With this number out, the "Tobacco Bulletin" will have completed its third year of service to the public. In this an attempt is made to give a picture of Indian Tobacco situation through recent years. Summary tables have been provided, wherever available, to make the retrospective survey effective. In addition, a brief note on the tobacco production and trade in some of the leading tobacco producing countries of the world, such as the U.S.A., Southern Rhodesia, Turkey, Greece, Italy, Canada, Philippines, Nyasaland, Yugoslavia and Western Germany, has been included in this issue. The whole hearted co-operation extended both by Government and non-government organisations in furnishing to the Committee information on various aspects of tobacco has made the Bulletin exceedingly useful and popular. The Committee is deeply indebted to them.

India is one of the major tobacco producing countries of the world being the third after the U.S.A. and China. The trend in acreage of tobacco in India during 1940 (excluding Pakistan)

to 1952 underwent great fluctuations rising to a peak level of 1,621,000 acres in 1946 and falling to 712,000 acres in 1952. The corresponding trend in production indicates a peak level at 797,440,000 lbs. in 1941 and a minimum level at 459,200,000 lbs. in 1952.

Andhra State accounts for 251,000 acres under tobacco producing to the extent of 164 million lbs. representing about 33% of the total tobacco production in India. Bombay State accounts for 218,000 acres producing about 117 million lbs. representing about 25% of the total production; Uttar Pradesh accounts for 58,000 acres producing about 40 million lbs. and the Residuary Madras State accounts for 49,000 acres producing about 48 million lbs. annually.

During the fiscal year 1952-53 about 522.5 million lbs. of tobacco were cleared for home consumption compared to 508.4 million lbs. and 490.6 million lbs. during 1951-52 and 1950-51 respectively. Over 35% of the total quantity cleared for home consumption was

shared by Madras and Andhra States; 16% by Uttar Pradesh and 14% by Bombay. None of the remaining states in the Union accounted for more than 10% of the total.

The system of tobacco sales by auction was first started in India on the 24th of January 1951 at the Market Yard of the Guntur Tobacco Market Committee. The Scheme was later extended to two other places in Guntur Dist. viz., Mangalagiri and Tadikonda in 1952 and 1953 respectively. At Guntur market yard about 2.4 million lbs. worth Rs. 10 lakhs and 5.2 million lbs. worth Rs. 34 lakhs were disposed of by auction and private negotiation respectively in 1951 season, compared to 2.5 million lbs. worth Rs. 11 lakhs and 4.8 million lbs. worth Rs. 34 lakhs in 1952 season and 4.5 million lbs. worth Rs. 17.5 lakhs and 6.8 million lbs. worth Rs. 32 lakhs in 1953 season. At Mangalagiri Market Yard about 6.9 million lbs. valued at Rs. 2.5 lakhs and 2.2 million lbs. valued at Rs. 18.7 lakhs were disposed of by auction and private negotiation respectively in 1952 season compared to 1 million lbs. valued at Rs. 2.6 lakhs and 1.9 million lbs. valued at Rs. 12.8 lakhs in 1953 season. At Tadikonda market yard the corresponding figures for the 1953 season sales were 15 thousand lbs. valued at Rs. 17 thousand and 2.6 million lbs. valued at Rs. 12 lakhs.

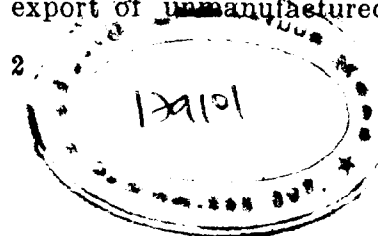
With a view to creating demand for Indian tobacco in foreign markets on specified standards the Government of India in June 1945 prohibited the export of ~~un~~manufactured tobacco of

