GENTLEMEN,

1.—In my report of the 30th November last, from the want of the proper names of the several Jaghier Villages separated from the Jeraity by former Chiefs at this place; and given to certain Zemindars in this province when their several Zemindari's were resumed for the liquidation of their balances, I omitted to send down a statement of them, shewing their names and value, and the Mootahs they respectively belonged to, as well as the period when, and by whom, these villages were bestowed in Jaghire.

2.—In giving the Sunnuds -i -Milkeut Istimrar to the several Zemindars, the names of the villages agreeable to the respective Mootahs will be inserted in the Cows, and it may be considered proper by your Board that the Jaghires should be inserted in the several Mootahs agreeable to the valuation affixed to each by the Zemindars themselves, and which valuation we must consider moderate; and, as the object of Government is the establishment of a moderate equitable revenue which may be paid without difficulty, your Board may not deem it necessary to recommend to Government to add the amount of the revenue of the Jaghire villages to the Jumma of the several Mootahs, with the exception of certain Zemindari's, but that the villages themselves should be included, is, I think, indispensable in order to prevent litigation in future when the Mootahs or Estates may be sold.

3.—Purchasers of the Zemindari's, should they hereafter be sold, will receive them at so moderate a Jumma that it is hoped when this race of Zemindars are extinct or entirely removed from possession of their proprietary right by the sale or transfer of their several Zemindari's, that the hill country in this Zillah will be in as high a state of cultivation and improvement as the low lands, and there can be little or no doubt entertained of the ability of the lands paying the tribute attached to them, as the revenue recommended in my letter of the 30th November last is in itself moderate, and we are in certain knowledge of the deceit practised by the Zemindars who furnished the accounts to Mr. Brown's servants. Vide Comparative Statement referred to in the 39th Paragraph of my letter. 30th November 1804.

4.—I was unable to furnish your Board with the village accounts of the Goomsur Zemindary at the time I submitted the accounts received from the other Zemindars; and I am sorry to say I have not been furnished by Brammah, the Manager, with the accounts I have so frequently directed to be sent, and I am equally disappointed at not being able to furnish the accounts of this Zemindar's Jaghire, and am in consequence deprived of the satisfaction of laying the accompanying statement before the Board so complete as I expected to do; but I have endeavoured, as far as the records of the Cutcherry will permit me, to make up the account, and, perhaps, as the other accounts furnished by the Zemindars are not to be fully depended upon, I may have the less cause to regret the want of the fabricated accounts of the Goomsur Zemindar, which might tend to deceive without adding to our present information. I have sent the General Abstract of the Committee of Circuit's account of this Zemindary as the only accounts I can furnish, together with two averages of gross collections.

5.—This is not the period for me to make a report on the collections for the current Fusley; but it is satisfactory to me to be able to say that my gross collections from the Zemindars from the 12th July 1803, to 31st March 1804, exceed my gross collections for the same period the year preceding, by Rupees 52,000.

6.—In the 33rd paragraph of my report of the 30th November last, I informed the Board of my having taken under management the Sayer and Abkarry &ca. revenue in the Zemindari's of Mundasaw, Turlah, Hoommah, Pauloor, and Birredy. I have now the pleasure of adding the names of Goomsur, Haughtghur, Chigutty, Daracoote, Seerghur, Jerredah, Souringhee; in the three first I had little difficulty; but Daracoote, the Zemindar of which is so much under the control of his servants and Pauter, I have met with some opposition, still I have no doubt but in a few months I shall have it in my power to report the complete introduction and establishment of the Sayer servants in all the Zemindari's, though the Zemindars of Pretaubgherry and Vizianaghur not only continue to evade the discharge of their tribute but positively refuse to admit the Sayer servants. Sooradah and Burraghur have also evinced their determination to obstruct the accomplishment of this new custom, but as my orders to all the servants employed are to act with becoming moderation in the assumption of this revenue, so I hope in time to remove their scruples also.

7.—The introduction in so extensive a place and among such a set of Zemindars is not only difficult, as embracing an increased correspondence to remove prejudices and correct abuses, but is also attended with considerable expense, more particularly for the first two or three months; but when the Chowkys are completely fixed, and the Regulation for the conduct of the servants, which I have had translated into Gentoo and Wooriah, fully understood, the expense may be again reduced and the duty conducted by fewer servants.

8.—From the distance I am from the Presidency I find myself sometimes called upon to act without waiting your previous sanction; at the same time I am aware of the impropriety of so doing. The small expense I have from necessity been obliged to put Government to in the collection of the Sayer, will, I hope, be sanctioned by your Board. The account particular enclosed will shew how the amount has been expended; and I have made out a list of charges on this account in the Zillah which has not been sanctioned, and which is in addition to the servants already employed in the Sayer duty, but is only to extend to the end of the Fusley 1213.—and your letter of the 5th January last might indeed be considered in some respect as authority for the disbursement yet anxious to prevent retrenchment from my account by the Office of Audit, I venture to intrude the account particular again on your notice.

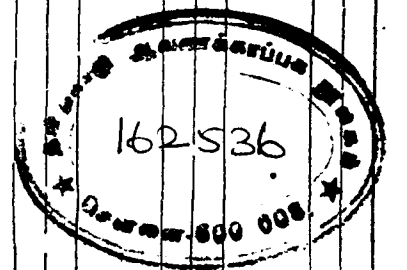
