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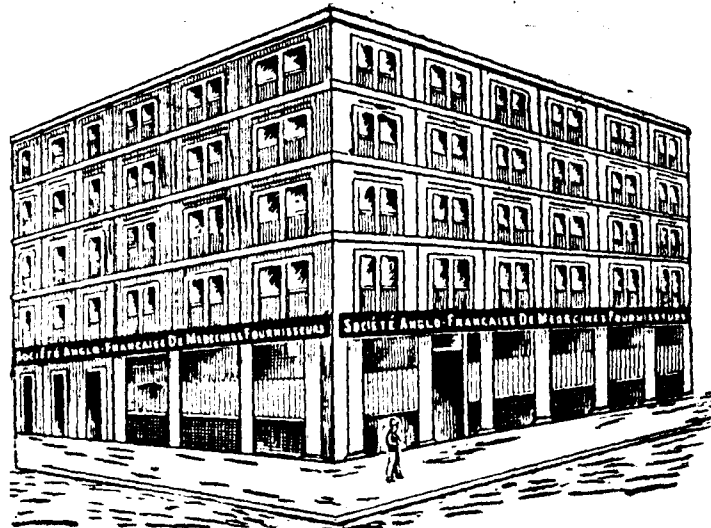
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Hope for the Tuberculous India's Key Problem

Even the dark cloud of tuberculosis has its silver lining. A century ago in England 4,500 persons in every million died every year of tuberculosis: the number has now fallen to 650 per million, or about one-seventh of what it used to be.

Tuberculosis is a disease, or rather a group of diseases, all of which have one thing in common: they are caused by a special kind of microbe discovered by Robert Koch in 1882 and called the bacillus of tuberculosis.

Tuberculosis is a cosmopolitan disease; it attacks people all over the world, except for a few isolated places which have remained free from contact with modern civilized conditions. The bacillus can attack any part of the body, but far more deaths are due to tuberculosis of the lungs than to all the other forms of the disease put together. In the great majority of cases the bacillus finds its way into the body by being inhaled into the air passages or by being swallowed with food or drink.

The general public have been thoroughly enlightened in the danger of spread of the infection by spitting: the penalties prescribed for indulgence in this filthy habit are widely advertised and too seldom imposed. But there is another habit which unfortunately does not cause the same feelings of disgust, although it is really far more dangerous—the habit of coughing in rooms or any kind of enclosed spaces which are occupied by other people.

When a person who has open tuberculosis of the lungs coughs he sends out a regular spray of droplets into the air: these droplets consist of sputum, and most of them are so small that they remain suspended in the air in much the same way as a puff of tobacco smoke. As each droplet may contain a large number of the bacilli you can realize how dangerous it is to breathe the air in the vicinity of an infected person.

The inhalation of disease microbes in this way is called "droplet infection," or more realistically "sputum spray infection." In the open air or even in the air of a well-ventilated room these droplets are so quickly carried away by air currents that there is little risk of infection except by inhaling the air within the actual zone of bombardment by the spray.

A Key Disease

Many other dangerous diseases are conveyed from man to man by droplet infection—for example, influenza, which in 1918-19 destroyed nearly ten million people in India; in fact, more people died within a few months from influenza than were killed by plague during the preceding twenty years. Pneumonia, bronchitis and diphtheria are examples of the diseases which are conveyed in this way.

The precautions which are effective in preventing the spread of tuberculosis by droplet infection will be equally successful in controlling a large number of deadly maladies, so that in this respect tuberculosis is a key disease.

The other chief method by which the bacillus enters the body is by swallowing infected food and drink. In this country a certain number of cases of tuberculous cattle, but in India people seldom drink unboiled milk, and besides, very few cattle are tuberculous, so that this source of infection is negligible.

Unfortunately the bacilli of human origin have many opportunities for getting into the food and drink in India, so that alimentary infection can by no means be ignored. Other microbic diseases communicated by alimentary infection are cholera, dysentery and typhoid fever, so that measures directed against this method of conveyance of tuberculosis will prove equally effective in controlling these maladies. Here then is another way in which tuberculosis is a key disease. In fact, apart from the group of diseases carried by insects every one of the great killing maladies of India will be completely controlled by the measures which are appropriate for the control of tuberculous infection.

The Seed and the Soil

Although tuberculosis is always caused by a special bacillus, and cannot exist in the absence of this microbe, it would be utterly misleading to confine our attention to the bacillus. The bacillus is the seed of the disease, but from the practical point of view the soil on which the seed falls is equally important.

abundant evidence that unless a heavy dose of infection enters a healthy and well-nourished body the seed will not produce a deadly crop of disease. The great majority of the people have been infected with tuberculosis at some time or other. What happens is that when the bacilli enter our bodies they begin to multiply, but, if we are well nourished, our defensive mechanism is stirred to activity and wages successful war against the bacilli. It is only when the dose of infection is excessive or when our powers of resistance are feeble that the microbe gains the upper hand.

There is reason to believe that when we have overcome an invasion by the bacilli of the disease our powers of resistance against further attacks are increased so that these inapparent forms of tuberculosis are often blessings in disguise. There is ample proof that these mild attacks of diseases are of common occurrence. Careful examination of the bodies of adults who have died from accidents reveals the presence of the scars of the diseases in the majority of cases. Even during life it is possible to obtain clear evidence of the previous existence of tuberculosis in many persons who have never shown signs of the disease.

In the course of the defensive reaction against the bacilli substances are produced in the body and these persist for years. Their presence can be detected quite easily by the tuberculin reaction which is positive in the majority of adults in many places. Even when the bacilli have gained the mastery to such an extent as to cause obvious signs of disease, it is usually possible to reinforce the defences of the body so as to bring about a cure. Hence the importance of early diagnosis. The true picture of tuberculosis is far different from that of the popular imagination.

The important point about the inapparent attacks of tuberculosis is that they indicate the impossibility of escaping from infection in existing conditions and the great importance of attention to the soil as well as the seed. The ideal is to eliminate the seed, but this is not practicable in the immediate future; we can, however, take comfort from the knowledge that even with partial control in infection there can still be a great degree of success in controlling the disease.

