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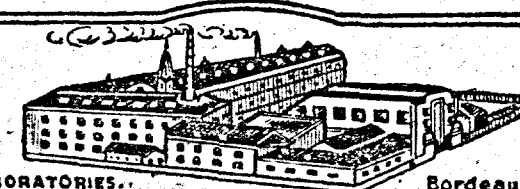

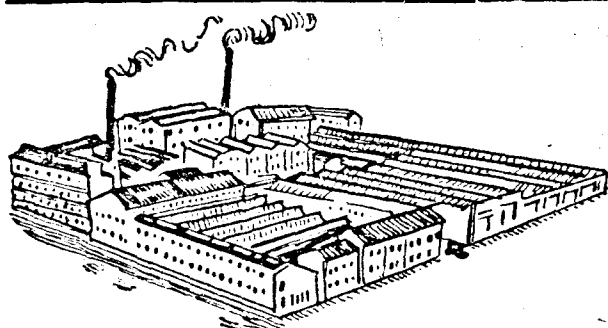
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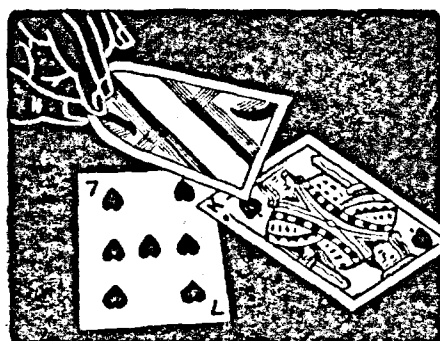

THE GENIUS OF SAMUEL MORSE

WHEN the United States declared war on England in 1812, Congress had no way of knowing that two days earlier Parliament had taken conciliatory steps that might well have averted war. A 21-year-old American painter who had recently arrived in London was deeply impressed by this tragedy. He wrote to his family in Boston lamenting that it was impossible to communicate news "in an instant" across the Atlantic. For centuries men had had this dream of messages swift as thought, but it remained for the young American, Samuel Finley Breese Morse, to do something practical about it.

That Morse was primarily an artist—and a very fine one—has been obscured by his more spectacular achievements. Yet Morse himself regarded painting as his career, and with reason. He became internationally famous at 22, when one of his pictures placed among the first nine out of 2000 exhibited at the Royal Academy in London. He was one of the founders of the National Academy of Design, and served as its president for nearly two decades. In 1932, 60 years after his death, the Metropolitan Museum in New York honored his memory with a one-man exhibit of his work.

Morse was born in 1791. His father, Pastor Jedidiah Morse, was a friend of Presidents Washington and Adams. He

was also the author of *The American Universal Geography* and *The American Gazetteer*, two books which made the family name famous and provided money to send Samuel and his two brothers to college. Samuel wrote home from Yale University that he enjoyed all his studies, "especially Mr. Day's lectures on electricity," and he announced that he was spending all his spare time painting miniatures of his friends on ivory at five dollars apiece. The study of electricity was his chief hobby, and he constantly sought out scientists who were experimenting with the new fluid."

At first his parents were opposed to his making a career of painting, but when at 19 his work won the praise of the famous Gilbert Stuart, they let him study art in England. For a time after his return to America in 1815, Morse made a good living painting portraits. His finest, a portrait of his friend Lafayette, now hangs in the New York city hall. But in a few years his market almost disappeared during an economic-depression.

In October 1832 Morset was returning from a second visit to Europe. One night shipboard conversation turned to electricity, and the other passengers were amused when Morse wondered aloud "why intelligence might not be instantaneously transmitted by electricity to any distance." The idea pos-

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essed him like a fever for the rest of the trip, and all that he had learned in the study of his hobby now suddenly bore fruit. When he landed in New York his artist's notebook contained sketches of an instrument and circuit whose basic principles have not changed to this day, and whose simplicity still excites the admiration of technical men.

But Morse was still primarily an artist. A few months earlier the newly founded New York University had appointed him Professor of Sculpture and Painting—the first professorship in the fine arts established in America. He worked nights on a model of his Telegraph (he always used the capital T) but he spent his days in a studio finishing a great canvas begun in France. This was an ambitious picture showing the exhibition gallery of the Louvre with 37 master pieces by Murillo, Van Dyck, Correggio and others on the walls. With typical American energy, civic spirit and promotional zeal, Morse planned to improve the taste of his countrymen by exhibiting his picture in all the principal cities. But audiences were so slim that before long, on the edge of bankruptcy, he was compelled to sell it.

