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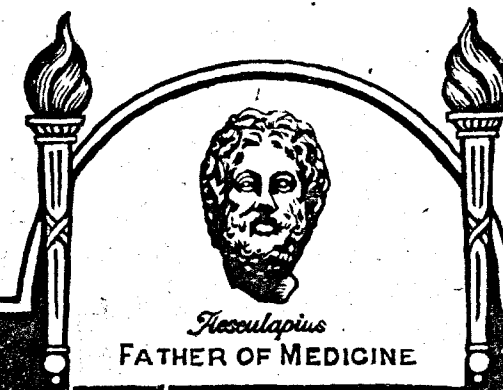
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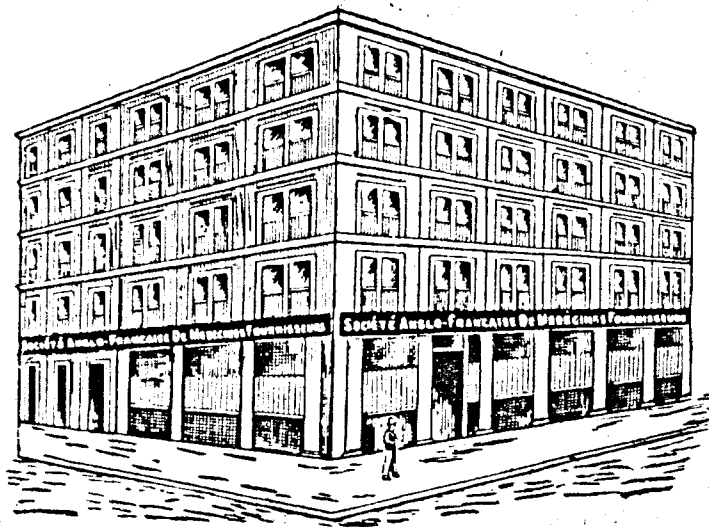

Ancient Medicine

Since the dawn of civilization, healers of the sick and medical men have been, next to kings and queens, the outstanding characters in the progress of mankind.

Babylon

The Babylonians were not free from the practice of mingling magic beliefs with scientific knowledge, for we know from old tablets that their medical men were quite scientific. They were highly cultured gentlemen, lovers of art and gardening, who lived an ideal family life, and were profound students. Their code of ethics was guided by the code of Hammurabi, the first king of Babylon who reigned between the second and third millenium before Christ. The many references in the code point to an attempt at socialization of medicine. "The doctor who treats and cures a gentleman's wounds, or who has operated on the eye with a copper lancet, shall charge ten shekels of silver as his fee. If the patient be a poor man, the doctor shall charge five shekels of silver. If the patient be a servant his master shall pay the doctor two shekels of silver."

Insulin as Insanity Treatment

Growing Use in Canada

Insulin as a treatment for dementia præcox is now being given in a number of mental hospitals in Canada, according to Dr. C. H. Best, Professor of Physiology at the University of Toronto. Dr. Best was a co-discoverer of insulin with Sir Frederick Grant Banting.

The use of insulin for mental cases, Dr. Best has stated while on a visit to the University of California is being gradually expanded in Canada.

While apparent cures have been effected in a number of cases and partial relief afforded in others, Dr. Best added, the percentage of failure was so great that no definite conclusion could be made for the treatment at present.

The method, first tried in Austria, two years ago, consists of giving the patient a much heavier dose than would be given in a case of diabetes. Such heavy doses are said to cause reactions that directly affect the brain centres.—

THE ALCHEMISTS.

Albertus Magnus and Raymond Dully, who searched so diligently for the Philosopher's Stone, by means of which their ingots of lustreless lead were to be turned into bars of ruddy gold, had little thought of atoms, molecules or ions, and yet the actual discoveries they and their fellow-seekers obtained in the field of chemical science formed a not negligible ground work on which latter-day workers were able to build up the still incomplete structure of chemical knowledge. Of the numerous alchemists who flourished during, and in the centuries succeeding, the Middle Ages, the Count de St. Germain was a notable figure. He was a distinguished and welcome habitue at the Court of Louis XV of France, where his claims to have discovered, among other things, the elixir of life were not entirely discredited. It seems to be an undisputed fact that he was in possession of a secret process for removing spots and flaws from diamonds, and that by utilising this knowledge he made a considerable fortune. Madame de Hausset relates that Louis XV had a stone containing a flaw, and that the diamond in that state was valued at six thousand livres. The King entrusted it to St. Germain for treatment, and when it came back flawless had it offered for sale to a jeweller, who knew nothing of its antecedents. The jeweller paid nine thousand six hundred livres for the stone—and Louis' respect for the Count increased in proportion.

HOMERIC ECHOES.

Æsculapius, the blameless physician revered by the ancient Greeks as the god of healing, had two sons, Machaon and Podalirius, who were also proficient in medical art. They obtained

their tuition from their father; and from the Centaur Cheiron, who is called by Homer the "Sire of Pharmacy." During the Trojan war Machon and Podalirius acted as surgeons-in-chief to the Greek Army, and by their skill and knowledge saved the lives of many members of the investing force. The Iliad records how Machaon dressed the wounded foot of Philoctetes, and how he attended the Spartan King, Menelaus, when the latter was wounded by an arrow. After with drawing the arrowhead from the sufferer's arm Machaon applied a healing balm prepared by Cheiron, the master, thereby doubtless affording to the doubly-injured husband of Helen considerable relief and comfort. Fate ordained that an arrow loosed by Helen's abductor, Paris, should wound Machaon, though not fatally. He recovered, but before the end of the siege was killed by Eury-pylus, a fighter in the Trojan Army. The loss of his dearly-loved brother filled Podalirius with grief and rage, so that, forsaking for a while his first-aid station, he rushed among the foemen, killing and wounding, in his endeavour to avenge his brother's death. Machaon's bones were carried to the Island of Rhodes, and their resting place became a sanctuary to which the sick resorted in order to be made whole. Podalirius survived the siege of Troy, but on returning home was cast by a storm on the coast of Syros. There he settled and died, after practising his healing powers among the native Carians. The value in which the brothers were held by the Greek forces is evidenced by the remark of Idomeneus, when Machaon is wounded by Paris—

"A wise physician, skilled our wounds to heal is more than armies to the public weal."

