PROCEEDINGS OF THE BOARD OF REVENUE

(LAND REVENUE AND SETTLEMENT).

Resolution—No. 7, Press, dated 1st February 1924

The Board submits its report on the settlement of land revenue in the Presidency for fasli 1332 (1922-23) together with the prescribed statements.

2. *Character of the season.*—The south-west monsoon was exceptionally favourable on the West Coast. But in the rest of the Presidency the rainfall was insufficient and ill-distributed except in the Agency division, Ganjam, South Arcot and Tanjore. The monsoon was a partial failure in the Deccan and parts of the Central districts. The north-east monsoon was however very favourable and saved parts of the Deccan and the Central districts from the worst effects of the failure of the south-west monsoon. Heavy rains in the end of November caused breaches in the Periyar main canal and in tanks in the Madura and Ramnad districts. The year on the whole was not unfavourable except in Bellary where the rainfall was hardly sufficient for the heavy black cotton soils. There was no famine or scarcity during the year. The test works which had been opened in parts of the Kurnool district in the previous fasli were closed by the end of August 1922.

3. *Number of ryotwari villages.*—There was a net decrease of six villages compared with the previous year. The increase of one village in the Agency division and the decrease of four in the Ganjam district were due to rectification of errors. There was a decrease of two villages in Kistna and three in Ramnad owing to amalgamations in the Narasapur and Srivilliputtur taluks respectively. The decrease of five villages in Guntur and the increase of one in South Arcot were due to changes made in connexion with the resurvey. The increase of one village in Cuddapah and five in Trichinopoly was due to the subdivision of villages.

4. The land revenue of the Presidency is derived from the undermentioned sources:—

- (a) Peshkash or revenue from permanently-settled estates,
- (b) Shrotriyam jodi or quit-rent levied on inam villages,
- (c) Assessment including water-rate on lands held under the ryotwari system,
- (d) Miscellaneous revenue, and
- (e) Proprietary estates village service.

5. *Peshkash or revenue from permanently-settled estates.*—The total amount of peshkash payable during the fasli was Rs. 49,79,964 against Rs. 49,86,020 in the preceding year. The decrease of Rs. 6,056 is the net result of—

6. The quit-rent payable on villages held on shrotriyam or favourable tenure was Rs. 7,52,774 against Rs. 7,53,172 in the preceding fasli. The decrease of Rs. 398 is accounted for as below:—

7. *Holdings*.—The total extent of ryotwari holdings during the year was 28.32 million acres which exceeded the extent of the previous year (as now revised) by 87,157 acres. The increase was contributed by all the districts except Vizagapatam, Bellary, Salem and the Agency division. The increase was marked in Anantapur (16,346 acres) and as in the previous year it is ascribed to the growing demand for land. The increase in South Arcot (11,289 acres) was due to fresh assignments made during the fasli and to the adoption of resurvey areas in the Vriddhachalam taluk.

8. *Assessment*.—The total assessment on holdings was Rs. 543.60 lakhs against Rs. 541.27 in the previous year (as now revised), showing an increase of Rs. 2,32,811 which was shared by all the districts except Vizagapatam and Anjengo. The marked increase in South Arcot (Rs. 1,18,886) was due to the introduction of resettlement rates in the Vriddhachalam taluk.

9. *Cultivation*.—The total area cultivated in ryotwari holdings during the year was 19.82 million acres compared with 19.84 million acres in the previous fasli. The area under dry 14,933,260 acres showed a decrease of 32,853 acres and that under wet, 4,882,458 acres, an increase of 7,058 acres. The decrease under dry was marked in Anantapur and it was due to want of sufficient rain. The increase under wet occurred chiefly in South Arcot and North Arcot, the season having been more favourable than in the previous year. Including the area under 'miscellaneous cultivation', the total area cultivated was 20.77 million acres against 20.86 million acres in the previous year.

Dry waste charged showed an increase of 116,398 acres, the increase in Anantapur, Kurnool and Coimbatore being particularly large. There was a decrease of 1,053 acres under wet waste charged. The area of wet waste remitted increased by 10,248 acres, the increase being confined to the Circars and the Deccan, Anantapur alone being responsible for an increase of 8,838 acres.

10. *Water-rate and second-crop charge*.—The revenue derived from these sources amounted to Rs. 34.49 lakhs against Rs. 32.60 lakhs in the previous year. The increase was thus an increase of Rs. 1,89,176. The increase was large in North Arcot, South Arcot and Chingleput and was due to the favourable character of the season.

