EXPLANATORY NOTE.

On the system of trade registration in the Bombay Presidency and compilation of trade statistics in the office of the Government Examiner of Accounts, B. B. & C. I. Railway, Bombay.

For purposes of trade registration, India has been divided into blocks

comprising the Presidencies, Provinces and Native States, named in the margin, according to administrative boundaries. The trade with the principal sea-ports referred to in the margin is dealt with separately from that of the Presidency or Province in which the port is situated. These main blocks are called "External" blocks with reference to each other.

The Bombay Presidency (exclusive of Sind) is divided into eight blocks, viz. :—

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The latter seven are the "Internal" blocks of the Presidency and the group is known as "Bombay" or "Bombay Presidency" excluding Bombay Port as distinguished from "Bombay Port" which is a main block.

The trade of the Bombay Presidency is of three kinds :—

- (1) Imports from "External" blocks.
- (2) Exports to "External" blocks.
- (3) Local trade, *i. e.*, traffic between "Internal" blocks.

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and is registered by the fifteen Railway Audit Offices shown in the margin.

Nos. (2) to (15) submit to the Government Examiner of Accounts quarterly returns of Trade and No. (1) submits weekly ones from which latter quarterly returns are prepared in the Government Examiner's Office similar to those submitted by the other offices named. From these returns quarterly statements are prepared showing—

- (i) The trade of each "Internal" block in the Presidency with other Presidencies, Provinces, etc.

- (ii) The trade of the "Internal" blocks of the Presidency with each other;

and from these two, another statement is compiled showing the trade of the Bombay Presidency with the "Bombay Port" and the "External" blocks.

The figures contained in Statements (i) and (ii) are registered, and at the end of the year the postings for the four quarters are totalled, and the following three statements prepared for the official year:—

- (a) Statement No. II(a) showing imports into "Internal" blocks of the Bombay Presidency from "External" blocks.
- (b) Statement No. II(b) showing exports from "Internal" blocks of the Presidency to "External" blocks.
- (c) Statement No. III showing the local trade of the Bombay Presidency, including Bombay Port.

In preparing Statements Nos. II(a) and II(b) all external trade in any commodity which falls below Rs. 10,000 in value is not shown under the block concerned but is grouped together under the head "other places."

Sir,

I have the honour to submit the Annual Returns of the Rail-borne Traffic of the Bombay Presidency (exclusive of Sind) for the year ending 31st March 1913.

2. The registration of the Rail-borne Trade was as usual carried out by the Railway Administrations concerned, the compilation by the Government Examiner of Accounts, B. B. & C. I. Railway, Bombay, and the review and the publication by this Department.

3. During the year under report there has been an addition of 103 miles to open mileage of railway. A branch line was opened from Nadiad on the B. B. & C. I. Railway to Kapadvanj, a distance of 28 miles, and another from Kosamba on the same Railway to Zankhvav (26 miles) in the Baroda Territory. There were two extensions in Káthiáwár on the B.-G.-J.-P. Railway, one of 27 miles from Junágad to Visavádar and the other of 17 miles from Khajadia to Gavadka. A small addition of 5 miles was made to the Vijapur-Kalol Railway by extension of the line from Kodi to Bhoyani.

4. *Season.*—The late rains of 1911-12 were considerably in defect of the average over the greater part of the Presidency, and crops yielded a moderate outturn in favourable situations only or where water was available to help them through the dry weather. Elsewhere they either withered or yielded poorly. During 1912-13 the monsoon opened timely but rain in July was continuous and heavy in almost every district and interfered with agricultural operations. Later rains were deficient and crops suffered particularly in the eastern parts of the Deccan. Elsewhere they made fair progress and yielded fair to good outturn.

5. *Prices.*—The table in the margin exhibits the variations in prices of the principal articles of trade as obtained in the Bombay market. They show a general rise over the prices of 1911-12 except in the case of cotton (raw) cotton manufactures, sugar and linseed. The drop in the price of cotton (raw) was in sympathy with the price of the American article in the home market on which it usually depends. The price of Indian piece-goods rose owing to considerable demand, but that of other cotton manufactures was kept down owing to large stocks on hand. The low price of sugar was due to the receipt of larger supplies from Mauritius and Austria where there were good harvests. The rise in the price of opium was due to the introduction of the system of auction-sales for right of export and to restrictions on the trade with China. Shorter supplies of wheat from Russia owing to the war in the near East raised the price of Indian wheat in the European market, and there was a greater demand for other food-grains also. Abundant crop of linseed in the Argentine lowered the price of the oil-seed, which had ruled very high in the previous year. Other oil-seeds were dearer owing to higher demand. The rise in price of copper was due to greater activity in the ship-building and electrical industries. The price of kerosene was about stationary.