A Window in Her Chest!

A Poland Medical Wonder.

An extraordinary case of a nine year-old girl is mystifying doctors in the town of Grudzonc, Poland. Her name is Maria Maliszewsky, but they call her the Child with a Heart of Gold, for doctors can watch her heart beating and it is valuable from a medical point of view.

A physician of the Municipal Hospital was one day walking along the main square of the little town when his attention was attracted by a crowd that had collected. Elbowing his way through, he saw in the centre of the crowd a shabbily-dressed man who was urging the spectators to view his daughter, a thin girl of nine years. The upper part of her body was unclad and she stood there shivering in the cold air.

"Anyone paying a nickel may come close and see how the heart works," he said, pointing to the child's chest.

The doctor stepped forward, paid his money and looked closely at the girl. To his amazement he found that her heart was just underneath the skin, protected only by the thin transparent layer of pericardium through which he could distinctly see the heart muscles working.

A Wonder

"Why, this child is a medical wonder!" he exclaimed to the father. "You should have her examined by doctors." But the man, distrustful apparently of doctors, replied that he saw no reason why his child should be medically examined.

The doctor, his scientific interest now thoroughly aroused by the extraordinary case, changed his tactics. He told the man that he was an impresario looking for a new turn for a circus. Would the father bring the girl to his flat the next day for his partners to have a look at her, so as to decide whether she could figure on the programme of the circus. The doctor produced a banknote, and the father, thus bribed, promised to keep the appointment.

Thus it was that the child was examined by the doctors from the municipal Hospital. They found that the girl, slightly built but healthy, had some of her ribs missing. There were no bones or flesh enclosing the central area of her chest, but only a transparent layer of thin skin—through which the doctors peered as through a window and beheld her heart pumping blood, and working as regularly as if placed in its normal position.

Father's Story

To the doctor's question Maliszewsky replied that the girl was his first and only child, born on May 20th, 1926, when he was thirty and his wife was twenty-five years of age. They were both healthy, normal people, who had never been ill in their lives. The girl was a gay, pleasure-loving little creature, equally fond of books and play. She liked to race other children, and ran about a lot, though on one or two occasions she had palpitations and fainted.

Maliszewsky obviously had no idea of the constant danger threatening his daughter's life. According to the doctors, it amounts almost to a miracle that the girl is still alive. In its abnormal position the heart may become feeble, and heart failure may set in at any moment. An accident which would result only in a slight bruise in normal people might be fatal to little Maria.

The child with the heart of gold has brought money to her parents, who once were very poor, for they are being paid so that Maria may be kept under scientific observation. But though their poverty is at an end, their anxiety for the child has increased. They wonder why the doctors and the scientists are watching Maria so closely. They don't like it. They are afraid.

Eye Lens From Newt's Tail

American Discovery

The possibility of growing a new eye in an adult animal, by a grafting operation has been demonstrated by experiments just completed by an American scientist.

Dr. E. O. Schotte, of Amherst College, has succeeded in changing a piece of a newt's tail into a crystalline lens. The fact that the newt (lizard like animal) was an adult adds considerably to the achievement.

Newts possess the ability of growing new tails when the old ones are cut off. But they never grow new eyes.

Dr. Schotte removed the crystalline lens from the eye of a newt and replaced it with a piece of tissue from a newly growing tail.

This tissue continued to grow and developed into a well formed crystalline lens. The eyes of the newt contain an unidentified chemical that has the power of forming eyes from sufficiently young embryonic tissue, which could be transferred to the eye.

The same experiment was successfully completed with adult tadpoles, (trad or frog.) The chemical which can fashion an eye is known to exist in many animals, and the same process might be applied in cases of animal blindness.

Alexis Carrel on Prolongation of Life

Alexis Carrel, member of the Rockefeller Institute and Nobel Prize winner, gave a very interesting report of the problem of the prolongation of life at the annual convention of the Association of Life Insurance Presidents. As he pointed out, the problem of longevity is entering a new period of its history. So far, the increase in the average duration of life has resulted from the efforts of hygiene and medicine. But after the average length of our existence has reached the value predicted a few years ago, progress will become difficult. Any true prolongation of life will require, not only protection against disease, but improvement of the quality of tissues and blood.

Some years ago, Carrel made a study of the longevity of a population of 23,000 mice. Mice that had lived for many years divided into small groups in boxes were set free in the large pens of a greenhouse. The animals burrowed into the soil, multiplied freely, ran, and fought in a large open space. They became stronger. But the duration of their existence decreased. Free life was 34 per cent shorter than sheltered life. Such was the price of liberty.

Two populations of mice were subjected to fasting for several generations. The expectation of life at weaning increased by 17 per cent. The mice became smaller and stronger. They were found also to be much more intelligent than the other groups. These experiments, and many others, demonstrate that longevity, although being a hereditary tendency, can be artificially modified in a measure. Therefore, we are not forbidden to hope that a wise handling of

environmental agencies may lead to lengthening of our existence.

Physiological age is different from chronological age. It consists of an organic and functional state, which varies at a certain rhythm. Even if blood serum is removed several times, it always regenerates with the characteristics corresponding to the age of the animal. At the same time as the blood does, tissues and organs undergo important alterations. The quality of the tissues and of the regulating mechanisms of the humors is responsible for longevity.

The importance of human life depends on its quality, as Carrel points out, and not on its length. If, for instance, our duration could be increased by a lowering of metabolism, as Loeb succeeded in doing with the fruit-fly, the existence thus obtained would not be worth living. To-day, the prolongation of life, for a great many people, would profit neither themselves nor society.

But, rightly or wrongly, humanity will never stop searching for the secret of eternal youth. In attempting to lengthen our existence, we may hope to find the means of improving its quality. There should be somewhere in the civilized world, Carrel said, an institute dedicated to the study of the process of aging. Strange to say, although men hold life to be the supreme good, there is no laboratory in America or in Europe where psycho-biological investigations of the mechanism of aging and of the means of lengthening life can be undertaken in an appropriate manner. We must remember that there is no example of a scientific research for truth which has not been rewarded.