four types viz., F.C.V., S.C.V., S.C.C. and Motihari, unless these were graded and marked in accordance with the Tobacco Grading and Marking Rules 1937 and was certified to that effect by the Agricultural Marketing Adviser to the Government of India or an officer authorised by him for the purpose. Subsequently these rules were enlarged to cover other types of tobacco also viz., Sun-Cured Jutty, Jati Bishpath and Jati tobacco grown in Bengal, White Burley and Top leaf and chewing tobacco grown in Bihar. The grading statistics indicate that about 97 million lbs. of tobacco valued at Rs. 12 crores were graded and marked for exports during 1952-53 season compared to 116.7 million lbs. worth Rs. 14.3 crores and 88.9 million lbs. worth Rs. 11.98 crores respectively in 1951-52 and 1950-51.

Exports of Indian tobacco (by sea and air) during 1952-53 was 81 million lbs. The most important outlet for Indian Flue-cured Virginia tobacco is the U. K. which purchased about 33.5 million lbs. worth Rs. 7 crores in 1952-53. Japan ranked next taking 14 million lbs. valued at Rs. 1.8 crores. Pakistan third and the U. S. S. R. the fourth purchasing about 2.7 million lbs. worth Rs. 62 lakhs and 3.6 million lbs. valued at Rs. 23 lakhs respectively. Other important markets for Indian tobacco are Aden and Dependencies, Belgium, Egypt, Hongkong, Netherlands, Republic of Indonesia and Sweden.

Imports of tobacco into India during the past five years indicate a

steadily decreasing trend. The peak volume reached in 1945-46 at 15.1 million lbs. valued at Rs. 3.9 crores. The main sources of tobacco imports are the U. S. A., Burma, Ceylon, U. K., Pakistan and Java. Total imports in 1952-53 amounted to 4.2 million lbs. valued at Rs. 1.5 crore.

According to London Reports about 280 million lbs. valued at Rs. 93 crores were imported into the U. K. during the eleven months ended November, 1953, whereas 224 million lbs. valued at Rs. 69.5 crores were imported in all of 1952 and 365 million lbs.

valued at Rs. 108 crores in all of 1951. India's share during 1953 was 28 million lbs. valued at Rs. 7 crores compared to the U.S.A.'s 154 million lbs. valued at Rs. 53 crores and Southern Rhodesia's 54 million lbs. valued at Rs. 18.6 crores.

The present rates of import duty charged on all forms of tobacco imported into India and the Excise duty levied on different types of manufactured and unmanufactured tobacco are also included in this number for the benefit of our readers.

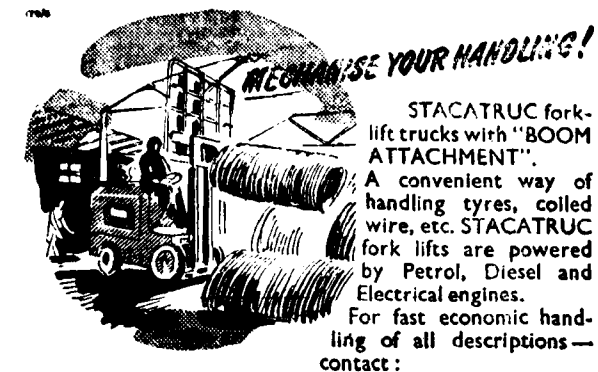

IMPORT DUTY.

Import duty is charged on all forms of tobacco imported into India. The present rates of duty are given below :—

Type.		Rate of duty.
1. Tobacco unmanufactured	..	Rs. 9-13-6 per lb. (standard rate as well as preferential rate).
2. Tobacco Manufactured not otherwise specified	..	Rs. 17-1-0 per lb.
3. Cigarettes	..	37½% ad valorem + Rs. 39-1-0 per 1000 or Rs. 15-10-0 per lb. whichever is higher + 5% of the total duty.
4. Cigars	..	37½% ad valorem + Rs. 15-10-0 per lb. + 5% of the total duty.

