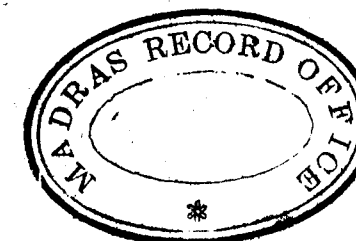

# ADMINISTRATION REPORT

## OF THE

# BANGANAPALLE STATE

### FOR THE YEAR 1910-1911.

*Census.*—Census was taken throughout the State on the night of the 10th March 1911, the State having been divided into 4 charges, 21 circles and 367 blocks for the purpose. The population was 33,356 against 32,000 according to the Census of 1901 or an increase of 22 per cent. A detailed statement showing the results of the four Census operations from 1881 is appended.

2. During the year under report Mr. J. M. Turing vacated the office of the Political Agent and Mr. E. S. Lloyd assumed charge. The latter gentleman visited Banganapalle in the month of February 1911.

3. Tahsildar Abdul Khader Khan Sahib died on the 21st March 1911.

4. For particulars regarding situation, principal tanks, Trade, Ruling family, etc., please see Administration Report for 1909 and 1910.

5. It will be observed that the total receipts of the year under all heads excluding "Debt Heads" amount to Rs. 2,70,379. The decrease of over Rs. 5,000 as compared with the last

year's receipts is due to the fact that the collections of the year under report include an outstanding arrear balance of only Rs. 3,302 whereas those of the previous year included an arrear balance of Rs. 7,554. Also there has been a decrease under Forests, Stamps, Registration fees, etc. The decrease under Forests is due to restrictions on grazing and to the less amount realized on amaro sales owing to the poverty of tamarind crop and also to the tangedu sale not having taken place as the trees have been allowed to rest.

6 The decrease under Registration and Stamps is due to large transactions in land having taken place in the two previous years immediately after the settlement and the issue of permanent puttass.

7. The Miniag rent of Rs. 1,000 will be collected in the current official year.

8. The increase under "Law and Justice" is due to two bail bonds valued at Rs. 900 having been forfeited, and also to the sale of unclaimed cattle which realized Rs. 350.

9. Increase under interest on Government Promissory Notes is due to Rs. 50,400 having been invested during the year in addition to the one lakh of rupees of the previous year. It is proposed to invest Rs. 50,000 again during the current year.

10. Excluding Debt Heads, purchase of Government Securities and Refunds, the total expenditure during the year amounted to Rs. 2,24,594 against Rs. 2,52,700 in the previous year although there has been an unexpected expenditure of Rs. 10,000 on account of the late Nawab's debts.

11. The increase under Village establishment is due to the increment of one rupee to the salaries of Reddies and Karnams with effect from 1st April 1911 under the reorganization of the village establishment scheme.

12. The addition of eight orphan pensioners and cripples at the rate of Rs. 2 each was the cause of increase under "Service pensions, etc."

13. The increase under the head "Religious Institutions" is due to the allotted amount for the previous year having been drawn in the year under report.

14. The cost of temporary establishment entertained in the Revenue Board Office, Madras, for compiling Banganapalle Settlement accounts, (ii) cost of printing, etc., of Diglott Registers and maps and the Stationery required for the purpose, account for increased expenditure under Survey and Settlement.

15. No provision for the payment of the late Nawab's debts was made in the Budget. The amount of Rs. 10,000 paid to Sowcar Nastram Ram Narayan of Hyderabad was an unexpected item.

16. The total expenditure under the head XVIII Miscellaneous (other charges) was Rs. 7,775 against Rs. 1,548 in the previous year or an increase of Rs. 6,227 over last year's. Compensation paid for lands acquired in the bed of Nallacheruvu Tank, for the Rest House at Pathapand and for laying the Nawipet Road, and also the payment of Public contributions such as to Edward Memorial Fund account for this increase.

17. The annual contribution to Municipality is Rs. 5,000 only. The amount of Rs. 5,500 shown under actuals for the year 1910-1911 includes an advance of Rs. 500 from the contribution for the current year.

18. Of the amount of Rs. 54,000 under Nawab's Civil list Rs. 50,841 were drawn by the Nawab during the year and the balance will be drawn during the current year.