Rebuilder of Bones

"Miracles" Performed by Grafting With Living Portions

During the war a stocky, energetic American surgeon sprang into international fame because he could mend a broken leg that had refused to heal, fasten together a fractured elbow, and perform "miracles" of bone surgery that saved the limbs and lives of many a wounded soldier.

After the war, he performed more than 2,000 operations, restoring the function of limbs to soldiers; giving them back the use of feet, hands, legs, hips, and arms where nature had failed.

He was Dr. Fred Houdlett Albee, to-day one of the foremost bone surgeons in the world. Doctor Albee reveals in the April *Scientific American*, how these miracles are performed.

The chief secret is to be a good mechanic; a combination of expert cabinetmaker, metal worker and prestidigitator. The difference is that these other experts work with inert materials. Doctor Albee and his colleagues work with living bone.

Like Cabinetmaker

Like a cabinetmaker, however, the surgeon first decides on the nature of the necessary repair. If it is a broken thigh-bone that has refused to mend, it may be that a splicing piece must be inserted between the broken ends. This piece will be taken from the living bone of the shin, joined into the broken thigh-

bone ends with the accuracy of a mosaic, and fastened there.

The remaining section of shin-bone will soon regenerate the bone taken from it. Meanwhile, the new piece in the thigh will grow, knit up the parts of the old bone, and if the operation is successful, will finally produce a thigh as good as ever.

Of course, all this must be done with the cooperation of nature.

Mysterious Processes

"The graft, having been applied in a way most likely to favour union with the host, is influenced by those mysterious processes by which the graft remakes its structure, alters its shape, and takes on added volume and strength, in order to accommodate itself to the demands of its new environment," says Doctor Albee.

"A graft of the general size of a lead pencil, and of any shaped cross-section, when implanted to take the place of a portion of the thigh-bone, will take on the characteristics of the thigh-bone shaft in every respect; that is, as to strength, size and shape of cross-section, external contour, and internal structure—it will even develop a marrow cavity."

When he began, Doctor Albee first studied the principles of plant grafting; a process in which a living bud from

one plant is made to grow from the stem of another. The principles of plant grafting, he decided, were fundamental to the transplantation of any kind of living tissues, including bone.

"There are three inviolable rules in plant grafting," he relates. "Though tissues must be applied like to like, the contact must be most intimate, and they must be immobilized in that position."

"These principles are important in bone grafting. Moreover, in the more highly specialized animal tissue, it is desirable, if not essential, that the graft be autogenous; that is, come from the same individual."

Precision Tools

In addition, the surgeon, must be uncannily skilful, and he finds electrically-driven precision tools of great value. Doctor Albee has designed a set of such tools, which he refers to as a "bone mill." It can be thoroughly and easily sterilized, and will almost instantly cut bone into any kind of shape for use in this hurried, living "carpentry."

"To perform work like this the surgeon must possess the mechanic's sure instincts for close, accurate work," wrote the editor of *The Scientific American*, after witnessing a bone operation on a tubercular knee joint.

"With such speed that it seemed like opening a 'zipper,'" he related, "the joint was completely exposed and the damaged bone sawed away from the under side of the knee cap and the joint itself."

"Loss of articulation then made necessary the rigid union of the upper and lower parts of the leg, and, to accomplish this, two bone dowels were inserted, reaching through the top of the tibia and into the bottom of the femur."

Sensitive Stomach

Like many another medical specialist, Dr. Walter Clement Alvarez of the Mayo Clinic suffers from the disease he cures in other people. In Dr. Alvarez' case the ailment is stomach ulcers.

At a recent meeting Dr. Alvarez: speaking from his personal experiences, told stomach specialists to beware of foods which harm their patients in strange ways. "Since I found that I was abnormally sensitive to chicken and stopped eating it," said he, "life has been much easier."

One of his patients was a businessman who became abnormally drowsy at 11 o'clock every morning, fell asleep at conference and while driving his automobile. Dr. Alvarez said, I had him test, one by one, things he ate customarily at breakfast, and eventually we found that it was the cream in his coffee. Eliminating the cream ended the trouble. It is absolutely startling to see how food influences the brain.

One responsible businessman had been in the hands of psychiatrists for eight or nine years. I put him on an elimination diet for the hives, and to my great astonishment had cured him of what was actually insanity.

"Another case was a young college student. He suddenly developed abnormal pains and a mental attitude that made his studies impossible. We really were convinced after a time that it was a mental case. Another doctor began testing him on food reactions. Two days later he called me over and showed me that the dull and apathetic boy was eager and bright again. The trouble was that he was sensitive to eggs. At school he had been eating three or four of them every morning and it was enough to knock him out."

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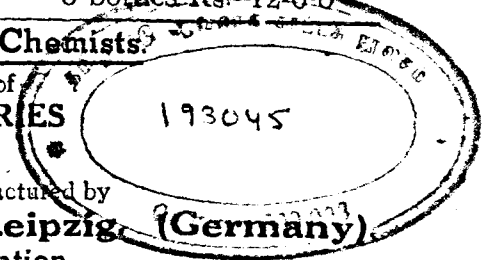

The Great Adventure of Healing

"Grandmother's Cure"

Centuries ago, in China, a "grandmother's cure" for burns was strong tea. Then the world forgot. In 1924, a young doctor, called Davidson, working as a surgeon in Detroit, was horrified at the awful toll of burning and the agonies it inflicted. He thought and read and studied, and discussed the subject with a colleague, Dr. E. C. Mason, who gave him his maturer advice. Gradually he got on to the track of something and behind his locked door, he experimented with rabbits, white rats, and tannic acid, the staining chemical found in strong tea.

On the morning of May 5th, 1924, when he was thirty, a disastrous explosion in Detroit resulted in seven suffering men being brought to his hospital. From that moment rabbits and rats were no more; he was done with faltering and secret experimenting. His shocked emotions made him take a desperate stride.

On the left side of one of the worst-burned victims he applied his tannic acid solution, and on the right he used the old method of wet boric acid compresses. Two days later, when he changed the dressings, there was the usual agony under the boric acid. But when his tannic acid bandages were removed no pain was felt, there was scarcely any swelling, and a protective acid-skin covered the wounds.

