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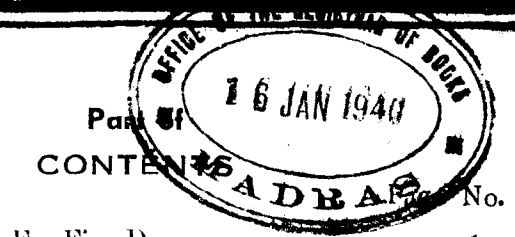

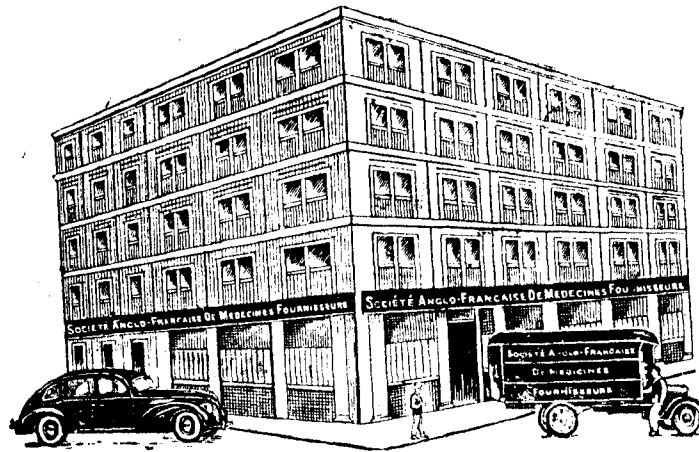

PATIENTS "FROZEN" FOR FIVE DAYS

Suspension of Life Amazes Medical World

EXPERIMENTS in "freezing" sick patients into a virtually suspended state of life—which may prove to be of the utmost importance in the world of medicine—have been made by two Philadelphia doctors, Dr Temple S. Fav and Dr Lawrence W. Smith.

They have been experimenting with cancer victims and they want to try their "freezing" process on heart disease, insanity, tuberculosis and many other diseases.

The process, as outlined by them at the annual meeting of the American Medical Association, is as follows:

The patients are stripped and covered with cracked ice. An electric fan is turned on. In three hours their internal temperatures are forced down below 90 degrees.

The patients literally go into a sleep similar to that drowsiness experienced normally by a freezing person, except that in this case the patients feel no pain.

Their room is kept cold so that when the ice is removed they remain cold. They stay like that for five days.

Then they are roused with hot coffee and warm applications. They awake smiling, with no memory of what has happened.

Cancer Cells Killed

In the meantime, it is claimed, the cold has killed at least the young cancer cells which form from 10 to 90 per cent. of growing cancer according to indications from these experiments.

But it is not this that has amazed the medical world.

It is the suspension of life—of which admittedly no one seems to know quite how to take advantage—that has awakened doctors to the possibilities of this freezing process.

For in their "frozen sleep," the patients' pulse beat disappears. Only the electrocardiograph shows that their hearts are still beating and that surprisingly, the rhythm is perfect, although very light.

Their kidneys and apparently all their digestive organs cease to work. But this, ordinarily a sign of approaching death, seems of no danger because at the same time analysis of the blood shows it has ceased to fill up with waste products. There is nothing to eliminate.

Metabolism—the process whereby nutritive materials is built up into living matter—is reduced to 10 per cent. from 20.

Prolonging Life

No frozen patient has ever caught pneumonia or a cold; the germs in their bodies apparently slow down along with the entire organism.

Previously, when a patient's temperature dropped even close to 90 degrees death was considered inevitable. But in these new experiments one woman's temperature was brought down to 82 for a short period with no ill effects.

What the experiments portend, doctors cannot forecast.

Some consider that they may provide a new weapon for science. By freezing patients in this manner, they think, it should be possible to give the heart a complete rest, as nothing else can, and so, perhaps prolong life. Germ diseases too, may be susceptible to this treatment.

Human "hibernation" is in its infancy but its possibilities are being viewed with grave attention by the medical profession.

The Oath of Hippocrates.

I SWEAR by Appolo the Physician, by Asklepios, by his daughters Hygeia and Panacea and by all the gods and goddesses, that to the best of my ability and judgment I will faithfully keep this oath and obligation.

THE master that has instructed me I will esteem as my parents, and shall supply to him, as occasion may require, the comforts and necessities of life. His children I will regard as my own brothers, and if they desire to learn I will instruct them in the same art without any reward. My patients shall be treated by me to the best of my power and judgment in the best manner, without injury or violence.

NEITHER will I be prevailed upon by anyone to administer noxious medicines nor I will be the author of such advice myself, but will live and practice chastely and religiously. I will not meddle with lithotomy, leaving that to operators of that art. Whatever house I am called upon to attend, I will aim at making the patient's good my chief aim, avoiding all injury, corruption and unchastity; and whatever I hear in the course of my practice relating to the affairs of life of my patients that ought to remain secret, nobody shall ever know of me.

MAY I be prosperous, honoured and esteemed by all men as I observe this solemn oath, and may the reverse be my lot if I violate it and forswear myself.

Health Rules

By a Doctor.

First of all, have your grinding teeth put in order; if you cannot bite your food, and consequently swallow it in lumps, your inside will be put out of gear at once, and constipation will result. Eat very slowly; cut your meat up on your plate before you put it into your mouth; take ten minutes longer over your meals than anybody else; get up in the morning in good time, so that you do not have to hurry over your breakfast.

Brown bread is better for you than white. Do not start telling me you hate brown bread; you must eat it, and you will soon prefer it to the white variety. Porridge for breakfast is good for you. Tea is bad; take only one cup of tea a day, and that very weak. Tea on waking, tea at eleven, tea for dinner, tea for tea, and an extra cup because Mrs Brown popped in at half-past five, and tea for supper—all this is the best I know for promoting constipation. Anæmic girls keep themselves ill by tea. Cocoa made with milk is worth the money because it is real nourishment.