11. *Remissions*.—As compared with the previous year, there were decreases under 'season remissions' and 'fixed remissions' and an increase under 'Beriz deductions'. The net decrease under all the three heads amounted to Rs. 64,108.

(i) *Season remissions*.—The remissions under this head showed a net decrease of Rs. 86,447. The decrease occurred mainly under 'shavi and short crop'.

(a) *Waste remitted*.—The remissions under this head amounted to Rs. 2.86 lakhs or Rs. 13,704 more than in the previous fasli. The increase occurred in the Circars and the Deccan except Kurnool and it was specially marked in Anantapur. A sum of Rs. 6,988 was remitted on 38,780 acres of dry land in Bellary under G.O. No. 159, Revenue, dated 20th March 1923.

(b) *Shavi and short crop*.—The total amount remitted under this head was Rs. 1,01,733 against Rs. 3,01,292 in the previous year, a net decrease of Rs. 1,99,559. A remission of Rs. 17,200 was granted under 'short crop' during the year against Rs. 65,174 in the previous year.

(c) *Tirvakammi remissions* (i.e., the remission of the difference between wet and dry assessment on wet lands cultivated with dry crops owing to insufficiency or failure of water-supply) amounted to Rs. 4,06,458 against Rs. 2,85,498 in the previous year, a net increase of Rs. 1,20,960. The increase was most noticeable in the districts of Vizagapatam (Rs. 59,887) and Gōdāvari (Rs. 50,738).

(d) *Injury by floods*.—The amount remitted under this head was Rs. 10,232 against Rs. 16,204 in the preceding year, a net decrease of Rs. 5,972. The decrease was large in Tanjore (Rs. 3,606) and Kistna (Rs. 2,755).

(e) *Fasalakammi or second crop not cultivated*.—The amount remitted under this head was Rs. 7,407 against Rs. 19,340 in the previous year, a net decrease of Rs. 11,933. The decrease was marked in North Arcot and is attributed to the favourable character of the season.

(ii) *Fixed remissions* (i.e., abatement of the demand granted for reasons unconnected with the season) amounted to Rs. 1.33 lakhs against Rs. 1.50 lakhs in the previous year, a net decrease of Rs. 16,915. The decrease occurred mainly under increment remissions (i.e., remissions allowed on the introduction of settlement or resettlement in cases where the increase over the old assessment was in excess of 25 per cent).

(iii) *Beriz deductions*.—(Deductions made from village collections in favour of inamdars and religious institutions) amounted to Rs. 9,14,046 against Rs. 8,94,787 in the previous year, a net increase of Rs. 19,259. The increase occurred mainly under the head 'payment for religious institutions in lieu of cash payments' and was particularly noticeable in South Arcot owing to the clearance of arrears in many cases, especially in the Chidambaram taluk.

12. *Miscellaneous revenue*.—The revenue under this head amounted to Rs. 107.9 lakhs against Rs. 100.27 lakhs in the previous year, a net increase of Rs. 7,63,191.

Among the several sub-heads under this head, there were large increases of Rs. 3,19,769, Rs. 2,64,565, Rs. 72,807 and Rs. 59,100 respectively under items 10 (sale-proceeds of lands sold), 7 (revenue derived from tree pattas), 4 (enhanced water-rate on lands irregularly irrigated) and 3 (charge for water in zamindari and inam villages, including tirvajasti and fasaljasti). The decrease of Rs. 21,228 under item 6 (charges levied for occupation of poramboke land) also deserves notice. All these items are dealt with below. The variations under the remaining items do not call for any remarks.

Item 3—Charge for water in zamindari and inam villages, including tirvajasti and fasaljasti.—The revenue under this head was Rs. 20.67 lakhs against Rs. 20.08 lakhs (as now revised) or Rs. 0.59 lakh more than in the previous year. The increase (Rs. 23,488) was large in Kistna.

Item 4—Enhanced water-rate on lands irregularly irrigated.—The revenue under this head was Rs. 6.02 lakhs against Rs. 4.29 lakhs or Rs. 0.73 lakh more than in the previous year. The increase (Rs. 47,543) was large in Kistna, and was due to irrigation of nearly twice the area of the previous year.

Item 6—Occupation of poramboke.—The revenue derived under this head was Rs. 6.93 lakhs against Rs. 7.14 lakhs or Rs. 0.21 lakh less than in the previous year. The decrease occurred mainly in Gōdāvari (Rs. 32,591) and Kistna (Rs. 22,698).

