EXPLANATORY NOTE.

For the purpose of recording the trade carried by rail and river, the Province of Bihar and Orissa is divided into four trade blocks, which are constituted as follows :—

- (1) Patna City, comprising the City of Patna, Bankipore, Dighaghat, Dinapore and Gulzarbagh.
- (2) Bihar, comprising the districts of Patna (excluding places comprised in the Patna City Block), Gaya, Shahabad, Saran, Champaran, Muzaffarpur, Darbhanga, Monghyr, Bhagalpur, Purnea and the Santal Parganas.
- (3) Chota Nagpur, comprising the districts of Hazaribagh, Ranchi, Palamau, Manbhum, Singhbhum and Gangpur (Tributary State).
- (4) Orissa, comprising Cuttack, Puri, Balasore, Angul, Sambalpur and Mayurbhanj State.

A record of the trade of these blocks by rail with one another and with other provinces is prepared in the railway audit offices from invoices of goods received. In a similar way, a record of trade carried by steamers between different blocks of Bihar and Orissa and Assam and Calcutta is prepared from the invoices preserved in the offices of the River Steam Navigation Company and the India General Navigation and Railway Company. The trade carried by steamers between the different blocks of Bihar and Orissa is not recorded. As regards the traffic by country boat there are two stations in Assam which record the trade of the province with the different internal blocks of Bihar and Orissa. Imports into and exports from Calcutta by country boat are registered by the Port Commissioners, Calcutta, but country boat traffic between the blocks of Bihar and Orissa and other blocks of Bengal is not registered.

The weights in these tables are given in maunds of 82½ lbs. and represent net weight that is to say, a reduction at a fixed conventional rate is made from the actual gross weight of the goods as recorded on the invoices by railway or steamer companies. A list of the rates at which reduction is made appears in the Appendix to this report.

The value of the goods carried by rail and steamer is not recorded on the invoices and consequently average values have to be assigned to each article when the accounts are made up. The average values are determined in a variety of ways. In the case of merchandise imported by sea, such as piece-goods, metals, foreign liquors, salt, foreign sugar, kerosine oil, etc., average quarterly values are reported by the Collector of Customs, Calcutta. As regards the great majority of articles of Indian produce or manufacture, average market rates for each quarter are reported by selected officers at Patna and Purulia, and on these an average is struck for the whole province. Coal, cotton, grain and pulse, jute, oilseeds, hides and skins, etc., are reported on in this way. The cost price of opium is reported by the Board of Revenue, United Provinces. For certain articles in which no markets have yet opened in this Province, *e.g.*, non-intoxicating drugs, tobacco manufactured, silk and its manufactures, leather, etc., Bengal rates are accepted. The quantity of traffic in each article for each quarter is multiplied by the value rate for that quarter and the sum of the product for the four quarters forms the value of the whole year. In valuing the export trade of the Province as well as the internal trade, the rates adopted are those fixed for this Province, while in valuing the imports of other Provinces and seaports the rates fixed by the exporting Province are adopted.

ON THE

TRADE CARRIED BY RAIL AND RIVER IN BIHAR AND ORISSA

IN THE

OFFICIAL YEAR

1913-1914.

THE climatic conditions were not very favourable during the year under review. In April the rainfall was below the normal everywhere. In May it was mostly above the average. In June the rainfall was heavy and exceeded the normal in all districts except Cuttack and Angul, where it was slightly below the normal. In July it was defective in all districts except Cuttack, Balasore, Angul, Puri, Ranchi, Palamau and Singhbhum. In Cuttack and Balasore the fall was very heavy. In August the rainfall was above the normal in all districts except Champaran, Bhagalpur, Purnea, Cuttack, Angul, Puri and Ranchi, and owing to an abnormal precipitation there were high floods in Patna, Gaya, Cuttack and Balasore, where the *bhadoi* crops and the newly planted winter rice crop were either washed away or severely damaged in certain areas. Slighter damage by floods and excessive rain also occurred in parts of Shahabad, Saran, Muzaffarpur, Darbhanga, the Santal Parganas and Hazaribagh. The rainfall in September was general, the fall being on the whole above the normal in Bihar but defective in Orissa and Chota Nagpur. In October the rainfall continued defective in Orissa, but was above the normal in Bihar and Chota Nagpur. In November there was practically no rain in Bihar, but in Orissa and Chota Nagpur there was a light to moderate fall. In December the rainfall was above the normal in Bihar and Chota Nagpur, but defective in Orissa. There was practically no rain in January. In February the rainfall was general, the fall being above the normal in all districts of Bihar except Patna, Gaya, Shahabad and Monghyr. In Orissa and Chota Nagpur it was below the normal except in Cuttack, Angul and Singhbhum. Slight damage was done to the *rabi* crops by rain and hail in February in some districts of Bihar. In March the rainfall was below the normal in all districts except Gaya, Champaran, Palamau and Singhbhum, where it was above the normal. The result, generally speaking was that an excellent winter rice crop was secured and a fair average *rabi* crop although the rain in February did some damage. There was also damage by rain to grain on the threshing floor in April and May :—