19. The balance at the close of the year is Rs. 3,74,602, viz., Rs. 2,22,202 in cash and Rs. 1,52,400 (Face value) in Government Promissory Notes.

20. It will thus be seen that the finances of the State are in a flourishing condition and that the balance is increasing year after year.

21. *Legislation.*—No laws were framed during the year under report.

### GENERAL REMARKS ON THE YEAR'S WORK.

22. *Town Improvement.*—Two new streets one in Kondapet and the other in Kasba were formed during the year and one more street also in Kasba was widened at a total cost of Rs. 3,424 under the Town Improvement Scheme. It is proposed to remove some more congestion during the current year both in Kasba and Kondapet.

23. *Weights and Measures.*—A temporary establishment was entertained for the renewed stamping of weights and measures and the work is in progress.

24. *Village works and village sanitation.*—Three village roads were formed and constructed, six village Chavadies and village gates were newly constructed and five Chavadies were repaired. Six village wells were deepened and repaired and the silt from Tungatur Kunta was removed besides three village latrines and five cattle pounds being either repaired or newly constructed. Several bunds across streams for irrigation purposes were also constructed.

25. 250 trees were newly planted in the villages and all these works were executed under the agency of the Revenue department supervised by the Tahsildar. The total number of trees planted during the past three years is 2,250. The cost of all these works was Rs. 3,966 charged to Village Sanitation.

26. The proposals of the Tahsildar to employ a village conservancy staff on a small scale in all big villages is under the consideration of the Durbar. The Tahsildar did much useful work as regards sanitation of villages with the aid of Revenue Inspectors.

27. *Public Works.*—Rs. 48,820 were spent on public works, details of which are given in Appendix XVII. Excluding Establishment a sum of Rs. 43,029 was spent on works of which Rs. 10,429 were on the two tanks Nallacheruvu and Racheruvu. The work of the latter

is in progress and the former having received full supply during the rainy season some temporary work had to be done for the protection of a portion of the bund.

It is under proposal to increase the capacity of this tank (Nallacheruvu) as it is insufficient to irrigate any appreciable extent at present even when the tank receives its full supply.

28. The perforated dam of eleven vents across the Paleru between Sanjamala and Kanala is a very substantial and grand looking structure. Its construction has removed the great inconvenience of crossing the river both for foot passengers and wheeled traffic. The extension by eight vents of the road dam near Appalapuram was a great necessity because during heavy rains adjacent fields were considerably damaged by the accumulation of water, the old vents being unable to discharge the quantity.

29. School buildings at Kasapala and at Kondapet which are charged to the D. P. W. and not to the Educational Department have been completed as well as the extension to the Kasba School.

30. The chief Police Station at Kasba is approaching completion. The delay being due to the work having been stopped during the whole of the rainy season. Police lines consisting of five quarters at Nandywargam, a cattle pound for the Town of Banganapalle and some other public buildings are in progress. There has been considerable progress in avenue plantation and the trees already planted as well as the new ones are in a flourishing condition.

31. The Overseer Ghulam Ghouse Khan Sahib worked with zeal and energy throughout the year and specially during the rainy season he had to work very hard in looking after the tanks and in repairing damages. The works executed by him are neat and strong.

32. *Educational Department.*—Appendix XXII shows particulars of work done in the Educational Department.

33. There is appreciable increase both in the number of schools and that of pupils. There were 1,103 pupils against 1,053 in the previous year. 774 appeared for the annual examination and 551 passed, against 747 and 498 in the previous year. The number of girls in all the State schools rose from 68 in the previous year to 85.

34. Grants-in-aid were withheld in the case of five Mission schools for deficiency in the number of school days.

35. A school for Muhammadan boys and girls has been started at Kanala during the year with an experienced Muhammadan teacher who knows both Telugu and Urdu. There is a fairly large Muhammadan population in the village, but in the matter of dress and social habits they do not differ from the Kapu inhabitants. Hence the necessity for a separate school. From the experience gained during its short existence the school appears to have bright prospects before it.

36. From the beginning of the current official year it has been proposed to appoint an Assistant Master for the Tungatur school and a Telugu Munshi for the Kasba Lower Secondary school. Also a clerk on Rs. 8-0-0 a month has been sanctioned for the Supervisor's office.