Enhanced charges amounting to Rs. 4,18,131 were levied on 41,064 acres against Rs. 3,87,692 on 30,817 acres in the previous year, showing an incidence of Rs. 10 per acre against Rs. 13 in the previous year. The highest average rates (Rs. 71, 58 and 40) were found in Gōdāvari, Tanjore and Nellore.

As regards the progress made in the reclassification of lands registered as poramboke, there were no lands of this class to be reclassified in the districts of Madras, Malabar and Anjengo. The work is reported to be complete or nearly complete in all the other districts except Ganjam, Kurnool, Tanjore, Trichinopoly and The Nilgiris, where it is still in progress. In dealing with encroachments on real poramboke, the provisions of section 6 of Madras Act III of 1905 were employed in the districts of Ganjam, Nellore, Cuddapah, Bellary, North Arcot, Tanjore, Madura, Ramnad and South Kanara. The Collectors of the remaining districts have furnished no specific information on the point.

Item 7—Revenue derived from tree-pattas.—The revenue under this head was Rs. 4.93 lakhs against Rs. 2.28 lakhs in the previous year, an increase of Rs. 2.65 lakhs. The increase occurred in all the districts except Vizagapatam, Guntur, Anantapur and Madras and it was due to the introduction of the new rates of tree-tax fixed in B.P. No. 47, Land Revenue, dated 11th August 1921.

Item 10—Sale-proceeds of lands sold.—The revenue under this head was Rs. 8.38 lakhs against Rs. 5.18 lakhs or Rs. 3.20 lakhs more than in the previous year. The increase was marked in Coimbatore (Rs. 1,43,912) and Chingleput (Rs. 91,308). The increase in Coimbatore was due to the sale of considerable

extents of disafforested lands, while that in Chingleput was due to the sale of valuable lands under the darkhast rules and to the credit of a sum of about Rs. 84,000 being the capitalized value of abatement of land revenue on lands made over to the Madras and Southern Mahratta Railway Company.

13. The net ryotwari demand, including water-rate, second-crop charge and miscellaneous revenue and deducting remissions, amounted to Rs. 667.15 lakhs against Rs. 654.1 lakhs (as now revised) in the previous year. The details for the increase of Rs. 12.55 lakhs are given below :—

16. *Demand and collection of land revenue and cesses (current).*—The current demand under land revenue and cesses was Rs. 8,18,07,670. Rupees 7,93,52,058 or 96.9 per cent was collected within the fasli and Rs. 2,510 written off the accounts.

17. *Demand and collection of arrears.*—The total arrear demand under all the heads was Rs. 27,65,917. A sum of Rs. 24,66,200 or 89.2 per cent was collected within the fasli and a sum of Rs. 1,15,294 or 4.2 per cent was written off the accounts.

18. The balance outstanding at the end of the fasli including both arrears and current was Rs. 26,37,525. As last reported in the demand, collection and balance statements for November 1923, the balance at the beginning of fasli 1333 was Rupees 26,11,903. Up to the end of November 1923, a sum of Rs. 19,37,970 had been collected, Rs. 24,68 written off the accounts and proposals have been made to write off Rs. 319. The net recoverable balance on 1st December 1923 was Rs. 6,49,706. Steps have been taken to collect this amount.

19. *Reconciliation of differences between the collection of land revenue and cesses as shown in the jamabandi and Accountant-General's statements and overpayments.*—This will be dealt with in a separate report.

20. *Distribution of collections between land revenue and cesses.*—Land revenue and cesses are collected together, and no attempt is made to exhibit the collections separately under these heads in the village accounts. The distribution of the total

collections between land revenue and the several cesses is effected in each Collector's office. In this process there are two stages : first a provisional distribution is effected by crediting to each head month by month so much of the total collections as will bear the same proportion to the demand under the head as the total collections bear to the total demand under all the heads; the second stage is the final adjustment which consists in correcting the provisional credit by transfer from one head to another, where necessary, after the demand for the year under all the heads has been collected or written off.

The statements of distribution for fasli 1332 show that, except in Gōdāvari, Kistna, Nellore, North Arcot, South Arcot, Ramnad and Tinnevely, the variations between the amounts due to the cesses in fasli 1332 and the amounts actually credited were inconsiderable. The accounts of fasli 1331 were not finally adjusted in eleven districts.