The trade with the external blocks advanced by 17 per cent. over the previous year and 58 per cent. over the average. The local trade was about the same as last year but 8 per cent. in excess of the average. The net result was an expansion of 11.3 per cent. over the total trade of the previous year.

IMPORTS.

7. The total transactions of the year, of which about 56 per cent. were with the Port of Bombay mainly for export abroad, showed an advance of 21 per cent. in quantity and 13.7 per cent. in value over the previous year. Compared with the average the increases amounted to 76 and 50 per cent. respectively. The principal transactions of the year are noted below and compared with those of the previous year and the average :—

Coal and Coke.—The trade in this article expanded by 93 L. M. or 73 per cent. over last year, mainly owing to larger supplies from Bengal into North Deccan and Gujarát, and from Bihar and Orissa into Gujarát and Bombay Port. The receipts from the Nizám's Territory into Gujarát and East and West Deccan, however, fell off by 7 L. M.

Cotton.—About 88 per cent. of the trade in this article is with the Bombay Port. The supplies from the Central Provinces and Berar receded by 15.7 L. M. below the previous year, but United Provinces (+7.9 L. M.), Punjáb (+3.6 L. M.), Rájputána and Central India (+4.5 L. M.) and Nizám's Territory (+2.4 L. M.) did larger business and more than made up the decline, giving a net increase of 2.4 L. M. or 3.2 per cent.

Dyes and Tans.—(+24,000 maunds). Bombay Port received larger supplies of myrabolams from the Central Provinces and of turmeric from Madras and Punjáb, but the imports of tanning barks from the Nizám's Territory into Konkan fell off.

Wheat.—The trade in this article rose by 35 L. M. or 43 per cent. over the previous year. Bombay Port took up larger supplies from the United Provinces (+17 L. M.) and Rájputána (+13.7 L. M.), but the receipts from the Central Provinces (—3.6 L. M.) and Punjáb (—2 L. M.) receded. Gujarát had larger dealings with the United Provinces (+4.2 L. M.) and Punjáb, and Deccan with Rájputána (+2.6 L. M.).

Other food-grains.—The transactions under this head further expanded by 13.34 L. M. or 6.2 per cent. over the previous year. Bombay Port (+8.7 L. M.), Deccan (+8.4 L. M.) and Gujarát (+2.7 L. M.) received larger supplies of gram and pulse, mainly from the United Provinces and Rájputána, but those from the Punjáb (—3.3 L. M.) receded to some extent. Larger consignments of jowár and bájra were received into Bombay Port (+9.3 L. M.), mainly from the United Provinces and Nizám's Territory, into Deccan (+15.4 L. M.) from the United Provinces, Rájputána and Nizám's Territory, and into the Southern Marátha Country from Mysore, but those into Gujarát (—20 L. M.) from the United Provinces and Rájputána fell off. The transactions in clean rice receded (—9.4 L. M.) by shorter receipts from Madras and Central Provinces into Bombay Port, from Madras into Deccan and from Sind into Gujarát. Deccan and Gujarát however received larger supplies from Central Provinces and the latter from Bihar. The trade in other grains declined by smaller consignments into Gujarát (—8 L. M.), mainly from Punjáb and Rájputána, but this decline was partly made up by extended dealings of the Port (+3 L. M.) with United Provinces, Punjáb and Rájputána.

Metals.—The bulk of the trade in metals consisted as usual of metallic ores, chiefly manganese ore, which showed a rise of 51 per cent. over the previous year owing to increased demand for export. There were larger receipts from the Central Provinces (+50.5 L. M.) and Rájputána (+3.8 L. M.) into Bombay Port, and from Mysore into Goa (+7.8 L. M.), but those from Madras into Goa (—7.4 L. M.) declined. Among metals proper, West Deccan received larger supplies of brass manufactures (+7,500 maunds) from Bengal, and Goa of miscellaneous manufactures (apparently aluminium ware) from Madras (+.75 L. M.). The imports of wrought and unwrought iron and mill machinery from the Central Provinces showed some expansion.