37. The State scholarship of Rs. 10 a month mentioned in para 33 of the last year's report is continued to be held by SYED HUSSAIN KHADRI.

38. The Supervisor of schools J. Raghothama Rao Garu continued to work creditably during the year. Though the number of his visits to village schools has decreased but that was due to his being on leave for a month and to his engagement in Census work.

39. *Trade*—Trade is flourishing though on a small scale but there is every hope of improvement in this direction. A gin for clearing cotton of seeds and an oil machine have been started at Sanjamala by private enterprise.

40. *Forests.*—The scientific survey of the blocks proposed to be reserved has been started under the Forest Improvement Scheme dealt with in para 31 of last year's report.

41. *Audit.*—The system of Periodical audit worked well and satisfactorily.

42. *Famine Programme.*—A special staff consisting of a Surveyor and two peons was entertained during the year to prepare estimates for Famine Programme. Several estimates have already been submitted and sanctioned and the work is still in progress.

43. *Rainfall.*—Appendix XV gives particulars of the registry of rain in the rain registering centres of the State. There was 35.30 inches at Banganapalle against 27.68 inches in the previous year. Rains were heavy and incessant and caused damages to a considerable extent. In addition to the minor losses such as to roads and culvert, the big Mudugedu Konneri, the Kasba Police lines, the bund across the stream at Ramabhairunipalli and the Pasa-

pula tank were seriously damaged causing a loss of about Rs. 10,000 in all. The damages to roads and culverts as well as to wells, etc., have been repaired, but the large works will be taken up during the current year.

44. On the whole the year was prosperous and though cholera crops yielded a poor harvest the high prices prevailing and the rise in the price of cotton made good the loss. Some old springs which were dry have been restored and the Zurraru stream continues to flow from the beginning of the rainy season and the ryots are endeavouring to replant the once flourishing betel leaf and other gardens along its banks. Innumerable applications have been received for bunding up the stream in several places for irrigation purposes.

45. Appendix XVI gives particulars as regards price of staple food grains.

50. In the current collections shown under Miscellaneous in column 6 of the statement a sum of Rs. 48-1-3 on account of Nawab's seri lands is included.

51. The figures shown in column 7 of this statement against Land Revenue, Quit-rent, Miscellaneous and Road cess differ from those shown as actual receipts in column 2 of Financial statement of receipts. The difference is due to the fact that the figures in this statement include a sum of Rs 249-6-11 being the excess collections of Faslies 1318 and 1319 adjusted to accounts this year while it was not shown in the Financial statement as it is not a cash transaction.

52. The balance at the close of the year under report is Rs. 1,406-8-8 against Rs. 3,140 of the previous year. Demand notice No. 1 was issued in the case of 952 defaulters involving Rs. 8,192 against 11,056 defaulters involving Rs. 10,748 in the previous year. The number of defaulters of the year under report against whom demand Notice No. II was issued was only 8 involving Rs. 123.

53. It will thus be seen that the collections were very satisfactory and that it was very creditable of the acting Tahsildar to have made the ryots understand their duty.

54. The current Demand under Land Revenue, Quit-rent, Miscellaneous and Road cess for the year under report was Rs. 2,05,882 against Rs. 2,07,151 in the previous year or a decrease of about Rs. 1,269 which is due to the following reasons:—

(1) The crops raised in the water spread of the Cherupalli tank totally failed as the tank received full supply. Remission had to be given in such cases and the amount was excluded from the demand.

(2) In Sanjamala, harvest in the threshing floors of eleven ryots was destroyed by an accidental fire. Partial remissions had to be made in deserving cases and the amount was not brought to demand; and

(3) In Banganapalle, Pathapaud, Nandavaram and Navipet putta lands were acquired for public purposes and the assessment on those lands had to be excluded from the demand.

55. *Takavi Loans.*—The allotment under this head was Rs. 4,000 and the amount actually disbursed was Rs. 3,630 against Rs. 2,985 in the previous year. With a view to encourage sinking of wells, applications for loans for other purposes, were discouraged. But only two such applications were recalled for Rs. 600. Nine applications for the purchase of fodder and bulls were entertained and of these seven refer to the cases in which the ryots had lost their harvest and fodder by accidental fire and the amount of Takavi loan disbursed in these cases was Rs. 2,800.