For many years it has been a matter of common knowledge that persons who are well nourished and who lead healthy outdoor lives rarely suffer from tuberculosis, but the clearest demonstration of the importance of nutrition was given during and after the Great War. During that period the death-rate from tuberculosis rose sharply in every country in which there was a great shortage of food, and the rise was directly proportional to the degree of shortage.

Recent work on nutrition has shown that not only tuberculosis but also many other diseases are greatly influenced by the state of nutrition of the body. Here again tuberculosis is a key disease.

Inherited Tuberculosis

The pessimistic outlook on tuberculosis has been greatly fostered by the belief that the disease is hereditary. Strictly speaking there is no such thing as inherited tuberculosis: the disease is always acquired.

Although infection may enter the body before birth such an occurrence is so rare as to be negligible and for practical purposes we may regard the newborn babe as entering the world with a clean bill of health even when both parents are suffering from tuberculosis.

The only part played by heredity is that some people inherit a constitution which offers a low degree of resistance to infection but all the evidence goes to show that nobody need be doomed to tuberculosis if the nutritional condition of the body is maintained and heavy doses of infection are avoided.

For concrete evidence that tuberculosis is easily controllable we can look at what has been happening in England. In the past twenty years the death-rate from the disease has fallen by nearly 50 per cent. During the same period the expenditure from public funds on anti-tuberculosis measures has risen enormously.

If one were to claim that the fall in the death-rate was due to the rise in expenditure you might be prepared to agree. But if public health partisanship were to tempt anyone to make such a claim, his public-health conscience ought to step in and insist that the whole truth should be told. The truth is that the death-rate was falling just as rapidly during the pre-war years when little public money was being spent on special anti-tuberculosis schemes.

Tuberculosis experts are the first to admit frankly that the chief cause of the rapid decline of tuberculosis is improvement in the conditions of life of the people. By better housing and better hygienic conditions in general the spread of infection has been greatly diminished, by better food the soil has been rendered less suitable for the development of the seeds of the disease.

Now let us come to grips with the critics of our modern anti-tuberculosis measures. They argue that modern treatment prolongs the lives of the patients and so enables them to continue to spread infection and also to bring into the world more children with an inherited predisposition to the disease.

We do not hear such arguments from persons who are suffering from tuberculosis or from persons whose relatives and friends are victims of the disease.

If the problem were purely biological, and if the sole consideration were to stamp out the disease in the shortest possible time, the best policy would be to consign every infected person to the lethal chamber. Such is the logical conclusion of the argument that humanitarian measures are a waste of money. On the other hand we can claim that the combination of humanitarian relief measures with scientific prevention is yielding the happiest results.

The important matter is that victory over tuberculosis in this country is in sight, and if the present rate of progress is maintained there are people alive today who will be able to tell their children how the scourge of tuberculosis darkened the lives of the people in the bad old days of the first half of the twentieth century.

Statisticians delight in supplying us with figures which show a close relationship between the prevalence of tuberculosis and such

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things as the average number of rooms occupied by each family, the average food supply, and the average birth-rate. All these factors are important, but the relative influence of each cannot be measured with accuracy. Better housing normally goes hand-in-hand with better food, a low birth-rate usually means smaller families, for which better food and more living space can be provided. An increasing population does not necessarily involve a worsening of hygienic conditions—for example, Sir Evelyn Wrench has recently stated that the French settlers in Quebec have increased from 60,000 in 1759 to nearly 5,000,000 at the present time. On the other hand an increase in population which is not accompanied by a proportionate growth in the production of the necessities of life must mean a lowering of economic standards and a corresponding deterioration in bodily health.

India's Special Features.

The Indian situation can only be understood in the light of experience gained in other countries where reliable evidence is available about the conditions which govern the increase or diminution in tuberculosis. Unfortunately we have very unsatisfactory information about the prevalence of tuberculosis in India, but as the disease is cosmopolitan and is governed by the same basic principles in every part of the world, all that I have said has a definite bearing on the Indian problem.

The causes of the terrible prevalence of the disease in England during the nineteenth century are just the same as those which operate in India today, and the causes which have brought about so rapid an improvement in England will certainly give the same results if applied in India. In a discussion on the tuberculosis situation in England it has been possible to speak in a definite manner, but in dealing with the position in India one has often to fall back on speculation and surmise.

Nobody can tell, even approximately, the death-rate from tuberculosis in India as a whole, nobody can describe the geographical distribution of the disease, and nobody can tell to what extent it is increasing. In the absence of authentic data we must make the best use we can of such evidence as is available. In the cities and large towns of

India the deaths from tuberculosis of the lungs are recorded. In Cawnpore the latest yearly death-rate was 4,600 per million of population, or much the same as it was in England a hundred years ago. In Calcutta it was 2,500, and in Bombay 2,000.

The death-rate from tuberculosis among girls and young women who live in purdah in the large centres of population is appalling; it is several times higher than that of males belonging to the same age group.

An Increasing Menace.

Medical men in India are almost unanimous in declaring that the disease is increasing rapidly and that it is extending to rural areas which were formerly free from infection. They also report that when the disease spreads to new localities it assumes a more virulent form than in places previously affected.

This is what would be expected, for it is well known that Gurkha soldiers and French colonial troops coming from isolated regions are far more liable to rapidly fatal attacks of tuberculosis than soldiers coming from places where the disease is common. In the case of Gurkhas and other people in unaffected localities the defensive mechanism of their bodies has not been stimulated to activity by previous mild attacks and so they are virgin soil on which the bacillus thrives without restraint. It may be noted that when proper care is taken to prevent infection among Gurkhas they remain perfectly healthy, so that we are not compelled to fall back on the unsatisfactory policy of controlling the disease by permitting mild attacks to occur.