Oil-seeds.—The trade in oil-seeds fell from 178.31 L. M. to 150.48 L. M. or by 15 per cent. below the previous year, but was higher by 24 per cent. over the average. Nearly 10ths of the trade is with the Bombay Port. The table in the margin shows the net variations under each head as compared with the previous year. The dealings in rape-seed and groundnuts alone showed some advance. Larger quantities of the former were received into the Bombay Port from the United Provinces (+4.5 L. M.), Central Provinces and Rájputána, and of the latter from Central Provinces (+1.5 L. M.) and Madras. East Deccan and Southern Marátha Country also took up larger consignments (+.71 L. M.) of groundnuts from Madras. Of other

oil-seeds Bombay Port received larger supplies of castor seed from the United Provinces (+2 L. M.), but those from Nizám's Territory (-5.5 L. M.) declined considerably. The receipts of cotton seed from the Central Provinces (-17.3 L. M.) and Nizám's Territory (-1.7 L. M.) into the Port fell off, but those from Madras (+1.2 L. M.) into Goa, from Central Provinces (+1.8 L. M.) into Gujarát, Konkan and North Deccan, and from Nizám's Territory and Mysore (+1.2 L. M.) into Deccan and Southern Marátha Country, showed a small expansion. Bombay Port received larger consignments of linseed from Rájputána (+1 L. M.), but those from the United Provinces, Central Provinces and Nizám's Territory (-5.6 L. M.) showed a considerable falling off. Larger imports of sesamum into the Port from the United Provinces (+3.5 L. M.) and Rájputána (+1.3 L. M.) barely covered the deficiency in the receipts from Nizám's Territory (-4 L. M.), Central Provinces (-8 L. M.) and Mysore. Central Provinces (-4.6 L. M.), United Provinces (-2 L. M.), Nizám's Territory (-2.2 L. M.) and Madras (-1.6 L. M.) principally led to the decline in the trade under miscellaneous seeds.

Opium.—The imports of Málwa opium into Bombay Port (-11,000 maunds) fell off owing to restrictions on the trade with China, but those from the United Provinces into the Presidency showed a small expansion.

Of other articles, the trade in fodders rose by 4.1 L. M. owing to increased imports of grass into East and West Deccan and the Southern Marátha Country due to scarcity from Nizám's Territory, Central Provinces and Madras. Bombay Port received larger supplies of hemp from the United Provinces and Central Provinces (+2 L. M.). The transactions in hides and skins with Central Provinces declined but the deficit was made up by increased receipts from United Provinces and Nizám's Territory. The trade in jute showed a small expansion. Of provisions there were larger receipts of dried fruits and nuts, chiefly cocoanuts, from Madras and Mysore (+1.5 L. M.), of ghi from United Provinces and Madras, and of miscellaneous provisions from Central Provinces, United Provinces and Rájputána into Bombay Port, Gujarát, North Deccan and Southern Marátha Country. Bombay Port took up railway materials to a larger extent from Rájputána, Central Provinces and Bengal, but the trade with the Presidency showed some falling off. The imports of chillies were nearly half those of last year owing to smaller supplies from Madras into Bombay Port, and from Rájputána into Gujarát. Miscellaneous spices from Rájputána also showed some decline. Gujarát and North Deccan received larger supplies of raw sugar from the United Provinces and Bihar (+3.9 L. M.), and East Deccan and Southern Marátha Country from Mysore, but those from Madras into Deccan and Southern Marátha Country (-1 L. M.) receded. Gujarát had larger dealings in tobacco (+15,000 maunds) with the United Provinces. Bombay Port received smaller consignments of gold (-65,000 ozs.) from Mysore, and of silver coin from Rájputána (-3,460,000 ozs.), but those of the latter from the Central Provinces (+6,038,000 ozs.) showed considerable expansion. The trade in silver bullion advanced by 644,000 ozs.

EXPORTS.