21. *Charges debitable to land revenue.*—The charges of district administration including the salaries and allowances of revenue inspectors but excluding those of village establishments were Rs. 1,08,07,870 or 13.23 per cent of land revenue and cesses realized. The ratio was 13 per cent in the preceding fasli. The village service charges (including proprietary estates) during the fasli were Rs. 1,20,50,640. Including this sum the total charges were Rs. 2,28,58,510 or 27.97 per cent of the collections of land revenue and cesses. It must however be pointed out that the establishment charged to land revenue performs multifarious duties of which the administration of the land is only one. The village establishment, especially, is the servant of all departments of Government. The result is that the actual cost of the collection of land revenue cannot be calculated with any exactitude; but it is certainly far less than the charges debited to this head.

22. *Processes under Act II of 1864.*—Statement No. 12 gives the particulars of the coercive processes issued for the realization of Government dues under Act II of 1864. The following extract shows the number of processes of each kind issued during the year as compared with the figures for the three preceding faslis :—

There has been a considerable increase in the total number of processes issued in this fasli compared with fasli 1331 and the previous two faslis.

23. *Demand notices.*—The rule that these notices should only be issued when absolutely necessary has been kept in view. There was decrease in seven districts and increase in 18 districts. The increase was most marked in North Arcot and Tanjore. The increase in North Arcot is attributed to the prompt action taken by the taluk officers in the collection of land revenue especially of penal charges levied for unauthorized occupation of Government land. The marked decrease in Guntūr is an obvious indication of the absence of the no-tax campaign, which formed the special feature of the previous fasli.

24. *Distrain or attachment.*—The number of processes under this head was 111,939 against 54,235 in fasli 1331 and 76,280 in fasli 1330. There was an increase in sixteen districts, the increase being most marked in Nellore, Anantapur, Bellary, North Arcot, South Arcot and Tanjore. In Anantapur and Bellary the increase is attributed to adverse season. In South Arcot it is ascribed to the tightness of the money market, while in North Arcot the reason has been explained in the foregoing paragraph.

25. As compared with the previous fasli there was an increase in the percentage borne by the number of distraints and attachments to that of demand notices.

The number of defaulters whose immovable property was attached during the year was 25,284 against 23,003 in fasli 1881. In the Madura district as in the previous years a large disproportion is noticeable between the number of defaulters whose personal property was distrained (1,236) and the number of those whose real property was attached (6,654). It is due as in former years to the fact that many of the landholders under the Periyar project are absentee pattadars. There is also similar disproportion in the Nellore, Chingleput, North Arcot and Tanjore districts.

26. *Sale notices.*—Out of 111,939 defaulters whose property was attached, 60,799 or 54.31 per cent paid the arrears before the sale notices were issued. The percentage was 29.47 in fasli 1881, 55.39 in fasli 1880 and 46.87 in fasli 1879.

27. *Sales.*—The number of defaulters whose property was sold is greater than in fasli 1881. The increase is noticeable in South Arcot. The Collector attributes the large number of sales to the tightness of the money market. The small number of sales in the Guntur district is again ample testimony to the subsidence of the non-co-operation movement in the district. The percentage of actual sales to sale notices was 12.87 against 12.73 in fasli 1881 and the percentage of the number of defaulters to the total number of pattas was 0.13 against 0.10 in the preceding fasli. The subjoined statement shows the particulars of sales in fasli 1882 compared with those for the three preceding faslis:—

Value of land sold.—Immovable property of the estimated value of Rs. 11,26,587 was sold for the recovery of arrears amounting to Rs. 2,38,719; the amount realized was Rs. 1,68,976. The price fetched on land sold to private individuals amounted on the average to six times the assessment in the case of dry lands and ten times the assessment in the case of wet lands. In fasli 1881 immovable property of the value of Rs. 2,80,951 was sold for the recovery of arrears amounting to Rs. 69,013 and Rs. 86,028 was realized, the average price fetched by lands sold to private individuals being four times the assessment in the case of dry lands and eight times in the case of wet lands. In the Tanjore district lands valued at Rs. 7,74,116 were sold for arrears amounting to Rs. 1,83,102 and Rs. 50,477 were realized.

Extent of land sold.—The extent of land sold during the year was 8,276 acres under 'dry' and 2,335 acres under 'wet' against 10,509 acres under 'dry' and 1,737 under 'wet' in fasli 1881. The extent of land sold was considerable in South Arcot, Tanjore and Madura.

