ADMINISTRATION REPORT OF THE STATE BROADCASTING DEPARTMENT FOR THE YEAR 1952-53.

I. *Introduction.*—(1) With the year ending 31st March 1953 the State Broadcasting Department completes its fifteenth year of its existence. This year marks a further stage in the activities of the department, viz., completion of the first large-scale scheme of assembling of 500 community radio sets taken up in May 1952 and commencement of another scheme of assembly of 600 community radios to meet the demands of the local bodies. Under this 600 Receiver Scheme, 250 sets were assembled and got ready for installation during this year. At the end of the year, there were 2,386 community receivers installed and maintained by this department.

(2) The loudspeaker equipments installed and maintained by the department in the Rajaji Hall continued to function satisfactorily. Necessary improvements at an estimated cost of Rs. 4,750 were also carried out to the existing equipment during the year under report.

(3) Industrial Research work on the design and construction of loudspeakers was continued during the year under review and considerable progress made. A scheme for the manufacture of 200 loudspeakers was sanctioned in G.O. Ms. No. 891, P.W., dated 3rd March 1952. Indigenous materials and production facilities were utilized for the manufacture and 35 loudspeakers were manufactured in this year.

(4) *Legislative Assembly.*—The sound reinforcement equipment installed in the New Madras Legislative Assembly Buildings in the Government House Estate, Mount Road, at a cost of Rs. 1,11,400 during 1951-52 continued to function satisfactorily. Three Radio Supervisors and one attender were specially appointed in June 1952, for the operation and maintenance of this equipment.

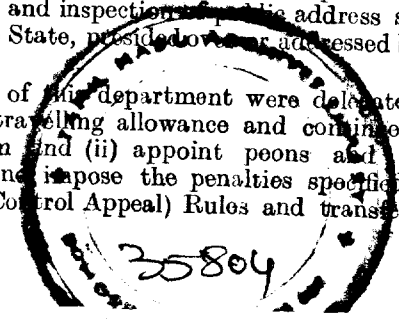
(5) The Department took part in the All-India Kadhi and Swadeshi Exhibition organized by the Tamil Nad Congress Committee in the Congress Grounds, Teynampet, during the year under report. Low-cost, community radio receiver assembled in this departmental laboratory, loudspeaker parts manufactured under Loudspeaker Research Scheme, Dynamic Demonstrator which shows the working of a radio set, Cathode ray Oscillograph which shows visual representation of radio waves, and various charts, etc., were displayed in the stall allotted to the State Broadcasting Department and Public Works Department.

(6) During the period under report, the Hon'ble Sri B. V. Keskar, Minister for Information and Broadcasting, Government of India and the Hon'ble Dr. M. V. Krishna Rao, Minister for Education, Government of Madras, visited the State Broadcasting Department Laboratory and Workshop, and evinced keen interest in the work of assembly of 600 community receivers for installation in the panchayat boards, etc.

(7) The 13 propaganda vans of Prohibition Department, 2 District Board Vans of Tanjore with all their equipments were continued to be maintained by this Department during the year under report.

(8) During the year under report Government entrusted this Department with the work and responsibility of installation and inspection of public address systems during all public meetings, throughout the State, presided over or addressed by high personages.

(9) The Assistant Radio Engineers of this department were delegated with the powers to (i) pass and countersign travelling allowance and contingent bills of the subordinates working under them and (ii) appoint peons and battery transport peons and grant them leave and impose the penalties specified in the Madras Civil Services (Classification and Control Appeal) Rules and transfer them within the circle concerned.



II. Staff and establishment.—(1) Sri V. V. L. Rao, permanent Radio Engineer, took charge on 7th July 1952, reverting Sri H. Joga Rao, as Assistant Radio Engineer.

(2) The entire regular staff of this department both permanent and temporary as it stood on 31st March 1953 excluding temporary staff for special schemes, etc., is shown below :—

In the same Government Order sanction was also accorded for the post of one store-keeper, grade II for a period of one year from the date of appointment to look after the work connected with the issue and receipts of 600 R. Stores. The appointment was made with effect from 16th December 1952, forenoon.