56. *Agricultural stock.*—Appendix XVIII gives particulars of Agricultural stock. The steady increase in the number of bullocks and ploughs is a sign of renewed Agricultural activity in the State and the increase in the number of riding conveyances is due to improvement in trade.

57. Out of the herd of Nellore cows that was maintained in 1907, 15 cows were boarded out to ryots on condition of their giving every second calf to the State. The number of calves now is 14, and half of this number viz., 7 falls to the share of the State. All the cows and calves are in good condition and they are regularly inspected by the officers concerned.

58. The condition of cattle was generally good throughout the year. Foot and mouth disease and Rinderpest were prevalent and some valuable bulls of high breed were lost. The annual cattle show had to be stopped this year on account of the prevalence of cattle disease.

59. *Vital statistics.*—The system observed in the Registration of vital statistics was explained in para 60 of last year's report. There has been no change in the system and full particulars are given in Appendix XXI. There is a marked increase in the number of deaths both

**Constitution of the Council.**

During the year under report there have been some changes in the membership of the Council, which usually consists of 16 members. The unexpected death of Muhammad Abdul Khader Khan Sahib, late Tahsildar of the State, which took place in the commencement of March 1911, was a loss to the Council. His place still remains vacant. M. R. Ry. N. Nagoji Rao Garu has resigned the Councillorship in the month of February 1911, and his place has also been vacant. M. R. Ry. G. Sreeram Sastri Garu continued to be the Chairman.

There were 23 meetings during the year of which four had to be adjourned for want of a quorum, as against 18 meetings in the previous year.

**Receipts.**

Statement showing the receipts and charges as compared with Budget estimates are enclosed.

*Tax on Arts.*—160 persons were assessed to this tax; and Rs. 202 were realized during the year, against the demand of Rs. 373-8-0, deducting Rs. 2-0-0 as written off. There remained at the close of the year a balance of Rs. 169-8-0. Of the arrear demand of Rs. 120-8-0 the amount of Rs. 57-8-0 has been collected and Rs. 38-8-0 written off, and at the end of official year there remained a balance of Rs. 24-8-0.

*Tax on Buildings.*—The demand of this tax was Rs. 1,668-0-11 deducting Rs. 1,104-0-3 collected and Rs. 102-13-5 written off, and Rs. 2-2-7 remitted on appeal, there remained a balance of Rs. 459-0-8. Out of demand in arrears of Rs. 321-10-4 a sum of Rs. 193-8-1 was collected and Rs. 40-14-9 was written off, and at the end of official year there remained a balance of Rs. 87-3-6.

*Tax on Lands.*—Out of demand of Rs. 333-7-2 the sum of Rs. 154-1-2 was collected and Rs. 24-6-8 was written off, and at the end there remained a balance of Rs. 154-15-4.

Out of demand in arrears of Rs. 171-8-0 a sum of Rs. 126-9-3 was collected and a sum of Rs. 22-15-7 has been written off, and at the end there remained a balance of Rs. 21-15-2.

*Coercive Process.*—For the collection of all the taxes 92 warrants were issued and in 19 cases property was distrained, and in three of them it was sold in auction. As the distraint was impracticable, five prosecutions were instituted.

*Tolls, Market and Slaughter house.*—The amount for which these were sold have been collected during the year.

*Contribution.*—In addition to the amount spent under town improvement scheme for widening three congested streets, the State has also contributed Rs. 5,500-0-0 in aid of the Municipal Fund as in the previous years.

*Incidence of Taxation.*—The incidence of taxation with reference to the collection comes to Rs. 0-7-11.

**Expenditure.**

The following works were executed during the year at a cost of Rs. 5,552-7-9:—

1. Extension of high road at Kondapet.
2. Laying a new road at Imdad Ali Sahib street.
3. Laying a new road at Lal Masjid street.
4. Laying a new road in Lawley Market.
5. Repairing a cart tract between Veerabhadruni and Hanaman temples.
6. Constructing a culvert of two vents at the junction of Imdad Ali Sahib street and Lawley road.

in the Town and in the villages. The principal cause of death was fever. No epidemic diseases prevailed during the year.