The total area of land bought in by Government for want of bidders was 6,773 acres of dry and 643 acres of wet land against 5,180 acres of dry and 523 acres of wet land in fasli 1881.

28. *Process-service establishments.*—Statement No. 13 gives the particulars of processes served by the ordinary village agency or by special establishments and the fees realized during the year. The total number of processes served was 833,323 or 117,140 more than in fasli 1881. The number of processes served by special agency (54,040) was less than in the previous fasli (71,155).

29. *Costs in Civil Suits.*—Rupees 22,483 were awarded to Government as costs during the year. Including Rs. 29,520, the revised opening balance, the total demand was Rs. 52,003 of which Rs. 21,502 were collected. Rupees 300 were written off the accounts. The net recoverable balance at the end of the year was Rs. 30,201 made up of as follows:—

30. *Interest on arrears of land revenue.* (Statement No. 14).—The total demand on account of interest on arrears of land revenue including the balance at the beginning of the fasli was Rs. 53,763 of which Rs. 29,357 were collected and Rs. 4,669 remitted, leaving a balance of Rs. 19,737 against Rs. 23,992 in the previous fasli. The largest arrears are in Nellore (3,321), South Arcot (2,364) and Tanjore (3,818).

31. *Sale of land under Board's Standing Orders Nos. 15, 16, 20, 21, 22, 45, 90 and 91.*—Under the rules for the sale of occupancy right in lands at the disposal of Government (Standing Order No. 15) 4,680 acres assessed at Rs. 7,572 were sold for Rs. 4,21,838, 135 acres of tank-bed land assessed at Rs. 135 were sold for Rs. 15,055 under Standing Order No. 16, 104 acres of house-sites in towns were sold for Rs. 28,325 under Standing Order No. 21, 810 acres of land which had been bought in by Government at sales for arrears of revenue were resold under Standing Order No. 45 for Rs. 3,330. Two acres which had been acquired for public purposes and were subsequently relinquished were sold under Standing Order No. 90 for Rs. 3,531. Twenty acres of land for which the railway is not likely to have any further use were sold in the Tinnevely district for Rs. 216 under Standing Order No. 91. Thirteen acres in Madras were sold for Rs. 369 under the rules published in G.O. No. 61, Revenue, dated 11th January 1902.

32. *Subdivision of quit-rent.*—No applications were received during the year under Standing Order No. 58 for the subdivision of the joint liability of shareholders in whole inam villages or inams.

33. *Transfers of Registry of holdings.*—Transfers of revenue registration fall under the following two main heads:—

- (1) applications and notices received from Sub-Registrars,
 - (2) applications and intimations received from parties, village officers and others—
- (i) Under the first head 316,706 applications were received during the fasli as against 332,319 in the previous fasli, the decrease being 15,613 or about 4.70 per cent. The bulk of the decrease occurred in the districts of Kistna, Guntur, Chingleput, North Arcot, Trichinopoly, Madura and Tinnevely.

(ii) Under the second head, the number received was 94,278 as against 75,328 in the previous fasli, the increase being 18,950 or about 25.16 per cent, Chittoor district alone contributing an increase of 13,165. This increase is reported to be due to prompter reporting by karnams in accordance with B.P. No. 146, dated 20th September 1920.

The total number of applications of all kinds to be dealt with in the fasli under report, including the number pending disposal at its beginning, was 560,475; of these 440,657 were disposed of during the fasli leaving a balance of 119,818 as against 150,513 in the previous year. Of the total number of applications disposed of during the fasli 27,972 or 6.35 per cent were rejected and 9,657 were transferred to Deputy Tahsildars and Special Staff officers for disposal.

The percentage of pendency was high in Ganjam, Nellore, Cuddapah and South Arcot as in the previous years and also in the Agency division, Anantapur and Trichinopoly.

Out of a total of 560,475 cases for disposal under both the heads during the year, 39,267 were referred to Revenue Inspectors as against 35,732 in the previous year, Kistna and Tinnevely alone contributing 15,768. The Collectors of these districts are requested to see that such cases are not referred unnecessarily to Revenue Inspectors in future.

