Direction.—Mr. A. H. Garrett continued to officiate as Chief Engineer and Secretary to Government, Public Works Department, till 4th February 1903, when Mr. W. B. deWinton, C.I.E., returned from leave. The work of the Marine Department was retransferred during the year to the Chief Secretariat.

Territorial Charges.—The only change during the year was the constitution, as a sub-division, of the Muniyera section and works in the Nandigama taluk of the Kistna Northern division.

The Asoka rock inscriptions at Pandya near Purushóttapuram in the Ganjam division were protected at a cost of Rs. 1,680, roofing and iron railing being provided and the inscriptions washed with water-glass preparation.
