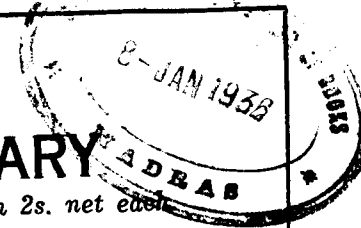

Sir Arthur Eddington is the founder in this country and the leader of the modern school of experimental philosophers, and is the first and most famous exponent of Einstein's theory.

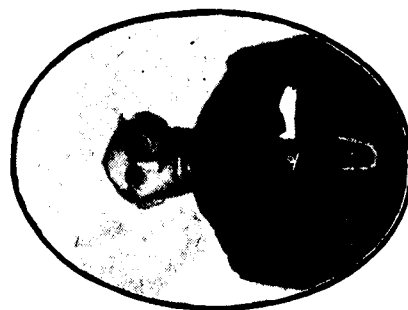

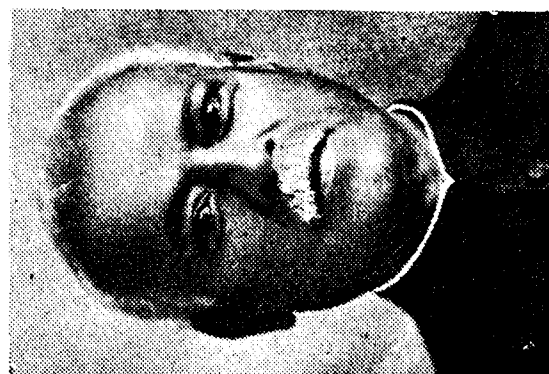

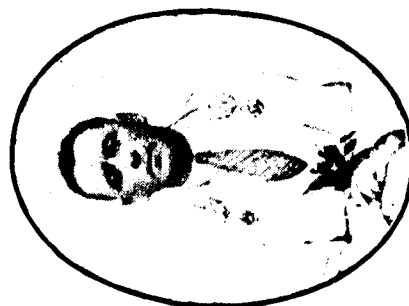

developed out of the Leprosy Survey made in that area. Forty-six boys suffering from leprosy were found in the schools, and the realization of this fact prompted the community to organize thorough medical inspection of schools. Later an Education Week was held at which a Sports Meet, musical contests, and a handwork exhibition were arranged and healthy activities were encouraged. It would be good if such associations could be organized in many places.

This record suggests to teachers many different ways of co-operation between home and school. Difficulties in the way of such co-operation, such as differences of language and social custom, pressure of work and constant transfers of teachers, have not been mentioned but they are obvious to all teachers. Many qualities in the teacher are needed to promote friendly relationships among the homes from which their pupils come; a love of children and tact with parents, a devotion to one's profession and a readiness to work overtime. But it is these qualities in teachers which will make Indian Education truly useful and teachers doing such work are in the highest sense doing national service.