The Government of India have recently revised the Indo-Ceylon Trade Agreement by allowing to import annually a quota of 1.5 million lbs. for the next four years ending 1956-57. According to the present agreement it has been decided that the import of Jaffna tobacco into Travancore-Cochin State will be permitted subject to the following conditions.

The total annual imports of Jaffna tobacco from Ceylon will be made through Allepey, port in Travancore-Cochin State. The import duty will be subjected to the under-mentioned conditions :—

Imports through other ports as well as imports in excess of the quantities specified above will be subject to the Indian tariff rate applicable for the time being to the imports of unmanufactured tobacco from other foreign countries.

EXPORT DUTY.

No export duty is charged on unmanufactured tobacco exported from India, except on manufactured cigars, which is 15% ad valorem.

A cess of ½% ad valorem is being collected on tobacco exported outside.

TOBACCO BULLETIN

"Tobacco Production and Trade in Important Tobacco Growing Countries in the World."

INTRODUCTION :

The world's tobacco production in the important tobacco growing areas is estimated at 7,196 million lbs. during 1952-53 compared with 7,371 million lbs. in 1951-52. Decrease in production is reported in North America and Europe as a result of drought conditions prevalent during the tobacco growing period. The principal type of tobacco entering world-trade is *flue-cured cigarette tobacco*, the production of which is expected to be less in 1952-53 when compared to 1951-52 owing mainly to decreased production of this type in the U. S. A. The production of Turkish-type leaf (otherwise known as oriental tobacco), another important variety entering worldtrade, is reported to be below the 1951-52 estimate, owing to decrease in its production in Turkey, Greece, Yugoslavia and Italy. World production of light air-cured types (including Burley) is also expected to be low whereas that of dark-air cured is expected to be at the level as that of the previous year.

A brief note on the statistics of tobacco production, exports, imports etc., in some of the leading tobacco growing countries of the world is given below in the order of their international importance in respect of tobacco production.

U. S. A.

The United States of America is the world's largest producer of tobacco. The different types of tobacco grown there are flue-cured, fire-cured, Burley, Maryland, dark air-cured, cigar-filler, cigar binder and cigar-wrapper. The following table gives the acreage and production during the crop years of 1949-50, 1950-51, 1951-52 and 1952-53.

American tobacco exports are mainly consigned to Germany, Netherlands, Australia, Irish Republic and Belgium. In 1952, Germany purchased 79 million lbs., against U. K.'s purchase of 54 million lbs. and Netherland's purchase of 35 million lbs. Tobacco exports during 1949 to 1952 are indicated in the following table.

United States imported unmanufactured tobacco to the tune of 103 million lbs. in 1952 as against 104.7 million lbs., 90 million lbs. and 88 million lbs. during 1951, 1950 and 1949 respectively. Cigarette leaf (oriental type) imports from Turkey, Greece, Syria and a few other countries amounted to about 76 million lbs. in 1952 compared to 51 million lbs. in 1951.

Tobacco trade in the U. S. is a free enterprise and the sales are made by four principal methods (i) the auction system (ii) country sales (iii) the hogshead market and (iv) co-operative marketing of which the sales by auction is the most prominent method. The amounts of tobacco sold by auction

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during the years 1950, 1951 and 1952 were as under.

SOUTHERN RHODESIA.

The main types of tobacco cultivated in Southern Rhodesia are flue-cured tobacco, fire-cured tobacco although small quantities of oriental type and cigar leaf tobacco are also grown. The statistics of tobacco acreage and production for the last four years are as given under.

About 95% of the home-grown tobacco are exported to the U. K., Australia, Union of South Africa and Nigeria. The following table gives the volume of tobacco exports during 1949-50 to 1952-53.

The bulk of Southern Rhodesian tobacco is sold on auction floors.

TURKEY.

The most popularly grown tobacco in Turkey is the renowned Turkish type or Oriental type of tobacco. The statistics of

tobacco acreage and production in Turkey during the years 1948-49 to 1952-53 are given below.