The six other men were then similarly treated. They all recovered—and, more remarkable still, there was no scarring.

Yet Davidson was laughed at in the beginning. So were the Curies, who gave us radium and its curative powers; Pasteur, who revealed the microbic origin of diseases and set medicine triumphantly along a new path; Lister, whose carbolic spray was jeeringly referred to as "Lister's bag and bellows," but who banished the widespread tragedy of septic operations by his experiments with antiseptics; James Young Simpson, who dispelled the terror of the knife by supplying the healing sleep of chloroform.

They were all regarded as the Clowns of of medicine; to-day they are idols.

It is not so many years ago—comparatively speaking when we are dealing with a subject which embraces Ambrose Pare and his sixteenth century foundations of modern surgery, and William Harvey, the Elizabethan benefactor who first mapped the course of the blood's flow in our bodies—it is not so many years ago that a clever young surgeon named W. A. Lane, F. R. C. S., gathered together an immense knowledge of bone surgery and decided that the accepted methods of setting fractures were crude and in many cases useless.

He experimented for long, and ultimately devised silver plants to hold the fractured bone together and so prevent shrinkage and consequent lameness.

Was he thanked? Not at first; he was ridiculed. But he had faith, and to-day he is happily still with us as Sir William Arbuthnot Lane, honoured in every continent. Dr. Sherman, chief surgeon of the Carnegie Steel Corporation of Pittsburg, once declared that out of 2,500 cases treated in the Lane manner, only two deaths occurred.

The discoveries of cures have invariably been thrilling. Just the other week a crate of venomous snakes was delivered to a famous London clinical laboratory where doctors are now extracting from the fangs of the reptiles the poison which kills. From it they are evolving a curative serum which will counteract the bite of the snake itself, prove an antidote to other poisons, and possibly cure, after further research, some of the most perplexing human diseases, such as cancer. An important announcement concerning this line of research is to be made in a week or two.

As proof of the possibilities of this line of research there is the claim of Dr. Hariz, of the Pasteur Institute of Paris, that he is healing internal growths with cobra poison.

To Save Mothers

Deadly Microbe Wiped Out

DYING PATIENTS CURED

BY A LITTLE PILL.

FRENCH CHEMIST'S DISCOVERY THAT HAS

INTRIGUED MEDICAL WORLD

A report will shortly be issued by Queen Charlotte's Hospital—world-famous London centre of maternity treatment—giving results of 18 month's experimental work on a new drug which may conquer one of the chief causes of maternal mortality.

The new drug may:—

Wipe out the heavy child-birth death rate caused by puerperal infection.

Cure a wide range of blood-poisoning cases.

Effectively cure septic throats and inflamed tonsils.

Conquer erysipelas and scarlet fever.

The drug is called para-aminobenzene-sulphenamide, but doctors have given it the handier name of sulphonamide.

It is administered in the form of a small white pill which is swallowed by the patient.

The story of the drug starts in the I. G. Farbenindustrie, Germany's great chemical works, where research director, Professor Heinrich Horlein started experiments to find a killer for the streptococci—microbes which cause many forms of blood poisoning.

After months of research the professor and his assistants devised a new chemical compound called prontosil—which was essentially a red dye.

TESTS WITH MICE

Mice were given lethal doses of streptococci and later given injections of the new red dye. They lived.

Soon the red dye injections were given to a few hospital patients dying from severe streptococci infection. They recovered.

Medical men throughout the world were immediately interested. The German professor was snowed under with requests for samples of the red dye.

Then they applied the treatment to patients who were gravely ill with haemolytic streptococci—the puerperal infection which once claimed the lives of one out of every 5 mothers.

Out of 64 infected cases so treated the percentage of deaths was 4.7 as compared with the 1935 rate of 24.4 per cent. before the drug had been discovered.

Then in France a chemist named Trefouel discovered a simpler form of prontosil. It can be made in any chemical laboratory and its name is paraaminobenzenesulphonamide—sulphonamide for short,

At Queen Charlotte's Hospital the long-named drug is now being used in the form of small white pills.

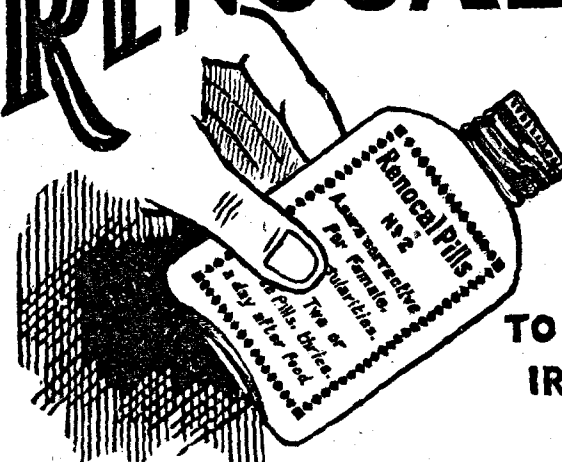

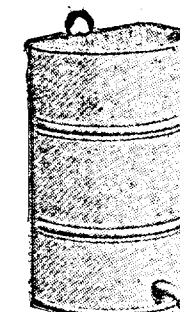

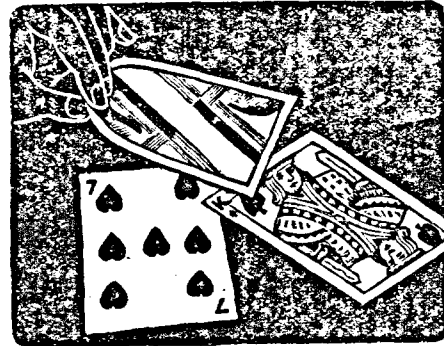

Gonorrhea—The Best Treatment

Gonorrhea is on the increase. In fact, the latest world statistics suggest that four out of five persons in capitals, like London and New York are stricken with the disease.

REST & FATIGUE

One of the penalties we are paying for the complexities of our present-day civilization, it seems, is a great increase in the incidence of nervous disorders. Indeed, to describe our age as neurotic is by no means an exaggeration. Multitudes of people today are finding life on the mental plane distressingly difficult. The machinery of civilization has certainly facilitated our material existence, but the maintenance of this machinery has imposed nervous strains which many are ill-equipped to withstand. Consequently on all sides, we hear of people who are victims of "nervous exhaustion," a disease which, in the majority of cases, might be more accurately described as chronic fatigue.