(c) In G.O. Ms. No. 2560, P.W., dated 13th June 1952, sanction was accorded for the employment of 3 Radio Supervisors and one attender for a period of one year from the date of appointment, for the operation and maintenance of sound reinforcement equipment in the New Legislative Assembly Buildings, Government Estate, Mount Road, Madras. The staff was appointed from 24th June 1952.

(k) For the maintenance of the sets installed during the year, Government sanctioned in G.O. Ms. No. 5326, P.W., dated 29th December 1952, the formation of 9 more additional service stations with 9 Radio Supervisors and eleven battery transport peons and 24 battery transport peons for the existing service stations which do not possess the required strength in accordance with instructions contained in G.O. Ms. No. 3081, P.W., dated 15th July 1952, fixing the work load and staff for each service station. The sanction for the above staff was accorded from the date of appointment till 31st March 1953. Ms. No. 903, P.W., dated 3rd March 1953, one Radio Supervisor, one carpenter and one unskilled labourer, was sanctioned for a period of one month from 28th March 1953, forenoon to 27th April 1953 for unpacking, testing, re-packing the radio sets, batteries, etc., for installation in secondary schools under Audio Visual Education Scheme.

(p) The Government sanctioned in G.O. Ms. No. 1039, P.W., dated 11th March 1953, the continuance from 2nd March 1953 till 31st March 1954, of the following staff sanctioned in G.O. Ms. No. 610, P.W., dated 15th February 1952, in the State

Broadcasting Department for the work connected with the maintenance of Community radio sets.

(q) In G.O. Ms. No. 1235, P.W., dated 23rd March 1953, Government sanctioned the continuance for a period of one year from 1st April 1953 to 31st March 1954, of the post of one Accountant, sanctioned in G.O. Ms. No. 623, P.W., dated 18th February 1952 in Radio Engineer's Office, Madras, for attending to the works connected with deposit works in State Broadcasting Department.

(r) Sri V. V. L. Rao, Permanent Radio Engineer, who was on foreign service with Messrs. Radio and Electricals, Limited, Madras, came back to the parent department and assumed charge with effect from 7th July 1952, forenoon.

(s) The permanent post of Storekeeper, grade II, was upgraded as Storekeeper, Grade I, with effect from 7th October 1952 in the scale of Rs. 150—10—250 in G.O. Ms. No. 4097, P.W., dated 7th October 1952.

(t) The permanent posts of 1 Personal Assistant, 43 Radio Supervisors, one Storekeeper and 3 attenders in the department were filled in during the year by senior members who were awaiting confirmation.

(u) During the year 40 candidates recruited for the post of Radio Supervisors to fill in new posts sanctioned and to replace emergency hands, by the Madras Public Service Commission and their services, were also regularized.

(b) The new system of accounts, ordered in G.O. Ms. No. 3316, P.W., dated 8th August 1951, and the modification to the new head of appropriation approved in G.O. Ms. No. 4540, P.W., dated 8th November 1952, have been given effect to only from 1st April 1953 as approved by Government in their Memorandum No. 103365-F/52-2, dated 13th December 1952. Accounts are being submitted to Accountant-General, Madras, with effect from April 1953 onwards.

(c) In G.O. Ms. No. 2957, P.W., dated 9th July 1952, the Assistant Radio Engineers of this department were authorized to countersign the travelling allowance bills of the non-gazetted staff working under them.

(d) In G.O. Ms. No. 3874, P.W., dated 16th September 1952, powers were delegated to the Assistant Radio Engineers to countersign and pass contingent bills of their own office and also of the subordinates working under them.

(e) In G.O. Ms. No. 5009, P.W., dated 9th December 1952, the Assistant Radio Engineers were also delegated with the powers to (i) appoint peons and battery transport peons and grant them leave and transfer them from one place to the other within their circles and impose the penalties specified in Madras Civil Services (Classification, Control and Appeal) Rules.