A few years ago I attempted to make a rough-and-ready survey of the number of cases of tuberculosis and other diseases in the rural areas of India. The method adopted was to issue a questionnaire to a large number of doctors in charge of dispensaries in typical agricultural villages throughout India. The doctors were asked to state how many persons were suffering from tuberculosis in their own village. An estimate based on their replies suggested that there were $1\frac{1}{2}$ to 2

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millions of cases in India. Not even a moderate degree of accuracy is claimed for this estimate; nothing short of a careful personal survey by trained men will give a convincing reply to the question—how many people are suffering from tuberculosis in India?

I have also tried to obtain some evidence on the subject by examining the statistics published every year in the Public Health Commissioner's Report on the health of the prisoners and troops in India. From these it appears that admission-rate for tuberculosis of the lung in prisons was 5.5 *per mille* in 1895, that it rose rapidly during the next ten years to the high figure of over 9 *per mille*, and there-after declined steadily to 5 *per mille* by 1935, or somewhat less than the figure of forty years previously.

We cannot derive much comfort from these figures, for the reports of the earlier years state that most of the cases resulted from infection contracted in the jails, and recognition of this fact was followed by the introduction of special measures for the isolation and special treatment of tuberculosis prisoners.

These reforms must have caused the great fall which is shown in the admission-rate during the latter part of the forty years' period with which we are dealing. The slight reduction in the admission-rate—namely, from $5\frac{1}{2}$ to 5 *per mille*—during the whole period of forty years is not encouraging, seeing that during the same period the general health of the prisoners improved in a striking manner, as is shown by the fall in the total death-rate from 27.6 to 11 *per mille*. If the present admission-rate for tuberculosis of the lung in Indian prisoners be regarded as a fair index of what is happening in the country as a whole, it would appear that close on 2,000,000 of the people of India and Burma are suffering from tuberculosis of the lungs. This figure corresponds closely with the estimate arrived at in the village survey, but here again it is unsafe to pin great confidence on the figures.

During the same period of forty years the number of cases of tuberculosis of the lung in Indian soldiers fell from 2.3 *per mille* to 1.9, but this small reduction contrasts sharply with a fall in the death-rate from all diseases in Indian troops from 11.6 to 2.15.

Another significant fact is that the cases of tuberculosis of the lung in British soldiers in India fell during the same period from 4.8 *per mille* to 1 *per mille*, although the present death-rate in British troops from all diseases is appreciably higher than that of the Indian troops.

This reduction in the tuberculosis rate among British troops is what would be expected from the combination of two factors: one being the improved hygienic conditions in which the soldiers are living, and the other the fall in the tuberculosis rate of the population from which the soldiers are recruited.

In the case of the prisoners and Indian troops similar improvements in hygienic conditions have brought about very satisfactory results in the case of all other diseases, but have had little effect on tuberculosis. The suggestion, therefore, is that the incidence of tuberculosis in the places from which the prisoners and soldiers come must be rising.

The number of patients under treatment for tuberculosis in the hospitals in India has greatly increased during the past few years, but here again we cannot be sure that the figures give a true index of the prevalence of the disease. Making the fullest allowances for the fallacies which are inherent in the preceding estimates, all the evidence points so strongly to a serious increase in the disease that an accurate survey of the situation is urgently needed.

Need for Surveys

The medical research workers of India at a recent conference expressed their regret that so little work had been done in India on tuberculosis research, and recommended that provincial authorities be urged to carry out accurate tuberculosis surveys in their areas. If we are to conduct a successful campaign we must at the outset find out the numbers and disposition of the opposing forces.

Does this mean that we ought to do nothing till we have completed the survey? Emphatically no!

Even though our knowledge of the situation in India is admittedly imperfect, it is quite enough to show not only the crying need for immediate action but also the lines on which action should be taken.

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India is fortunate in having at her disposal the accumulated experience of other countries in which the tuberculosis problem has already been closely studied with the result that it is being successfully solved.

Anti-tuberculosis measures are of two main types, preventive and remedial. Preventive measures must deal with both the seed and the soil, they must aim at controlling the spread of infection and at raising the bodily resistance of the community. The ideal means of preventing the spread of infection would be to isolate under proper control everyone who is infectious. This measure would involve the construction of sanatoria, with accommodation for at least two million patients and the maintenance of a large and costly army of skilled doctors and attendants. Even the most prosperous Western countries are far from having attained the ideal of providing one bed for every person suffering from infectious tuberculosis, so that any suggestion of this kind must be ruled out as being utterly impracticable in India.

There is no need to be unduly discouraged because of the obvious impossibility of doing for the people all that is necessary. In the case of tuberculosis and all other public health problems a far better way is to teach and persuade the people to do things for themselves.

The control of tuberculosis in England has been brought about, not by the Government, but by the people.

Things done for the people must necessarily be expensive and of temporary benefit, whereas things done by the people themselves are both economical and durable.

The spread of infection in India can only be prevented by a process of educative persuasion. The people must be taught how droplet and alimentary infections are conveyed and how they can be avoided. To carry out the educative campaign we have at our disposal the schools, the printing press, public lectures, the cinema and above all wireless broadcasting.

A world of warning must be said against laying undue emphasis on the horrific aspects of the disease. The fear of tuberculosis already exists; in some places it amounts to a state of unwarranted panic. It is a case of a little learning being a dangerous thing. Stress must always be laid on the maintenance of health and the means of avoiding infection rather than on the horrors of disease.

There is much to be said for directing propaganda against all infectious diseases of the respiratory and alimentary systems rather than against tuberculosis alone.

If it came to be understood that everyone who has a cough ought to be kept in the open air or isolated in a well-ventilated room tuberculosis would lose much of its power to terrorize and demoralize its victims.

Fatal delay in seeking treatment is often due to the dread of hearing the diagnosis, which is regarded by many people as a sentence of death.

Suitable accommodation in a verandah or open "lean-to" can be provided for the patient at a trifling cost, at any rate in rural areas: a member of the patient's family can be trained to look after the patient.

From ten to twenty patients can be treated in their own homes for the cost of a single patient in a modern sanatorium. A useful piece of research would consist in devising models of suitable shelters made of materials available in the various localities.

