1. The Board submits its report on the settlement of land revenue in the Province of Madras for fasli 1353 (1943-44) together with the prescribed statements.

Main features. The main features of the fasli were—

(i) On the whole the season was generally fair in the Province except in Vizagapatam, Guntur, Nellore, Rannad and Tinnevely—vide paragraph 4 below.

(ii) The total extent of ryotwari holdings increased by 9,850 acres from 27,646,403—vide paragraph 7.

(iii) The total assessment on holdings showed an increase of Rs. 11,57,7 from Rs. 6,02,67,494 in the previous fasli—vide paragraph 8.

(iv) The total area cultivated in ryotwari holdings decreased by 105,725 acres—vide paragraph 9.

(v) The amount of water-rate and second crop charge increased by Rs. 11,14,161—vide paragraph 10.

(vi) Seasonal remissions decreased by Rs. 33,78,082—vide paragraph 11 (i).

(vii) Fixed remissions increased by Rs. 9,500—vide paragraph 11 (ii).

(viii) Beriz deductions decreased by Rs. 1,23,894—vide paragraph 11 (iii).

(ix) The amount of revenue remitted under this fasli was 19.6 lakhs as against 57.7 lakhs in the previous fasli—vide paragraph 11.

(x) Miscellaneous revenue increased by Rs. 6,78,181—vide paragraph 12.

(xi) There was a decrease in the number of land sales—vide paragraph 26.

2. *Season.*—(1) The south-west monsoon set in on the Malabar Coast early at the beginning of the second week of May. This proved to be only a temporary phase and the regular advance of the monsoon took place on the Malabar Coast on the 29th May. The monsoon was generally active in June. Thunder showers occurred over the Peninsula during the second and last week of the month. The rainfall in June was above the normal in Vizagapatam, West Godavari, Kistna, Guntur, Chingleput, Tinnevely, Malabar and South Kanara and below the normal in the other districts of the Province. The monsoon continued to be active on the West Coast in July and the interior of the Peninsula it was active in the beginning of the month. The rainfall in the month was normal in East Godavari (Plains), above the normal in Guntur, Cuddapah, Nellore, Chittoor, Malabar, South Kanara and the Nilgiris and below the normal elsewhere. In August, the monsoon weakened and the rainfall was below the normal except in East Godavari (Plains), Chingleput, South Arcot and North Arcot as a result of the insufficient rainfall in the month, dry crops in parts of the Deccan were affected by drought to some extent. Except for a temporary strengthening in the first fortnight of September, the monsoon was feeble on the West Coast. The rainfall in the month was bordering on the normal in Cuddapah and Tinnevely, above the normal in the Circars (except Vizagapatam), Kurnool, Bellary, South Arcot, Trichinopoly, Tanjore, Malabar, South Kanara and the Nilgiris and below the normal in the other districts of the Province. Over the whole period of the south-west monsoon (June to September) rainfall was below the normal in all the districts of the Province except East Godavari (Plains), West Godavari, Guntur, South Kanara and the Nilgiris.

Freshes came down the main rivers in time and continued steady and generally sufficient for agricultural operations.

Sowings of the early crops were above the average in the Circars and West Coast (dry crops only). In the rest of the Province, sowings of early dry crops were below the average and of early wet crops above the average.

The condition of the standing crops was generally satisfactory except in parts of the Deccan.

(2) A depression formed in the Bay on 3rd October, intensified into a cyclonic storm and crossed the coast near Malabar on the 10th. Associated with this depression there was widespread and locally heavy rain in the Peninsula from the 10th to 12th. The heavy rains and storm caused much damage to irrigation sources in the Chingleput district and to huts and houses in Madras City, rendering thousands of people homeless. Conditions again became unsettled in the south-west Bay of Bengal on the 14th intensified into a cyclonic storm on the 16th and crossed the coast near Nellore, causing widespread and locally heavy rain between the 13th and 16th. The north-east monsoon became well-established in the south of the Peninsula in the last week of October and the rainfall was fairly widespread between the 23rd and 27th. The rainfall in October was above the normal in all the districts of the Province and very heavy in the districts of Nellore, Chingleput, Chittoor, North Arcot and Malabar. The monsoon was generally active for a week from the 6th of November in the south of the Peninsula and between the 20th and 23rd November. It became weak in the last week of the month. The rainfall in November was normal or bordering on the normal in the Anantapur, Kurnool, Ramnad and Tirunelveli, above the normal in Vizagapatam (Plains), Giddalohi, Malabar and South Kanara and below the normal elsewhere. The monsoon revived during the first week of December and caused widespread and locally heavy rain accompanied by thunderstorms in south-east Madras. Local showers occurred in parts of the Peninsula on the 12th, 13th, 20th to 22nd and 27th to 31st December 1943. There was practically no rain in the month in the Circars and the Deccan and the fall was below the normal in the rest of the Province except South Arcot. The monsoon was generally weak in January except between the 8th and 11th when it caused local showers in south-east Madras. Over the whole period of the north-east monsoon (October 1943 to January 1944) rainfall was bordering on the normal in Ramnad, above the normal in Vizagapatam (Plains), West Godavari, the Deccan, Nellore, Chingleput, the Central districts, Madura, Malabar and South Kanara and below the normal in the rest of the Province.