8. The total exports to outside provinces, of which the Port claimed nearly 54 per cent., showed an advance of 3 per cent. over the previous year and 13.5 per cent. over the average of the preceding 5 years. In value the increases amounted to 8.7 and 33.8 per cent. respectively over the previous year and the average. The chief variations are noted below :—

Coal and Coke.—The consignments from Bombay Port to Rájputána (-3 L. M.) declined, but those from Gujarát to Rájputána (+1.4 L. M.), from North Deccan to Central Provinces (+1.6 L. M.), and from Goa to Mysore (+2.8 L. M.) showed considerable increases.

Cotton Manufactures.—The trade of the Port in twist and yarn (European) advanced by 22,000 maunds: Madras, Bengal, United Provinces and Rájputána receiving increased supplies, while the Central Provinces restricting their demand. Bombay Port forwarded smaller consignments of the Indian article to Madras, Bengal, Punjáb, Rájputána and Nizám's Territory; also such consignments were smaller from Gujarát to Punjáb and Madras, and from East Deccan and the Southern Marátha Country to Madras; but those from Gujarát to Central Provinces and Bengal showed some increase, reducing the net decline to 34,000 maunds. There was a higher demand for European piece-goods from all the Provinces, Madras, United Provinces, Punjáb and Rájputána taking the bulk of the increased exports (+1.6 L. M.). Bengal (+44,000 maunds) received larger supplies of the Indian goods from Gujarát, but restricted its demand (-10,000 maunds) on the Port. Punjáb (+49,000 maunds) and Rájputána received larger supplies from Gujarát, and Madras, Mysore and Nizám's Territory from Deccan and Southern Marátha Country.

Wheat.—The exports of wheat were stationary. The consignments from East Deccan were restricted by 59,000 maunds, but the deficit was made up by larger supplies from the Southern Marátha Country (+28,000 maunds) to Madras, Nizám's Territory and Mysore, and from Gujarát (+20,000 maunds) to Rájputána. The trade in wheat-flour advanced by 41,000 maunds, Mysore and Nizám's Territory taking up larger supplies from the Port.

Other food-grains.—Bombay Port sent out larger consignments of gram and pulse (+.75 L. M.) to Mysore, Nizám's Territory and Madras. From North Deccan to Central Provinces and from Southern Marátha Country and Goa to Mysore, such consignments were larger, but those from East Deccan (-.73 L. M.) to Mysore and Madras receded. Rájputána and Central India and Central Provinces received less of clean rice from Bombay Port (-.4 L. M.), but its supplies from East Deccan and Southern Marátha Country to Mysore showed a small increase.

Liquors.—The trade in liquors advanced by 8,000 maunds only. There were larger exports of ale and beer to Rájputána, but those to Central Provinces and Punjáb receded.

Metals.—The transactions in metals (unwrought) rose by .5 L. M. There were larger dealings in brass (+ 22,000 maunds) and iron (+ 41,000 maunds) with United Provinces, Central Provinces and Madras and in the latter with Nizám's Territory; but the trade in copper fell by 13,000 maunds owing to shorter supplies to Punjáb, United Provinces and Rájputána. Bombay Port sent out smaller supplies of brass and copper manufactures to United Provinces and Punjáb; but the exports of the former from West Deccan to United Provinces and Central Provinces were extended. The exports of mill machinery (—44,000 maunds) receded owing to smaller consignments to Central Provinces and Punjáb, but the deficit was partly made up by extended supplies to Nizám's Territory and Madras. The trade in other iron manufactures (+1.5 L. M.) advanced owing to larger dealings of the Port with United Provinces, Central Provinces, Rájputána and Nizám's Territory.

Oils.—The trade in Kerosene oil advanced by .86 L. M. Bombay Port had larger dealings with United Provinces, Central Provinces and Rájputána, but Mysore and Nizám's Territory restricted their demand on it in favour of Goa which also sent larger supplies to Madras. Miscellaneous oils were sent out in larger quantity to United Provinces, Rájputána and Nizám's Territory, but the consignments to Central Provinces fell off considerably.

Oil-seeds.—The exports of cotton-seed from East Deccan and Southern Marátha Country to Madras (—1.3 L. M.), and of groundnuts from Bombay Port, West Deccan and Southern Marátha Country to United Provinces (—.5 L. M.) and Punjáb (—14,000 maunds) declined. Bombay Port had almost no dealings in sesamum, but the consignments from East Deccan and Southern Marátha Country to Madras advanced by 20,000 maunds. The supplies of miscellaneous oil-seeds from East Deccan and Southern Marátha Country to Madras were largely curtailed (—3.4 L. M.).