Another disappointment shook his faith in his art even more painfully. Four panels in the rotunda of the Capitol at Washington remained to be filled and Morse applied for the privilege of painting one, but his name was passed over. Discouraged, he gave up art and

turned all his intense energy to the development of his Telegraph.

By now he was living in his studio in New York University, too poor even to pay the rent of a bedroom, cooking his own meals to save money for his experiments. He had to make every single part he used—batteries, magnets, even the insulated wire for his circuits. For the receiving instrument he used a picture frame, with parts of an old clock to draw a ribbon of paper under a pendulum to which a pencil point was attached. The pencil point clicked back and forth, making a wavy line which could be read as dots and dashes.

Only two steps remained to complete the Telegraph as we know it, and Morse himself had the genius to add both. In 1836 he hit on the idea of the relay—using the transmitted signal in one circuit to open and close contacts in a second circuit, thus giving every dot-dash message seven-league boots to stride, circuit by circuit, across continents and around the world. The final step was the Morse code, in the perfecting of which Morse was assisted by his partner, Alfred Vail.

On January 24, 1838, in his studio in the University, Morse gave the first demonstration of messages in Morse code and began getting ready to show his work to Congress in the hope of Government support. But he had acquired three partners, and now as success approached he found himself invol-

ved in the beginning of an endless parade of feuds and suits with jealous claimants. "The condition of an inventor," he wrote sadly, "is, indeed, not enviable."

Five years of frustration were to pass before Congress voted money for an experimental telegraph line, and Morse turned to a new field, this time photography. In Paris he had become friendly with Daguerre, and in April 1839 he described Daguerre's work to the American public. Morse probably built the first camera in America; and with his help Professor John W. Draper made the world's first photographic portrait on the roof above Morse's New York University studio in December 1839. By 1841 Morse and Draper had reduced exposure time from five minutes to a matter of seconds, and Morse was conducting enthusiastic classes in the new art.

At last in 1843 Congress appropriated \$30,000 for the building of the first telegraph line—though many of the law-

makers considered the bill so silly that they tried to tack on an amendment diverting part of the money to the support of mesmerism. Morse, appointed Superintendent of U. S. Telegraphs, began to construct a 40 mile line from Washington to Baltimore. The first plan was to run the wires underground in lead pipe, and Ezra Cornell, who later founded Cornell University, invented an ingenious plow which in one operation trenched, laid and covered the cable. But when \$23,000 had been spent, Morse discovered that his wires could not be properly insulated for underground use. Anxiously he called Cornell into conference. They must stop the trenching, but if the public learned the truth before the problem was solved there would be a scandal. Cornell's Yankee ingenuity was equal to the crisis. He walked back to the plow, whipped up the eight yoke of oxen—and drove his beloved, machine into a boul-

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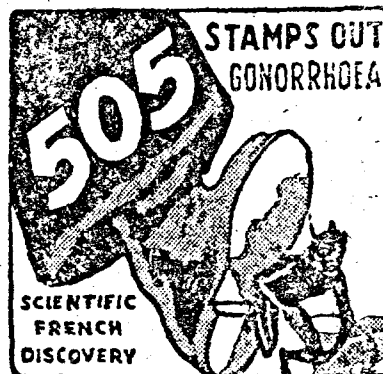
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der, shattering it. The "accident" gave Morse an excuse to string the wires from poles.

In May 1844 the first line was completed and the famous message, "What hath God wrought," was sent to Vail in Baltimore during a ceremony in the Supreme Court chambers. The first use of the American device was to provide Washington with a blow-by-blow description of the Democratic convention in Baltimore, and when the delegates arose to shout, "Three cheers for James K. Polk, and three cheers for the Telegraph," its national reputation was made.

Morse wanted the Government to take the new invention and operate it, but Congress refused, and development of the Telegraph was left to private initiative. By 1846 a New York editorial writer could say proudly, "While England by her government has got with great labor 175 miles of telegraph into operation, the United States with her individual enterprise has now in successful operation 1269 miles."