The most important outlets for Turkish tobacco are the U.S.A., Germany, Egypt and the U. K. The U.S.A. and Germany purchased about 51.7 million lbs. and 25.6 million lbs. respectively of Turkish tobacco in 1952 as against their purchases of 36.8 million lbs. and 44.8 million lbs. respectively in 1949. Figures of the total tobacco exports from Turkey during the last five years are given below.

GREECE.

The 1952 tobacco production in Greece was estimated at 93 million lbs. from about 189 thousand acres as against 137 million lbs. from 236 thousand acres in 1951. The decline in 1952 was due partly to the long drought and partly to the reduction of one fifth in the area under tobacco cultivation following the growers' continuous difficulties in finding adequate markets for the crop. Virginia tobacco is grown only on experimental basis. Air-cured tobacco is the important type of tobacco grown in Greece. Figures of acreage

and production for the last five years are given below.

Exports of 91 million lbs. of unmanufactured tobacco in 1952 were 21 million lbs. greater than in 1951 and for the first time since war, approached the level of the immediate pre-war years. This expansion was due mainly to larger shipments to Germany which purchased 41 million lbs. in 1952 as against 17 million lbs. in 1951. The U.S.A. France, Australia, Finland, Egypt, Sweden and Switzerland are some of the other important outlets for Grecian tobacco. Most of the tobacco sales in Greece are effected through the co-operative union of tobacco growers.

ITALY.

Tobacco acreage and production in Italy during the past four years are given in the following table.

Exports of unmanufactured tobacco in 1952 totalled 17.3 million lbs. More than half the exports went to Germany, Netherlands, the U. K., and France and the rest to the U. S. A., Indo-China, Switzerland, Belgium, Poland, U. S. S. R., Finland and Argentina.

Italy's total leaf tobacco imports in 1952 were 4.3 million lbs. which were 1.2 million

lbs. less than in 1951. Of the total, Greece provided 2.2 million lbs. and Turkey 2.1 million lbs.

CANADA.

The principal tobacco growing areas in Canada are centred around Ontario and Quebec. The acreage and production statistics during the years 1949-50 to 1952-53 are given below.

About 90% of the total production is flue-cured Virginia.

Total exports of unmanufactured tobacco during 1952 was 31.9 million lbs. as against 23.2 million lbs. in 1951 and 15.8 million lbs. in 1950. More than 90% of the total exports are shipped to the U. K. and the remaining to Australia, Trinidad, Jamaica and Barbados. Flue-cured leaf as well as lesser quantities of Burley leaf made up the bulk of tobacco exports.

The imports of raw leaf diminished from 15 million lbs. in 1930 to 4 million lbs. in 1940 and to 1.5 million lbs. in 1949, whereas exports of raw leaf increased from 6.5 million lbs. in 1930 to 31 million lbs. in 1931 and then decreased to 15.7 million lbs. in 1949. Canada exported 88.6 million cigarettes in 1952 compared to 36.3 million in 1951, the important outlets being Germany, Japan, Pakistan, Syria, Mexico, the U. S. A. and Vene Zuela.

Growers associations are functioning with the co-operation of buying companies. These associations regulate the planted acreage, appraise the cured leaf on growers farm prior

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to sale and fix the minimum price to be paid to the growers for the entire crop.

PHILIPPINES.

Tobacco played a prominent part in the national economy of Philippines. It is estimated that about 50 million lbs. of tobacco are produced in 1952 from 100,000 acres as compared to 60 million lbs. from 114,000 acres in 1951. The principal type of tobacco grown in Philippines are sun-cured tobacco and air-cured wrapper tobacco. The cultivation of Virginia type of tobacco on a commercial basis was started only in 1949-50 season. Production of Burley tobacco and Oriental type are only in the experimental stage.

During the pre-war and immediate post-war years, Philippines was importing large quantities of manufactured tobacco products and the leaf tobacco imports were negligible. But in 1950 many cigarette factories were started and the leaf tobacco imports also increased to the tune of about 29 million lbs. Later in 1952, it was decided that the tobacco leaf imports should be cut down in order to increase the home production and import quotas were thereafter fixed up to 1955 as given below.