The Onion as a Social Problem

In the laboratory of applied physiology at Yale University, H. W. Haggard and L. A. Greenberg have been trying to find why an alliaceous odour persists in the breath after eating onions or garlic. It is generally supposed that, like ether, alcohol, and acetone,

the essential oil of onion passes into the blood stream and is aerated from the blood in the lungs, so passing into the expired air. Alternative possibilities are that these oils are secreted into the saliva or that the smell comes from the stomach by way of the oesophagus. Haggard and Greenberg will have none of these hypotheses, and they seem to produce conclusive evidence in favour of their own explanation. Their initial experiment was to give 1.5 g. of raw garlic, chewed and swallowed in the ordinary way and followed by the usual odours for a day or more. The same person then took the same quantity chopped in small particles but enclosed in gelatin capsules. No smell whatever was detected in the breath, except once when the subject belched three hours after taking his dose. The investigators thence passed to quantitative tests, where we need not follow them. But all the results go to show that they are right in thinking that the continuing smell of onions or garlic in the breath arises solely from particles retained in the mouth. These particles cannot be completely removed by mechanical means; to brush the teeth and tongue, to wash the mouth with soap and water or even with a 30 per cent. solution of alcohol, will not deodorise the breath. Haggard and Greenberg however are able to propose a remedy which is in fact effective namely, the rinsing of the mouth with a solution of chloramine, which liberates free chlorine in the mouth and so quickly and completely removes the offending odour. They suggest that many cases of foul breath from other local causes are probably amenable to the same simple treatment, and we hope this may be so. It is salutary, however, to remember the story of the American millionaire who, stimulated by advertisements, spent a large sum on a cure for halitosis; only to find afterwards that his friends did not like him any way.—*The Lancet*,

The utility of beard.

Dr. Charles Hooper, writes as follows:—

A writer advocates the use of the electric needle to eliminate the beard, and so save the large amount of time spent in shaving.

Why this horror at thought of a beard? Men let hair grow on the head, why not let it grow on the face? A man is ashamed of a bald spot on his head; yet he makes his entire face bald, and shamelessly deprives himself of a beard, the symbol of manhood.

A beard or moustache gives strength, character, individuality, and distinction to face and bearing, and marks the difference between man and woman. In their hearts women like moustaches and beards, and secretly admire and respect bearded men more than they do smooth-faced men. Women affect to dislike moustaches and beards simply because style—woman's master—has placed the beard under a ban. Hair about the nostrils and mouth strains out harmful dust and germs. A beard protects the throat from cold.

The moustache and beard are coming back. With them will come back man's old authority over woman. No wife ever got a divorce from a bearded patriarch. A bearded man tries to live up to his beard. He is dignified, as becomes a man. Why should a full-grown man have a smooth face like a boy or a babe?

The good Lord made the moustache and beard because he meant men to wear them.

Diet in Pregnancy

DIET should be ample but not excessive. Good quantity of milk should be taken. Sufficient carbohydrate must be taken for neutralization of fatty acids, maintenance of normal alkali reserve and for helping general nutrition and foetal growth. Proteins and fats must be low as excessive intake will produce toxic substance. Eggs should not be taken more than one a day. Mild exercise such as walking two miles a day is also recommended.

Toxæmia of Pregnancy is mainly due to vitamin deficiency. The foetus, a true parasite, robs the mother of important substances of which she has an inadequate supply for her own needs. Food itself requires vitamins for full assimilation. A high protein diet requires more vitamins B and D than a mainly carbohydrate diet. Deficiency of one Vitamin interferes with the action of the others. Pregnancy requires an increased intake of all vitamins.

Administration of calcium during pregnancy is necessary to maintain the mother's calcium storage to satisfy the requirements of the foetus in the last month of pregnancy and with the supply of calcium there should be a supply of phosphorus as well. Milk is the best source of calcium and at least 2 points must be given a day. Other sources are cheese and green vegetable. Eggs for phosphorus and vitamins D in the form of cod-liver oil for calcium metabolism must be used.

Addition of iron in the form of iron and ammonium citrate, liver extracts and marmite (autolysed yeast) will easily solve the problem of anæmia of pregnancy. (From a discussion at the Royal Society of Medicine).—"*Clinical Digest*",

How it Feels to be Bitten by a "Black Widow"

Like many physicians, I thought the bite of the Black Widow spider was less dangerous than some of the newspaper accounts had made people believe. While poisonous, I contended that the creature could not inflict a serious wound, some of the extreme symptoms being presumably due to hysteria. Having been bitten, I am no longer a sceptic. The Black Widow wields a lethal weapon, and woe to anyone who crosses her trail.

My experience came just after I had decided to spend my summer vacation at home: it was the very first morning that I encountered the ebony queen. I stalked into the backyard, surveyed the landscape, and discovered a tangle of honeysuckle vines which dropped from a fence and covered old boards against the garage. Several vines had become entwined in the lumber, and while extracting one I felt a slight prick in the knuckle of my left hand. Glancing at the injury, I discerned only a tiny red spot, and concluded it was a sliver from dry Oregon pine. The job, a pleasant one under a balmy sky, was completed at eleven o'clock. But the hand, now aching considerably, needed attention, so I painted it with a strong solution of tincture of iodine.

By noon the hand had grown worse and become greatly swollen. The back where the skin adhered to the knuckles appeared smooth and glossy, as if affected by erysipeals. My mind searched through the annals of medical lore, but found no satisfactory answer in ancient or modern diagnoses. I therefore became simply a patient whose symptoms must be charted. The necessary pencil and pad, ruled forms, and clinical supplies rested upon a small table. The clock indicating one o'clock, declared that the moment had arrived for further checking. The pain, extending to the elbow, suggested additional remedies, and I soaked the hand and forearm for thirty minutes in a concentrated solution of Epsom salts.

Two hours passed, and the whole body, as in a severe case of influenza, groaned with the so-called muscle and bone aches. Temperature had risen to 101 degrees. I was helpless and quite ill, so I called in a brother physician.

He looked me over, maliciously thumped me here and there, and glared accusingly but said nothing.

"Well, what's wrong?"