Sowings of the late crops were above the average except in the Circars.

The condition of the late crops was generally fair except in parts of the Deccan where dry crops were affected by pests and in Ramnad where they were affected by drought.

(3) Thunder showers occurred locally in the North Madras Coast between the 9th and 13th and in the south of the Peninsula between the 19th and 23rd February 1944. The weather became unsettled in the south-west Bay of Bengal on the morning of the 1st March, intensified into a cyclonic storm and crossed the Coast south of Madras causing widespread and locally heavy rain in the first week of the month. Local thunder showers occurred in the Peninsula on the 7th and 8th, 11th and 14th and on the 27th and 28th. The rainfall in the month was above the normal in all the districts of the Province. Thunder showers occurred in the parts of the Province in the first and last

week of April. The rainfall in the month was normal or above the normal in Vizagapatam, East Godavari (Plains), West Godavari, Salem, Madura, Ramnad and Tirunelveli and below the normal elsewhere. There were scattered showers in May. The rainfall in the month was bordering on the normal in Giddalohi, above the normal in Bellary, Coimbatore and South Kanara and below the normal in the other districts of the Province.

(4) On the whole, the season was generally fair in the year under review in the Province except Vizagapatam, Guntur, Nellore, Ramnad and Tirunelveli.

The fasli opened with twenty-six relief works in the Bellary district, fourteen relief works in the Anantapur district and five relief works in the Kurnool district, the average number of persons relieved daily in all the three districts during the week ending the 3rd July 1943 being 306,742 of whom 233,592 were workers and 67,150 received gratuitous relief. Drought continued severe in all the three districts and additional relief works were opened in July and August. The total number of persons relieved daily in all the three districts during the week ending the 3rd September 1943 rose to 484,036, of whom 381,368 were workers. Seasonal conditions improved in September and good rains were received from the 1st to the 10th of this month and in the next month. In consequence people found employment in agricultural operations and the average daily output of the Government relief works began to decline. The relief works were closed down after a further week and the grant of relief was stopped completely by the end of December 1943.

(5) Remission of land revenue was appreciably less in the fasli under review than in the previous fasli in most districts. The only districts in which remission of land revenue was granted on a fairly large scale were (i) Vizagapatam (Rs. 46,442), (ii) Kistna (Rs. 99,000) and (iii) Guntur (Rs. 69,923). In view of the adverse seasonal conditions graded remission of assessment on dry lands ranging from 25 to 100 per cent was granted by the Government in six villages in the Yemmanur sub-taluk and seven villages in the Alur taluk in Bellary district. The amount involved was Rs. 14,726.

In addition to the seasonal remissions referred to above, the Government continued the temporary reduction of water cess in East and West Godavari and Kistna districts and in the deltaic tracts of Guntur.

The collection of the suspended land revenue of fasli 1352 in the taluks of Bellary, Rayachoti, Siruguppa, Alur and Yemmanur sub-taluk of the Bellary district was postponed to fasli 1354. The portion of the land revenue for fasli 1352 collection of which had been postponed to fasli 1353 in certain villages of the taluks of Dharmavaram, Rayachoti, Anantapur, Gooty, Talipatri, Madakasira and Perumunda in the Anantapur district was remitted.

(6) Stocks of fodder were generally sufficient.