As early as 1842 Morse had envisioned an Atlantic cable. Indeed, his own first experimental line was a submarine cable between the Battery and Governors Island in New York Bay. He himself laid it from a rowboat. There was to be a great ceremony at its opening,

and at daybreak Morse was down at the water front making sure all was ready. Suddenly looking out across the bay he saw the skipper of a fishing smack haul up the cable on his anchor, shake it angrily, and chop it off to let the severed ends drop. The ceremony that afternoon turned into a public jeering. For many years the scheme was derided, but finally Cyrus Field organized a group of financiers to underwrite the ambitious Atlantic project, and after three failures a successful cable was laid in 1866. Morse was for a time associated with the Field enterprise.

His tremendous energy carried him into politics and made him a vigorous participant in every national fight—almost always on the losing side. He was stubbornly opposed to the Civil War, and at the age of 73 he campaigned furiously against Lincoln's re-election.

Morse died in 1872 within a few days of his 81st birthday, grieving that his genius as a painter was not appreciated. The specific inventions for which Europe and America showered honors and wealth on him have been superseded by later devices. But his paintings grow more valuable every year and he is now ranked as one of the world's great portraitists. Nothing could have pleased him more.

INVENTORS WITHOUT HONOUR

IN the House of Commons, some time ago the Postmaster-General was asked whether he would consider dedicating a memorial to Marconi, as the inventor of wireless, at Penarth where the first transmission was made in Britain. The reply was that Marconi's wireless transmission was not the first at Penarth, for in 1892 Sir William Preece, Engineer-in-Chief of the Post Office, transmitted wireless messages between Penarth and Flat Holme.

If there is any memorial at Penarth, it seems it should be to Sir William Preece. Yet it is certain that ninety-nine people out of a hundred asked "Who invented wireless telegraphy?" would reply: "Marconi," and it is doubtful if the other one would mention Sir William Preece or the experiments of Heriz.

The plain fact, as with other important inventions, is that wireless telegraphy was "invented" by a number of different

men, each of whom contributed something vital, but for various reasons one name caught the public attention and its owner received all the honours.

Fifty years hence it is probable that one man will be known as the 'inventor' of radar and that the majority of the scientists who contributed will be forgotten. When we talk about the inventor of this or that, we should consider whether we mean the man who conceived the original idea, the man who built the first practicable apparatus incorporating it or perhaps someone who contributed a vital improvement.

RADIO AND RADAR

No one speaks of Sir Ambrose Fleming as the 'inventor' of broad-casting. But his invention in 1904 of the thermionic valve in which electrons are generated by a heated electrode paved the way to broad-casting. The invention of the magnetron by Professor J. T. Randall in 1940 was as important to radar as Fleming's valve to radio. The magnetron made possible the generation of the powerful pulses that are the secret of the radar devices which revealed the targets to our bombers and now enable merchant shipping to move in narrow waters in fog.

Inventions do not appear fully fledged from nothing, but are the result of continuity of thought and experiment, in some cases extending over a hundred years and involving scores of notable names. The 'background' to the invention of wireless was provided by the discoveries of men famous in the history of electricity, like Ampere, Faraday and Lord Kelvin—men whose names are commemorated in the very terms we use to define a current, instruments for computing its value and the very principles of magneto-electricity itself.

Clerk Maxwell discovered other waves 'mathematically' thirty years before Marconi, and Heriz in 1888 was the first man to send wireless signals. Professor Branly in France invented an improved coherer, by which feeble electric currents could be detected, and Sir Oliver Lodge and

Lord Rutherford devised improved methods of tuning when they investigated the whole subject of resonance and oscillation. Marconi was a man of genius who commercialised what was already invented.

There were many other inventors whose names today are quite unknown. In the eighties, for instance, Professor David Hughes constructed a wireless set—largely, it is said, out of his wife's work-basket—with which he successfully transmitted and received signals from his home in London. And there was the even more astonishing case of J. B. Lindsay, who 'wirelessly' in Dundee in 1853. A Dundee newspaper report of the demonstration said: "The experiment removes all doubt about the practicability of telegraphic communication without wires." But who remembers Lindsay?