On the basis of the rates which prevailed at typical centres such as Patna, Purulia and Cuttack, the average retail prices of food-grains per maund during the year under report and two preceding years were :—

The nature of the trade recorded in the several tables of the report is explained below :—

- (a) Tables I and II.—Trade of each internal block of Bihar and Orissa with other Provinces.
- (b) Tables III and IV.—Trade of each internal block with Assam and Calcutta by river.
- (c) Table V.—Trade of each internal block of Bihar and Orissa with other blocks by rail.

The trade falls naturally into the following classes :—

(1) *Imports into Bihar and Orissa.*—These imports consist principally of goods which have been imported by sea into Calcutta and also of the products of Calcutta and Bengal, both manufactured and natural.

(2) *Exports from Bihar and Orissa to other provinces.*—Goods sent to Calcutta for export by sea or for manufacture, and to the rest of Bengal and other provinces consist principally of natural produce and a few articles of local manufacture.

The following figures show the trade of Bihar and Orissa with other provinces during the year under review and the preceding year (exclusive of animals and treasure) :—

As compared with the preceding year's figures the imports showed an increase of 19·8 per cent. in volume and 16·7 per cent. in value. Of the total value of the imports into Bihar and Orissa (Rs. 24·08 crores), some 65·8 per cent. was contributed by the Calcutta trade block, 15·1 per cent. by Bengal, excluding Calcutta, 10·6 per cent. by the United Provinces, 3·7 per cent. by the Central Provinces and Berar, and the remaining 4·8 per cent. by other Provinces.

The export trade showed a decrease of 5·8 per cent. in volume but an increase of 1·7 per cent. in value as compared with that of the preceding year owing to rise in prices. Of the total exports of Rs. 29·7 crores, some 45·4 per cent. went to Calcutta, 26·9 per cent. to Bengal, excluding Calcutta, 13·0 per cent. to the United Provinces, 3·6 per cent. to the Central Provinces and Berar, 3·5 per cent. to the Punjab, and the remaining 7·6 per cent. to other provinces.

The principal articles of imports during the year under report were:—(1) Cotton

Imports. manufactures, Rs. 895·6 lakhs of which Rs. 804·7 lakhs came from Bengal, including Calcutta, Rs. 40·2 lakhs from the United Provinces of Agra and Oudh, Rs. 32·5 lakhs from the Central Provinces and Berar, and the remaining Rs. 18·2 lakhs from other provinces; (2) Metals and manufactures thereof, Rs. 286·7 lakhs of which Rs. 265·8 were imported from Bengal, including Calcutta, Rs. 16·4 lakhs from the United Provinces of Agra and Oudh, and the remaining Rs. 4·5 lakhs from other provinces; (3) Grain and pulse Rs. 254·2 lakhs of which Rs. 132·8 lakhs, chiefly rice, were from Bengal, including Calcutta, Rs. 90·7 lakhs from the United Provinces of Agra and Oudh, and the remaining Rs. 30·7 lakhs from other provinces; (4) Railway plant and rolling stock, Rs. 156·0 lakhs, of which Bengal, including Calcutta, sent Rs. 139·3 lakhs and the other provinces the remaining Rs. 16·7 lakhs; (5) Sugar Rs. 134·2 lakhs of which Rs. 115·1 lakhs were received from Bengal including Calcutta, Rs. 15·8 lakhs from the United Provinces of Agra and Oudh, Rs. 3·1 lakhs from Madras and the remaining Rs. 0·2 lakhs from other provinces; (6) Oils, Rs. 112·6 lakhs, of which Rs. 101·3 lakhs, chiefly kerosine, was exported by Bengal including Calcutta. The less important articles of import arranged according to value were salt Rs. 92·0 lakhs, spices Rs. 60·5 lakhs, gunny bags and cloth Rs. 47·8 lakhs, apparel Rs. 40·0 lakhs, tobacco Rs. 22·9 lakhs, coal Rs. 21·8 lakhs, wood Rs. 19·2 lakhs, ghee Rs. 18·8 lakhs, lac Rs. 15·0 lakhs, oil-seeds Rs. 13·9 lakhs, woollen manufactures 8·8 lakhs, paper and paste-boards Rs. 7·2 lakhs, chemicals, excepting saltpetre Rs. 5·8 lakhs, cotton (raw) Rs. 5·1 lakhs and opium Rs. 4·8 lakhs.

