித்தாளுக்குத் தரவில்லை என்று விளக்கமாகக் கூறினார். மேலும் இச்செய்தி செய்தித்தாளில் பிரசுரிக்கப்பட்ட நாட்களில் அவைக் கூட்டம் இல்லை. எனவே அந்த மரபு மீறப்படவில்லை.

போதுதலன் குறித்து அறிக்கைகளைச் சட்டப்பேரவை களுக்குத் தருமுன் சொல்வதானது அவையின் உரிமைப் பிரச்சினையில் வராது.

இரண்டாவதாக, நிதி நிலை அறிக்கையில் வரக்கூடிய விவரம் முன்னதாக வெளியிடப்படுவதும் அவையுரிமைப் பிரச்சினையில் வராது. இதுகுறித்து இங்கிலாந்து பாராளுமன்றத்தில் இரண்டு முன் மாதிரிகள் உள்ளன. அவை 'தாமஸ் வழக்கு' மற்றும் 'டால்டன் வழக்கு'—மாகும். இந்த இரண்டு வழக்குகளும் நிதி நிலை அறிக்கையின் விவரங்களை முன்னதாக வெளியிடப்பட்டுள்ளது குறித்தவையாகும். இந்த இரண்டு வழக்குகளிலும் எழுப்பப்பட்ட பிரச்சினை அவை உரிமை மீறிய பிரச்சினைகள் அல்ல என்று தீர்ப்பு வழங்கப்பட்டுள்ளது. இந்தியப் பாராளுமன்றத்திலும், பிற மாதிரிச் சட்டமன்றங்களிலும் இம்மாதிரியான தீர்ப்புகள் வழங்கப்பட்டுள்ளன.

1960 ஆம் ஆண்டு நிதி நிலை அறிக்கை அவையில் வெளியிடப்படுவதற்கு முன் அதில் கண்டுள்ள அழகுபொருட்களமேல் விதிக்கப்படும் விற்பனை வரி குறித்த விபரம் முன்னதாகவே பத்திரிகையில் வெளிவந்தது பற்றி டாக்டர் எ. இலட்சுமணசுவாமி முதலியார் அவர்கள் 18—3—1960 அன்று ஓர் உரிமைப் பிரச்சினையை இந்த அவையில் எழுப்பியபோது, அப்போதைய தலைவர் டாக்டர் பி. வி. சேரியன் அவர்கள் கீழ்க்கண்டவாறு தீர்ப்பளித்தார் :—

“வரவு—செலவுத் திட்டத்தில் வரி விதிப்புச் செயற் குறிப்புகள் குறித்த செய்தி அவைக்கு அறிக்குமுன்பு வெளியே பரவுவது பின்வரும் காரணங்களால் அவை உரிமை மீறிய பிரச்சினையாகக் கொள்ளமுடியாது” என்று அவர் தீர்ப்பளித்தார். காரணங்களாவன :

1. அவை முன் நிதி நிலை குறித்த செயற்குறிப்புகள் வைக்கப்படும்வரை அவைகள் அரசு இரகசியமாகும் தனியாக அவையின் உரிமையாகாது.

2. அத்தகைய செயற் குறிப்புகள் குறித்த செய்திகள் ‘அமைச்சரவை இரகசியம்’. போது மக்களின் நலனைக் கருத்தில் கொண்டு அவற்றை அமைச்சரவை பாதுகாக்க வேண்டுமென்றிருந்த போதிலும், அதை முன்னதாக வெளியிடுவது அவையின் உரிமைப் பிரச்சினை ஆகாது.

3. அரசின் வரி விதிப்பு குறித்த செயற்குறிப்புகளை முதலில் சட்டமன்ற உறுப்பினர்களுக்குத் தெரிவிக்க வேண்டுமென்பது, ஏற்பளிக்கப்பட்ட அவை உரிமைகளில் சேர்க்கப்படவில்லை.

எனவே, திரு. தாமோதரன் அவர்கள் எழுப்பிய பிரச்சினை மேலெழுந்த வாகியாகப் பரிகாரம்போது, அவை உரிமை மீறிய செயல் அல்ல என்று தீர்ப்பு கூறுகிறேன்.

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With reference to a representation made about the coverage of the proceedings of the Legislative Council by the All India Radio, the Chairman observed—

‘சட்டமன்றத்தின் இன்று’ திகழ்ச்சியின்போது வானொலியில் பேசுவது திகழ்ச்சிகளை முன்பெல்லாம் சொல்லாத சங்கடமாக இருந்திருக்கலாம். நாளை முன்பெல்லாம் மாலை மீள் சட்டமன்ற பேசுவது நடவடிக்கைகள் தடைபெற்றதால், இப்போது பேசுவது நடவடிக்கைகள் காலையில் தடைபெறுவதால், அவர்களுக்கு ‘சட்டமன்றத்தின் இன்று’ திகழ்ச்சியின் போது பேசுவது திகழ்ச்சிகளைச் சொல்ல வாய்ப்பாக இருக்கும். பேசுவது திகழ்ச்சிகளுக்கு இடம் தர வழிவகை இருக்கிறது. மாண்புமிகு உறுப்பினர் எழுப்பியிருந்த பிரச்சினையை நான் வானொலி நிகழ்ச்சிகளுடைய கவனத்திற்குக் கொண்டு வந்துகிறேன். வானொலி நிகழ்ச்சி இன்று இருக்கிறார் என்பது நான் எங்களுக்கு விளக்கி இருக்கிறேன். அவர்களுக்கு இது தெரிந்த கவனிப்பார்கள். நான் இந்த அவர்களுடைய கவனத்திற்குக் கொண்டு செல்கிறேன்.”

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“ஒருவர் இந்த அவையில் உறுப்பினராகத் தேர்ந்தெடுக்கப்பட்டால், இவ்வளவு நாட்களுக்குள் வந்து பதவிப் பிரமாணம் எடுத்துக் கொள்ள வேண்டும் என்று விதிமுறை இருக்கிறது. அதற்குள் அவர் வராவிட்டால் இயற்கையாகவே அவருடைய பதவி காலாவதியாகிறது, அவ்வளவு தான். அவைத் தலைவரும், இந்த அவையும் அக்கறையைச் செலுத்த முடியும். அவர் எத்தனை நாள் சீக்கிரத்து வருகிறார் என்பதைப் பற்றி அவைக்கு அக்கறையில்லை.”

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Walk-out—

When some members walked out at the time of voting on a motion, the Chairman observed—

“வெளியேறிவதென்பது உறுப்பினர்களின் உரிமை. ஆனால், வெளியேறிவதற்கு ஒரு இடத்தைத் தேர்ந்தெடுக்க வேண்டும். ஏற்கனவே இப்படி நடந்திருக்கிறதோ, என்னவோ, வாக்கெடுப்பின் போது வெளிநடப்பு செய்வது நல்லதொரு சம்பிரதாயமல்ல என்பதைத் தெரிவித்துக் கொள்கிறேன்.”

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