34. *Settlement by Collectors.*—The rule laid down in paragraph 2 of Board's Standing Order No. 12 that the settlement of each taluk should be conducted by the Collector himself once in five years was complied with except in (1) the taluks of Nugur, Bhadrachalam, Gunupur, Udayagiri and Yellavaram of the Agency division; (2) the Cocanada taluk of the Gōdāvari district; (3) the Tiruvur and Nuzvid divisions and the taluks of Gannavaram, Nandigam, Bezvada, Gudivada and Kaikalur in the Kistna district; (4) the Guntūr taluk of the Guntūr district; (5) the Dharmapuri taluk of the Salem district; and (6) the taluks of Kottayam, Kurumbranad, Calicut and Walluvanad of the Malabar district. In the Agency division item (1), the Commissioner could not settle any taluk on account of the Rampa disturbances. In Gōdāvari (item 2), the settlement by the Collector was overdue in the taluks of Razolē and Cocanada at the end of the previous fasli. The Collector took up the jamabandi of the former taluk during the fasli under report and could not settle the latter taluk as well. In Kistna (item 3), the Headquarters Sub-Collector was entrusted with the settlement of some of the taluks as the district is a heavy one, the Collector himself having conducted the jamabandi of the Tanuku taluk. As regards item 4 (Guntūr), the Collector states that owing to the modification of the programme for fasli 1331 on account of the then disturbed condition of the district, the taluks of Repalle, Nārasaraopet and Guntūr were due for the Collector's jamabandi in fasli 1332 and that he conducted the jamabandi of the first two taluks, leaving Guntūr to be settled by him in fasli 1333. In Salem (item 5), the jamabandi of the Atur taluk which was left over in the quinquennium ending with fasli 1331 was taken up in fasli 1332 instead of Dharmapuri which the Collector proposes to take up in fasli 1333. As regards item 6, the Collector explains that owing to the deviation made from the original programme in fasli 1330, he had to take up first the jamabandi of the Cochin taluk which was due for settlement in fasli 1330 and thus found it impossible to take up Walluvanad too without unduly delaying his enquiries into a large number of 'Mappilla Act' cases.

35. *Loans and advances.*—The advances made under the Land Improvement Loans Act during the year amounted to 7.61 lakhs and those under the Agriculturists' Loans Act to 7.20 lakhs, a total of 14.81 lakhs against 21.38 lakhs in fasli 1331. The difference was the net result of an increase in the amounts advanced in eleven and a decrease in fourteen districts. There were no transactions in Madras during the year. The advances granted in Kurnool and Bellary showed a considerable decrease over those of fasli 1331, the decrease in Bellary alone amounting to as much as Rs. 5.57 lakhs. The amount advanced in Ramnad was much in excess of that given in fasli 1331. The decrease in Kurnool and Bellary was due to the fact that loans were advanced on a considerable scale during the previous fasli on account of the famine, a condition which did not recur during the year under report. The increase in Ramnad was caused by the grant of a large loan to the Raja of Ramnad for the repair of certain railway-affected tanks in his zamindari.

36. Of the sum of Rs. 5.93 lakhs and 11.89 lakhs repayable during the year under the Land Improvement Loans and the Agriculturists' Loans Acts on account of principal, 4.35 lakhs or 73.4 per cent under the former Act and 8.40 lakhs or 70.6 per cent under the latter were collected. Advances amounting to Rs. 35,774 under the

Improvement Loans Act and Rs. 38,227 under the Agriculturists' Loans Act aid by borrowers on account of loans, the repayment of which had not fallen due a sum of Rs. 1,546 was written off as irrecoverable under the former Act 105 under the latter Act.

Coercive processes.—The aggregate amount of principal and interest repaying during the year under both the Acts, including the balance remaining unpaid of sums which fell due in previous years, was Rs. 24,40,982, of which a sum of Rs. 3,79,607 or 15.6 per cent was collected without resort to coercion and a sum of Rs. 12,47,426 or 51.1 per cent after issue of demand notices. A sum of Rs. 55,762 was collected after attachment of property but before sale, while the amounts realized by the sale of movable and immovable property amounted to Rs. 5,071 and Rs. 71,451 respectively. A sum of Rs. 1,755 was written off as irrecoverable under both principal and interest. The balance outstanding at the end of the year was Rs. 6,79,910, the arrears being very heavy in Bellary (Rs. 1,43,554), Tanjore (Rs. 1,31,715), Salem (Rs. 73,952), Anantapur (Rs. 58,828), Chingleput (Rs. 46,761) and Madura (Rs. 40,358).