Railway Plant and Rolling Stock.—There were smaller consignments of carriages and trucks and locomotives from Bombay Port (—.9 L. M.), but its trade in sleepers, steel rails and miscellaneous articles with Rájputána (+4.3 L. M.) and Nizám's Territory (+1.8 L. M.) showed considerable expansion. Madras and Mysore received carriages and trucks to a larger extent from Southern Marátha Country (+33,000 maunds), and Central Provinces, steel rails and sleepers (+1.2 L. M.) from Konkan and North Deccan, but the supplies to Rájputána (—.5 L. M.) fell off.

Salt.—The exports of salt declined by 4.4 L. M. Central Provinces (—3.2 L. M.) and Nizám's Territory (—65 L. M.) received smaller supplies from the Port and Konkan, and Rájputána (—7 L. M.) from Gujarát, but those from Gujarát to United Provinces (+28,000 maunds) and from Goa to Madras and Mysore (+17,000 maunds) expanded to some extent.

Sugar.—The transactions in refined sugar advanced by 2.3 L. M. Central Provinces (+1.7 L. M.), Nizám's Territory (+.64 L. M.) and Punjáb received increased supplies from Bombay Port and North Deccan, but the consignments to Mysore declined. The exports of unrefined sugar expanded by 1.1 L. M. owing to increased supplies to Rájputána (+.9 L. M.), United Provinces and Central Provinces from the Bombay Port. Shorter supplies of gul from Southern Marátha Country to Central Provinces (—95 L. M.) and Rájputána (—9,000 maunds) and from West Deccan to Nizám's Territory (—7,500 maunds) curtailed the trade in this article by 1.2 L. M.

Of the other articles, the trade in hides and skins expanded by .7 L. M. owing to increased exports from Gujarát to United Provinces and Bengal, and from North Deccan to United Provinces. There were smaller dealings in gunny bags with Central Provinces and Rájputána, but these were more than made up by increased exports to United Provinces, Nizám's Territory and Madras. Among provisions larger consignments of dried fruits and nuts were sent to Central Provinces (+26,000 maunds) and Rájputána (+31,000 maunds), but

the latter curtailed its demand for ghi and miscellaneous provisions from Gujarát. Among spices there were larger exports of chillies to Central Provinces from Bombay Port and North Deccan, and to Nizám's Territory from Southern Marátha Country, but the trade in miscellaneous spices from Bombay Port to United Provinces and Punjáb showed some decline. There were smaller supplies of gold to United Provinces (—334,000 ozs.) and Central Provinces (—66,000 ozs.), but these were more than made up by increased takings by Punjáb, Madras, Karáchi and Calcutta. United Provinces (+2,100,000 ozs.), Nizám's Territory (+2,400,000 ozs.), Calcutta (+1,900,000 ozs.) and Mysore (+176,000 ozs.) received larger quantities of silver bullion from Bombay Port but Punjáb (—3,000,000 ozs.) and Rájputána (—500,000 ozs.) curtailed their demand. The transactions in silver coin with United Provinces, Punjáb, Nizám's Territory and Karáchi were considerably extended but those with Central Provinces and Rájputána fell off considerably resulting in a net decrease of 5.5 million ozs.

LOCAL TRADE.

9. This branch of the trade consists mainly of transactions between the Bombay Port and the rest of the Presidency and formed about 76 per cent. of the total traffic. The remaining 24 per cent. represented the interchange of commodities between the different blocks of the rest of the Presidency. The total trade of the year showed a small decline of .4 per cent. below the previous year but was about 8 per cent. over the average. In value it fell by 12 and 2 per cent. respectively. The principal fluctuations are noted below:—

Coal and Coke.—The trade in this article rose by 21.4 L. M. Bombay Port sent out larger supplies to Gujarát (+12.2 L. M.), North Deccan (+4.2 L. M.) and West Deccan (+3 L. M.) and Goa to East and West Deccan and Southern Marátha Country (+1.7 L. M.). North Deccan also received some supplies from Gujarát.

Cotton, raw.—Bombay Port received smaller consignments from Gujarát (—7.5 L. M.), Deccan (—5.2 L. M.) and Southern Marátha Country (—3.5 L. M.), and West Deccan (—20,000 maunds) from the last, resulting in a total decrease of 17.5 L. M.

