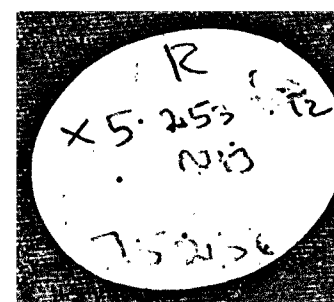

ment and the fluctuations in the statistics.

2. The report from the Collector of Customs, Cuttack, Balasore, and Puri, were received on the 21st, 24th and 12th April 1913, respectively.

3. *Customs Revenue.*—Statement A shows the details under this head. The total gross revenue realised during the year under report amounted to Rs. 2,54,331 against Rs. 2,70,853 in the previous year and the net revenue, deducting refunds, was Rs. 2,44,671 against Rs. 2,60,235 of the previous year, resulting in a decrease of Rs. 15,564.

There was a decrease of Rs. 14,404 in the revenue in Cuttack and Rs. 12,714 in Balasore. But this decrease was partly made up by a corresponding increase of Rs. 11,554 in Puri. These variations are due to less exports to Colombo and Mauritius from Cuttack and Balasore and greater exports from Puri to Colombo owing to increased demand for rice by Ceylon tea-planters.

4. There was no receipt from dutiable goods under the head "Import duty" in any of the ports of this Division during the year under report.

5. Though there was a small increase in the import of duty-paid Salt, the net receipts on account of duty on bonded salt resulted in a decrease of Rs. 1,388 as compared with the figures of the preceding year. This is ascribed to the fact that some purchasers of Kendrapara imported Ganjam Karkatch Salt at a cheaper rate.

6. The total refund on export was Rs. 9,660 against Rs. 10,618 of the previous year. In Cuttack the total amount of duty refunded on account of short shipment during the year under report was Rs. 8,916. Of this amount Rs. 6,699 was refunded on account of 35,730 maunds of rice short-shipped during the year under review and Rs. 2,217 on account of short shipment of 11,824 maunds of the preceding year. Rupees 994 still remains to be refunded on account of short-shipments during the year under report.

7. *Receipt charges and net Revenue.*—Statement C gives the statistics of each district separately.

8. *Shipping.*—Statement D gives the statistics of vessels engaged in trade for the last 10 years and of the value of trade carried by them. The total value of trade shows an increase in Puri and a decrease in Cuttack and Balasore.

There was a small increase in the value of imports in Cuttack on account of importation of medical stores and other articles for the Light House and Dispensary at False Point. But this was more than counterbalanced by the heavy decrease in the value of exports to foreign ports. The small decrease in Balasore and increase in Puri in the value of exports do not call for explanation.

9. Statement E compares the statistics of value of imports and exports by sea during the past five years. There was no importation of free or dutiable foreign trade goods into any of the ports of this Division during the year under report.

10. There was an increase of Rs. 6,347 in Cuttack in the value of free exports to foreign ports due to large exportation of gingelly and til seeds during the year; whilst under the head "Coasting trade" there was a decrease both in the total value of imports and exports on account of the less exportation of rice to coast ports.

11. Statement G compares the value of the total trade for the past two years. There has been a decrease of Rs. 11,97,433 in the total value of imports and exports as compared with the preceding year and the reason has been explained in paragraphs 8 and 10 above.

12. The other statements do not call for any special remarks.

13. *Wreck and Casualties.*—No wreck is reported during the year under report. A casualty resulting in loss of a life happened on the 25th January last on board the British India Steamer "Virawa." While working cargo in the anchorage, one of the crew of a licensed cargo boat, a cooly and a Preventive Officer were hurt—the first two seriously by the falling of the steamer's derrick. The cargo-boatman died on his way to Cuttack for medical treatment on the 28th January 1913. The commander of the vessel reported the casualty to the Steamer Company's Agent at False Point, and though the latter sent intimation to the Police, no report was made to any Magistrate as required by section 6 of the Indian Merchant Shipping Act, 1883. The Managing Agents of the Steamer Company at Calcutta attribute this omission to the Commander's ignorance of the law. There appears to have been no desire to conceal the casualty, and the Agents have compensated the lascar and widow.

14. *Breach of Customs law.*—In Balasore there were 50 prosecutions against boats plying without license, and a sum of Rs. 93 was realised in fines during the year under report. The number of prosecutions in the previous year was 43 and the fines amounted to Rs. 95. Though there was an increase in the number of prosecutions, the fines imposed were less than in the preceding year. In Puri Rs. 53 was realised as fines against nil in the previous year.

15. *Indian Merchandise Marks Act.*—No proceedings were taken under the Act in any of the districts of this Division during the year under review.

16. *Charge.*—Mr. W. G. Mayston, Port Officer of the Orissa Ports, remained in charge of the Cuttack and Balasore ports throughout the year.

17. *Inspections.*—The Collector of Customs, Cuttack, visited the False Point Customs office on 25th March 1913. In Balasore the Customs Office was inspected by my predecessor on 18th September 1912, by the Collector on 31st January 1913, and the Deputy Collector in charge on 15th August 1912, and 28th March 1913, during the year under report. The Chandipur Flag-staff was inspected several times by the Port Officer of Cuttack and Balasore Ports as well as by the Collector of the district. The Chandbali Customs and Port Office were also inspected by the Collector of Balasore and the Port Officer of Calcutta.