Take another invention which has become a great industry with an annual 'turnover' of a hundred millions in Britain alone—the cinema. Recently we honoured the names of the Lumiere brothers on the occasion of the fiftieth anniversary of their famous show at the Polytechnic, when the 'cinema' was shown in public for the first time in Great Britain. But did the Lumiere brothers 'invent' the cinema? They certainly invented the name—their machine was called the cinematographe. But at least a dozen other men also 'invented' the cinema. The Americans have no doubt Edison was the inventor—he carried on law suits for ten years over the patents. There is no doubt that Friese-Greene preceded both Edison and the Lumieres, and Le Prince, the Frenchman who lived in Leeds, was even earlier.

CINEMAS OF THE PAST

But we can go even further back and find that round about 1850 Ducos du Hauron in France made a complete anticipation of motion pictures in a patent application and Heyl in Philadelphia built a motion picture machine which embodied the principle of the blackout between each picture when the next picture is

being moved into position, a principle which had to be 're-discovered' a quarter of a century later. The whirling praxinoscope also contributed and its inventor is reported to have lived nearly two hundred years ago!

In this apparatus, very popular about forty years ago, a wheel carries under its rim a series of pictures each showing a

further stage of movement. A slot is opened and covered alternately so that the eye does not see the pictures until each section is in place opposite the slot. Indeed, it might be said that in his work on optics Ptolemy in A.D. 130 very definitely suggests the possibility of continuing pictures in such a way as to suggest motion.

THE SCOURGE OF SYPHILIS AND GONORRHEA AND THE CURE.

Britain's figures of venereal disease have risen since the War. In 1940 the increase was 23 per cent over 1939. Proportionately this is better than the situation in World War 1, when the V. D. rate doubled, but it is no occasion for complacency.

Treatment was woefully inadequate between 1914 and 1918.

The short courses of treatment then in use were responsible for tragic developments a generation later. If left untreated, syphilis has a tendency to clear up. This is disastrously deceptive. The disease may lie dormant for years, then suddenly break out again.

Syphilis is not a new disease. It has been treated a thousand different ways since 1493, when Dr. Diaz de Isla climbed aboard Columbus's ships at Palos to treat sailors loathsomely sick of the malady they had brought back from the West Indies.

Such things as China root and sarsaparilla have had their day, to say nothing of a medley of things like powdered serpents and even toad's spittle. It was not until March 1905, that science began to get at grips with syphilis.

In that year a bushy-bearded German named Fritz Schaudinn was ordered by Berlin's Imperial Health Office to make laboratory tests of a germ which was suspected of causing not only small pox, but the great pox. He got positive results, named the germ "the pale horror" because it could scarcely be seen, even under a microscope.

Another discovery in 1907 brought August von Wassermann's fixation test, which to this day is the doctor's quickest, most practical test for the disease: Three

years later Paul Ehrlich made the discovery which beat syphilis down from astronomical figures to something within reasonable understanding. This was "606"—salvarsan.

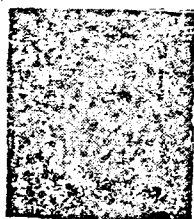

SPOTLIGHT ON THE REDHEADS

YOU know how it is with red heads. They know what they want and almost always get it. Redheaded persons have strong personalities. They are impulsive, intelligent, aggressive, imaginative and temperamental to a degree. Sometimes they lack discretion but never courage. And now, at long last, science has discovered what makes redheads redheads.

It's (C₁₅ H₂₀ N₂ O₉) 2 Fe₂. Which, translated, is trichosiderin, an organic compound of iron. The redness of human hair, if it is not dyed is proportional to the amount of trichosiderin it contains. And, researchers emphasise, the newlyfound compound, contained only in red human hair, is responsible for degree of colour alone.

Two scientists from the University of Chicago's Department of Medicine—Dr. Peter Flesch and Dr. Stephen Rothman—made the discovery of trichosiderin after extensive on virtually every shade of red hair. Just the other day they demonstrated their findings at the National Chemical Exposition, held in conjunction with a meeting of the American Chemical Society in Chicago.