Philippine exports of unmanufactured tobacco prior to world war II were principally to Spain (about $\frac{3}{4}$ of the total) and the United States, Netherlands, Italy, Korea and Japan. Exports of manufactured cigars were consigned to Hongkong, Havai, Japan and the United States of America and cigarettes to Spain, Hongkong and China.

NYASALAND.

The principal varieties of tobacco grown in Nyasaland are fire-cured, flue-cured and Burley tobacco. About 70% of the total production is of fire-cured type. The statistics of acreage and production of tobacco grown in Nyasaland during 1951-52 and 1952-53 are shown in the following table.

Tobacco exports from Nyasaland are mainly consigned to the United Kingdom from early times. Small quantities of fire-cured tobacco are sent to Belgian Congo, and Sierra Leone. The following table shows the total exports of tobacco from Nyasaland during the years 1949 to 1952.

All the tobacco produced in Nysland are sold by auction at Limbe.

YUGOSLAVIA.

Yugoslavia which grows principally the Oriental type of tobacco has always shown marked variations in its annual output. A maximum level of production at 74 million lbs. reached in 1924. During the war output fell down considerably. In 1947, about 40 million lbs. were produced but in 1948, 1949 and 1951 the production exceeded 60 million lbs. In 1950, again, owing to drought conditions, production fell to about 35 million lbs. The 1952 production is estimated at 26 million lbs.

Exports of unmanufactured tobacco have had corresponding fluctuations. After the war, exports were on the increase rising to a maximum of 39.25 million lbs. in 1948, followed by a steady decline of 13.8 million lbs. in 1951. Before war, exports were mainly sent to Poland, Czechoslovakia and Soviet Union. By 1950, the trade with these countries ceased completely. From 1949 onwards, France had constituted the chief market for Yugoslavia's tobacco while Austria, Denmark, Italy, Netherlands and Western Germany accounted for major part of the remainder. Exports figures for 1949 to 1951 were as under.

FRANCE.

In France, since 1811, a monopoly by name S. E. I. T. A. (Department of Industrial Exploitation of Tobacco) is controlling the tobacco cultivation trade and industry. The table given below shows the acreage and production of tobacco during 1949-50 to 1952-53.

Besides domestic production, France buys Algerian tobacco in large quantities and also imports tobacco from Madagascar, U.S.A., Greece, Yugoslavia, Turkey and Brazil. The total imports of unmanufactured tobacco have fluctuated widely in postwar years and reached a peak level of 73 million lbs. in 1952 as compared to 46 million in 1950 and 57 million

lbs. in 1938. As a measure of limiting dollar expenditure, imports from Balkans and Turkey have become more important. A table showing the total imports of tobacco into France during 1949 to 1952 is given below.

WESTERN GERMANY.

The bulk of the tobacco grown in West Germany is a dark, heavy cigar type. Small quantities of somewhat lighter leaf and flue-cured tobacco leaf are also grown and attempts are being made to grow Burley tobacco also. About 38 million lbs., of tobacco were produced in 1952-53 from an acreage of 25,000 acres as against 54 million lbs. from 27,000 acres in 1951-52.

Export trade of Germany is negligibly small. However in 1950 and 1951 about 100,000 lbs. and 800,000 lbs. respectively were exported to Denmark, Saar, Belgium, Netherlands, Austria and Switzerland.