"You have been bitten by a Black Widow spider," he blurted out.

The naked and unadorned statement had an ominous ring. There flashed through my mind the many legends, tales of horror and woeful death, which had been chalked up to this fifth horseman of the Apocalypse.

"What's to be done?" I said.

"A little morphine. Yes, possibly, the hospital."

The rule is, of course, to obey the physician, but there are few physicians who could reassure their patient with an affirmative answer to the question: "Are you a Black Widow spider doctor?" Therefore I bluntly protested: "No morphine. And let's postpone the hospital. For a while, anyway." I did not want to miss my own show.

As a parting gesture he warned; "When you get worse, call me—if you are able." Factory whistles screeched four o'clock.

A sudden excruciating pain, similar to being hit by a club, struck at the base of the skull, followed by dizziness, a stiffening of the neck, nausea, and vomiting. Lancinating cramps, agonising and vomiting. Lancinating cramps, agonising and gnawing, attacked the stomach, and the sole relief was pressure from the hands.

Determined to continue my observations and attempting to be scientific and impartial as toward a laboratory specimen, I proceeded to jot down my condition at six p.m. The hand, swollen still larger, tingled with pain when touched; the fingers stood out rigid, but the thumb proved flexible! Just before retiring at seven, I obtained a half pint of hot water, and mixed into it a teaspoon-

ful of soda bicarbonate and ten grains of aspirin.

Abruptly, about midnight, I awakened, startled and confused. My pyjamas, the sheets, and the pillow dripped with perspiration, and intense thirst clawed at the throat. I hastily changed, drank two glasses of water, and crawled into another bed.

Merely my diary, feebly scrawled, exposed the wreckage that morning. The aftermath, naturally, annoyed me; weakness, nervousness, and a dull, steady ache in the hand and arm. But the terrific pains, those resembling huge tidal waves, seemingly had vanished.

Now other irritations, both physical and psychological, over whelmed me. Ordinary street noises, usually unheard, echoed loudly, and the ring of the telephone sounded like a fire gong. Food, even the thought of it, was abhorrent.

I arose, steadied myself, dressed with difficulty, and attended a local weekly meeting. I remember a single fact, that of refusing to eat. Who participated, what was said, and how I acted will forever remain a mystery. I trudged slowly home, and dug in my pockets for the key. It had evidently been misplaced, so I summoned a lock-smith. Upon entering and walking through the hall, I found the rear door ajar. Amnesia, that strange phenomenon of forgetfulness, had crept upon me, and did not disappear for two long weeks.

The second night eerie dreams, with excessive sweat and subnormal temperature, interrupted my sleep. I slumped out of bed in the morning, and a flare of lights which had burned all night blazed

into my eyes as I entered the living-room. A cantelupe, uncut, stood on the radio cabinet. Where the melon came from, who put it there, and for what purpose, perplexed me. Though my memory gave no answer, I knew that I had alone occupied the quarters.

By Thursday morning my curiosity was aroused regarding the culprit. I prized the timbers loose, uncovered a quantity

of debris, and exposed a coal-black spider, with eight wiry legs, dangling from a coarsely woven web. I viewed her from another position, and saw, beneath the abdomen, a scarlet insignia shaped like an old-fashioned hour-glass. Three egg-sacs, each containing several hundred spiderlings, nestled in close proximity. Deliberately, and with forethought, I aimed, fired, and squashed my holiday spoiler.