While the new discovery scarcely can be termed earth shaking, it is a fact that the quest for a scientific explanation of red hair has been going on for centuries. In view of the evidence that history teems with such Titainhaired as George Washington, Napoleon Bonaparte, William Shakespeare, Thomas Jefferson, Andrew Jackson, Lord Nelson and Cleopatra, there has been ages-old conjecture as to why red-heads are redheaded. The Egyptians believed that a man or woman with red hair had been marked for distinction by the sun god. Roman philosophers in the time of Nero advanced the theory that red hair was an indisputable mark of mental brilliance.

A few years ago a chemist named Arnold reported on acid-soluble pigment which he had obtained from human hair by boiling it for some days in hydrochloric acid. His conclusion was that the pigment probably was an oxidation of melanin, the brown-black pigment which gives color to all hair.

Now, Dr. Flesch and Dr. Pothman declare that the iron-containing trichosiderin definitely is distinct from melanin. They point out that, whereas melanin is to be found in the hair of every human, trichosiderin is peculiar only to redhead.

The scientists found it no easy task procuring enough genuine red hair for their experiments, which were begun in 1939 and interrupted by Dr. Flesch's service in the Army during the war. They had the co-operation of the United Master Barbers of Illinois, as well as that of the Journeymen Barbers, Hairdressers and Cosmetologists' International Union of America, which meant that barbers and operators of beauty shops from Maine to California carefully swept up clippings of red hair and forwarded them to Chicago.

The researchers found that the average single hair-cut yielded 6 to 7 grams of hair. This in turn yielded 2 to 3 grams of trichosiderin if the hair was a brilliant red, considerably less as the brilliance diminished.

Altogether, Dr. Flesch and Dr. Rothman collected 2½ pounds of red hair of varying hues for their experiments. At first they were careful to keep individual cuttings separate; then, finding that the same red pigment appeared in varying amounts in all red hair, they pooled the lot and worked with samples of from 10 to 175 grams at a time.

It was found that 100 grams of Titian-red hair yielded from 40 to 60 milligrams of dry pigment. The yield from other shades was dependent upon the intensity of their reddish hues. To make certain of the validity of the experiments, the researchers carefully checked each individual shipment of hair against known naturally-red locks, since hair that has received a henna treatment contains no more trichosiderin than the stuffings of your sofa.

Not only did Dr. Flesch and Dr. Rothman subject human red hair to the scientific eye, but also they tested various animals with red coats. Hair from a horse, a dog, a cat, a rabbit and a fox were checked, but none of the sought-for pigment was found.

Last year, the experimenters evolved a definite technique for extracting trichosiderin from hair. First the hair is soaked in chloroform for 12 to 24 hours. After it has dried in the air, it is immersed in acetone for two hours, then in glacial acetic acid for 16 hours, then boiled in hydrochloric acid for 2 hours.

The pigment appears to be deposited in the central part of each hair as tiny granules which normally are invisible under the microscope, but which can be shown to exist. Paradoxically, it contributes little to the actual color of the hair. But, without it, there wouldn't be a natural redhead in existence. And, according to Dr. Flesch and Dr. Rothman, discovery of the iron pigment found only in red hair may lead to a new approach to the study of genetics.

Not so many years ago "Gentlemen Preferred Blondes." Now they clamor for redheads, according to Walter Thornton, who directs a large agency for photographers' models. With the development of color photography and technicolor films, flaming red hair and pale skin give greater contrast and more artistic photographs than either blonde or brunette.

"But preserve me from synthetic red-heads!" Thornton exclaims. "I can tell them at a glance because they lack the pep, personality and glamor of the natural sorrel-top. You can dye the hair—but not the soul."

Lee Bostock, a famous model, who doubles as a New York advertising agency junior executive, has hair the color of a Turner sunset. Miss Bostock, educated at Boston University, says she would not want it otherwise.

"It's terrific fun, being a redhead," she declares. "But it's not the simplest thing in the world. It's much more complex than being either a brunette or a blonde. Of course, I mean of natural red hair."

The redhead is an individualist. Regardless of the current color trends, she follows her own color scheme, both in make-up and clothes, which she has developed by the trial-and-error method. Somebody once said that a redhaired girl always seemed to be walking in the sunlight. That's like always being in the spotlight.

spite the cold weather—for it was now December—a large crowd had followed the hearse each time.