3. The total number of ryotwari villages in the Presidency was 21,101 the same as in the last fasli.

4. The land revenue of the Province is derived from the following sources:—

- (i) Peshkash or revenue from permanently settled estates,
- (ii) shrotriyam jodi or quit-rent levied on inam villages,
- (iii) assessment including water-rate on lands held under ryotwar tenure, and
- (iv) miscellaneous revenue.

5. *Peshkash or revenue from permanently settled estates.*—The total amount of peshkash payable during the fasli was Rs. 47,50,169 as against Rs. 47,42,420 (revised figure) in the previous fasli. The increase of Rs. 7,749 is explained below :—

6. The quit-rent payable on villages held on shrotriyam or favourable tenure was Rs. 7,33,974 as against Rs. 7,33,996 (revised figure) in the previous fasli. The decrease of Rs. 22 is explained below :—

7. The total extent of ryotwari holdings during the fasli was 17,656,253 acres as against 27,646,403 acres of the previous fasli which shows an increase of 9,850 acres. There was an increase in all the districts except in the following where there was a decrease :

East Godavari (3,649 acres), Guntur (32 acres), Nellore (175 acres), Kurnool (264 acres), Chingleput (32 acres) and Trichinopoly (337 acres). The increase was marked in the districts of Tanjore (3,180 acres), South Kanara (4,616 acres), Malabar (3,186 acres) and Chittoor (1,038 acres).

The increase in Malabar was mainly due to the transfer of unoccupied dry land to occupied dry. The increase in the other districts was chiefly due to fresh assignments and resumption of minor inams.

8. The total assessment of holdings was Rs. 603.79 lakhs as against Rs. 603.67 lakhs in the previous fasli showing a net increase of Rs. 0.12 lakh. There was an increase in all the districts except the following where there was a decrease :—

East Godavari (Rs. 216), Cuddapah (Rs. 8,086), Bellary (Rs. 21), Chingleput (Rs. 117), Ramnad (Rs. 275) and Coimbatore (Rs. 479). The increase was marked in Tanjore (Rs. 3,293), Salem (Rs. 5,262), South Kanara (Rs. 3,804) and Malabar (Rs. 4,827). The decrease in Cuddapah (Rs. 8,086) was due to reduction in the classification of some irrigation sources. The decrease in other districts is not appreciable.

9. (i) The total area cultivated in ryotwari holdings was 20.59 million acres as against 20.70 million acres in the previous fasli. There was a net

increase of 20,187 acres under dry and a net decrease of 125,912 acres under wet resulting in a net decrease of 105,725 acres.

(ii) The total area cultivated during the fasli including that under miscellaneous cultivation was 215.87 lakhs acres as against 215.57 (revised figure) in the previous fasli. There was a decrease of 1,286 acres under waste charged.

10. *Water-rate and second crop charge.*—The revenue derived from this source amounted to Rs. 52.98 lakhs against Rs. 41.84 lakhs in the previous fasli. There was an increase of Rs. 12,21,417 in some districts and a decrease of Rs. 1,97,316 in other districts resulting in a net increase of Rs. 11,14,101. The increase was marked in all the districts except in the following where there was a decrease :—

Vizagapatnam (Rs. 8,433), East Godavari (Rs. 85,286), West Godavari (Rs. 27,474) and Ramnad (Rs. 6,123). The increase was due to adequate supply of water. The decrease in Vizagapatnam was due to want of adequate supply of water. In East Godavari it was due to the decrease in the area cultivated under second crop and fasljasti crops in view of the introduction of the localization scheme with considerable reduction in the number of channels opened for irrigation. In West Godavari the decrease was due to the fact that no additional areas were thrown open for the cultivation of dalwa paddy on account of scarcity of water and in Ramnad it was due to the unfavourable season.

11. *Remissions.* There was a total remission of Rs. 190 lakhs of which Rs. 6.2 lakhs were seasonal remissions. As compared with the previous year, there was a decrease of Rs. 38.99 lakhs. The decrease was marked in all the districts except in West Godavari, Madras, Trichinopoly, Ramnad, Madura, Tinnevely and Tanjore where there was an increase.

(i) *Seasonal remissions.* The amount remitted under this head was Rs. 6,18,611 as against Rs. 39,96,700 (revised figure) in the previous fasli and there was a net decrease of Rs. 33,78,089. The decrease was due to favourable conditions of the season and was appreciable in all the districts except in West Godavari, Kistna, Tanjore, Madura, Ramnad, Tinnevely and Trichinopoly districts where there was an increase.