IV. (a) *Field Staff*.—No additional circle was formed during the year under report. Fifteen additional service stations were opened (with the appointment of 15 Radio Supervisors and 17 Battery Transport peons) thus bringing the total number of service stations from 74 to 89 on 31st March 1953. A list of the existing service stations and the circle to which they are attached as on 31st March 1953 is furnished in Appendix VI.

(b) *Accommodation.*—Some of the service stations were shifted to the new stations from the original places of occupation for administrative convenience, as shown below :—

(c) *Laboratory and Workshops.*—(i) In the laboratories of the Circle offices major servicing of Radio sets amplifiers which are under departmental maintenance, repairs to petrol generators and battery chargers which are in use at the various service stations, rewinding of transformers of various types, loudspeaker cones, etc., were done as usual.

(ii) During the year under report Radio Engineer's Workshop was provided with the latest model engraving machine at a cost of Rs. 5,000.

(iii) Tools and equipment worth of Rs. 14,830 were purchased and supplied to 22 service stations and Major Servicing Laboratory of the Assistant Radio Engineer, VI Circle, Kozhikode.

(d) *Maintenance of Radio Receivers.*—(i) Sets installed at Dummagudem and Venkatapuram in the Agency area of East Godavari district and also Amindivi Islands are continued to be maintained by this department, despite transport difficulties. Proposals for the replacement of these two sets by dry battery sets, together with the installation of dry battery sets in about 39 more centres in the Agency area under the Special Agency Development Officer are still under consideration of Government.

(ii) *Maintenance charges.*—During the year under report there has been no change in the rate of maintenance charges recoverable from panchayat boards, private bodies, etc. The existing rate of maintenance charges are as follows :—

(ii) In G.O. Ms. No. 275, Education, dated 11th February 1952, sanction was accorded for the purchase and installation of 170 sets in local board, Government and private schools under Audio Visual Education Scheme. Out of these 170 sets, 100 sets were taken up for maintenance by this department during the year under report.

(iii) As per G.O. Ms. No. 165, Education, dated 30th January 1953, 142 sets were supplied to Government, local bodies and private schools under the Audio Visual Education Scheme. Out of these 142, sets 82 were taken up for maintenance by this department.

(iv) In G.O. Ms. 382, Education, dated 26th February 1953, sanction was accorded for the purchase and installation of 120 radio sets for Adult Education centres. The question of selection of suitable centres is under consideration of the Education Department. The sets will be purchased and installed in 1953-54.

(f) *Sets taken up for maintenance.*—The following sets (not installed by the State Broadcasting Department) were taken up for maintenance during the year under report :—

(g) *Sets lost and withdrawn.*—One rural and seven private body sets were withdrawn during this year. Two rural sets and one school set were stolen during this year.

(h) *Programme—Transmission and planning.*—The planning of the rural programmes continues to be entirely in the hands of the All-India Radio Station Directors. However, the reaction of the rural listeners on the rural broadcasts

and the reception data were continued to be sent by the State Broadcasting Department in the shape of programme and technical reports.

(i) *Tuning, arresting and working hours of sets.*—(i) There has been no change in the working hours of rural, battery-operated and mains sets.

(ii) The three rural centres (viz. Kudligi, Ramasagar and Narayanadevarkeri in Kannada areas of Bellary district) were continued to be tuned to Madras Short wave station, at their request, as against the original arresting to Dharwar station.

(iii) As in the previous years the rural sets in the Nilgiris, Malabar and South Kanara districts were continued to be tuned to any of All-India Radio Stations, that are well received during the rural programme hours, owing to poor reception conditions in those areas.

(iv) The intention of arresting and tuning of sets to a particular station is, that the rural folk should be made to listen to the rural programme in the evenings, specially broadcast for them on matters of particular interest to them.