Preventive measures which aim at building up bodily resistance against the bacillus are essential parts of the programme; these constitute a complex problem in themselves. The Governments of India would find it just as impossible to provide proper food and housing for everyone as to build and maintain modern sanatoria for all the patients who need treatment. Here again they must fall back on the plan of persuading the people to do things for themselves.

Education In Life Planning

The key unit in every State is the family, and the only prosperous States are those in which each family lives a well-planned life.

The heads of every family must, therefore, be taught how to plan a satisfactory existence for those who are dependent on them. Here is where the responsibility of Government comes in; it is their duty to provide sound education in life planning and to persuade the people to adopt the plans which have been prepared.

The most difficult part of the task is to bring about the change in the out-look of the people without which better conditions of life are unattainable. Inefficient methods of agriculture, wasteful customs, early and improvident marriages, are some of the chief handicaps which the people of India have imposed on themselves. Unless these can be thrown off. Nature will continue to maintain the balance between population and food supply by tuberculosis and other cruel methods.

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In fact, all the world over people must choose between planning their lives as they would have them to be or having them planned for them by the blind and brutal forces of Nature.

Can the outlook on life of 350 millions of people be changed?

A few years ago such a question would have been received with derision, but after the recent demonstrations given by Russia, Germany, and Italy everyone must admit that incredible changes in the mentality of great nations can be wrought by persistent propaganda.

Far be it from me to suggest that we ought to copy any of the political systems of these countries, but we might well adopt their methods of mass suggestion in the good cause of promoting the welfare of the people. In doing this we need not interfere with religion or curtail liberty in the slightest degree.

There is good reason for believing that if one quarter of the money which is now spent on education in India were allotted to a scheme of instruction in life planning, the problem of tuberculosis and most of the other great problems could be solved.

The first essential is to have a sound plan, and the preparation of such a plan demands the co-operation of men with practical knowledge of agriculture, industry, economics, hygiene, education, and, above all, of men with a sympathetic understanding of the psychology of the Indian peasant.

Technical advisers are needed, but the knowledge of the various kinds of experts must be co-ordinated and translated into simple language which will bring home to the people the causes of the ills from which they suffer and the means by which these can be cured.

This sounds quite simple, but in reality the scheme will call for a lot of hard thinking by the best brains of India, helped by the best brains of the countries which have already solved most of the problems which India has to face. When once a plan has been prepared the rest will be easy; it will only be necessary to carry out a system of mass propaganda on the lines that have always proved successful.

Encouraging Signs

There are encouraging signs that those who are responsible for the welfare of India realise the nature and gravity of the problem and the responsibility of Government for initiating action. Let me first quote the following statement from the Report of the Royal Commission

on Agriculture in India. This may fairly be assumed to have emanated from Lord Linlithgow:

The demand for a better life can in our opinion be stimulated only by deliberate and concerted action to improve the condition of the countryside, and we have no hesitation in affirming that the responsibility for initiating the steps necessary to effect this improvement rests with Government."

Everyone will agree that His Excellency is doing everything in his power to discharge a responsibility which ten years ago he little dreamt he was imposing on himself.

Again, we have the statement by the President of the party which has become responsible for the welfare of more than half of the people of British India, that he is greatly concerned at the economic and population situation, and that something will have to be done.

It now only remains for public opinion to demand the action which Government will be only too glad to initiate.

Medical Relief

The campaign against tuberculosis must include humanitarian effort for the relief of the sick.

Prevention and cure are going hand-in-hand in England with the happiest results: in India there are special reasons for supplying medical aid to the victims of the disease; the chief of these is that before any preventive action can have a hope of success the goodwill of the people must always be enlisted by the cure of disease. Apart from this, sanatoria and dispensaries have great educational value and serve as centres for propaganda work.

There is little need to stress the importance of medical relief in dealing with tuberculosis; the public will insist on having treatment, and it is the business of Government to see that they get it.

I have tried to show you that tuberculosis is a key problem of India and that its solution will mean far more than the conquest of one terrible disease.

Let me close by appealing to you for your sympathy and help in the splendid effort which is being made by Lady Linlithgow.

Her chief aim is doubtless the relief of suffering, but the work cannot fail to give a great stimulus to the campaign for the eradication of the disease.

ALBERT NEISSER

Discoverer of the cause of Gonorrhoea

The name of Albert Neisser will be perpetuated for his discovery of the causal agent of gonorrhoea. However, gonorrhoea is still one of the most prevalent infections. This disease and other sexual diseases have existed since the dawn of civilization.

Health authorities have estimated that one out of ten persons in the United States suffers from some form of venereal disease. Despite all the modern prophylactic measures and the knowledge of effective prevention of gonorrheal infections after exposure, nevertheless indifference, ignorance and false prudery are still largely responsible for the undue prevalence of this disease. Gonorrhea is entirely a human affliction. In adults it is almost invariably transmitted through sex contact, but in some instances the gonococcus may remain alive on towels, clothing or bedding for short periods of time and thus infrequently prove infective. The disease has been known to spread rapidly through schools and orphan asylums in which infected attendants have been employed. Sterility in women and blindness in new-born babies are frequently produced by the gonococcus; but in recent years the prevention and treatment of gonorrheal infections have under gone considerable progress. A 2 percent solution of silver nitrate in the eyes of a new-born infant is a positive preventive of blindness from this disease. This preventive measure is now used throughout the civilized world.

The cause of gonorrhea remained unknown until 1879. In that year Albert Neisser, following the bacteriologic methods of Koch, poured a watery solution of methyl violet over a bit of gonorrheal pus and then examined it under high power magnification through a microscope. In this manner he was first to discover the gonococcus.

Neisser was born at Breslau, Germany, January, 22, 1855, and he lived until 1916. For many years prior to the discovery which brought him into world prominence, he was successively professor of skin and venereal diseases and occupant of the chair in dermatology at the University of Breslau. His studies embraced almost the entire field of dermatology and syphilology, and he was first to observe the tuberculous. An indefatigable research worker and writer, he was particularly active in studying the prophylaxis of venereal diseases in general and the prostitution problem from the sociologic, national economic and ethical points of view. Like his father, who was a practising physician at Breslau before him, Neisser was held in high esteem by all who knew him. For his isolation of the gonococcus, numerous researches on various pathogenic microbes and incessant warfare against infectious disease, he rose to immortal leadership in the cause of medical progress and human welfare.

