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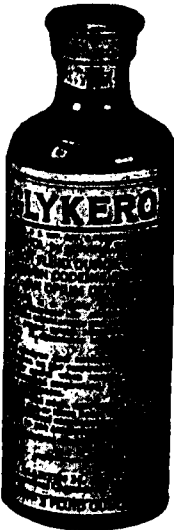
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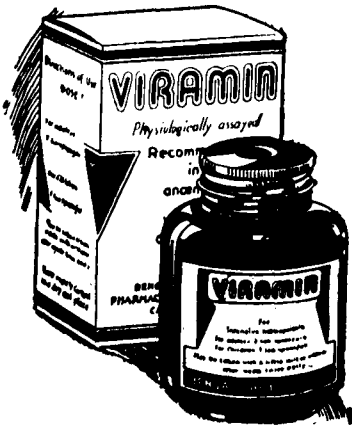
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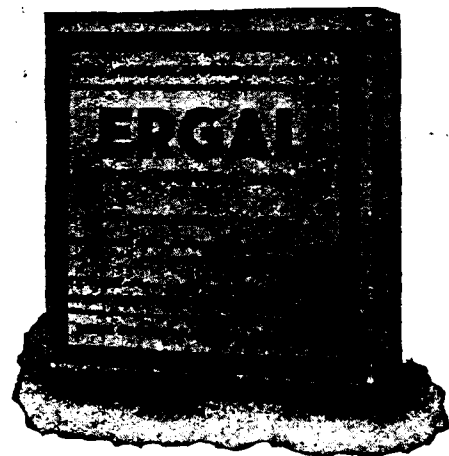
General treatment. Though it is certain that together with the above treatment patients

are always advised to obey the general rules of hygiene, yet we must be precise in our statements. The patients should always be asked to save their eyes from Sun or glare, dust smoke and dirt etc., and should try to live as far as possible a sober life, free from drink etc. Now the Madras School under Wright has begun to think that Trachoma is also a deficiency disease and therefore the patients should always be advised to take more of vitamins, in the form of cod liver oil, fresh fruits, eggs, tomatoes etc. All irritating diet should be avoided. Constipation and pyorrhoea should be treated.

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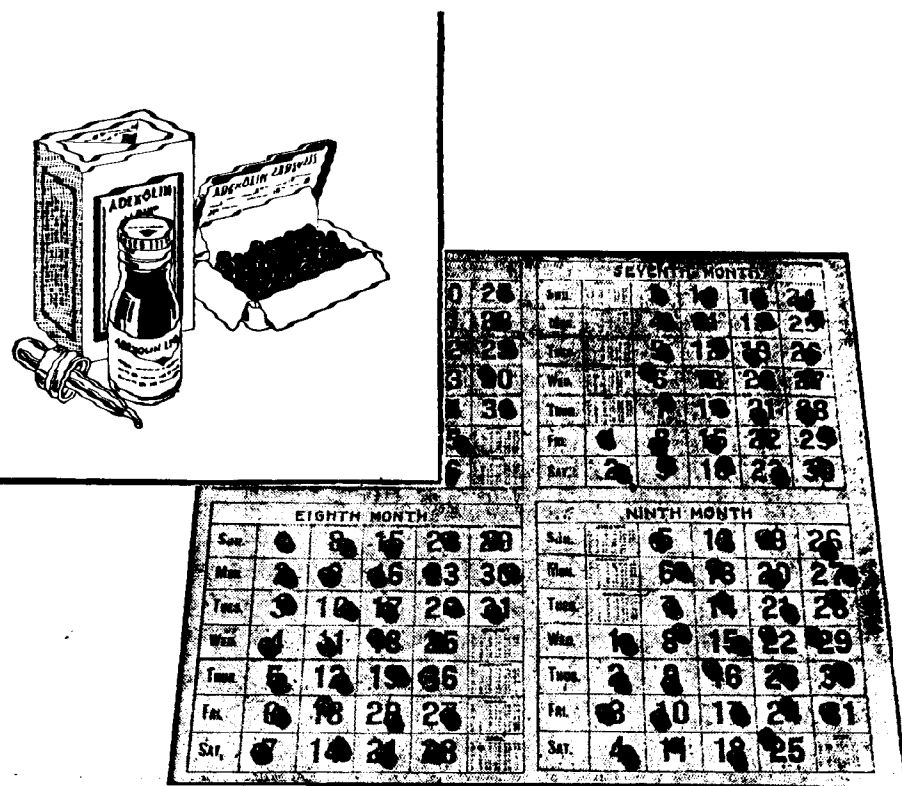
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