(a) *Waste remissions.*—The total amounts remitted under this head was Rs. 1.6 lakhs against Rs. 4.8 lakhs (revised figure) in the previous fasli, resulting in a net decrease of Rs. 3.2 lakhs.

(b) *Sari or loss of crop.*—The total amount remitted under this head was Rs. 1,59,474 against Rs. 9,12,285 (revised figure) in the previous fasli, resulting in a net decrease of Rs. 7,52,811 which was due to favourable conditions of the season. The decrease is marked in all the districts except in the following, where there was an increase : West Godavari (Rs. 3,751), Kistna (Rs. 4,822), Tanjore (Rs. 25,058), Trichinopoly (Rs. 8,731), Madura (Rs. 10,199), Ramnad (Rs. 3,504), Tinnevely (Rs. 5,109) and Coimbatore (Rs. 675).

(c) *Pirakammi remissions, i.e., remissions of the difference between wet and dry assessment on wet lands cultivated with dry crops on account of insufficiency or failure of water-supply.* The amount remitted under this head was Rs. 2,46,340 against Rs. 8,52,497 in the previous fasli, resulting in a net decrease of Rs. 6,18,157. The decrease was marked in all the districts except in the following, where there was an increase : West Godavari (Rs. 1,331), Tanjore (Rs. 879), Madura (Rs. 5,942), Ramnad (Rs. 17,091) and Tinnevely (Rs. 16,761). The decrease was due to adequate and timely supply of water.

(d) *Injury by floods.* The amount remitted under this head was Rs. 1,18,778 against Rs. 22,245 in the previous fasli resulting in the net increase of (Rs. 6,573).

(e) *Remission of second-crop charge.*—The amount remitted under this head was Rs. 10,833 against Rs. 6,045 (revised figure) in the previous fasli.

(f) *Short crop of paddy.*—The amount remitted under this head was Rs. 25,722 against Rs. 16,08,410 in the previous fasli resulting in the net decrease of Rs. 15,82,888.

(ii) *Fixed remissions (i.e., abatement of demand on account of reasons unconnected with the season).*—The amount remitted under this head was Rs. 1,05,568 against Rs. 1,61,068 the net increase being Rs. 9,500.

(iii) *Beriz deductions.*—Deductions made in favour of inamdars and religious institutions amounted to Rs. 10,13,655 against Rs. 11,37,549 (revised figure) showing a net decrease of Rs. 1,23,894.

(iv) *Land Revenue concessions.*—As the economic condition of the agriculturists has generally improved with the rise in prices of agricultural produce, the Government withdrew in fasli 1353 the general concessions of land revenue granted in the previous faslis. But special dry remission of Rs. 14,726 on account of loss of crop due to adverse seasonal conditions was granted in 13 villages of the Bellary district.

12. *Miscellaneous revenue.*—The revenue under this head amounted to Rs. 122.50 lakhs against Rs. 115.72 lakhs (as now revised) in the previous fasli. There was an increase of Rs. 8,31,192 and a decrease of Rs. 1,52,710 resulting in a net increase of Rs. 6,78,482. The several items of revenue are dealt with below:—

(i) *Jodi and qui rent on minor inams.*—The revenue under this head was Rs. 23.56 lakhs against Rs. 10.99 lakhs (revised figure) of previous fasli.

(ii) (a) *Second crop charge on minor inam wet lands in ryotwari villages.*—The revenue derived under this head was Rs. 2.57 lakhs against Rs. 1.98 lakhs (now revised) in the previous fasli the increase being Rs. 0.58 lakhs.

(b) *Water-rate on minor inams in ryotwari villages.*—The revenue under this head was Rs. 17.84 lakhs as against Rs. 17.48 lakhs (revised figure) in the previous fasli the increase being of Rs. 35,861.

(iii) *Charge for water in villages in estates including tirvjasti and fashjasti.*—The revenue under this head was Rs. 33.99 lakhs as against Rs. 32.72 lakhs (revised figure) in the previous fasli resulting in an increase of Rs. 1,26,753.

(iv) *Enhanced water-rate on lands irregularly irrigated.*—The revenue under this head was Rs. 2.65 lakhs against as Rs. 2.49 lakhs (revised figure) in the previous fasli, showing an increase of Rs. 15,942.