Complications of Gonorrhoea

The causative organism of gonorrhoea, micro-coccus gonorrhoea was first described by Neisser in 1877. It is an acute infection with a primary lesion which is usually urethritis. It is usually followed by numerous secondary and systemic manifestations of which the most common are epididymitis, salphingitis, arthritis, synovitis and endocarditis.

It is not a killing disease in itself, but looking to its far-reaching consequences, it does not fall very far short of syphilis. It should never be neglected.

Its organism is biscuit-shaped which occurs in pairs, usually within the leucocytes. It occurs in adults due to impure sexual intercourse, in the new born child due to vaginal contamination and in elder children due to accidental infection.

Regarding the systemic gonococcal infection, the most important is gonococcal septicaemia and pyemia. Thayer and Blumer were the first to cultivate gonococci from the blood of a patient. The death rate though not very high, is of considerable high ratio.

Next in importance comes, Gonorrheal arthritis, which in many respects is the most damaging and disabling of all the complications of gonorrhoea. It occurs in 2 to 5 percent of cases. It

occurs more frequently in males than females. As a rule it is found when gonorrhea is in an acute stage but, it can also be seen when the attack is subacute or even chronic. A gonorrhoeal arthritis of great intensity may be found in a woman newly married, being infected by the old gleet in her husband. As a rule, many joints are affected together. Clinically the variability and obstinacy are two main features.

In certain cases wandering pains are detected near the joints, without redness or swelling. In others hydrarthrosis spondylitis and painful heel are found.

Iritis is another complication which is not infrequently found and which has a tendency to recur with every attack subsequently. Sometimes meningitis, myelitis and true neuritis occur.

The search for the primary lesion and a thought of the possibility of gonorrhoeal infection are the best safeguards. The most common blunder that one can commit is to mistake gonococcus arthritis for rheumatic fever. The persistence of trouble in one or two joints should put one on guard. In gonorrhoea the swelling often extends more above and below joints than in other forms of arthritis. The compliment fixation test is sometimes of value.

They keep it from their bodies with tight head coverings, with leather shoes, with corsets, with closely-fitting underwear, with collars, and with closely-woven fabrics of all kinds.

The Contempt Bred by Familiarity

If, through some revolutionary natural convulsion, mankind became suddenly immersed in water and had to exist thereafter in such a surrounding medium, laymen, scientists and governments would labour instantly to learn all about its qualities and effects; but of man's natural medium—air—very little notice is taken.

Mankind is immersed in air, as fish is in water. Whatever environment man may be in, or whatever he may do, he can never get away from the environment of air; yet he does not attempt to use it as it should be used.

It is obvious that no human being can hope to attain, or maintain, *perfect* health without using the unescapable environment of air to the fullest degree. Humanity is still suffering from the delusion that, for

some unknown reason, day-air is good while night-air is deadly.

That superstition is being slowly driven out by science, but it still exists in many minds and communities. The number of civilised people who shut themselves up, hermetically, at night is still appallingly large, and much more education will be required before the night-air superstition is completely banished.

Another Superstition

Following the night-air superstition, there is another which remains fixed firmly in the human mind. It is the belief that the value of air lies in certain properties that can be obtained only if the air is full of oxygen and, particularly, ozone. That error, while not harmful like the one about nightair, has the effect of stopping people from taking the fullest and most correct advantage of air. It has been proved, within recent times, that the body does not depend entirely on the oxygen or ozone that is brought into the lungs; *but that fresh air concerns the skin even more than the lungs.*

It has been established that the value of deepbreathing lies more in its mechanical effect on the circulation than in the conveying of more oxygen to the lungs. Flugge, Leonard Hill and Krotkoff have demonstrated that, while re-breathed air is without apparent ill effects on animals or men, heated, humid, motionless air that surrounds the human body will produce all the characteristic effects of vitiated air. It is not ozone nor even oxygen, then, that represents the value provided by fresh air. It is Motion and Change.

Avoid Motionless Air

Motion in air not only purifies what we breathe, but it regulates the fundamentally important matter of temperature. Even outdoor air, as everyone knows, becomes oppressive when it becomes still. If people could live out of doors constantly, they would not need to worry lack of motion in the air, for outdoor air is rarely still, and when it does become motionless it does so for only a short period. Civilisation has forced people

to spend most of their lives indoors, and so they suffer from the result of "Caged motionless air—bad health.

What does this mean to you? It means that motionless air is the air to avoid. Moving air is what the body, inside and outside, needs for perfect health. It means that draughts should not be feared. It means that, whatever your living or working conditions may be, you should give yourself the daily air-bath that your body needs. You should keep the air moving by any device: by open windows, open doors, or fans. You will then be obtaining the first essential value from the air by which you are surrounded.

Malaria Research

Malaria is one of the most important factors to be considered in the development and economics of all tropical and subtropical countries. Until half a century ago the cause and mode of transmission were entirely unknown. Hippocrates considered that it had some connection with bile and he divided the disease into quotidian, tertian and quartan fevers. Celsus recognized two types of tertian fever, one benign and the other more malignant. Even in Cæsar's time, Vatro associated the disease with swamp air. A specific was first recognized in 1638 when the Countess of Chinchon was cured of an intermittent fever by the bark of certain trees obtained from Peru: hence the origin of the name Cinchona. Morton and Sydenham confirmed its use as a specific in certain fevers in 1666, but not until Torti made his research in 1753 was it definitely established which clinical forms of fever yielded to the bark and which were unaffected. Many famous names are connected with the history of malaria; Andouard, who recognized the malarial spleen; Meckel who noted malarial pigmentation; Virchow who demonstrated

the pigment in the cells; and Kelsch who further concluded that this pigmentation was diagnostic of malaria.