There can be no doubt that the social life of a great city tends to "race" the human machine. Work and play are carried out at high pressure and, though we are endowed by Nature with a wide margin of reserve energy, capable of being called upon in emergencies, the "intense living" of to day causes this margin to be narrowed to a perilous degree. Insidiously we get worn down. The artificial exhilaration of new pleasures may sustain us for a time, but our minds and bodies are not to be so cheated. The reckoning will come with mathematical certainty. A feeling of tiredness is the body's call for rest, a call

which if neglected, becomes the harbinger of exhaustion and break-down.

These comments may appear rather alarming, but no competent observer will deny that they are applicable to vast numbers of those who dwell within the turmoil of our modern cities. Chronic fatigue holds millions of people in its toils and reflects most adversely on their happiness and working efficiency. Adequate rest, the simplest and most easily attained of all the elemental requirements of health, is the one most neglected in these hectic times. Somehow, its very obviousness causes it to be regarded by many as a factor of little importance in their lives, and yet sinning against the law of rest can be most devastating in its effects upon the human mind and body. We can tolerate bad food, we can deprive ourselves of fresh air, sunshine and exercise for a very much longer period of time than we can do without sufficient rest. Inobservance of the need for rest can do irreparable harm to our systems in a remarkably short time. Rest is an elemental condition for the efficient functioning of the human organism.

Briefly, I will describe the physiology of rest. In any person, physical and mental activity, if sufficiently prolonged, will end in a state where their

muscular and intellectual power is diminished. Such a condition is associated with a conscious sense of weariness, and is known as fatigue. In so far as all our activities require expenditure of energy, the original source of which is our food, these activities are limited by the available energy supply. Also, the release of energy by the tissues is accompanied by the formation of waste products which are of the nature of poisons and which create the characteristic feeling of fatigue or tiredness. This symptom is the body's warning that check must be placed upon the output of energy, in order to permit the harmful waste substance to be got rid of and the full energy complement restored. In other words, it is the signal for rest, a cessation of all non-essential activities to enable the tissues to undergo repairs and to re-establish their vitality.

Fortunately, the effects of fatigue are quickly dispelled in healthy persons provided the rest pauses are adequate, but therein lies the difficulty. In these times, a great many people are consumed with a restless activity; in some way their lives are unsatisfactory and they are constantly in pursuit of exciting distractions. There are others, of course, who are compelled by economic circumstances to over work, and in both types there is a grave danger of their suffering from the cumulative effects of lack of rest. These are the people who incessantly are on the verge of an attack of nervous exhaustion and who are apt ultimately to swell the ranks of the mentally unfit.

OBSERVE how the symptoms of chronic fatigue reveal themselves. Those who do not obey the impulse to rest quickly find that their mental efficiency is impaired. The power of attention is weakened, memory is diminished and all thinking is difficult. There is a failure in judgment, as a rule easily apparent in business activities, and emotional control is lessened as shown by irritability of temper. A feeling of heaviness or of lightness in the head, giddiness, palpitation and indigestion are frequently experienced.

At this stage all will be well if the obvious remedy, rest, is applied, but such is human frailty that the obvious is all too often ignored. All work, mental or physical, becomes impossible or can only be carried out at the expense of a disagreeable and painful effort and even then is but half done. There is a loss of control of the muscles for fine movements. Digestion is gravely impaired and the bodily organs show evidence of faulty functioning. The persistent lack of rest has set all the bodily and mental mechanisms out of alignment—a dangerous state of affairs, for recuperation is inevitably slow and in such a lowered condition of vitality, the body is an easy prey to disease germs, notably those of tuberculosis, and dire consequences may ensue.

