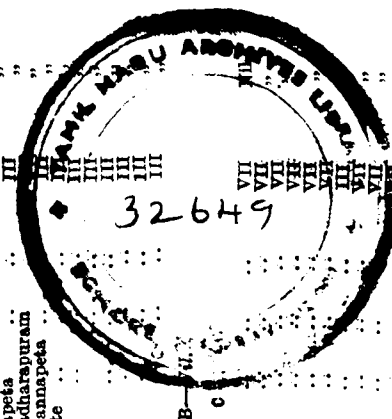

2. *Medical institutions.*—The number of institutions of Indigenous Medicine increased from 720 in 1950 to 788 in 1951. Of these, one is a hospital, viz., the Government Hospital of Indigenous Medicine at Madras and the others are dispensaries.

3. *Rural dispensaries.*—The total number of rural dispensaries kept closed during the year 1951 was 38 as against 55 in 1950.

4. *Medical attendance.*—The daily average attendance of in-patients in the Hospital of Indigenous Medicine increased from 183 to 190. There was also an increase in the daily average attendance of out-patients from 1,093 to 1,261.