In 1880, the most important date in the history of malaria research, Laveran, the French military surgeon at Constantine in Algiers, first saw the parasites of malaria. He noted both: spherical pigmented bodies and crescents and realized that these were living bodies because he saw the flagellation of the male gamete taking place. It was however not until 1855 that the world in general was finally convinced that these were the causal organisms when Marchiafava using preparations stained with methylene blue was able to observe the whole process of ring formation, increase in size, etc; up to the sporulating cyst. Golgi further elaborated this work and succeeded in demonstrating that fever remissions exactly coincided with the maturity of the merocytes (sporulating forms) and he worked out the definite quartan fever cycle.

Celli and Koch are also particularly connected with the differentiation of the various types of malaria. Romanowsk's stain was a great factor in the further elucidation. In 1894 the mosquito transmission theory was formulated by Manson. Pfeiffer suggested that there was both an endogenous and an exogenous cycle and Ross proved this in bird malaria, working with sparrows. Later Grassi and Bignanni demonstrated the cycle of human malaria. Sambon and Low's experiment in a mosquito screened hut in the Roman campagna, and the transmission of typical malaria to Dr. P. T. Mansen and Mr. G. Warren through infected mosquitoes sent from Italy to London, were strong links in the chain of research. Koch definitely established the fact that human and animal malaria-like infections are distinct entities.

Meanwhile, to return to the therapy of the disease, the alkaloid quinine was isolated from Cinchona by Pelletier and Caventou and

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at the same time attempts were made to synthesize the alkaloid. All such attempts have hitherto proved unsuccessful and it was not until Schulemann, Wingler and Schonhofer succeeded in synthesizing a quinoline derivative, now known as 'Plasmoquine', that a very definite step forward was made. This substance was tested by Roehl on bird malaria and after having proved thoroughly satisfactory was sent out for clinical trials. Sioli, Muhlens and Roehl all obtained good results with it in human malaria and the trials were extended to other parts of the globe by numerous workers. As was only natural, in the first few years of its trial the most effective and least toxic dosage was difficult to establish. It was recognized very early that its specific action on the gametes of subtertian malaria was a valuable economic factor but it was not until it was combined with quinine, which had a better effect on the schizonts, that full use of this asset could be made. Now, after many diligent researches by thoroughly reliable authorities, a definite dosage has been established which in the majority of cases meets all requirements. The drug is now universally accepted as one of the most valuable advances that has been made in the prevention of malaria. Through a combination of quinine and 'Plasmoquine' (issued under the name of Quino-'Plasmoquine') it is now possible to sterilize populations so that even although other economic factors prevent complete eradication of mosquitoes, nevertheless malaria incidence can be diminished since the mosquitoes no longer feed on infected blood.

Treatment of Psoriasis

Richard Sutton, in the *U. S. Naval Medical Bulletin*, says that during the past twenty-five years the remedies that he has employed in the treatment of psoriasis are legion. In the end, he has sifted them down to four. He no longer dreads to see an extensive case of psoriasis brought into his office. Internally he has learned

to depend upon foreign proteins and, to a lesser degree, arsenic; externally, on chrysarobin and ammoniated mercury. Chrysarobin is the most valuable of all.

It is prescribed in a vaseline mixture, in the proportion of one to five. At first glance, 20 per cent may appear rather strong, but in an experience covering several hundreds of cases he has never seen any ill effects following its use. Of course it cannot be applied to the scalp and face because of its staining qualities and its liability to cause conjunctivitis, but when employed on the trunk and limbs, best with a small, stiff bristle brush, night and morning, the result is little short of marvelous. One week of hospitalization generally is sufficient. The mercurial, in a mixture consisting of salicylic acid (10 parts), ammoniated mercury (5 parts), and vaseline (85 parts), is used on the face and scalp, and later, if need be, on the trunk and limbs. As a rule, at the end of a week it is best carefully to cleanse the skin with soap and water, and if much inflamed apply zinc oxide ointment for a few days. Any persistent lesions can then be treated with the ammoniated mercury ointment after the patient leaves the hospital. Care must be taken to bandage the patient's eyes at night to protect them from the chrysarobin.

Of the various foreign proteins, he has found colon vaccine best (in doses from 100,000,000 upwards, always subcutaneously, never intravenously), although some of the milk preparations are reliable and dependable.

Protein shock appears to lessen the resistance of the cutaneous lesions, and render them more susceptible to the action of chrysarobin and similar remedies.

Not until the patient is rid of the eruption is arsenic prescribed, and even then its action is carefully watched. It is best given by mouth, in the form of Liquor potassii arsenitis, and doses of not more than five or six drops, well diluted, and on a full stomach. Care must be exercised to prevent the patient from continuing the arsenic over long periods of time. Arsenical keratoses are easily acquired and hard to get rid of.—*Urolog & Cutaneous Rev.*