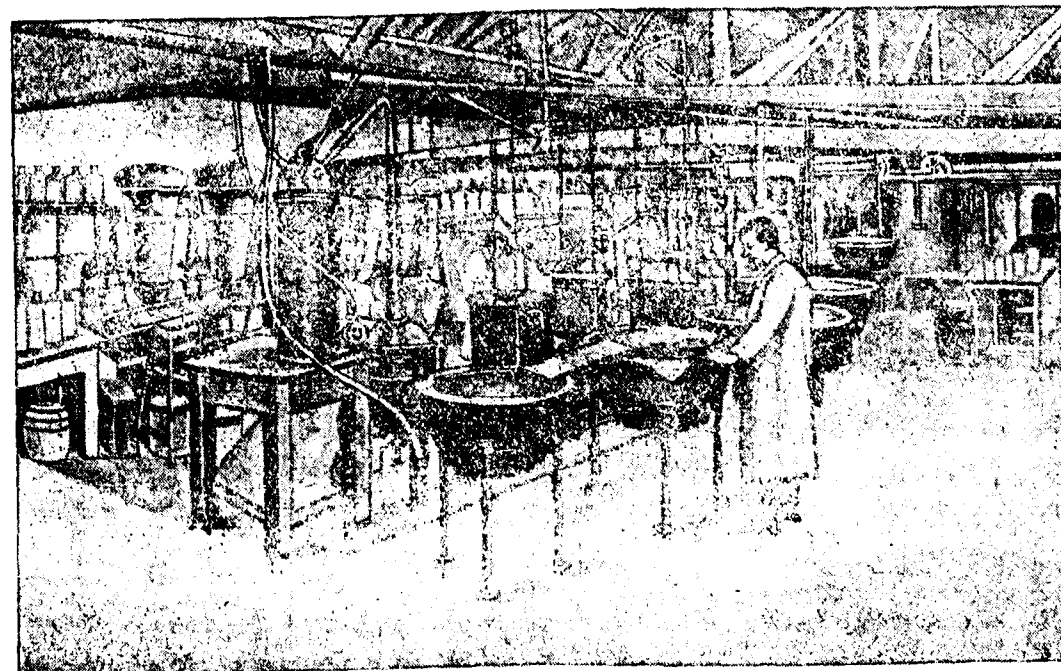

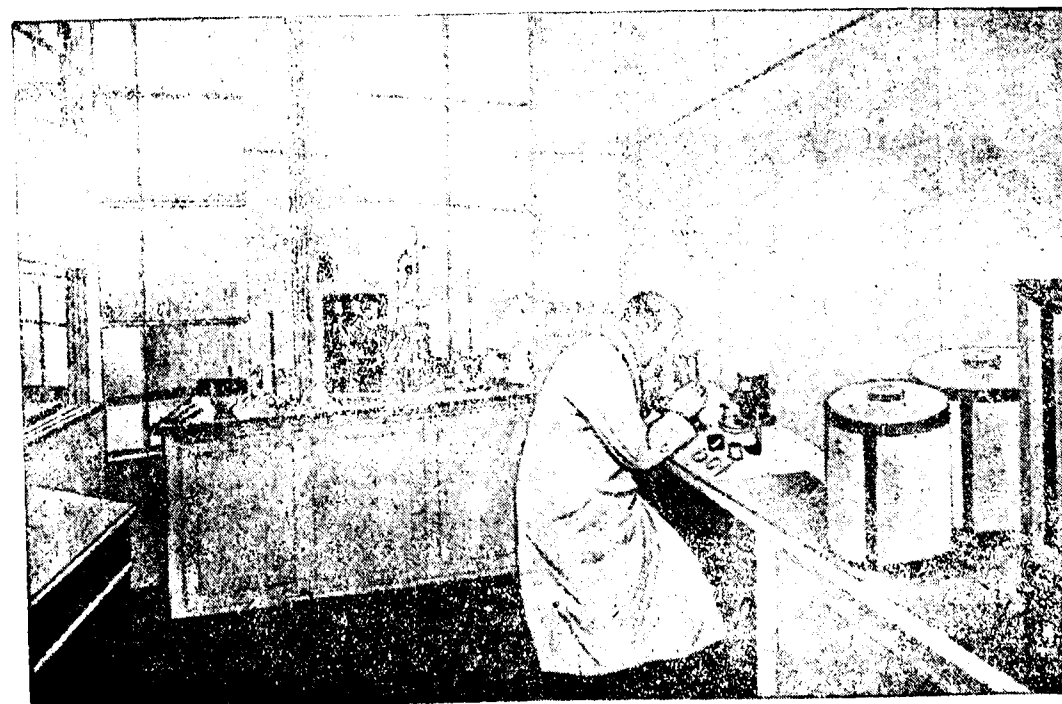

ALBERT NEISSER

Discoverer of the cause of Gonorrhoea

The name of Albert Neisser will be perpetuated for his discovery of the causal agent of gonorrhoea. However, gonorrhoea is still one of the most prevalent infections. This disease and other sexual diseases have existed since the dawn of civilization.

Health authorities have estimated that one out of ten persons in the United States suffers from some form of venereal disease. Despite all the modern prophylactic measures and the knowledge of effective prevention of gonorrheal infections after exposure, nevertheless indifference, ignorance and false prudery are still largely responsible for the undue prevalence of this disease. Gonorrhea is entirely a human affliction. In adults it is almost invariably transmitted through sex contact, but in some instances the gonococcus may remain alive on towels, clothing or bedding for short periods of time and thus infrequently prove infective. The disease has been known to spread rapidly through schools and orphan asylums in which infected attendants have been employed. Sterility in women and blindness in new-born babies are frequently produced by the gonococcus; but in recent years the prevention and treatment of gonorrheal infections have under gone considerable progress. A 2 percent solution of silver nitrate in the eyes of a new-born infant is a positive preventive of blindness from this disease. This preventive measure is now used throughout the civilized world.

The cause of gonorrhea remained unknown until 1879. In that year Albert Neisser, following the bacteriologic methods of Koch, poured a watery solution of methyl violet over a bit of gonorrheal pus and then examined it under high power magnification through a microscope. In this manner he was first to discover the gonococcus.

Neisser was born at Breslau, Germany, January, 22, 1855, and he lived until 1916. For many years prior to the discovery which brought him into world prominence, he was successively professor of skin and venereal diseases and occupant of the chair in dermatology at the University of Breslau. His studies embraced almost the entire field of dermatology and syphilology, and he was first to observe the tuberculous. An indefatigable research worker and writer, he was particularly active in studying the prophylaxis of venereal diseases in general and the prostitution problem from the sociologic, national economic and ethical points of view. Like his father, who was a practising physician at Breslau before him, Neisser was held in high esteem by all who knew him. For his isolation of the gonococcus, numerous researches on various pathogenic microbes and incessant warfare against infectious disease, he rose to immortal leadership in the cause of medical progress and human welfare.

Complications of Gonorrhoea

The causative organism of gonorrhoea, micro-coccus gonorrhoea was first described by Neisser in 1877. It is an acute infection with a primary lesion which is usually urethritis. It is usually followed by numerous secondary and systemic manifestations of which the most common are epididymitis, salpingitis, arthritis, synovitis and endocarditis.

It is not a killing disease in itself, but looking to its far-reaching consequences, it does not fall very far short of syphilis. It should never be neglected.

Its organism is biscuit-shaped which occurs in pairs, usually within the leucocytes. It occurs in adults due to impure sexual intercourse, in the new born child due to vaginal contamination and in elder children due to accidental infection.

Regarding the systemic gonococcal infection, the most important is gonococcal septicæmia and pyemia. Thayer and Blumer were the first to cultivate gonococci from the blood of a patient. The death rate though not very high, is of considerable high ratio.

Next in importance comes, Gonorrheal arthritis, which in many respects is the most damaging and disabling of all the complications of gonorrhoea. It occurs in 2 to 5 percent of cases. It

occurs more frequently in males than females. As a rule it is found when gonorrhea is in an acute stage but, it can also be seen when the attack is subacute or even chronic. A gonorrhoeal arthritis of great intensity may be found in a woman newly married, being infected by the old gleet in her husband. As a rule, many joints are affected together. Clinically the variability and obstinacy are two main features.

In certain cases wandering pains are detected near the joints, without redness or swelling. In others hydrarthrosis spondylitis and painful heel are found.

Iritis is another complication which is not infrequently found and which has a tendency to recur with every attack subsequently. Sometimes meningitis, myelitis and true neuritis occur.