(j) *His Excellency's Public Address System.*—This department continued to maintain the Governor's Public Address equipment, for providing loudspeaker arrangements on public functions, presided over by the President of the Indian Union, the Honourable Prime Minister of India, His Excellency the Governor of Madras and Honourable Chief Minister of the State, etc. The most important public functions presided over by High Personages during which public address systems were installed or inspected by this department during the year under review are as follows:—

V. *Sound-reinforcement equipment in the New Legislative Assembly Hall, Madras.*—The sound reinforcement equipment installed in the New Legislative Hall during 1951-52 and maintained by this department continued to function well during the year under report. Three Radio Supervisors and one attender were specially appointed to operate and maintain the equipment. The Hon'ble Prime Minister of India visited the new Legislative Assembly Hall during his visit to Madras in October 1952 and evinced keen interest in the special features of this system.

VI. *Assembling of sets in the departmental laboratory and workshops.*—(i) The Scheme of assembling 500 Receivers started in May 1951 was completed by end of August 1952 and installation of all these sets was completed.

(ii) On successful completion of the 500 R-Scheme, Government were pleased to sanction in G.O. Ms. No. 3081, P.W., dated 18th July 1952, assembling of community set as an annual feature at the rate of 600 numbers per annum or 50 per month. A total of only 250 sets were completed at the end of 31st March 1953 and 600 mark is expected to be completed before 1st September 1953. The performance of these community sets was found to be better than any commercial set for purposes of community listening and fulfilled the need that necessitated the design, development and production of these sets by this department.

VII. *Mobile publicity equipment.*—Out of the 17 propaganda vans under the maintenance of this department two were put out of commission during the year under report. The remaining 13 vans of the Prohibition department, and the two Rural Reconstruction propaganda vans of the Tanjore District Board were continued to be maintained by this department.

A new 16 mm. projector and a generating engine were installed in Tiruvannamalai van (MSC 7665) replacing the old equipment.

VIII. *Services rendered to other departments.*—(a) The services and technical advice of this department were sought by and rendered to sister departments of this State such as the Prohibition (Amelioration), Education (Audio-Visual Aids), Public Health, Women's Welfare, Co-operative, etc.

(b) *Assistance to radio industry, wireless trade and technical education.*—The department continued to conduct standard tests on radio equipments and accessories on receipt of prescribed fees.

(c) This departmental laboratory was visited by

- (i) the Engineering Instructors of High Schools undergoing summer technical teachers' training course at Teachers' College, Saidapet, in May 1952;
- (ii) the students of the Royal Telegraph and Wireless Training Institute, Madras, in June 1952.

IX. *Battery Section.*—New 6-volt, lead acid batteries of various models (such as Exide, Oldham, Bharat, Amco, Mitar and Senco, etc.) purchased in uncharged condition were initially filled in and charged in the battery section. During the year under report 1,710 new batteries were initially filled and charged. Besides this, 367 batteries were put on capacity test, 88 defective batteries were serviced and 800 new batteries were examined.

X. *Research.*—(i) The Industries Department of the Government of Madras awarded scholarships at Rs. 50 per mensem each to the following three candidates who were conducting research on the problem noted against each:—

Sri B. N. Kaiwar worked as a non-stipendiary Research Scholar from 20th May 1952 to 13th November 1952. Considerable preliminary work was done by them during the year under report.

(ii) *Loudspeaker Research Scheme.*—The posts of one Research Assistant and Workshop Assistant for the research work on loudspeakers were continued during the year 1952-53 with the renewed sanction of the Government.

(a) *Putting up of pilot plant for the production of loudspeaker cones.*—With the addition of accessory equipment to the pulp beater, like pulp storage and pumping facilities, electrically operated cone drying rack and baking oven, greater numbers of cone forming moulds, electrical heating facilities for the master cone dies, etc., the plant for the semi-mass production loudspeaker cones was completed.

About 450 numbers of cones were made and 200 of these sized and finished for use in the "Experimental 200 numbers of 8" P.M. loudspeakers manufacturing scheme."

(b) *Assembly and testing of experimental speakers.*—Six experimental speakers of the design evolved for speakers of the "200 loudspeaker manufacturing scheme" were made and tested. They were satisfactory except for the somewhat large distortion noticed at low frequencies. This defect was remedied by re-designing the fabric of the centring spider.