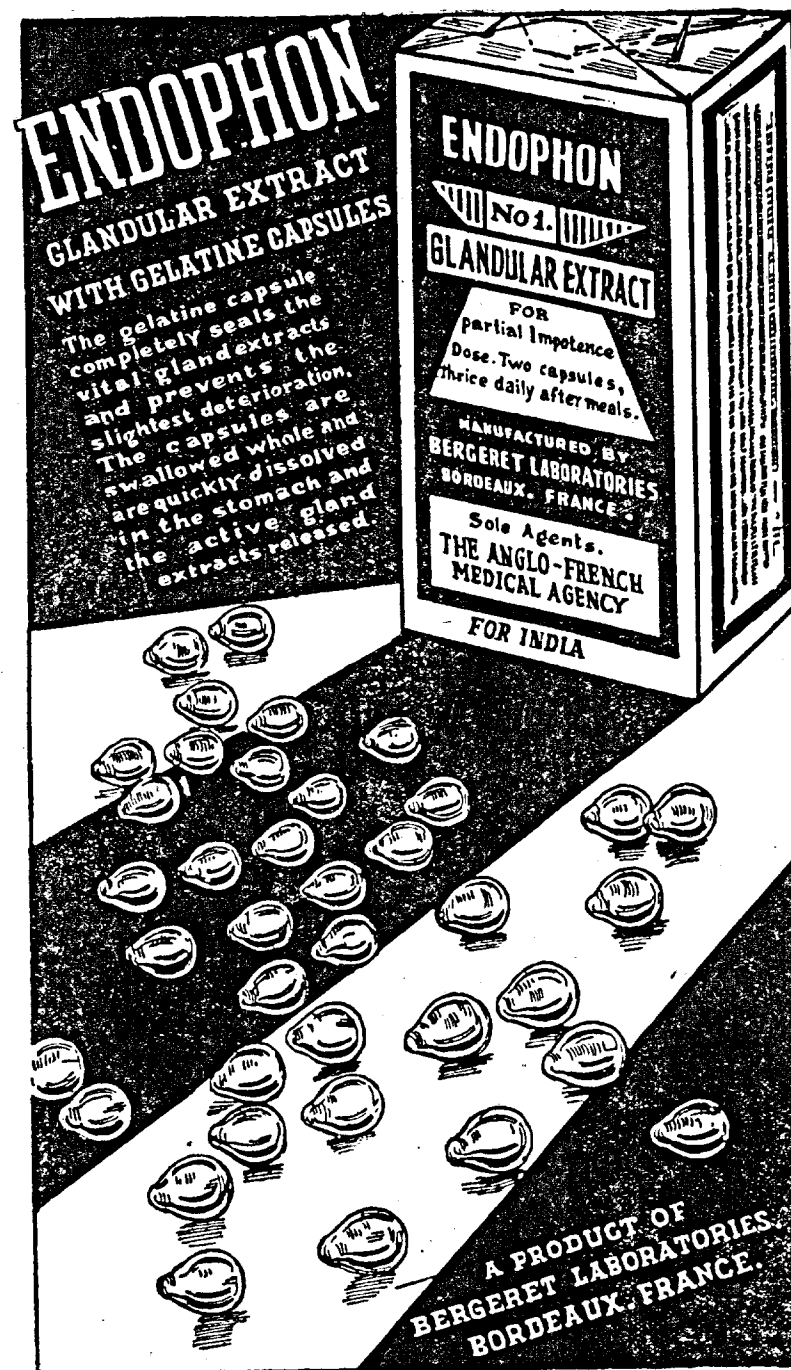

Before going on to describe the nature of a "rest cure" which is indicated in those cases of exhaustion from chronic fatigue. I will describe the essential features of the hygiene of rest. In order to obtain the maximum health advantage from rest, it must be of sufficient quantity and regular in its occurrence. People vary quite considerably in the matter of energy display and rest. Some nervous systems run steadily, regularly but not very intensely, while others run by fits and starts—short bursts of energy followed by short pauses. It is worth while to fully realize the kind of energy pattern you possess for then you can run your body machine much more efficiently.

Generally speaking, however periods of relaxation are essential during and between the working hours. Neither mind nor muscle can maintain concentrated effort for an indefinite length of time without the work produced suffering in quality. In the industrial world, the importance of interpolating frequent rest pauses especially during the carrying out of monotonous work has now been fully appreciated. An unbroken spell of four or more hours of work has been found to be an unsound economic proposition and experience has shown that the systematic introduction of rest pauses leads to a very considerable increase in productivity. Industrialists are now finding that the practical psychologist can be of extreme value to him in finding out

the most favorable rest pauses, in other words, pause in which the various factors so operate as to produce a maximum amount of work after that pause.

It is sleep, of course, which is the body's chief mechanism for producing periodic rest and as such is a health factor of supreme importance; it is now well known that want of sleep is more damaging than want of food. The sleep problem is one of the most difficult which long flight airmen have to combat. Natural sleep is a state of partial or complete insensibility which recurs in every twenty-four hours and occupies about one-third of that time. This is no place to enter into the many theories concerning the cause of sleep and we will regard it simply as a stage in the rhythmical activities of the brain cells acting as a defensive process against fatigue and exhaustion: it ensures rest for the vital organs, particularly the brain; it is a rhythmical pause in the body's activities for repair and growth.

A CORRECT hygiene of sleep is essential for all and must be carefully sustained during a rest cure. This method of treatment of cases of nervous exhaustion is simple and effective, provided it is rigorously carried out. The fundamental principle is complete *rest in bed* with entire absence of all mental and physical exercise for at least a month. This treatment can only be satisfactorily carried out in a hospital or nursing home, for all visits from friends must be prohibited and the patient must neither write nor receive letters.