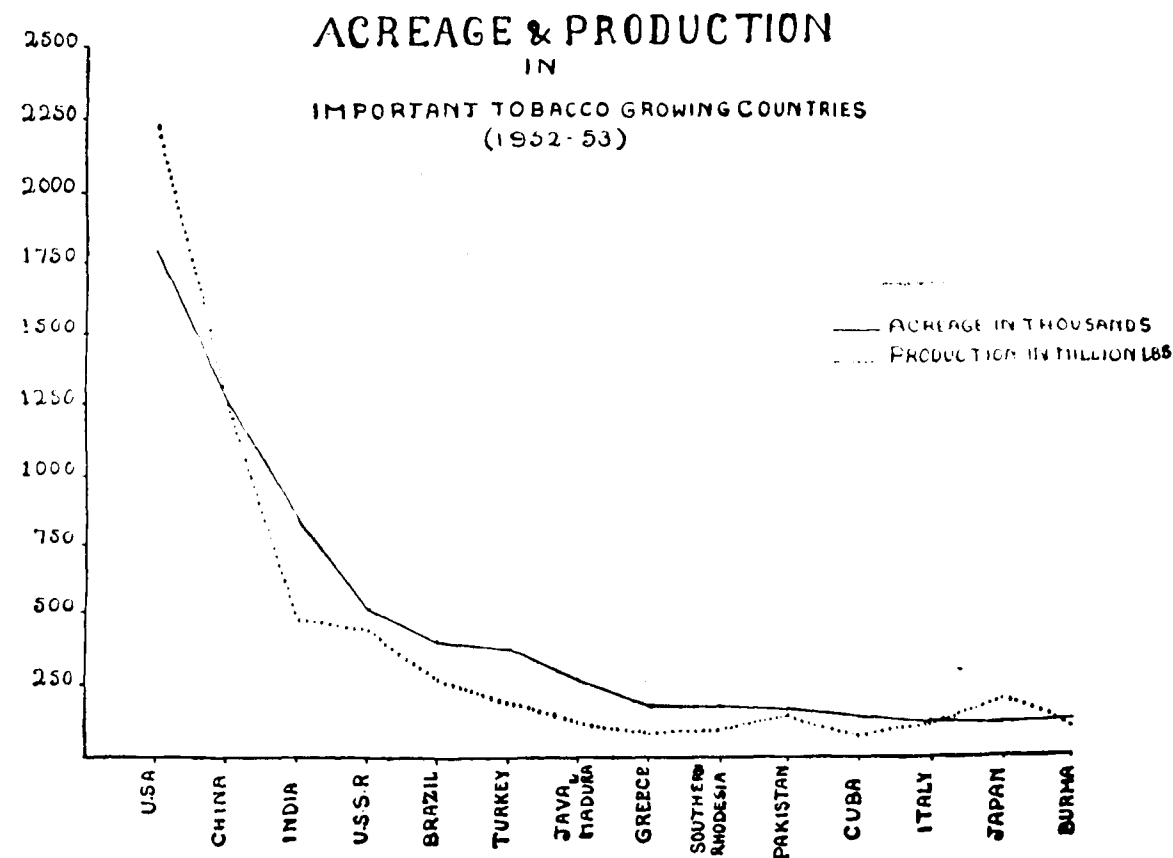
The total imports of unmanufactured tobacco increased considerably after the war. Tobacco imports reached 100.9 million lbs. in 1949, 101.3 million lbs. in 1950, 101.9 million lbs. in 1951 and 113.4 million lbs. in 1952. About 50% of the imported tobacco came from the U. S. and the rest from Greece, Turkey, Brazil, Indonesia, Columbia, Italy, Dominican Republic, Southern Rhodesia, Japan, China and India and a few other countries.

(As amended by the Finance Act, 1951)

'Tobacco' means any form of tobacco, whether cured or uncured, and whether manufactured or not, and includes the leaf, stalks and stems of the tobacco plant, but does not include any part of a tobacco plant while still attached to the earth.

NOTIFICATION

Central Excises.

No. 25. In exercise of the powers conferred by sub-rule (1) of rule 8 of the Central Excise Rules, 1944, the Central Government hereby exempts stems of flue-cured virginia tobacco broken into pieces not more than one sixth of an inch in length, from so much of the duty leviable thereon as is in excess of fourteen annas per lb.