38. The number of wells newly constructed and the number repaired during the year with the aid of loans under the Land Improvement Loans Act are shown below together with the corresponding figures for the previous fasli:—

As in the previous year, the largest number of wells (201) constructed or repaired during the year was in Salem. The numbers in North Arcot (174), Madura (146) and Anantapur (115) were also large. A sum of Rs. 52,662 was spent during the year on the reclamation of 1,006 acres of land against Rs. 36,062 in the previous fasli. Rupees 1,73,775 were spent on other improvements such as the removal of muth grass, the repair of private tanks and the construction of bunds and deepening of fields, altogether benefiting some 6,147 acres.

The following statement shows the purposes for which the advances made to cultivators under the Agriculturists' Loans Act during the two faslis 1331 and 1332 were utilized:—

39. *Survey advances.*—The advances drawn by Collectors during the official year 1922-23 under the head 'Revenue survey advances—Collectors' amounted to Rs. 84,808 as against Rs. 78,358 in the previous year. The amounts spent in the districts were as follow:—

Of the total amount of advances outstanding against Collectors, a sum of Rs. 2,43,869 under 'survey advances—Collectors'.

Under the head 'Cost of survey marks—Collectors', a sum of Rs. 55, collected during the year, leaving a balance of Rs. 17,596 to be realized. Arrears outstanding at the beginning of the year under the head 'Cost of survey marks—Survey officers' were Rs. 5,66,528. Fresh landholders' bills Rs. 5,65,915 were received from Survey officers during the year. Of the demand of Rs. 11,32,443 under this head, Rs. 6,07,733 were collected during the year, leaving an uncollected balance of Rs. 5,24,710.

40. *Junior Civilians.*—The reports from Collectors show generally that the Civilian Divisional Officers possess an adequate knowledge of the vernaculars and that the progress of Assistant Collectors is satisfactory.

41. *Growth of sub-letting in ryotwari tracts.*—Ryotwari lands were sub-let mainly by absentee pattadars, by those engaged in professions other than agriculture or by capitalists and large landholders. Sub-letting is on the increase in the Chingleput district as it is said the Adi-Dravidas who were hitherto working as farm servants now own lands themselves and are becoming more and more independent of the land-owning classes. In Gōdāvari there is a tendency on the part of the landholders to cultivate lands themselves owing to the increasing prices of food-grains. In the Rayadrug and Kudligi taluks of the Bellary district, sub-letting is generally on the decrease owing to the anxiety of the ryots to secure for themselves a full share of the produce. In the Anantapur district, the poverty of the soil and of the average ryot coupled with the unfavourable character of the season in the last three years has checked the tendency to sub-let.

42. *Effect of recent legislation on the people.*—The Madras Decentralization Act VIII of 1914, which empowered Tahsildars and Deputy Tahsildars to charge penalties in cases of unauthorized occupation and to deal with cases of irregular irrigation, is reported to have worked satisfactorily. The Indian Income-tax Act XI of 1922 and the Madras Court Fees and Stamp Amendment Acts are reported to be well understood by the people and to be working without any difficulty. The new District Municipalities Act, the Local Boards Act, the Village Panchayats Act and the Village Courts Act afford greater opportunities to the people to manage their local affairs and to participate more fully in the administration of local self government than formerly, but the successful working of these Acts is retarded to some extent by lack of co-operation and public spirit. The Madras Survey and Boundaries Act, 1923, came into force at the end of the fasli under report.

43. *Enhanced water cess for irregular irrigation.*—The system of publishing a general or collective notice in each village giving (1) preliminary intimation to ryots of their liability to enhanced water-cess for the irregular use of Government water and (2) a final intimation of the actual penalty charged immediately after the village account No. 6 is passed by the Tahsildar [vide B.P. No. 53 (Settlement), dated 10th April 1919] is generally reported to have worked fairly well. The system was not however followed in the taluks of Gooty, Tadpatri and Anantapur in the Anantapur district and steps are being taken by the Collector to enforce it. The ryots are generally aware of the rules and make timely representations to the Jambandi officer. The system has resulted in the prompt investigation of objections and consequent reduction in the number of water-rate appeals.