The search for the primary lesion and a thought of the possibility of gonorrhoeal infection are the best safeguards. The most common blunder that one can commit is to mistake gonococcus arthritis for rheumatic fever. The persistence of trouble in one or two joints should put one on guard. In gonorrhoea the swelling often extends more above and below joints than in other forms of arthritis. The compliment fixation test is sometimes of value.

Teasers (Answers.)

1. Aphorism is a concise sentence embodying an important truth. It seeks to systematise human experience. The word was first used for a collection of medical propositions made by Hippocrates which began with the words "Life is short, art is long." The best known collection of aphorisms is contained in the Book of Proverbs in the Bible. Another well known aphorism of Hippocrates is "experience is fallacious, and judgment difficult" In recent times Professor Gee is well known for teaching medicine by means of aphorisms.

2. (a) The case of the son of the Shunamite woman (2nd Book of Kings chapter IV—the Bible) is perhaps the oldest on record. (Osler)

(b) An Hawaiian convict under sentence of death, who was inoculated on September 30, 1884, by Arning four weeks later had rheumatoid pains and gradual painful swelling of the ulnar and median nerves. The neuritis gradually subsided, but a small lepra tubercle developed at the site of inoculation. In 1887 the disease was manifest and the man died of it six years after inoculation.

(c) Scrofula, tuberculosis of the lymph nodes was known as king's evil, since it was believed that the disease was healed by a King touching the affected person. In the early days the streets of London were crowded with scrofula patients whenever a King went out. Dr. Johnson the celebra-

ted man of letters as a baby was carried to the royal palace for getting touched by the King for the evil.

The first monarch to touch, it is believed, was Edward the confessor.

3. (a) Bedlam is a popular name for any mental hospital. The Bethlehem Hospital, London, was founded in 1247 as a religious house, and became a home for the insane, the first in the country in 1403. It came to be known as Bedlam, and from that Bedlam developed as the name for any mental hospital.

(b) The Greeks called the fluid that ran in the veins of gods, ichor, the equivalent of blood in human beings. The watery discharge from a wound or ulcer is also called ichor.

(c) Mechanical man. The term was first used by Karel Capek in his play R. U. R. 1920 where it described a piece of mechanism extraordinarily efficient, but wholly without heart or soul. Robots of varying degree of efficiency have been invented.

(d) Stone coffin used especially in ancient Egypt as a receptacle for the mummified body. At first stone sarcophagi were reserved for Kings, but later came into more general use.

(b) Samuel Smiles, the author of Thrift, Self-Help, Character, etc.

(c) Esperanto, the universal language was invented by Dr. Zamenhof, a Warsaw medical man, in 1887.

6. (a) Galen—the Greek Physician was born about A. D. 130 at Pergamum and studied medicine in Greece and Egypt. He was physician to the Roman emperors Marcus Aurelius and Commodus, and to many eminent Romans. He died in A. D. 200. Galen wrote a great deal in medicine; though most of his writings have been lost, those that remain were studied by medical men for centuries, and proved him to have been after Hippocrates, the greatest of Greek physicians.

(b) Lord Horder K. C. V. O, M. D. is an English Physician. Thomas Horder born Jan 7, 1871, he received his medical training in St. Bartholomew's Hospital, London. He joined the staff there, and soon became known as a consultant, his patients including members of the royal family. He was raised to peerage in 1933 as Lord Horder of Ashford.

(c) Name given to an American dwarf whose real name was Charles Sherwood Stratton. He was 2 ft. 7 in height and was exhibited in London in 1844 and 1857. He married another dwarf Lavinia Warren.

(A fairy tale of the same name deals with the adventure of a child dwarf.)

(d) Russian Surgeon. Born July 10, 1866, studied medicine in Paris, becoming chief surgeon in the Russian Hospital, and the Military hospital there. He is best known for his method of preventing or delaying senility by grafting monkey glands into the human body. Among his publi-

cations are Thyroid grafting and Life, The Study of Old Age, and My method of Rejuvenation.

(e) Sir Aldo Castellani, the Director General of the Ross Institute and Hospital for Tropical Diseases, London, an Italian by birth, succeeded to that place after the death of Sir Ronald Ross. He has married an English lady. Sir Aldo was in charge of the medical attendance, etc., for the Italian troops in the recent Italo-Abysinian war. One of the main reasons for the Italian victory, was, thanks to Sir Aldo Castellani's careful arrangements, the excellent health of its troops.

7. (a) The baser half of the deal personality of Dr. Jekyll from R. L. Stevenson's "The strange case of Dr. Jekyll and Mr. Hyde.

(b) Central figure of the novel Dracula by Bram Stoker. The chief of the vampires he sucks the blood of healthy human beings, who in turn become vampires.

(c) In Sax Rohmer's, The Devil Doctor, The Mystery of Dr. Fumanchu etc. The doctor is depicted as a picturesque oriental criminal, with a subtle western polish and culture.

(d) There is one Dr. Pangloss in Voltaire's Candide and another in George Colman's comedy the Heir at law. In the latter he is seen as a poor scholar full of learned quotations.

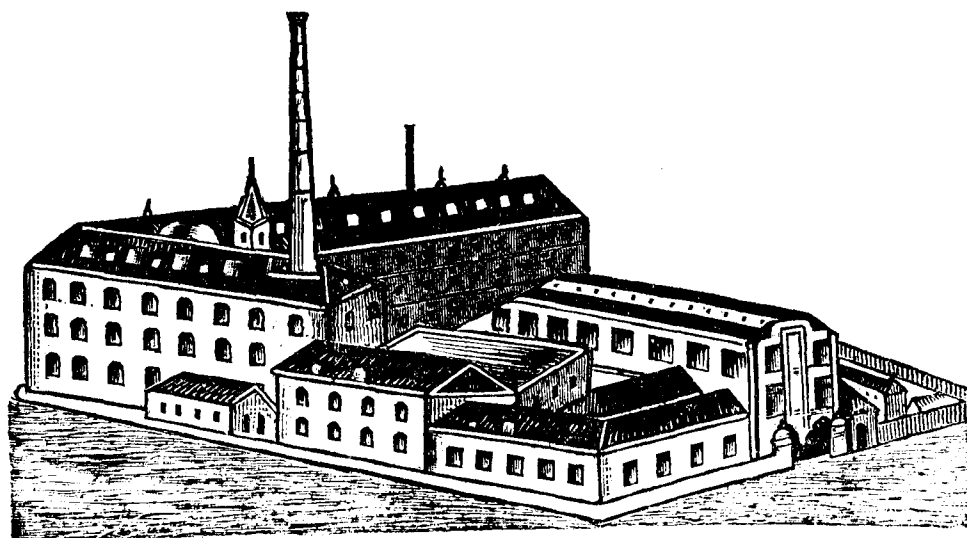

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THE PUFF THAT CHEERS.