The doctor cleared his throat importantly and told the stranger the sad story. Clearly, space in the little burial ground of Cagnac must have been getting crowded, but evidently a solution must have been found, for the funerals continued in a steady stream throughout February and early March. They were always held in the late afternoon, when the shadows began to deepen. Larger and larger grew the crowds that saw the good countrymen of Cagnac to their last resting-place. Yet the mourners now seemed to bear their grief with singular self-control. One seldom saw anybody weep, though they were all serious enough in mien.

These were hasty and rather ghastly funerals that took place there in the little graveyard of the village. Frequently they lasted till almost midnight, as in times of plague, or like the funerals of miners in some countries. Strangely enough, few of the mourners left the cemetery by the main gate after the sad ceremonies were over. They just seemed to fade away into the shadows. The priest would get home worn out and pale, a gruesome and diabolical grin on his plump face which, thank the Lord, no one could see. Strangers

could find no explanation for these things.

But for the indiscretion of still another travelling salesman—salad oil from pulverized whalebone (made in Germany)—the dead might have continued on their wellbeaten course in Cagnac. On March 20, however, a small provincial paper printed a brief story about the mysterious plague that had afflicted the village. The Paris press (made in Germany) picked up the story, and one editorial characterized the epidemic as a scandal.

Many more virtuous women and law-abiding men had been put to rest in the Cagnac graveyard, escorted by crowds of mourners, when one day in April a venerable, old professor from the Sorbonne arrived in Cagnac on a mission of inquiry, putting up for a single night in the only available guest-room over the little bistro—a room he shared with seven spiders and two hundred and twenty-three cockroaches.

The professor arrived on a Wednesday evening by the 7.10 train from Paris. Later that night he was seen successively in earnest conversation, first with the towering mayor, next with the cure, and finally with the sexton. The next morning, when he hurried from the bistro to catch the 8.28 back to Paris, he was accompanied to the little railway station by the whole village, including old men, children, and even the village idiot, for some mysterious reason called Jacques the Soap Eater.

The little train arrived shrilling its whistle, and the famous professor smilingly waved his umbrella from the window.

Everyone cheered, Jacques the Soap Eater tossed his old felt hat in the air, and the train disappeared around a bend...

Three days later, on Saturday—there had been four more funerals in Cagnac in the meantime—the old professor forwarded a document to the German Occupation Authorities. "A Report on the Plague Now Raging in the Village of Cagnac," ran the title. It was a long statement, but its chief findings were as follows:

The inquiry extended over a period of more than one week, during which more than two hundred (200) patients and other individuals were examined.

The results point unquestionably to an outbreak of a very rare epidemic disease of a highly contagious character, which I would identify as a curious compound of *Cemeteria eterna* major and *Fraudulozia perniciosus*. Since medical science knows very little about this plague (which, however, seems to have become much more widespread since the war), I have been unable to do more than dispatch to Cagnac a large quantity of medicaments that seem indicated.

In brief, I prescribed that injections should be administered consisting of trimethylaminopyrazolonesulfate, combined with 4' diaminosulfoazobenzol and metanyturecophysostygmimobenzol ester. Of course, I also suggested the use of lozenges of trickogene, the well-known salt of 2' salicylate of stygmobenzodythylmalanytureon.

I am convinced that this simple treatment will succeed in the swift arrest of

At the very hour the venerable professor was dispatching his report, the hulking Mayor of Cagnac, M. Augustin Bernes, was sitting at his desk over an ancient ledger, drawing up a balance-sheet. He wrote:

SNAKES FOR HEALTH

Strangest of all military units among the Allied forces is the South African Medical Corps' Snake Catching Unit, which hunts in the kloof, the thick bush country and along the steamy river banks of the Eastern Transvaal near the Portuguese East African Border.

Three men total the force of this strange unit which hunts down and captures deadly snakes and vipers and brings them back alive to the snake farm at their headquarters in an abandoned jail. For the venom removed from these reptiles is used in the manufacture of antivenom snakebite serum.

All three men are experts at their job of catching and "milking" snakes, and those for which they search the most are the "yellow cobra" and the puff adder. For it is these most deadly of reptiles that yield the most valuable venom.