(c) *Manufacture of component parts for 200 loudspeakers.*—In addition to the production of 200 finished cones stated in paragraph (a), the following parts for use in the experimental production of 200 loudspeakers were made, including the dies and small tools required for their manufacture:—

(i) Spiders of improved design	250 Nos.
(ii) Voice coils	250 "
(iii) Fabric apical domes (for protecting air gap) ..	200 "
(iv) Mild steel pole pieces	200 "
(v) Voice coil loads	200 pairs.

(d) *Assembly of 200 loudspeakers.*—The sub-assembly of 102 field structures and the final assembly of 35 speakers were completed during the year. The sub-assembly of the remaining field structures and the final assembly of the rest of the speakers could not be completed during the year owing to the delay in the supply of metal parts by a local workshop with whom orders for the manufacture and supply of these (to the designs of the department) had been placed. They experienced great difficulty in pressing the cone chassis out of mild steel sheet and were finally allowed to make the chassis in brass in order to minimise the delay in the completion of the "200 loudspeaker scheme."

The 35 speakers made are undergoing detailed performance tests.

(e) *General remarks.*—Detailed records are being kept of the manufacturing data and the results of the quantitative speaker tests in order to correlate them at a later date.

The research work so far done has solved the major problems of speaker production and future research may be directed towards improvement of the quality of the product.

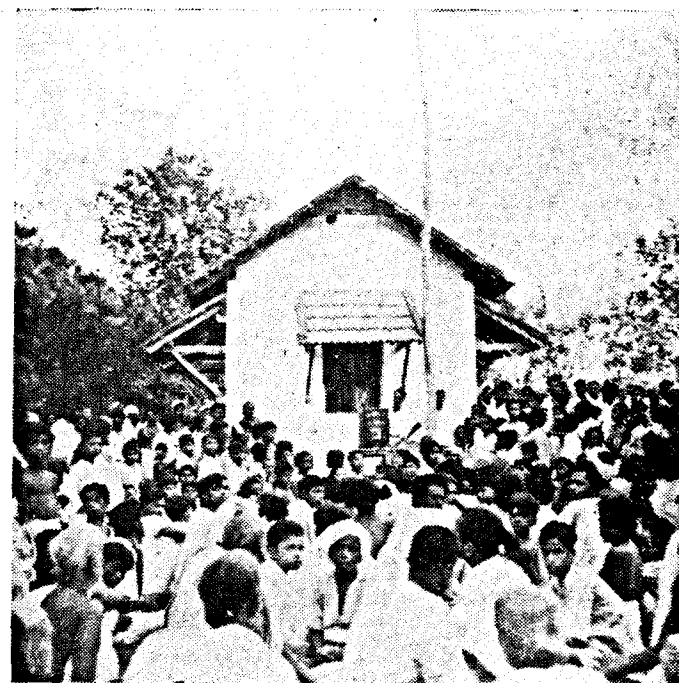
XI. *Unpaid apprentices scheme.*—(i) This department continued to give training in "servicing and maintenance of radio receivers" to those who pass out of Government and private institutions, under the unpaid apprentice scheme sanctioned in G.O. Ms. No. 3939, P.W., dated 25th October 1950. Seven candidates underwent the training in Radio Engineer's laboratory at Madras and major servicing laboratories of the Assistant Radio Engineers during the year under report.

(ii) Two third-year lady students of the Engineering College, Guindy (Telecommunication) Branch, underwent practical training in Radio Engineer's laboratory for eight weeks during April-June 1952.

(iii) Eight second-year students of the Electronics Faculty of the Madras Institute of Technology, Chromepet, underwent practical training for thirty working days in Radio Engineer's laboratory at Madras, and major servicing laboratories of the Assistant Radio Engineers in the mufassal.