Cotton Manufactures.—Gujarát and Southern Marátha Country received larger supplies of foreign yarn (+15,000 maunds) from Bombay Port, but restricted their demand for the Indian article (—11,000 maunds). They however sent out larger consignments of the local produce (+22,000 maunds) to Bombay Port. Their trade in foreign piece-goods also showed some expansion

(+27,000 maunds). East and West Deccan supplied larger quantities of Indian piece-goods to Bombay Port (+8,000 maunds), but their receipts from Gujarát and Southern Marátha Country receded to the same extent. The exports from Bombay Port were stationary, Gujarát extending its demand (+6,000 maunds) in lieu of shorter supplies sent to East and West Deccan and Southern Marátha Country.

Wheat.—The trade in wheat receded by 7 L. M. There were smaller exports from North and East Deccan to Bombay Port (—5 L. M.) and Gujarát (—22,000 maunds), from East Deccan to North Deccan (—1·05 L. M.), and from Gujarát to Bombay Port (—1·1 L. M.), but the supplies from Bombay Port were extended by 56,000 maunds, of which West Deccan received three-fourths. West Deccan also received larger supplies of wheat-flour from Bombay Port and Gujarát (+30,000 maunds).

Other food-grains.—The transactions in food-grains other than wheat declined by 7·9 L. M., the deficit being practically equally divided between jowár and bájri and rice. Bombay Port received smaller consignments of the former (—5·1 L. M.) from Deccan and Southern Marátha Country, and Gujarát and Southern Marátha Country (—1·7 L. M.) from East Deccan, but the supplies to West Deccan (+2·8 L. M.) from East Deccan and Bombay Port were considerably extended. Gujarát (—4·5 L. M.), Konkan and North Deccan curtailed their supplies of rice from Bombay Port, but there were larger dealings between West Deccan and the Port and Konkan (+·6 L. M.), and between the Port and Southern Marátha Country (+17,000 maunds). Bombay Port received smaller supplies of gram and pulse (—1·7 L. M.) from Gujarát and Deccan, but sent them out in larger quantity (+2·2 L. M.) to Southern Marátha Country and other blocks. There were also larger exports in them from Goa to Southern Marátha Country (+·8 L. M.).

Metals.—The trade in metals advanced by 1·8 L. M. owing mainly to increased supplies of manganese ore (+3 L. M.) from Gujarát to Bombay Port. West Deccan and Southern Marátha Country had smaller dealings in brass and copper, wrought and unwrought, and Gujarát and East Deccan in iron, wrought, (—2·1 L. M.). There was increased activity in the trade in mill-machinery (+·5 L. M.), and Bombay Port extended its supplies to Gujarát, Konkan, North Deccan and Southern Marátha Country. Articles of hardware and cutlery were received in larger quantity by Gujarát and West Deccan.

Oils.—Gujarát received larger consignments of kerosene oil (+·4 L. M.) from Bombay Port, but its dealings with East and West Deccan and Southern Marátha Country (—9 L. M.) fell off. These blocks made up the deficiency by extended receipts from Goa. The trade of the Port in miscellaneous oils showed some expansion (+·4 L. M.), but that of the East and West Deccan (—1·1 L. M.) declined considerably.

Oil-seeds.—The transactions in oil-seeds receded by 15·9 L. M. Bombay Port received smaller supplies of groundnuts (—4 L. M.) from East Deccan and Southern Marátha Country, of linseed (—3·4 L. M.) from North and East Deccan, of rape-seed (—2·1 L. M.) from Gujarát and North Deccan, of sesamum (—5 L. M.) from East Deccan and of miscellaneous seeds (—6·4 L. M.) from the Gujarát, Deccan and Southern Marátha Country. Gujarát received larger supplies of cotton seed from Bombay Port and North Deccan, and Goa from Southern Marátha Country, but the exports from East Deccan to Goa fell off. Gujarát did smaller business with North and East Deccan in sesamum and in castors with North Deccan. Bombay Port took up larger supplies of castors (+1·8 L. M.) from Gujarát and North Deccan.

Salt.—There were smaller supplies of salt from Konkan (—2·5 L. M.) to Deccan and Southern Marátha Country and from Goa (—18,000 maunds) to the latter.