When the two corporals and one private comprising the unit have extracted, weighed and dried the venom they send it to the S. A. Institute for Medical Research, where the next steps are carried out under the supervision of Dr. E. Grasset, a pioneer of snakebite antidote in the first experiments at Pondicherry.

Selected horses are injected with a mixture of the two venoms—nerve poison and blood poison—in gradually increasing doses over a period of about seven months. Then the horses' blood is drawn off and scientifically centrifugated—that is, spun round at high speed.

That vital serum separates off and is carefully withdrawn from the solution and is then ready to go into hypodermic syringe outfits. These have helped to save many lives and are the answer to the Nazi seizure of the Pasteur Institute in Paris.

It is not only for the treatment of snakebites that the venom of snakes is prepared in the Komatipoort laboratories. For example, the crystals of the puff adder's

dried venom find their way to the ends of the earth since they prove to be a very potent coagulant for the blood of haemophiliacs.

These unfortunate sufferers are afflicted with a dread bleeding disease that will not react to ordinary treatment. But now dried snake venom is saving many sufferers.

All the members of the unit are real experts and they handle deadly snakes with a confidence that is never at fault. They seriously affirm that if one is gentle and shows no fear, snakes are safe to handle and will never attack the human being who picks them up from the ground.

Certainly, they hunt their prey with nothing more formidable than an ordinary stick, and pick up the snakes with a sure grasp. But much practice has made them perfect, but theirs is not a practice that is likely to become generally popular.

TRIUMPHS OF TWO LONDON DOCTORS

Saved More Lives in Armies Than Anyone Else.

London, July 5: Lord Moran said last night that two doctors of St Mary's Hospital, London, had saved more lives in armies in the field than anyone else in the world—Almroth Wright, by his typhoid inoculations, and Prof. Fleming by the discovery of penicillin.

"I was called," he said, "to see a certain man, a great public figure, who was suffering from a form of meningitis from which in the past no one had ever recovered. We put penicillin into his brain and from that moment he never looked back. He is fit for work now and as good as ever."

Lord Moran was apparently referring to Lord Norman, former Governor of the Bank of England.

THE SCOURGE OF SYPHILIS AND GONORRHEA AND THE CURE.

From the Lancet. June 11, 1942.

Britain's figures of venereal disease have risen since the War. In 1940 the increase was 23 per cent over 1939. Proportionately this is better than the situation in World War I, when the V. D. rate doubled, but it is no occasion for complacency.

Treatment was woefully inadequate between 1914 and 1918.

The short courses of treatment then in use were responsible for tragic developments a generation later. If left untreated, syphilis has a tendency to clear up. This is disastrously deceptive. The disease may lie dormant for years, then suddenly break out again.

Syphilis is not a new disease. It has been treated a thousand different ways since 1493, when Dr. Diaz de Isla climbed aboard Columbus's ships at Palos to treat sailors loathsome sick of the malady they had brought back from the West Indies.

DISCOVERY OF NEW CHOLERA VACCINE

Provides Immunity With One Dose

Conclusive Tests to be Made in India

New York. June 23: An important new medical discovery, a direct cholera vaccine which provides immunity with one dose instead of the normal 3 doses will very soon get its first conclusive practical test in areas of India recently affected by famine, it is disclosed here. Mr J Edgar Rhoads, President of the newly formed American Relief for India. Inc., announced that his organisation was rushing out supplies of the new medicine to American Quaker relief workers in Bengal, where a cholera epidemic is reported to be claiming 100 lives weekly.

Six teams, capable of inoculating thousands of persons daily, will dispense the vaccine, which is expected to prove superior in

strength, as well as in other qualities, to other methods. Materials for its manufacture are said to be available almost anywhere, and it is also reported to be possible to manufacture it quickly, at the scene of the epidemic, without the skill of technicians—a fact which it is hoped, will permit of the inoculation of the entire area affected, especially the environs of Calcutta.

Dr Robert K. Jennings, of the Biochemical Research Foundation, of the Franklin Institute, Philadelphia, and the discoverer of the vaccine, is awaiting news from India; that he may leave immediately to help to develop the vaccine's use, as so far only laboratory tests have been made, and India is expected to prove whether such tests stand up in practice.