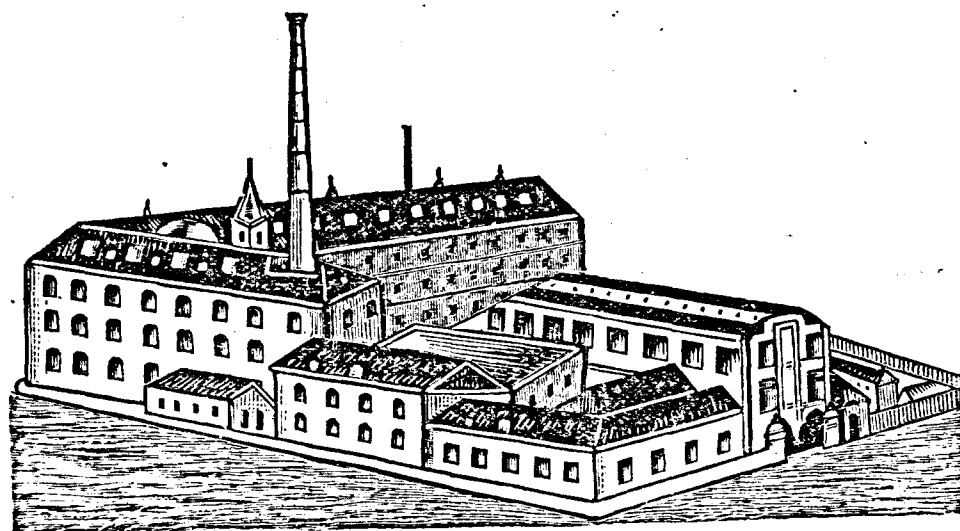

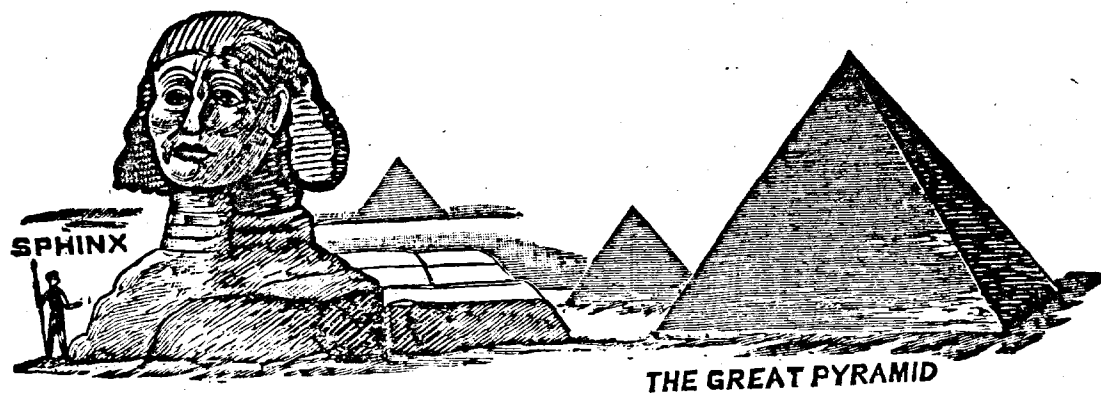

The Discovery of Bromine

On September 30th, 1802, there was born to the Balard family, simple vinegrowers of Montpellier, a boy, Antoine Jerome. In 1824, Antoine Balard, then a student at the Ecole de Pharmacie of the College of Montpellier, observed a deposit of sodium sulphate which had crystallized out of a pan containing mother liquid from the Montpellier salt marshes. Forthwith, there occurred to him the idea of utilizing these mother liquors, which was to occupy the greater part of his life. That same year he observed a yellowish tinge in certain parts of his salts when treated with chlorine. Various tests led him to believe that he was dealing with a new element; and this he succeeded in isolating a drop or so at a time as a brownish red mobile liquid, with a peculiar suffocating odor. From the latter characteristic

he named it "Brome" (Greek: Bromos—stench). In 1826 (the year he graduated from Montpellier), he published a masterly paper on Bromine and his work with it, then already extensive. It is interesting that Liebig, who had received a bottle of nearly pure bromine from a German firm, thought it to be chloride of iodine. When he heard of Balard's discovery he placed the bottle in "his cupboard of mistakes" and would often show it to visitors.

The first bromine salt Balard produced was potassium bromide, and he spent many years removing the obstacles to commercial production of the Bromides. Ironically, just as he succeeded in this the great Stassfurt salt deposits were discovered, rendering Balard's work valueless from a financial viewpoint.

Civilization Is Young

Authorities agree that the civilized mind is of recent growth, and is still in a comparatively early stage of development. We find it acting in an erratic manner with a strong tendency to revert to its earlier states with their brutish longings, degenerate sentiments, and atavistic instincts. These instincts are most marked in fancy, and indicate that man is still born a savage, and is merely trained into the civilized habits of his community. It is the rare individual of good character, exerting his influence for the good of his community, who keeps civilization progressing. If the majority of a community were given complete freedom, civilization would be rapidly lost, and mankind would suddenly revert to savagery.

That is why atavistic social movements, like communism and anarchy, constitute such serious menace. They threaten to destroy the intellectual few upon whose shoulders the burden of civilization rests. It has taken millions of years of trials for the human mind to reach its present state of efficiency, and only a few minds of every age develop sufficiently to add to the general well-being and assist in carrying civilization to a higher

level. Homers, Platos, Shakespeares, Darwins, and Huxleys are exceedingly rare thinkers and inventors. The vast majority of men merely live, taking what they can from life and yielding little that shall benefit the race. Sometimes we realize how blind we are mentally; how little we understand, see, and think. In such lucid moments, we are willing to raise monuments to leaders we have misunderstood, and thinkers we have ridiculed, acknowledging that our sluggish observation faculties have not enabled us to distinguish a demoralizing radical from a beneficial philosophical thinker.

Our social life is barely thirty thousand years old. This is an insignificant period in comparison with the millions of years required for the human mind to become so well balanced that it developed the individual personality and character that was needed before an advanced social life could be evolved. It is but a mere fraction of the millions of years in which man lived and struggled in savagery. It is also an insignificant fraction of the period during which the earth will continue habitable and suitable for eugenic developments.—

MEDICAL

Leprosy Being Conquered

Leprosy, the most horror-inspiring of human diseases ever since Bible times, is being knocked out by a combination of botanical and chemical research. Speaking before the Academy, Dr. Roger Adams told how chaulmoogra oil, brought to the western world by botanical explorers in the Orient, is being improved on by the synthetic chemist. The oil itself is not the thing that is deadly to the leprosy germ, it was found, but rather two natural acids which developed from it. Chemical examination of these acids showed that each was built of a five-cornered ring of carbon and hydrogen atoms, with a chain of other atoms sticking out at one side like a tail. By piling extra atoms on this tail at a certain point, brand-new kinds of acid, that had never existed anywhere before, could be created. And it was found that these new acids were far more effective as leprosy germ killers than the natural acids—some of them as much as fifty or a hundred times as strong as the natural product.

5 Years Old—50 Operations!

One of the most cruel sentences that fate can inflict on a man or woman has been pronounced on eight-year-old Wayne Roszman, of Ohio.

In five years, he has had no fewer than seventy operations to save him starving to death. As a child of three, he found a tin of poison and swallowed some of it burning his inside so badly that his food passage was partially closed unless frequent operations to keep it open are carried out.

So more or less regularly the boy has to be operated on.

Poor Wayne will probably have to be endure these ordeals for the rest of his life.

Olive Oil in Feeding of Infants and Small Children

According to Reuss (*Med. Klin.*, Berlin), olive oil is as valuable as butter in the feeding of infants. He enumerates the good results that have been obtained by other investigators and then he describes how olive oil may be used in preparing foods for infants and children. He asserts that foods which were prepared with olive oil were taken by children just as rapidly as foods that were prepared with butter. Disturbances in the gastro-intestinal tract or other harmful effects were not noted.—*J.A.M.A.*

Iodine Milk

Experiments on Mrs. Ruth Hanna McCormick's Rock River Farms at Byrn, Illinois, have shown that by feeding powdered seaweed to cows they can be made to produce milk containing iodine, says a special to the *New York Times*. A sufficient amount of iodine was found in the milk to encourage the hope that a way might be found to prevent and possibly to cure cases of common goitre. The tests have been made in the heart of the goitre belt, where thousands suffer from the disease. The chemical analyses were made by Prof. George W. Cavanaugh of Cornell University. Food and health specialists have been following the tests with interest. It is said that the seaweed diet leaves the flavour and quality of milk unaffected.—*Med. Journ. & Record.*