44. *Tank-bed cultivation.*—The special concession of cultivating tank-bed lands with food crops granted to ryots since fasli 1329 was withdrawn in G.O. Mis. No. 1613, Revenue, dated 2nd September 1922. The ordinary powers vested in Collectors to permit cultivation of tank-beds were unaffected by this order. During the fasli under report permission was accorded by Collectors for the cultivation of tank-beds in the districts of Kistna, Kurnool, Bellary and Chittoor. In Kistna the concession was granted in three villages of the Ellore taluk while in Kurnool it was granted only in the case of the Owk tank. In Chittoor permission was granted in 12 cases in consideration of the unfavourable season. In Bellary also owing to the adverse season permission was granted in respect of 15 tanks in the Rayadrug taluk, 14 in the Harpanahalli taluk and 7 in the Kudligi taluk. There were cases of unauthorized cultivation of such lands in the Gōdāvari Agency and in the districts

of Gōdāvari, Anantapur, Cuddapah, Nellore, Chingleput, Chittoor, North Arcot, Salem, Coimbatore and Madura. They were generally penalized under the provisions of Madras Act III of 1905, but in some cases the highest dry rate of the village was charged. In Trichinopoly 125 acres of tank-bed lands were cultivated in the taluks of Perambalur, Musiri, Laigudi and Trichinopoly, but the Collector has not stated whether the cultivation was authorized or not. The Collectors of North Arcot and Coimbatore report that the cultivation did not do any appreciable harm to the tanks. The Collectors of other districts have furnished no specific information on the point apparently because the effect of such cultivation would not be marked until after several years.

45. *Examination of village and taluk accounts.*—The maintenance of the accounts in ryotwari villages was fairly satisfactory and the examination disclosed no general errors of a serious nature. Such defects as were noticed were pointed out and promptly rectified in most cases. In the Vizagapatam Agency some accounts were not properly maintained, while a few others were not maintained at all. As regards non-Government villages, the system of accounts was introduced with effect from fasli 1329 and the report submitted to Government in 1922 showed that there was scope for much improvement. Government have sanctioned the introduction of these accounts in all non-Government villages except those in the Agency division.

46. *The taluk and village statistical registers.*—Taluk statistical registers prescribed in the Manual of Taluk Accounts were maintained in the districts of the Nilgiris, Malabar, South Kanara and Anjengo. Village statistical registers were maintained in the ryotwari villages of all the other districts except Madras. The subjoined statement shows the progress made in the writing up and checking of the registers up to and during fasli 1332 (1922-23).

The work of opening these registers was completed or nearly complete in all districts; they were not however brought up to date (i.e., up to the end of fasli 1332) in some districts, notably in Bellary, Anantapur and Chingleput. The preparation of these registers in non-Government villages has been ordered to be discontinued in B.P. Mis. No. 445, dated 22nd February 1923.

47. *Minor irrigation.*—Statement No. 19 shows for each district the number of irrigation works in charge of the Revenue Department, the number repaired and the amount spent on them during the official year ending 31st March 1923. It also shows the number proposed for repairs during the official year ending 31st March 1924.

48. *Conference with ryots.*—Everywhere except (1) in the Rajampet division of the Cuddapah district and (2) in the Chittoor division of the Chittoor district, conferences with ryots were held by Collectors and Divisional Officers during their tours and at the time of jamabandi. The Collector of Coimbatore, however, is silent on this point and the Collectors of Chingleput, North Arcot and Tinnevely have not specifically reported whether the Divisional Officers in their districts held any conferences. The Revenue Divisional Officer, Rajampet, held no conference during the last two faslis either. The Collector has promised to draw the Divisional Officer's attention to the orders on the subject. The Collector of Chittoor reports that the Revenue Divisional Officer, Chittoor, did not hold any conferences as there was no necessity for them. The Collector of Vizagapatam states that no steps were taken in this direction in the Agency portions of his district.

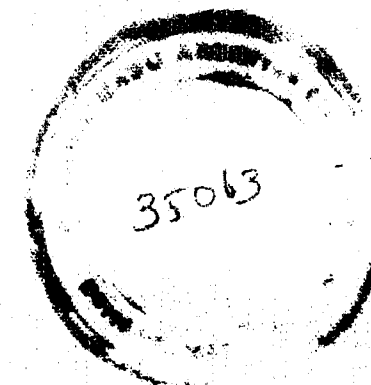
2. The Government observe that the season was on the whole not unfavourable from an agricultural standpoint. There was no famine or scarcity during the year. The amount of season remissions was less than in the previous fasli by Rs. 66 lakh.

3. The revenue was collected without much difficulty though there was an increase in the total number of processes issued in the fasli.

4. The total amount advanced during the year under the Loans Acts was Rs. 14.81 lakhs. There was an appreciable increase in the number of wells newly constructed or repaired with the aid of loans under Land Improvement Loans Act.