XII. *Wire broadcasting and special installations.*—(a) During the year under report, Wire broadcasting, public address system, etc., were installed at the following places:—

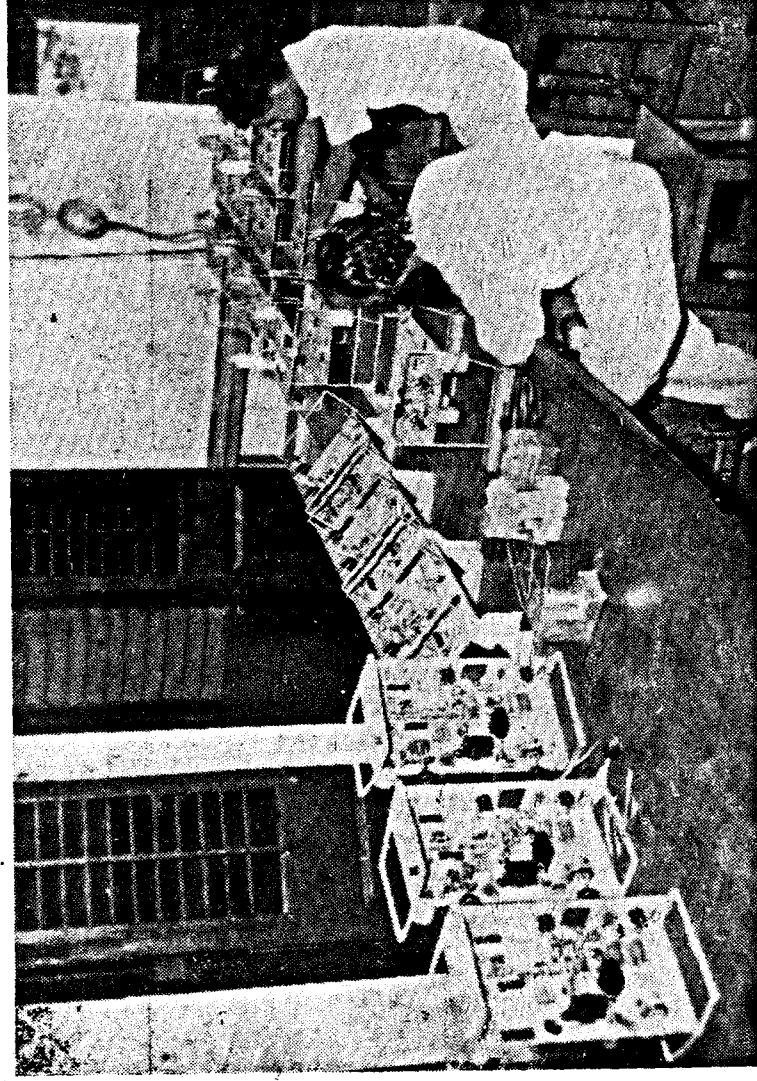