60. *Labour and Wages.*—The condition of labouring classes was generally good. In fact the supply of labourers was not equal to the demand and in many cases labourers had to be obtained from the surrounding British villages.

61. The following table gives particulars of wages in the Town of Banganapalle and in the villages :—

62. There was fall in the price of the staple fool grain—cholan which was sold at sixteen seers per Rupee.

63. The Administrative Departments continued to be the same as in the previous year and except the acting arrangements that had to be made in consequence of the long illness of the Tahsildar there was no change in the personnel. The powers and functions of the various offices of the State were fully dealt with on pages 9-14 of the Administration report for 1909-1910 and there is no need for repeating the same here.

64. *Police*—Appendices III, V give particulars as to strength, cost, discipline, etc., of the Police Force. There was no change in the strength during the year. The efficiency of the force continued to be the same as in the previous year. Recovery of stolen property as shown in Appendix V is satisfactory. The cost of maintaining the force was Rs. 10,392 against Rs. 10,923. The reduction was chiefly under equipment as the supply of only one suit instead of two was found to be quite sufficient. The strength of the village Police continued to be 62 as in the previous year. Three constables and one bugler were undergoing training at Kurnool. Relations between the British and State Police continued to be good.

65. *Civil and Criminal Courts.*—There was no change either in the number or in the constitution of the Civil and Criminal Courts of the State. Appendices VI, XI show the work done by them.

66. *Extradition*—Only four applications for Extradition were made during the year by the British courts through the Political Agent and 11 accused were surrendered. No applications for Extradition were made by the Durbar.

67. *Prison.*—There was only one Jail as in the previous year, the Chief Medical Officer being its Ex-officio Superintendent.

68. Weaving and gardening was the occupation of the prisoners during the year. There was a fall in the Jail income during the year due to a stock of articles worth Rs. 70 not having been sold during the year. The cost of maintaining the prisoners was Rs. 1,274. The decrease of Rs. 174 over last year's expenditure is due to less amount spent on contingencies. The health of the prisoners was good and discipline was well maintained.

69. In Honour of the occasion of His Majesty the King Emperor's accession to the throne remissions were granted to ten prisoners for terms varying from 5 months to 15 days. Appendix XII shows particulars as to admissions, etc.

70. *Registration of Assurances.*—Appendices XIII and XIV give particulars as to the documents registered during the year. There was no change in the staff and the causes for decrease in the number and value of documents have been already given under general remarks.

71. *Medical and Sanitary and Vaccination.*—There was no change in the staff. It continues to be the same as detailed in para 72 of last year's report.

72. For particulars regarding the work done in the Hospital, please, *vide*, Appendix XX patients. The Hospital continues to be very popular.

73. 157 Minor operations were performed during the year and the Midwife attached to the Hospital conducted 33 cases of labour.

74. The total number of cases vaccinated during the year was 1,940 against 2,118 in the previous year. The percentage of unsuccessful cases was 14.38 against 3.69 of last year. The increase of unsuccessful cases and the decrease in the number vaccinated was due to the death of 2nd Grade Vaccinator Ghulam Dastagir whose place was vacant for some months owing to the difficulty of securing the services of a qualified man.

75. The Assistant Medical Officer who is Ex-officio Inspector of Vaccination checked 39 per cent. of cases against 45 per cent. in the previous year. The decrease is due to the absence of the Chief Medical Officer on leave during which period the Inspector had to remain at Head Quarters attending wholly to the Hospital work.

76. Vaccine paste from Guindy continues to be used and it gives satisfaction. Drinking water wells were in good condition and public health in villages was generally good. Cases of fevers, Dysentery, coughs, abscesses, etc., were treated by the Inspector of Vaccination during his tours.

77. *Post office.*—The Postal management of the State is under the control of the Imperial Postal Department.

78. *Abkari*—The Abkari Administration of the State has been leased out to the Abkari Department for five years beginning from September 1909 in consideration of Rs. 27,760. Particulars as to the number of Arrack, etc., shops are given in Appendix XIX.

79. *Water supply.*—Preparations are being made for renewing boring operations in connection with the Town water supply. The work was stopped on account of heavy rains of last year and for want of a competent Boring Maistry.