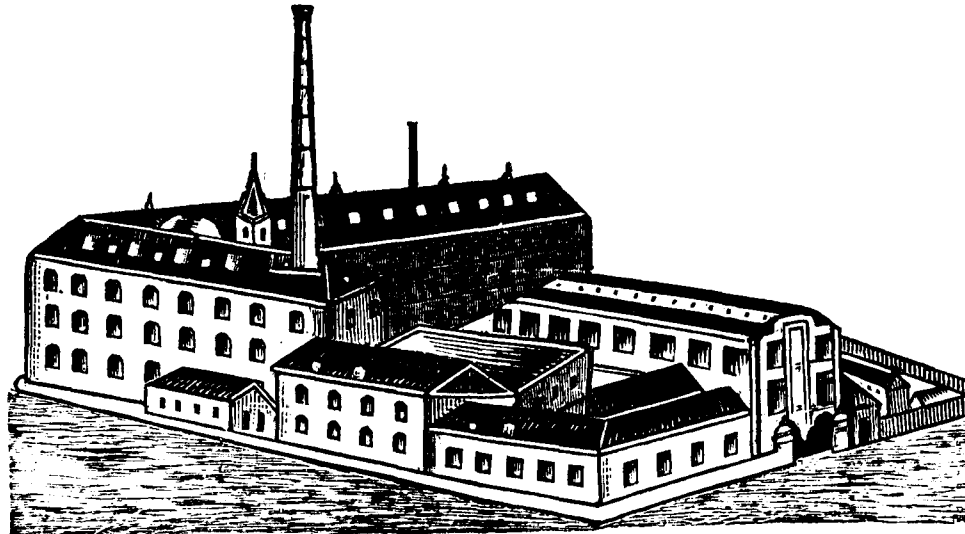

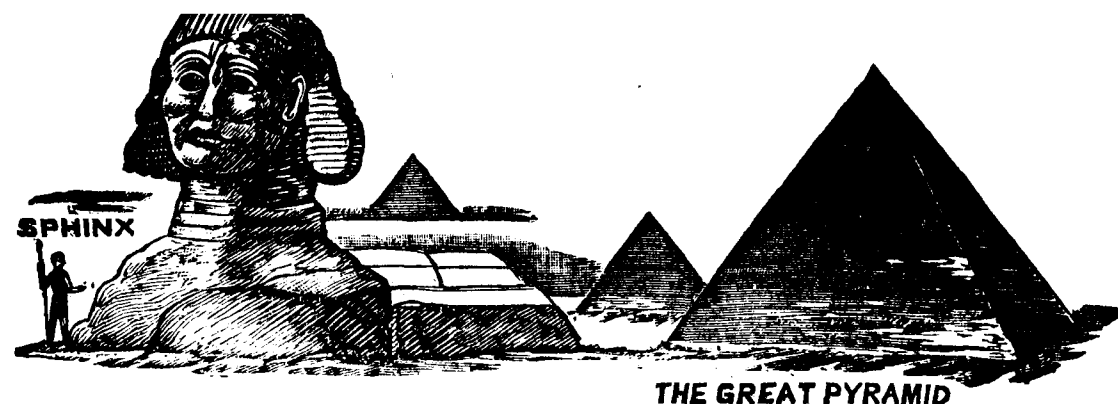

New Uses of Blood from the Dead

The blood of the dead may soon be used to restore the living to health.

Experiments in Russia are stated to have disclosed these startling facts:—

Blood from corpses gives better results than that from live donors.

Red cell increase is higher after transfusion from a dead person than after transfusion from live donors.

Professor W. N. Shamor, outlining his remarkable experiments on animals and man in *The Lancet* declares that the transfusion of cadaver (corpse) blood has other definite advantage—notably the rarer and less conspicuous reactions on patients.

"PREJUDICE"

"In spite of the fact that there is a large body of supporting evidence for its value and that full sanction has been obtained for taking blood from cases of sudden death, medical men at the courts of justice were unwilling to allow the blood of bodies that are at their disposal to be drawn for clinical needs," writes the professor.

He speaks of the strong prejudice in the majority of people at the bare thought of transfusing into a live person the blood from a corpse and the "holy awe" at the thought of "disturbing the repose of the dead."

From experiments on animals the professor "confirmed our fundamental thesis that the blood in the dead body

preserves its vitality for about ten hours after death."

The efforts of two Berlin doctors named Wencklebach and Kunert have led to the isolation of the virus of measles, according to the *German Medical Weekly*, writes a medical correspondent.

It is stated that the virus has been discovered in an embryonic membrane of a hen's leg.

If this virus has been successfully isolated and cultured it may become possible to prepare an effective vaccine of specific preventive value.

CONSERVATIVE ENGLISH DOCTORS

A London hospital doctor declared

"The use of corpses' blood in the treatment of illness has been in vogue for some years in Russia.

"I saw it done at a big accident hospital in Moscow. Precautions are taken to ensure that the dead did not die from any disease.

"It is claimed that very good results have been obtained.

"I have been trying to advocate this method in this country in order to relieve the strain on blood donors, but there seems to be very little enthusiasm for it among British medical men.

Dr. EIJKMAN and BERIBERI

Beriberi is a disease of the Orient. As long ago as 1880, a young Japanese physician, Dr. Takaki, educated at St. Thomas Hospital, London, realized that the disease was caused by a deficiency in the diet. But he went no further than to add fresh meat and other foods to the unbalanced rice diet of the Japanese Navy.

Dr. Christian Eijkman, a Hollander by birth, was sent to the Dutch East Indies with the Colonial Army in 1883. He was amazed at the numerous cases of beriberi among the prisoners who were in his charge. The disease manifested itself in a polyneuritis and muscular atrophy of the arms and legs with extreme swelling.

Unfortunately Dr. Eijkman was invalidated after two years of service in the tropics. He returned to Holland and began work as a bacteriologist. He could not forget the suffering of the victims of beriberi that he had left behind, and in 1886 he returned to the East Indies as a member of a Commission to study this disease. The Commission concluded that it was caused by an infection. They thereupon returned home. Dr. Eijkman remained in Batavia. He was not satisfied. An admirer of Dr. Koch, he wanted to isolate the germ. He applied all known laboratory methods to secretions and blood of patients with no results.

One day he noticed something peculiar about the chickens in the hospital yard; a limpness of the neck and wings, and paralysis of the legs. Suddenly he identified their condition with beriberi of humans.

At last Dr. Eijkman had an experimental animal to work with. These chickens were fed with scraps from the hospital food, mainly polished rice. The young doctor thought that the germ causing beriberi entered the chicken's body through the waste food of the patients. He watched them, but a newly appointed hospital superintendent refused to let Dr. Eijkman feed the scraps to the chickens.

He protested in vain, little realizing that here was a stroke of good fortune. The fowl were then fed unhusked rice and recovered! Amazed, he began experiments on two sets of fowl, feeding one polished rice alone, and the other unpolished rice. The latter remained healthy, the former developed polyneuritis. Here was the answer to his question. The experiment was continued on prisoners, with identical results. Some years later the beriberi hospital was closed for want of inmates.

Dr. Eijkman's work for which he later received the Nobel Prize, was done from 1889 to 1897. In 1911 the crystalline anti-beriberi element was extracted from rice husks by Casimir Funk. He named it "Vitamin."