(v) *Charges levied for occupation (with or without permission) of assessed and unassessed lands.*—The revenue under this head was Rs. 6.90 lakhs as against Rs. 6.49 lakhs (revised figure) in the last fasli showing an increase of Rs. 40,637.

(vi) *Charges levied for occupation of poramboke lands.*—The revenue under this head was Rs. 5.52 lakhs as against Rs. 4.68 lakhs (revised figure) in the previous fasli, showing an increase of Rs. 83,818.

Taram assessment was levied on an extent of 134,752 acres as against 115,203 acres in the previous fasli. Such occupation was extensive in the districts of Guntur (16,557 acres), Nellore (13,411 acres), Cuddapah (5,600 acres), Bellary (7,227 acres), Kurnool 10,351 acres), North Arcot (6,456 acres), South Arcot (5,892 acres), Tanjore (11,077 acres), Trichinopoly (13,605 acres) and Salem (10,840 acres).

(vii) *Revenue derived from taxed trees.* The revenue under this head was Rs. 3,27,144 as against Rs. 3,26,633 (revised figure) in the previous fasli.

(viii) *Commission for Estates under the Court of Wards.*—Revenue under this head was Rs. 30,472 as against Rs. 40,463 (now revised) in the previous fasli showing a decrease of Rs. 9,991.

(ix) *Revenue from process fees.*—The revenue derived under this head was Rs. 8,496 as against Rs. 6,698 (revised figure) in the previous fasli resulting in an increase of Rs. 1,798.

(x) *Sale-proceeds of lands sold.*—The revenue under this head was Rs. 4.47 lakhs against Rs. 5.90 lakhs (revised figure) in the previous fasli showing a decrease of Rs. 1.43 lakhs. The decrease is marked in Guntur (Rs. 11,221), Tanjore (Rs. 1,54,540) and Salem (Rs. 11,656).

(xi) *Rent of hulkas.*—The revenue under this head was Rs. 5.56 lakhs against Rs. 4.47 lakhs resulting in an increase of Rs. 1.09 lakhs.

(xii) *Quit-rent and ground-rent.*—Revenue under this head was Rs. 2.99 lakhs against Rs. 2.79 lakhs (revised figure) in the previous fasli showing the net increase of Rs. 0.2 lakh.

13. The net ryotwari demand including water-rate, second crop charge and miscellaneous revenue amounted to Rs. 759.65 lakhs against Rs. 703.51 lakhs (revised figure) in the previous fasli, resulting in an increase of Rs. 56,13,438. The details for the net increase are given below:—

16. *Demand, collection and balance of land revenue and cesses (current).*—The current demand under land revenue and cesses during the fasli was Rs. 9,79,81,984. A sum of Rs. 9,65,32,307 or 98.52 per cent was collected within the fasli and Rs. 4,13,991 or 0.43 per cent written off the accounts. The collection of a sum of Rs. 18,199 or 0.02 per cent was suspended or postponed. The percentage of collection to the collectable demand was the afore 98.96 per cent. The percentage of collection to demand during the previous fasli was 90.79 per cent, that written off was 7.65 and that suspended or postponed was 0.15. The percentage of collection to the collectable demand was 98.4. The land revenue collections for fasli 1353 have been dealt with in paragraph 11 (iv) above.

17. *Demand and collection of arrears.*—The total arrears demand under all the heads amounted to Rs. 19,53,470. A sum of Rs. 11,97,939 or 61.32 per cent was collected and a sum of Rs. 1,65,456 or 8.46 per cent was written off the accounts. The collection of Rs. 3,66,046 or 18.73 per cent was postponed or suspended. The percentage of collection in the previous fasli was 82.3 and that written off was 2.1 per cent.

18. The balance outstanding at the end of the fasli including both arrears and current was Rs. 16,19,721 against Rs. 18,39,060 at the end of the previous fasli. As reported by the Collectors in their demand collection and balance statements for September 1944, the balance at the beginning of fasli 1354 was Rs. 14,48,269. Up to the end of September 1944, a sum of Rs. 5,73,596 was collected and Rs. 16,553 written off the accounts. Proposals have been made to write off Rs. 17,772. The net recoverable balance on 1st October 1944 was thus Rs. 8,49,348. Out of this amount a sum of Rs. 4,49,663 is covered by orders of suspension or postponements in the Presidency. Deducting this amount, the realizable balance on 1st October 1944 was Rs. 3,99,685.