The History of Tobacco.—By the word "tobacco" to-day is meant the leaves of certain 'species' of *Nicotiana* (natural order—*Solanaceae*), but the origin of the word "tobacco", though not exactly wrapped in obscurity, is certainly somewhat vague.

Several hundreds of years ago it was the custom among the inhabitants of San Domingo to inhale tobacco fumes through an instrument of queer shape, which they called the "tobacco". The instrument consisted of 'y' shaped wooden tube; one end of this was placed in the fumes arising from the fire which had been kindled from tobacco leaves, and the other two extremities were inserted into the nostrils of the inhaler. Thus it would seem that the word owes its origin to the apparatus used for the inhalation of its fumes. On the other hand reliable record leads us to believe that the Mexican name for the herb has always been "tobacco".

The scientific name of the genus, *i.e.*, "*Nicotiana*" was established in commemoration of Jean Nicot. This man was at one time the French Ambassador to Portugal. He is supposed to have carried out some botanical investigations in connection with the plant, and to have sent a large quantity of tobacco seeds to Catherine de Medici, because they were accredited with miraculous healing powers, so much so that the tobacco plant in ancient times was known as the "*Herba panacea*" and the "*Herba Sancta*". The immortal Spenser in his writings even went so far as to use the adjective 'divine' in describing the plant.

It is common knowledge that the home of tobacco is America. In 1492 the followers of Columbus, at Cuba, noticed the natives carrying lighted firebrands which gave forth large volumes of smoke, and it was observed that the natives were in the habit of perfuming themselves with the same herb, moreover the inhalation of the fumes was part of the most solemn tribal ceremonies, and had considerable religious significance.

The tobacco plant itself was first brought to Europe in 1558 by Francisco Fernandez, who was a physician to Phillip II of Spain. He had been sent to Mexico to investigate the medicinal products of that country.

Although the credit for the introduction of the plant into Europe goes to Spain nevertheless the habit of smoking was neither initiated nor propagated by the Spanish people. It was through the example of Englishmen that the practice of smoking spread rapidly throughout Europe.

Probably the first habitual smoker was an Englishman named Ralph Lane, who was the Governor of Virginia. However it was not Ralph Lane but Sir Walter Raleigh who was responsible for the inculcation of the habit among the Elizabethan courtiers. In the popularisation of the habit in England Sir Walter Raleigh was assisted by other famous people, chief among whom were Sir John Hawkins and Sir Francis Drake. With so many renowned sailors as parents of the habit it does not seem extraordinary why almost every sailor to-day say that his best friend is his pipe!

The implements and materials for "tobacco smoking" were brought to England in 1586 by Ralph Lane and Sir Francis Drake, and these were first handed over to Sir Walter Raleigh, whose servant had to douse him with water when he first attempted to smoke!

From the very first the use of tobacco was bitterly opposed by both statesmen and priests. Popes issued edicts against smoking; in Turkey and Russia it was made a punishable offence and in England James I was constrained to issue his "counterblaste to tobacco" in which he described smoking as 'custom loathsome to the eye, hateful to the lungs.....resembling the horrible Stygian smoke of the pit that is bottomless'. Nevertheless the most resolute opposition failed to suppress the practice in its initial

stages, and the habit spread with amazing rapidity throughout all nations and countries, until to-day the habit is more or less world-wide. Notwithstanding the fact that three centuries of experience have, since that time, shown the comparative harmlessness of tobacco when used in moderation, equally violent diatribes are still occasionally directed against smoking by that estimable band of people who call themselves 'Temperance workers', but who too in reality are guilty of intemperance; for are they not intemperate in their temperance?

The acquirement of the habit and its maintenance.—An investigation into the acquirement of the habit of smoking in modern young men cannot fail to be of interest. The process of maturation of the normal human male is marked by physiological phenomena such as the appearance of hair upon the upper lip, the development of a deeper tone of voice, and by certain psychological changes; among these latter is included a desire to put away childish things and to take unto oneself the deportment, the habit, and the hall mark of a full grown man. This may appropriately be termed a stage of precocity, during which there develops a seemingly unnatural tendency toward habits generally considered to be typically masculine, some of which however have, in truth, nothing to commend them. At no other time in the life of a man is the fact that he is a 'creature of habit' more evident. At no other time is he more liable to acquire habits which are harmful to himself.

The sex instinct is undoubtedly associated with the acquirement of these so-called masculine habits. It is the desire to appear in the light of a seasoned man of the world before the eyes of the opposite sex, that is in no small measure responsible for the practices of smoking and drinking among modern youth. Women do not judge man by breadth of shoulder and depth of voice alone, but by his habits and deportment as well. There is a fair majority of women who look askance at men who do not smoke, or drink, or do things generally considered to be typically masculine. A 'he-man' who is too temperate ceases to be considered a 'he-man'.