Compound Solution of Tannic Acid in the Treatment of Burns

According to Bernard Fantus and H. A. Dyniewicz (*J. A. M. A.*, July 17, 1937) the following solution is now being used with success in the Cook County Hospital in the treatment of extensive burns. It is comparatively stable and is kept on hand for use in emergencies. It produces a denser coagulum. It is superior to plain tannic acid solutions because it has bacteriostatic action.

R Potassium chloride.....	0.42 Gm.
Calcium chloride.....	0.84 Gm.
Salicylic acid.....	1.00 Gm.
Sodium chloride.....	10.50 Gm.
Tannic acid.....	100.00 Gm.
Distilled water to make.	1000, c.c.

Mix and permit to stand with occasional agitation until dissolved and filter, if required to dispense a clear solution.

They also recommend that a ten per cent silver nitrate solution be applied to the tannic acid crust.

Tannic acid acts by controlling "white bleeding," i. e., the depletion of the serum from the circulation into the inflammatory edema and exudate. It is also believed that the crust renders insoluble and unabsorbable the hypothetical "burn toxins."

Heart Pain Traced to Overweight in Many Cases

Severe chest pain resembling that of the dread heart malady, angina pectoris, is often due to overweight, William J. Kerr, professor of medicine in the University of California Medical School, has found.

The huge "bay window" of very fat men forces them to adopt an abnormal posture which cramps the chest, causes flaring of the lower ribs, fixes the diaphragm at a low position, thus producing breathlessness and preventing the heart from getting a normal supply of oxygen. Severe pain and low blood pressure in the standing position which is contrary to the usual experience in heart failure.

The pain and other features clear up when the weight is reduced and the posture brought back to normal, Dr. Kerr discovered. Diet, properly fitted abdominal belts, and later postural exercises are used in the treatment.—*Science News-Letter*.

Bed Sores

When bed sores threaten, the skin may be hardened with a five per cent solution of silver nitrate in distilled water, or by equal parts of tincture of catechu and solution lead subacetate. When bed sores have already formed spray with a five per cent solution of tannic acid at hourly intervals and dry by an electric drier or exposure to dry heat from electric lights. A tough coagulum forms after about 20 applications at intervals of one hour.—J. M. Love, *Practitioner*, London.

Animal Disease Virus

One of the outstanding events in the progress of medical science reported in the year just past and one of far reaching promise, states the *Science News-Letter*, is that the virus of at least two animal diseases, in addition to those of certain plant diseases, are non-living protein molecules. News and more successful methods of treating and preventing the largely unconquered group of virus caused ailments, to which belong infantile paralysis and encephalitis, may result from the new knowledge of the nature of the causes of these diseases. It has even been suggested that this discovery may give a clue to the secret of life itself, since it gives scientists a chance to study the phenomenon by which non-living matter appears to become endowed with characteristics of living matter.

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**Pericarditis as an Early Sign of
Rheumatic Infection in Children**

According to J. B. Wilson and Victor A. Digilio (J. A. M. A.) childhood rheumatism is associated with a multiplicity of symptoms (e. g., muscle and joint pains, paroxysmal abdominal pains, sore throat, stiff neck, involuntary muscular twitchings resembling tics, pallor, fixation of weight and a persistent lowgrade elevation of temperature).

There is, however, a new physical sign: a murmur over the base of the heart due to basal pericarditis. A plastic exudate occurs at the base of the heart especially in the region of the origin of the great vessels and the groove between the aorta and the pulmonary artery. It is an early sign which portends the development of childhood rheumatism. This murmur or pericardial friction fremitus has the following characteristics.

1. Time. Either systolic or diastolic. It may vary even during a single examination.
2. Character. Friction-like but variable from beat to beat. Often transitory playing hide and seek. It usually persists for years after the arrest of the rheumatic phase.
3. Where heard. Heard best in the region of the second and third intercostal junction on the left side.
4. Transmission. Not transmitted.

Fever and Rash After Sulfanilamide

P. O. Hageman and F. G. Blake (J. A. M. A.) state that in 15 per cent of their cases, fever occurred after the administration of sulfanilamide. It occurred most commonly between the 7th and 10th days but may occur earlier or later (4th to 13th days). Drug fever usually appeared abruptly. Fever may be associated with malaise, itching and tinnitus. Fever usually lasts from 2 to 3 days.

In a few cases the fever was associated with a rash. It usually was a maculo-papular erythema. Other lesions were: hemorrhagic and urticarial-like wheals. The lesions varied in size from 0.3 to 4.0 cm. The usual locations were: face, trunk and extremities. It is most marked over the buttocks, knees and back where the rash tends to become confluent.

**Don't Fight That Tired Feeling;
Rest and Relax**

Fatigue is something most persons in this strenuous, struggling world resent and fight against. Fatigue should, however, be welcomed as a friend giving a first-class safety warning. The person who feels tired all the time should find out why he is tired and take steps to dispel the cause.

Rest and relaxation are probably called for. Dr. Conrad S. Sommer, medical director of the Illinois Society for Mental Hygiene, says that most of us need to reorganize our lives. Fatigue comes to many people simply because they are trying to do too much—and often for not very good reasons. A yearly vacation, an occasional week-end of relaxation and at least one evening a week of really relaxing recreation are prescribed by Dr. Sommer as antidotes for that tired feeling.

Besides overexertion, either mental or physical, there are a number of other causes of fatigue. The weather may make anyone feel tired. This may range from the not unpleasant lassitude of spring fever to the utter exhaustion experienced on a hot humid day in midsummer.

Not much can be done about the weather, but eyestrain, strain from exposure to continuous noise, weakened arches, poor posture, hernia, and strain or relaxation of muscles, tendons and ligaments that support important body organs are important causes of fatigue that can be remedied. A physician's aid is indicated in these cases.

More subtle reasons for feeling tired are to be found in the field of personal relations. The complex, competitive manner of modern life makes it doubly hard to get along with people. To this strain is often added the stress of internal conflict, than which nothing is more wearing. It is less tiring and better for mental health to recognize the causes of such inner conflict than to try to bury or ignore them.—*Science News-Letter*.

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