19. *Adjustment to local boards of cesses collected during the fasli.*—Land revenue and cesses are collected together and the distribution of the total collections between the land revenue and cesses is effected in the Collectors' offices after the compilation of the accounts relating to the fasli year.

The statements showing the amounts collected during the fasli 1353 on behalf of the local boards, the payments made to them during the fasli, and the amounts to be finally adjusted either to their credit or debit, are received from the Collectors. After verification by the Accountant-General of the amounts shown by Collectors as payments made to local boards, the recovery of over-payments is being watched by the Board in accordance with the instructions contained in paragraph 3 of G.O. No. 5197, L. & M., dated 7th December 1926.

20. *Charges debitable to land revenue.*—The charges in the Land Revenue department are shown in the accounts under the head "25. General Administration." The district administration charges excluding village establishments amounted to Rs. 123.76 lakhs during fasli 1353. The village service charges including those of the proprietary estates during the fasli were Rs. 128.55 lakhs. The total charges amounted to Rs. 252.31 lakhs or 25.82 per cent of the total land revenue and cesses collected.

It has, however, to be borne in mind that the expenditure does not represent merely the cost of collecting the land revenue. The Land Revenue department performs many duties of which the control and collection of land revenue is only one. The village establishment in particular is the

servant of all the departments of the Government. Moreover a considerable portion of the time of the Collector and his subordinate officials is occupied with magisterial work and of late with war and civil supplies work also. While the actual cost of collecting the land revenue cannot be estimated with any degree of accuracy it is far less than the amount of expenditure shown above.

General establishments

21. *Processes under Act II of 1864.*—Statement No. 12 gives particulars of coercive processes issued for the realization of the Government dues under Madras Act II of 1864. The following extract shows the number of processes issued during the fasli under report as compared with those for the three preceding faslis :—

There is a general decrease in the number of demand, distraint or attachment and sale notices and the number of defaulters whose properties (personal or real) were sold shows a decrease of 70 per cent as compared with fasli 1352.

22. *Demand notices.*—The number of demand notices issued during the fasli is less than those of the three previous faslis 1350, 1351 and 1352.

23. *Distrain or attachment notices.* There is a decrease in the number of distraint or attachment notices when compared with those of the three previous faslis.

24. There is an increase of 5.85 per cent in the percentage of the number of notices of distraint and attachment of personal property to the total number of demand notices when compared with the previous fasli. There is a decrease of 0.54 per cent in respect of real property.

The number of defaulters whose immovable properties were attached during the fasli was 3,306 against 8,687 in fasli 1352.

25. *Sale notices.*—Out of 19,873 defaulters whose properties were attached 94 per cent paid up the arrears before sale notices were issued as against 32.94 in the last fasli. The number of notices of sale was large in Malabar (2,480).

26. *Sales.*—The number of defaulters whose properties were sold in the fasli was less than that in fasli 1352 by 29.40. There was a decrease in the number of sales of personal property by 1,266 and also the number of sales of real property by 16.74. The percentage borne by the actual number of sales to the number of sale notices in the Province is 14.03 against 13.76 in fasli 1352. The percentage of the number of defaulters whose properties were sold to the total number of holdings is 0.02 against 0.06 in the previous fasli.

Value of lands sold.—Immovable property of the estimated value of Rs. 35,822 was sold for the recovery of arrears amounting to Rs. 17,750. The estimated value of lands sold was disproportionate to the amount of arrears in some of the districts. The prices fetched for lands sold to private

individuals amounted on the average to 1-2/5 times the assessment in the case of dry lands; and 6 2/50 times the assessment in the case of wet lands. In fasli 1352 immovable property of the estimated value of Rs. 1,75,029 was sold for the recovery of arrears amounting to Rs. 41,401 and the amount realized was Rs. 42,157. The average price fetched for lands sold to private individuals is much less than in fasli 1352 in the case of both dry and wet lands, being 1-2/5 and 6 7/50 the assessment against 4-19/20 and 6-3/5 times respectively in fasli 1352.