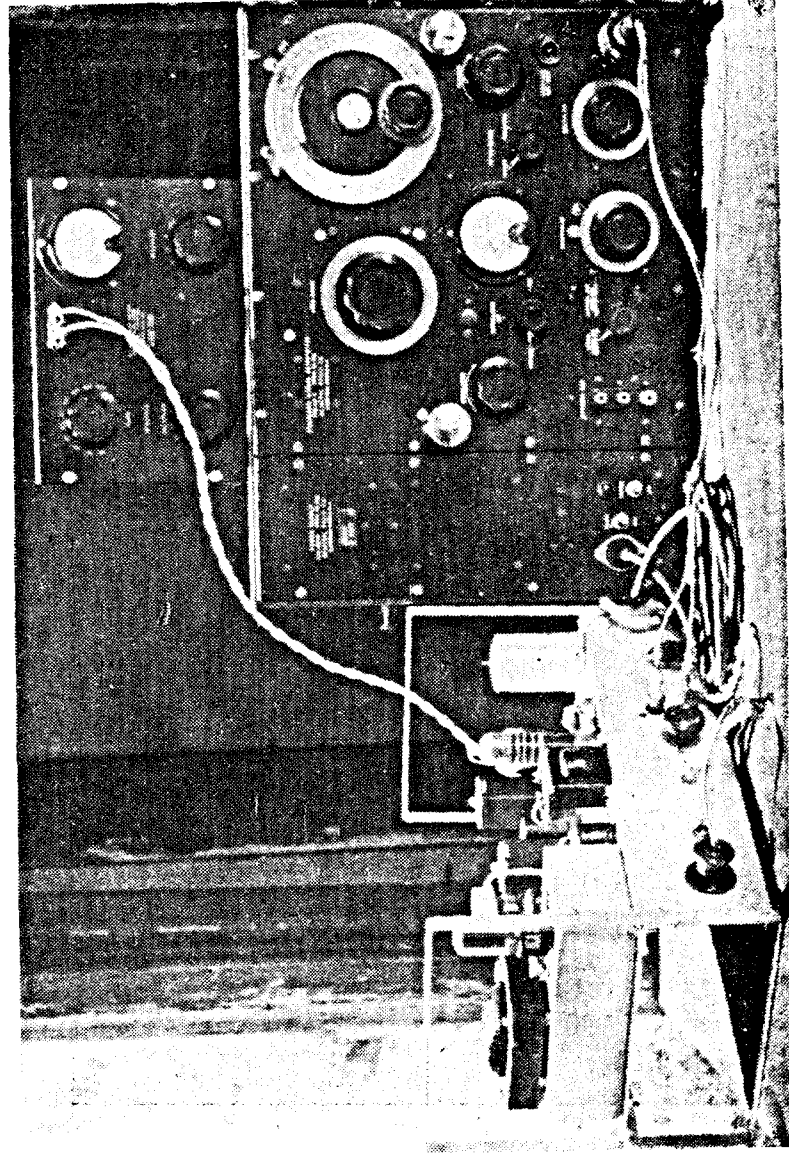
A TYPICAL COMMUNITY LISTENING CENTRE.

STATE BROADCASTING DEPARTMENT.



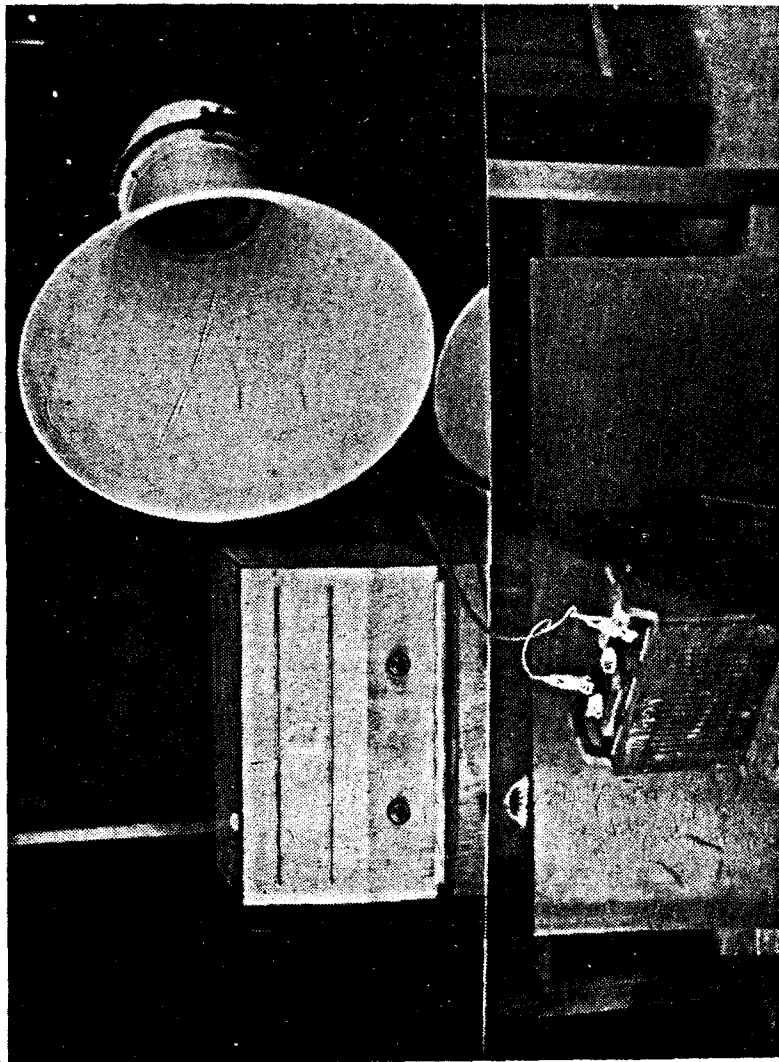

Broadcasting—State—Administration Report of State Broadcastin
Department for 1952-53—Recorded.