80. *Telegraph.*—Negotiations were completed during the year for a guaranteed Telegraph line to the Town of Banganapalle. Preliminaries are being arranged and it is expected, that a Telegraph Office will shortly be opened.

81. *Nawab.*—During the year under report the Nawab toured throughout the State, inspected all the works in progress and conducted the Jamabandi of 24 villages. There was not a single work whether important or unimportant the progress of which he did not watch with keen interest. The works connected with the sanitation and improvement of the Town of Banganapalle always have his best attention.

82. He visited Madras privately for the treatment of his eye complaint (Granular Ophthalmia) and he had to undergo an operation by Major Elliot M.S. He also visited Allahabad during the Exhibition as well as several important places in Northern India.

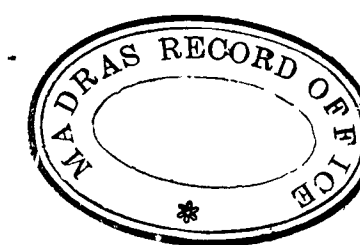
83. *Nawab's brother.*—The Nawab's brother, Meer Asaf Ali Khan Bahadur had title of "Khan Bahadur" conferred on him by the Government of India.

84. *Municipality.*—A separate report on the Municipal Administration is appended. Much useful work was done during the year and the Councillors worked harmoniously and well. The general Sanitary condition of the Town and the lighting arrangements speak well of the work of the Council and its Chairman.

85. *Conclusion.*—In conclusion I have to thank all the Officers of the State who have worked so well. The good result of the year's work is due to their timely suggestions and the accuracy and faithfulness with which they have carried out the orders of the Durbar.

These works were designed, estimated and supervised by the full timed Overseer and they were checked by the Councillors. All the roads of the Municipality are maintained and they are in good order.

*Vital Statistics.*—265 births, 143 deaths were registered during the year against 228 and 102, respectively, in the previous year.

*Sanitation and water supply*—Particular attention was devoted to the sanitation of the town during the year. The sum of Rs. 556-7-0 was spent for the sinking of two new wells in the thickest parts of the town, viz., one within the compound of the new Market and the other in Rajputwadi, and a sum of Rs. 200 was spent in the repairs of four old wells.

2. His Highness the Nawab takes the deepest interest in and devotes personal attention to the work of the Municipality. Two new public latrines were constructed in different parts of the town and the present slaughter house has been repaired.

3. Many people have constructed private latrines in their houses.

4. In the matter of the removal of congestion in the town much useful work has been done with the aid of the State.

5. Three new streets were formed at a cost of about Rs. 3,000.

6. This amount has been borne by the State under the town improvement scheme. The cost of formation and laying roads will have to be borne by the Municipality.

*General remarks.*—The Municipal Council takes this opportunity to thank His Highness the Nawab for the keen interest always evinced by him in its work and administration. In this connection the Council also takes this opportunity to thank the Dewan Sahib for taking warm interest in all Municipal matters. The improvements in the town effected during the year were largely due to their ready help.

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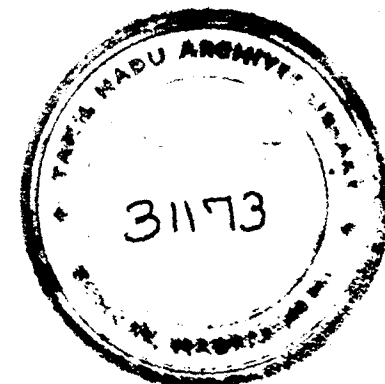

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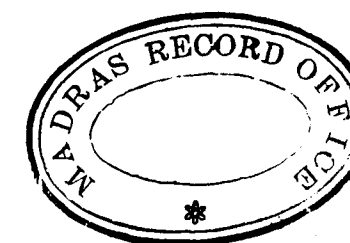

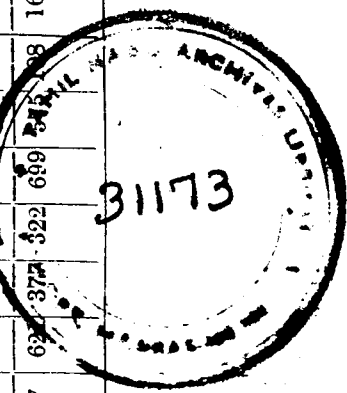