Extent of lands sold. The extent of lands sold to private individuals in the fasli was 667.51 acres under dry and 660.46 acres under wet, against 1,936 acres and 297 acres respectively in fasli 1352. The total area bought in by Government for want of bidders was 471.65 acres under dry and 23.08 acres under wet against 2,090 acres and 408 acres respectively in fasli 1352. The total area of lands sold is 8,22.70 acres against the total holdings of 6,689,824 acres.

27. *Process-service establishments.* Statement No. 13 gives the particulars of processes served by the ordinary village agency and by the special establishment and of the fees realized during the fasli. The total number of processes served by the village agency was 712,339 or less than that in fasli 1352 by 162,844. The number of processes served by the special agency (14,830) was less than that in the previous fasli by 4,153.

28. *Costs in civil suits.*—A sum of Rs. 31,450 was awarded to Government as costs during the fasli. Including the revised opening balance the total demand was Rs. 1,15,010-7-4 of which Rs. 55,621-8-7 was collected and Rs. 1,252-7-4 written off the accounts. The net recoverable balance at the end of the fasli was Rs. 56,873-10-11.

29. *Interest on arrears of land revenue.*—The total demand on account of interest on arrears of land revenue including the balance at the beginning of the fasli was Rs. 88,383 of which Rs. 26,176 was collected and Rs. 1,159 was remitted leaving a balance of Rs. 61,048. The balance is nil in Madras, Coimbatore and the Nilgiris, and exceeds Rs. 1,000 in East Godavari, Krishna, Nellore, Chingleput, Chittoor, South Arcot, Tanjore, Madura, Ramnad and Malabar.

30. *Sale of lands under B.S.O. Nos. 15, 16, 21, 22, 45, 90, 91 and 197.*—2,994.15 acres of lands assessed at Rs. 4,077-11-0 were sold for Rs. 4,08,941-11-0 under S. O. No. 15, 33.71 acres of house-sites with a ground rent of Rs. 241-14-0 were sold for Rs. 29,676-11-0 under S.O. No. 21. An extent of 6.49 cent with a ground rent of Rs. 8-11-0 was sold for Rs. 61 under B.S.O. No. 22. An extent of 326.53 acres of land bought in by the Government at sales for arrears of land revenue, was resold under B.S.O. No. 45 for Rs. 6,182-12-0.

44.54 acres of lands which had been acquired for public purposes, but subsequently relinquished were sold under S.O. No. 90 for Rs. 5,786-1-0. An extent of 4.32 acres of land for which the ryots were not likely to have any further use, was sold for Rs. 1,397 under S.O. No. 91. There have been no sales of tank-bed lands during the year under reports.

31. *Subdivision of quit-rent.*—In the fasli, there were no cases of subdivision under B.S.O. No. 58 of the joint liability of shareholders in enfranchised inams to the payment of quit-rent.

32. In view of the orders in G.O. No. 2595, Revenue dated 18th November 1942, the Collectors of districts did not conduct jamabandi.

33. The advances made under the Land Improvement Loans and Agriculturists' Loans Acts during the year amounted to Rs. 10.76 lakhs against Rs. 8.51 lakhs in the previous year. The amount advanced during the year under the Agriculturists' Loans (Madras Amendment) Act, 1935, for the relief of the agricultural indebtedness was Rs. 31. This scheme was suspended by the Government for the duration of the war in G.O. Ms. No. 95 (S), Revenue, dated 11th August 1942 and since then no loans are being granted for the purpose.

34. Including the uncollected balance at the end of the previous year, the amount repayable during the year on account of principal under both the Land Improvement Loans and Agriculturists' Loans Acts was Rs. 20.89 lakhs against Rs. 12.88 lakhs in the preceding year. Of this amount a sum of Rs. 14.65 lakhs or 70 per cent was collected. A sum of Rs. 1.38 lakhs was repaid by the borrowers on account of loans, the repayment of which had not fallen due, while a sum of Rs. 692 was written off as irrecoverable.

The amount repayable during the year under the Agriculturists' Loans (Madras Amendment) Act, 1935, was Rs. 1.68 lakhs of which Rs. 1.53 lakhs was collected.

The aggregate amount of principal and interest repayable during the year under the Land Improvement Loans and Agriculturists' Loans Acts, including the balance remaining unpaid out of sums which fell due in the previous years was Rs. 25,36,715 of which a sum of Rs. 18,22,365 was collected and a sum of Rs. 692 was written off. The balance outstanding at the end of the year was Rs. 7,13,658 as against Rs. 1,49,808 in the previous year.