The principal articles of exports during the year under report were :—(1) Coal, Rs. 685·6

Exports. lakhs, of which Rs. 426·3 lakhs went to Bengal, including Calcutta, Rs. 87·8 lakhs to the United Provinces of Agra and Oudh, Rs. 69·4 lakhs to the Punjab, Rs. 43·5 lakhs to Bombay, Rs. 20·0 lakhs to the Central Provinces and Berar, Rs. 17·3 lakhs to Rajputana, Rs. 14·4 lakhs to Madras, and the remaining Rs. 6·9 lakhs to other provinces; (2) Railway plant and rolling stock Rs. 333·0 lakhs, of which Rs. 277·6 lakhs were exported to Bengal, including Calcutta, Rs. 32·8 lakhs to the United Provinces of Agra and Oudh, and the remaining Rs. 22·6 lakhs to other provinces; (3) Oilseeds, Rs. 317·8 lakhs, of which Bengal, including Calcutta, took the major portion *viz.*, Rs. 302·6 lakhs, chiefly linseed; (4) Grain and pulse, Rs. 284·5 lakhs of which Rs. 177·3 lakhs found their way to Bengal, including Calcutta,

Rs. 46·4 lakhs to the United Provinces of Agra and Oudh, Rs. 28·4 lakhs to Assam, and the remaining Rs. 32·4 lakhs to other provinces; (5) Jute (raw), Rs. 171·9 lakhs, almost the whole of which went to Bengal, including Calcutta; (6) Metals and manufactures thereof, Rs. 150·3 lakhs, of which Bengal including Calcutta, received Rs. 118·4 lakhs and the United Provinces of Agra and Oudh Rs. 25·7 lakhs; (7) Tobacco, Rs. 145·7 lakhs, of which Rs. 75·3 lakhs were exported to Bengal, including Calcutta, Rs. 44·6 lakhs to the United Provinces of Agra and Oudh, Rs. 10·6 lakhs to the Central Provinces and Berar, and the remaining Rs. 15·2 lakhs to other provinces; (8) Hides and skins, Rs. 139·8 lakhs, of which Rs. 129·8 lakhs went to Bengal, including Calcutta, and the remainder to other provinces. Other principal articles of exports were sugar Rs. 92·5 lakhs, lac Rs. 87·2 lakhs, fruits and vegetables Rs. 57·4 lakhs, silk (raw) Rs. 56·6 lakhs, animals Rs. 52·6 lakhs, hemp and other fibres excluding jute Rs. 43·3 lakhs, spices Rs. 40·7 lakhs, wood Rs. 38·5 lakhs, dyes and tans Rs. 35·9 lakhs, cotton manufactures Rs. 24·7 lakhs, oil Rs. 22·5 lakhs, fodder, Rs. 20·1 lakhs and cotton (raw) Rs. 16·9 lakhs.

The large part of the produce imported into the Patna City block by rail was derived from Bihar (mainly paddy, chalk and lime, marble and stone and "railway materials—other sorts") and Chota Nagpur blocks (chiefly coal and coke, paddy and timber unwrought). The Bihar block received principally food-grains, sugar (gur) and unwrought timber from Patna City, coal and coke, unwrought timber and "railway materials—other sorts" from Chota Nagpur.

The Chota Nagpur block imports grain and pulse, rice and fruits and vegetables from Bihar and metallic ores from Orissa. Orissa imports coal and coke from Chota Nagpur and sugar (gur) from Bihar. The exports from the Patna City block consist chiefly of food-grains, unrefined sugar and unwrought timber Bihar sends grain and pulse, rice, paddy, Chalk and lime and marble and stone. The articles most largely exported from Chota Nagpur are coal and coke and unwrought timber and from the Orissa block metallic ores, found in the Mayurbhanj State.