A factor of equal importance in the acquirement of habits detrimental to one's well-being is a dread of being considered a masculine by one's own fellow-men. Thus the probable explanation of the origin and establishment of the habit of smoking in the young man of to-day lies in the desire to appear fashionable and up-to-date, the dread of being considered under-sexed and amasculine, but certainly not in the desire to experience any pleasurable effects. Perhaps the acquirement of the habit is due in some measure to a sense of curiosity. It is a well acknowledged fact that the first taste of tobacco is decidedly nauseating, so nauseating in fact that in many cases it is sufficient to last the would-be smoker for the rest of his natural life. Almost everyone knows this, and yet the potential smoker deliberately seeks the experience. Having survived the unpleasant experience of the first inhalation and still being intent upon smoking, the individual learns to avoid any unpleasant sensations by inhaling at first very small but later gradually increasing quantities of tobacco smoke, until ultimately he is able to inspire the fumes of an entire cigarette without experiencing any uncomfortable subjective symptoms. The amount of tobacco consumed by the individual gradually increases until there comes a time when he is capable of smoking just as much tobacco as the next man. Social intercourse aggravates the desire to smoke but is not responsible for the maintenance of the habit. A habitual smoker, having been cut off entirely from civilisation still experiences the desire to smoke, and there are many lonely men who find tobacco indispensable. From this fact it may be gathered that some kind of enjoyment must be derived from the use of tobacco, by the habitual smoker at any rate. Habitual smokers continue to smoke not because they have become the slaves of a habit but because they have learnt to appreciate smoking and to derive some pleasure therefrom. There are many strong willed men who are capable of giving up the habit at a moments notice but who do not do so because they do not desire to do so. It would seem ridiculous to compare tobacco addiction with morphine addiction or even with the alcohol habit, for although a desire, which in some cases almost

amounts to a craving is experienced when habitual smokers suddenly abstain from tobacco, yet this craving is not attributable to any definitely stimulant or depressant effect such as is the case with morphine and alcohol.

It has been suggested that the establishment of the habit has nothing whatever to do with the effects of tobacco itself but is merely due to the development of a complicated system of conditioned reflex arising out of a series of movements such as the following:—insert hand in pocket—remove cigarette—place cigarette between lips—extract match box from pocket—remove match stick—strike match—flick burnt out match away—return match box to pocket—remove cigarette from mouth—inhalate deeply—return cigarette to mouth, etc. Whether or not this theory is the sole explanation is certainly open to question but conditioned reflexes probably have something to do with the continuance of the practice.

A curious but very significant fact is that blind men hardly ever smoke. Moreover the enjoyment derived out of smoking is greatly reduced when the subject blindfolds himself.

The most probable explanation of the maintenance of the habit seems to be the pleasurable sedative influence of tobacco experienced by habitual smokers, the sense of mild intoxication that over-comes nervous irritability, and the feeling of well being and contentment.

Chemical composition of tobacco smoke.—Tobacco smoke is a very complex mixture; it contains among other things:—

Carbon monoxide.

Prussic acid.

Ammonia.

Nicotine. .57%

Tar.

Pyrocin and its derivatives.

Resinous compounds.

There is a retention of about 66% in 'puffing' and 88% in inhaling.

The action of Tobacco.—The enjoyment derived out of the use of tobacco has never been adequately explained. It has not yet been proved that nicotine is responsible for the pleasurable effects experienced by the habitual smoker. The vomiting, giddiness, faintness, and other unpleasant sensations experienced as a result of the inhalation of the concentrated fumes in an individual unaccustomed to tobacco, are in all probability reflex phenomena and are the result of irritation of the bronchial and laryngeal mucosa, and perhaps of gastric irritation too because the novice, in addition to inhaling the fumes, swallows a good deal as well. The effects could not possibly be due to the absorption of noxious substances in tobacco smoke because the effects are almost instantaneous; but at the same time they might be due to the action of nicotine on the ganglia of the gastrointestinal musculature.

With the habitual smoker the picture is a very different one. The first few inhalations of the first cigarette of the day, especially if postponed until three or four hours have elapsed since awakening from sleep, induce a pleasurable sense of intoxication. A certain definite interval elapses before this sense of intoxication is experienced and it

seems indisputable that some substance or substances, which are constituents of tobacco smoke, are absorbed, conveyed to the brain via the blood stream and affect the former in some obscure way. The initial sensation is one of exhilaration, followed by a care free lethargy and a feeling of peace and contentment, and a desire for complete relaxation. Only the action of a drug or a drug like substance would transform a normally energetic individual into the laziest of men. Moreover the sensation of exhilaration and well being is very similar to that experienced as a result of the inhalation of fumes of 'cannabis indica' though with this latter drug the effects are far more pronounced, the duration of the sensations just described seldom exceeds twenty seconds, and cannot be elicited again, until a lapse of about fifteen hours has been permitted, since the previous cigarette was smoked. This latter period therefore seems to indicate the time taken for the intoxicating substances to be eliminated from the brain.

It has been suggested that smoking gives repose and thereby facilitates intellectual work because repose aids coherence of thought, but this effect is denied by quite a few habitual smokers. Other people describe a constant stimulation of mental activities which greatly increases mental acuteness but this too is uncertain.

The action of tobacco depends largely upon

- (1) the constitution of the smoker,
- (2) his habituation to the drug.
- (3) the circumstances under which he smokes.

Whether or not the action of tobacco is the action of its contained nicotine is still a disputed fact. Nevertheless it is known that a very small amount of nicotine, *e. g.*, that contained in a single cigarette, has a

definitely stimulating effect on the mental and bodily powers. In larger amount the action is a depressant and narcotic one, which in habitual smokers is modified to a sedative effect upon the central nervous system without much depression of the heart.

The most suitable time for smoking is generally admitted to be after meals, and especially in the evening after a day's work, when the sedative action is most beneficial to the nervous system.

Susceptibility to the action of tobacco is very different in different people. In some, and particularly in young persons, very small quantities suffice to cause depression and irritability of the nervous system, the heart, and the digestive organs; while others, specially those who lead an open-air life, are not in the least affected by very large amounts.