Sugar.—Bombay Port did larger business (+3·3 L. M.), in refined sugar with all the blocks, Gujarát, North and West Deccan and Southern Marátha Country taking larger supplies. The trade in unrefined sugar was about stationary. North Deccan received smaller supplies from Bombay Port, but

Gujarát increased its demand for it to an equal extent. Bombay Port received larger consignments of gul from West Deccan, Gujarát from Bombay Port and North Deccan, and Goa from Southern Marátha Country; but North and East Deccan had smaller dealings with West Deccan, Bombay Port and Southern Marátha Country, and Southern Marátha Country with Bombay Port and Deccan, resulting in a net decline of 18,000 maunds.

Among other articles, the trade in dyes and tans receded by 1 L. M. owing to smaller receipts into Bombay Port of myrabolams from West Deccan (—1 L. M.), and of turmeric (—27,000 maunds) from West Deccan and Southern Marátha Country. Konkan however had larger supplies of tanning barks (+·56 L. M.) from Deccan. Bombay Port took up larger supplies of bran and oil-cake from Gujarát and of fodder from Gujarát and North Deccan, but restricted its receipts of the latter from West Deccan. Gujarát received less fodder from Konkan and North and East Deccan; but Deccan had extended dealings with Gujarát, Konkan and Southern Marátha Country. West Deccan received less supplies of oil-cake (—9 L. M.) from East Deccan and Southern Marátha Country. The trade in hides and skins showed a small increase owing to extended receipts by Bombay Port from Deccan and Southern Marátha Country. Bombay Port sent out smaller supplies of gunny bags to Deccan and Southern Marátha Country (—6 L. M.). The trade in liquors fell by 5,000 maunds owing to smaller supplies from West Deccan to East Deccan. Among provisions there were smaller exports of dried fruits and nuts from Bombay Port (—5 L. M.), to North and East Deccan and from Goa (—18,000 maunds) to Southern Marátha Country, but the receipts from Bombay Port to Gujarát and from Goa to West Deccan were extended (+·6 L. M.). The transactions in railway materials between Bombay Port and Gujarát, Konkan and West Deccan, and between Southern Marátha Country and Goa and West Deccan showed some extension, but those between West Deccan and Konkan fell off. Among spices the trade in chillies declined by 45,000 maunds owing to shorter supplies from Southern Marátha Country to Bombay Port and East and West Deccan, and from North Deccan to Gujarát, and in miscellaneous spices from North Deccan to Bombay Port and Gujarát. The receipts of silver bullion into Bombay Port from Gujarát and East Deccan showed some advance, but those from Southern Marátha Country (—740,000 ozs.) largely fell off. The distribution of the white metal from Bombay Port to all the blocks nearly halved (—960,000 ozs.). There were larger receipts of silver coin into Bombay Port from Southern Marátha Country (+1,100,000 ozs.) and other blocks, but its supply from Bombay Port to Gujarát and East Deccan receded by 2,500,000 ozs.

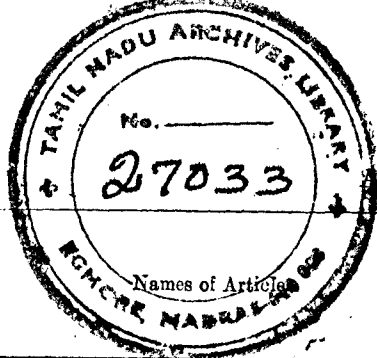

Note.—(1) Rates of articles classed A relate to articles of foreign merchandise and are furnished by the Collector of Customs, Bombay. These are based on values assigned by the importers at the time of passing the goods out of the Customs House and may be regarded as only approximately accurate.

(2) Rates of articles classed B are obtained from the monthly returns of prices published in the Gazette by the Director of Agriculture. They represent the average of monthly prices ruling on the 20th of each month which are furnished by the Huzar Deputy Collectors according to orders in Government Resolution No. 3653, dated 8th October 1892, General Department. The quarterly averages of the Presidency are founded on the monthly prices at the head-quarters of the principal representative districts. These rates may be regarded as fairly reliable.

(3) Rates of articles classed C are obtained every month by special local inquiry in Bombay, and from the monthly rates thus obtained the quarterly averages are found. These rates may be regarded as merely approximate.

(4) The rates of articles classed D are the rates fixed once for all and they are merely conventional.
