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GLYKERON loosens the mucus in the bronchial passages and aids in its expulsion.

It lessens the hazard of complications by getting rid of germ-laden secretions.

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GOUT AND RHEUMATISM

GOUT and RHEUMATISM may be said to be due to

- (a) UNDUE RETENTION OF THE PRODUCTS OF FAULTY METABOLISM

- (b) ENCOURAGEMENT AND STIMULATION OF ELIMINATION