35. The aggregate amount of principal and interest repayable during the year under the Agriculturists' Loans (Madras Amendment) Act, 1935, was Rs. 2,57,705 of which a sum of Rs. 2,36,180 was collected and a sum of Rs. 6,751 was written off. The outstanding balance during the year was Rs. 20,850.

36. The Debt Conciliation Boards established to dispose of the pending cases, completed their work and ceased to function in all the districts. The work done during the fasli was generally on the decline as compared with the previous fasli.

37. *Enhanced water-cess on irregular irrigation.*—The system of publishing a general or collective notice in each village in accordance with B.P. No. 53, Settlement, dated 10th April 1919, is reported to have worked well. The ryots were aware of the rules and made timely representations to the Jamabandi Officers. It resulted in the prompt investigation of objections and consequent reduction in the number of water-rate appeals. In cases where Government water was taken without permission deterrent penalties were imposed.

38. *Cultivation of tank-bed lands.*—As a result of the Grow More Food Campaign, there was a considerable increase in the cultivation of tank-bed lands. Wherever the cultivation was permitted, ordinary rates were charged; and cases of objectionable cultivation were dealt with under the provisions of the Madras Land Encroachment Act.

39. *Cowle.*—During the fasli, 8 acres of land were held on cowle for Rs. 10 as in the previous fasli.

40. *Examination of village and taluk accounts.*—Maintenance of these registers was fairly satisfactory and no general errors of a serious nature were disclosed.

41. *Taluk and village statistical registers.*—The taluk statistical registers prescribed in the Manual of Taluk Accounts (Special) were maintained in the districts of Malabar, South Kanara and the Nilgiris.

The village statistical registers were maintained in all the ryotwari villages of the other districts. The following statement shows the progress made in the writing up and checking of these registers up to and during the fasli :—

42. *Minor irrigation.*—Statement No. 19 shows by each district the number of works in charge of the Revenue department, the number repaired and the amount spent on them during the official year ending 31st March 1944. The statement also shows the number proposed for repairs during the official year ending 31st March 1945.

43. *Ryots' conferences.*—Ryots' conferences were held in all the districts except Cingleput, Coimbatore and Malabar and steps were taken to redress the grievances of the ryots.

44. *Extent to which the inspection of subordinate offices has been carried out by the Board, the Collectors and the Revenue Divisional Officers.*—All subordinate offices (excepting the Madras Taluk office) were inspected by the Collectors and the Revenue Divisional Officers. The Collectors' inspections of the Revenue Divisional offices was generally thorough. The Board examined the notes of inspection of the Revenue Divisional Officers and issued suitable instructions.

During the fasti under report the Members of the Board of Revenue inspected the offices of the Collectors of East Godavari, Kistna, Nellore, Cuddapah, Kurnool, Bellary, Madras, South Arcot, Tanjore, Tiruchirappalli and the Nilgiris with reference to the instructions in G.Os. Ms. No. 2086, Revenue, dated 17th September 1942, and Ms. No. 2954, Revenue, dated 22nd November 1943, and found that the administration of the districts continued to be efficient.

45. *Administration of charitable and religious service inams.*—In their order Ms. No. 851, Revenue, dated 25th April 1944, the Government suspended for the duration of the war the submission of the annual periodical statements showing the religious and charitable inams resumed during the year.

2. The percentage of collection of principal and interest under loans under the Land Improvement and Agriculturists' Loans Acts in the fasli is 71.8 as against 90.6 in the previous fasli. The Government observe that the fall in collection is unexpected in these days when agriculturists are obtaining high prices for their products.

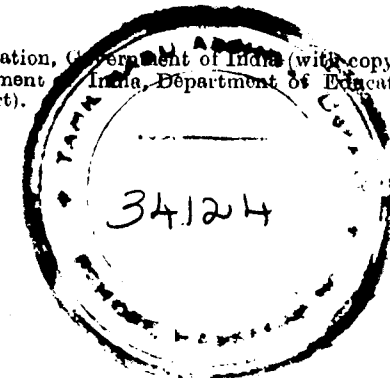

The Government observe that the village statistical registers have been written up and checked for all the villages for which the registers have been opened, except in the three Javadi villages in the North Arcot district under the Forest department for which registers have not been opened. The statement under paragraph 41 of the report is consequently unnecessary.