Continued and excessive smoking are definitely harmful. The pipe, cigar, and cigarette in this order are methods of smoking by which increasing amounts of nicotine are taken into the system from a given weight of tobacco. As a cigar or cigarette is smoked, the nicotine and other volatile products retreat before the heat, so that the stump or butt becomes very highly charged with them and is therefore the most active part of the cigar. Excessive smoking is most harmful in young people. A healthy full grown man should not consume more than four ounces per week. Symptoms of excessive smoking include palpitation and cardiac irregularity, giddiness, and a tendency to syncope ("Tobacco Heart"). Other symptoms are fatigue on slight exertion, dyspepsia, and dimness of vision. Ocular derangements are particularly liable to occur when excessive smoking is associated with excessive indulgence in alcohol. So called, "Tobacco Amblyopia" is the commonest eye symptom. Tobacco heart and tobacco Amblyopia how-

ever are really not so common as people are apt to make out. What is a very much commoner result of tobacco over-indulgence is what is known as "Smoker's throat" or "Smoker's cough", which is a chronic laryngitis associated with distressing cough and aphonia; this is obviously due, not to a specific action of nicotine, but to the constant application of an irritant alkaline vapour to the throat. It is particularly liable to occur when the brand of cigarette smoked is suddenly changed, but on the whole seems to be more common in pipe smokers than in cigarette smokers. "Smoker's cancer" is another sequel to excessive smoking and was by no means uncommon in olden days when men were in the habit of using clay pipes. A similar chronic irritant of the tongue, which however very rarely develops into cancer, is fairly common among both pipe and cigar smokers nowadays.

Diabetics and pellagrous subjects are believed to be unduly susceptible to the ill effects of over indulgence in tobacco, an increased liability to Vincents' Angina is also believed to be the result of over indulgence.

To set a common standard we may take four ounces as the maximum permissible tobacco consumption per week for the normal healthy adult. Nevertheless it is a well known fact that certain individuals are capable of consuming quantities greatly in excess of this, for long periods, without much apparent harm to themselves. For instance it was recently reported that a certain officer in the British army was in the habit of smoking no less than one hundred and thirty cigars per day for years. An equally astonishing story is one of a woman who smokes a hundred and twenty cigarettes a day.* How on earth these people ever find time to eat or think or sleep is a mystery; perhaps they smoke even in their sleep! when one recollects that the average time taken to smoke a single cigarette is about six minutes, it hardly seems possible that these extraordinary people can consume so much tobacco within the short space of time between waking and sleeping. these performances, if authentic, may obviously be accepted as records in the smoking world!

Withdrawal symptoms. — When a 'seasoned' smoker endeavours to rid himself

of the habit suddenly, various symptoms, which depend to a large extent upon the constitution of the smoker and his habituation to tobacco, manifest themselves. These symptoms range from a slight restlessness or irritability on the one hand to severe muscular twitchings and nervous derangements on the other. The most constant withdrawal symptoms appear to be:—

- (1) Insomnia.
- (2) Indigestion.
- (3) Irritability.
- (4) Restlessness.

The more serious symptoms are exceedingly rare. They include:—

- (1) Dyspnoea.
- (2) Involuntary movements of the tongue, lips, and cheeks-tremors and slight twitchings.
- (3) Twitching of the muscles in the right arm.
- (4) Giddiness and syncope.

While remembering that allowances must be made for the peculiarities of the individual yet it may be taken as the general rule that smokers below the age of forty are hardly if at all affected by sudden stoppage. It is in older men and especially those of neurotic temperament, in whom great care must be exercised in the breaking off of the habit. Moreover this should not be attempted while the subject is under any kind of nervous strain such as anxiety or worry or over-work. It should be done very gradually and over a very protracted period of time, depending upon the response of the individual, months if necessary. At first sight it would appear that such assiduous supervision is quite unnecessary owing to the rarity of alarming symptoms, but on the other hand it must be remembered that a good deal of domestic friction is liable to arise when the man of the house is restless and illtempered, and the avoidance of this is of course very desirable.

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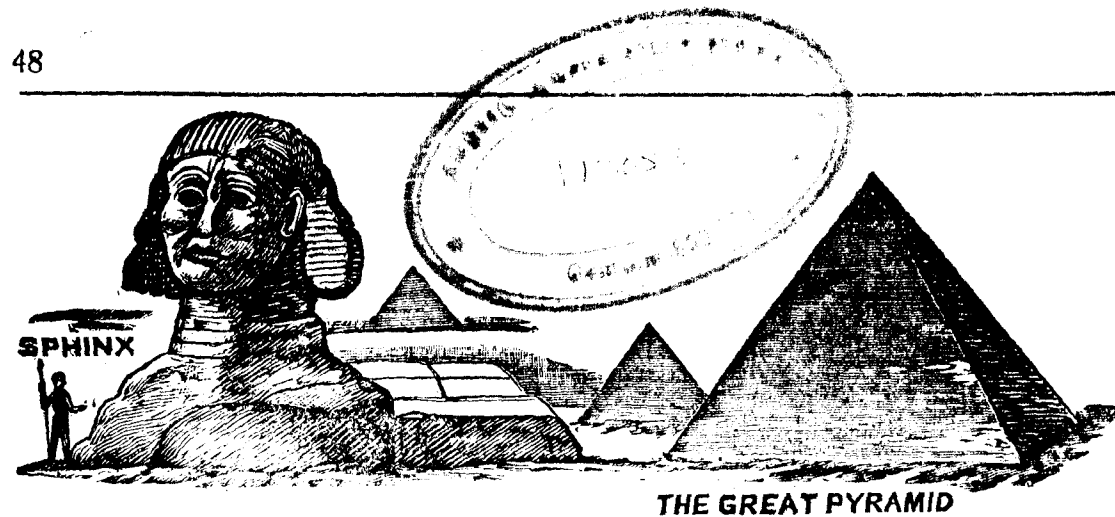
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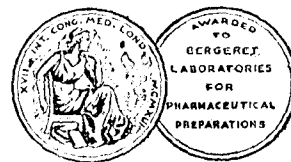
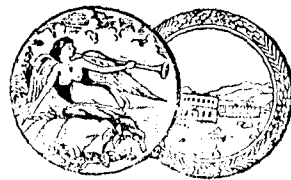
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