The Above Experiment Carried Further

Cows were fed seaweed on an Illinois farm on the theory that the milk they'd give would cure goiter. Why not give them an aspirin tablet every day? So no one who drinks milk ever would be bothered with headaches. . . . The trouble is that it isn't the people who drink milk who get headaches. . . . The experiment might be carried further. A man might buy a cow these days: mix up a few political speeches with the animal's hay, take a drink of milk and go to bed disgusted, saving time and the expense of a radio. . . . Sufferers with insomnia might find relief by buying a cow and feeding it on grand opera selections. . . . If this experiment is a success, however, the bootleggers all will go into the dairy business, feed the bovines corn mash and sell milk at \$12 the quart.—*Tonic & Sedatives in J.A.M.A.*

A New Cure For Threadworm

Dr. Edward A. McAnalley, writes in the *Lancet* :—

Two or three years ago I was attending a rather elderly patient of mine for thread-worms, which had for some long time caused him a great deal of inconvenience, but my efforts to remove them proved of no avail. Some months later when attending him for an entirely different complaint, I casually asked whether he was still troubled by the worms and to my surprise he replied that they had completely disappeared. When I asked him the reason, he said that the only thing he could think of was after taking ammoniated tincture of quinine for a cold he had seen no more of them. As a result of this I thought that I would try the effect of quinine on other patients with the same disease, and I found to my pleasure that a few doses of the drug in all cases and in sufferers of all ages completely got rid of the worms. I have looked up the uses of quinine in a good many books and find no mention of this particular one.

HAD 1000 GRAND CHILDREN

Centenarians, seem to pile up some fairly impressive figures, particularly now-a-days.

Li Chang Yun, who recently died aged 256, outlived 28 wives! His claims to such a great age were remarkably convincing.

Present claimant is the title of W.O.M. in ancient Turk Badik Agha who says he was born six years before the French revolution and is therefore 150. Badik has had 122 wives and 112 children—plus 1000 grandchildren in varying degrees of "greatness."

Two Harley Street specialists are daily flirting with death by experimenting on each other to discover the perfect anaesthetic. Their aim is to put people to sleep before they are aware that they are "going under"—and these two men do not know when they, as researchers, will never waken again.

It is only now and again that we are told of the romantic adventuring behind closed doors and in the tense atmosphere of secret laboratories. The recent London Medical Exhibition, revealed some of the fruits of those hidden workers, one of the most important being the latest machines for radiodiathermy treatment.

Some years ago, a party of men working near the aerial of a short-wave broadcasting transmitter complained of sickness and general discomfort. When they were medicalled examined it was found that their internal temperatures were raised for some unaccountable reason.

That reason was soon explained by research. The "heating thought" power of wireless short-wave had been revealed. Experiments are now producing fresh miracles at the Marconi Company's laboratory at Chelmsford, Essex, the diathermy pioneering centre in that country. A radio operating instrument can now by the use of short waves, cut painlessly and bloodlessly. "The knife" is a blunt tool energized by wireless emanations from a diathermy-machine. When held over the flesh it incises clearly and instantly and seals the veins as it passes through. It can also produce curative fevers internally.

This new health from radio is another milestone in the march of medical progress. To-morrow it will be a commonplace like anesthetics—but none the less wonderful.

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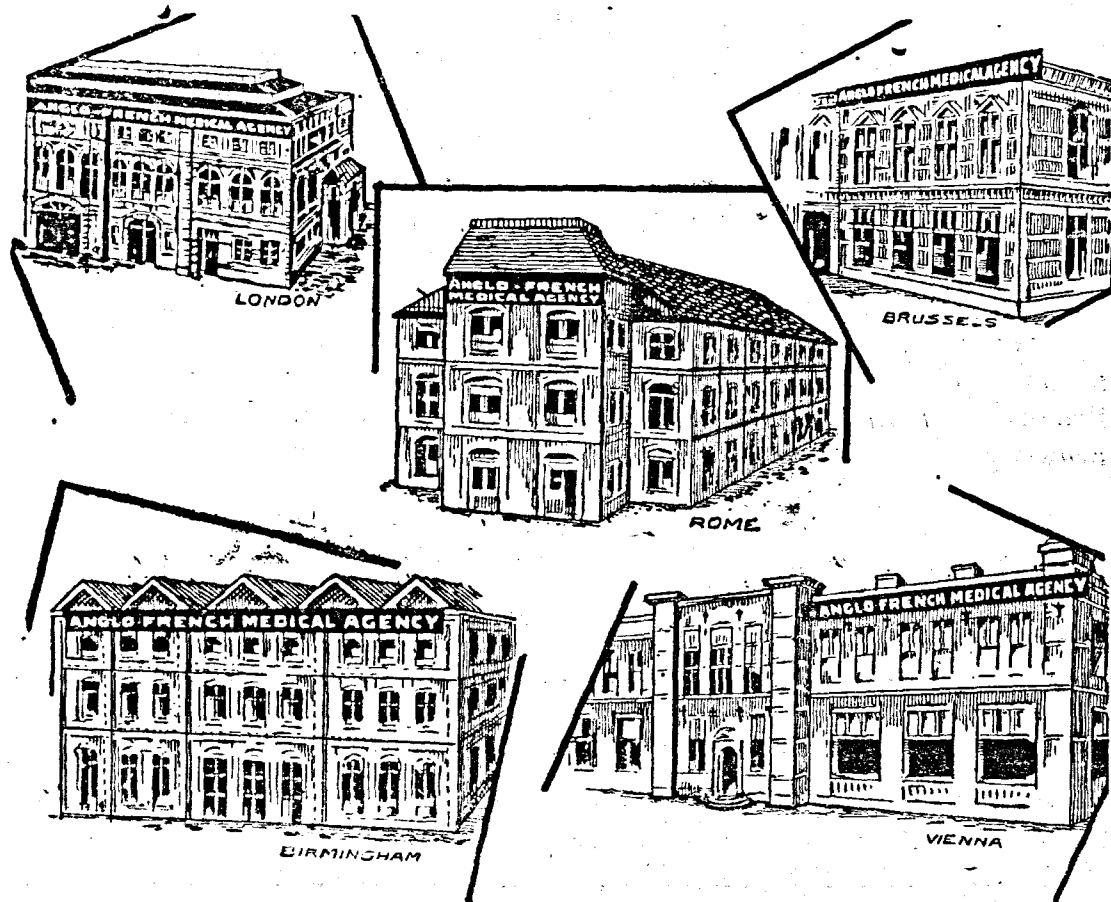
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