READ—the following paper :—

Endorsement from the Chief Engineer, P.W.D. (Buildings),

The administration report of the State Broadcasting Department annexed to these proceedings records the activities of the department from 1st April 1952 to 31st March 1953.

2. The total number of sets maintained by the department on behalf of panchayats, municipalities, district boards, and Government and private institutions and working on 31st March 1953 was 1,786 in panchayat areas, 292 in municipal areas, 117 in district board areas and 191 in Government and private institutions. Besides these, about 107 items relating to Public Address and Wire Broadcasting systems were maintained by the department thus making a total of 2,493.

3. The first large-scale scheme for assembling 500 community receiver sets started in May 1951 was concluded by the end of August 1952. On its successful completion another scheme for the assembling of community receiver sets at the rate of 600 sets per annum or 50 sets per month was taken up. A total number of 250 sets out of these were completed by the end of March 1953 and the annual target is expected to be reached before the beginning of September 1953.

4. The Public Address and Wire Broadcasting systems installed in the Rajaji Hall, and the New Assembly Hall in Madras and also in various other municipalities, panchayats and private institutions in the mufassal continued to be maintained satisfactorily by the State Broadcasting Department. Works on special installations in several municipalities which were taken up last year were also concluded. The first sound proof and air-conditioned, Wire Broadcasting Studio along with equipments to operate 44 loudspeakers, ever

owned by any municipality was constructed at Tenali under the technical supervision of the departmental staff of the State Broadcasting Department.

The work and the responsibility of installation and inspection of Public Address systems during all public meetings presided over or addressed by high personages throughout the state was also entrusted to the State Broadcasting Department.

5. There was no change in the rates of maintenance charges. The panchayats, municipalities and district boards continued to enjoy the concessional rates of maintenance charges.

6. Three candidates who were awarded scholarships for research work conducted research on the following problems:—

- (i) Loudspeaker manufacture and testing.
- (ii) Tracking problems in a super-hit.
- (iii) Design and construction of I.F. Transformers.

The assembling of 200 loudspeakers in progress and 35 speakers manufactured are undergoing detailed performance tests. The research so far made has solved several major problems of speaker production and future research will be in the direction of improvement of the quality of the product.

7. The State Broadcasting Department continued to render assistance to the Prohibition (Amelioration), Education (Audio-Visual Aids), Public Health, Co-operative and other sister departments. The department also assisted radio industry, etc., by conducting standard tests on radio equipment and accessories.

8. The State Broadcasting Department continued to give training in "Servicing and Maintenance of Radio Receivers" to students passing out from Government and private institutions. Seven candidates underwent training in the Radio Engineers' laboratory at Madras and in the major Servicing laboratories of the Assistant Radio Engineers during the year under report. Two lady students in the Third year class of the Engineering College, Guindy (Tele-communication), underwent practical training in the Radio Engineer's laboratory for 8 weeks during April-June 1952. Eight students in the Second year class of the Electronics Faculty of the Madras Institute of Technology, Chromepet, also underwent practical training for thirty working days in the laboratories of the State Broadcasting Department.

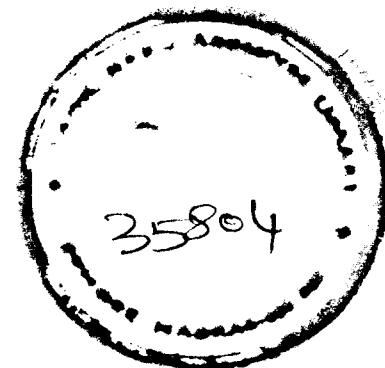
