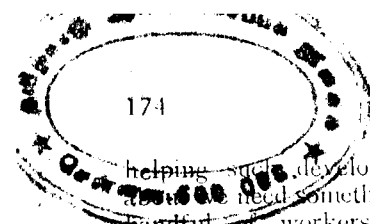

helping such development. But to bring it about we need something more than our present handful of workers and our few hundred thousands of boys and girls.

We need a more widespread knowledge and appreciation of our aims, and more general support and cooperation in our work. Can we not, each in our own country, enlist into our crusade (and where possible to take active part in it) the best men and women that exist, that is the greatest thinkers to advise us, the finest speakers to promote our cause, the best writers to expound our cause, the heads of the different Churches, the Statesmen, the leaders of labour, of commerce, of art, etc., all in one great combine for the good of all.

We do not want faddists, or others, with ulterior interests of their own in mind, but practical men imbued with the sole desire to make a better world of it.

I am not a great believer in councils, but I do believe in cooperation with others working to the same ends.

It is suggested that a small selection committee might be set up in each country to consider

which would be the best men in that nation to call upon, and then to carry the idea into effect, and ask these men to join us, and each in his own line to help us in a genuine world wide effort to achieve that great end.

It would indeed be as great as any ever, attempted; and the time seems to be ripe for it. The time seems ripe, first, because nations are tired of war and are yet in a state of unrest for want of common ideals to go upon. Secondly because
