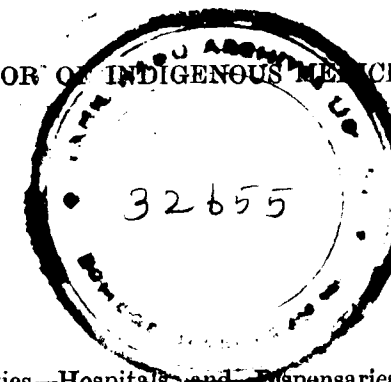
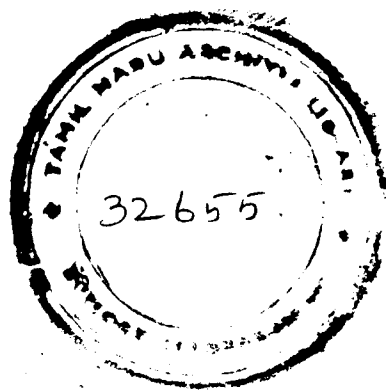

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ANNUAL REPORT OF THE HOSPITALS AND DISPENSARIES OF INDIGENOUS MEDICINE IN THE MADRAS STATE FOR THE PERIOD 1st OCTOBER TO 31st DECEMBER 1953.

The total number of Hospitals and Dispensaries of Indigenous Medicine at the close of the year 1953 was 396. Excepting the Hospital of Indigenous Medicine, Madras, and the dispensary under Devakottai Municipality, other dispensaries are only for the treatment of out-door patients. The details of number of dispensaries and hospitals are shown in Statement A.

The Hospital of Indigenous Medicine at Madras and the Ayurvedic Dispensary at Pudukkottai are maintained entirely from State Funds. The rest of the institutions are maintained by local bodies, the Government paying subsidy to about 216 rural dispensaries.

2. *The distribution of medical officers.*—A detailed statement is furnished in Statement B.

3. *The number of in-door and out-door patients.*—The number of in-door patients treated was 1,220 with the daily average attendance of 188. The total number of out-door patients treated in all dispensaries of Indigenous Medicine was 633,194. Further details are given in Statement C.

4. *Diseases treated.*—This is shown in Statement D. The order of prevalence of diseases accounting for large number of cases is given below :—

5. The details regarding operations performed are given in Statement E.

6. *Labour cases.*—The total number of labour cases conducted was 2,813.

7. *Inspection.*—The dispensaries of Indigenous Medicine were inspected both by the respective District Health Officers and Inspecting Medical Officers. The District Medical Officers also inspected some regular and municipal dispensaries during the period under review.

SPECIAL REPORT ON THE HOSPITAL OF INDIGENOUS MEDICINE, MADRAS, FOR THE PERIOD 1st OCTOBER TO 31st DECEMBER 1953.

1. *Accommodation.*—The in-patient wards are located in Government buildings. The improvised college buildings continue to be utilized for accommodating the patients. The temporary sheds constructed for the hospital were also in use.

2. *Staff.*—The medical staff attached to the College of Indigenous Medicine continued to do collateral work in the Hospital.

3. *Average treated.*—The sanctioned bed strength was 210, and the daily average attendance during the past three years was as follows:—

The total number of cases treated during the period (1st October to 31st December 1953) in the in-patient department was 1,220 while in the out-patient it was 30,170.

4. *Mortality.*—The ratio of death per cent to the total treated during the period was 2.

5. *Classes and diseases treated.*—The diseases for which patients were treated are included in Statement 'D' along with the figures for other dispensaries of Indigenous Medicine.

6. *Training of medical students.*—The L.I.M. and G.C.I.M. students of the College of Indigenous Medicine continue to be posted to the out-patient and in-patient departments for clinical training. The students undergoing Village Vaidya course were also afforded facilities for clinical study and training.

7. *Working of special departments.*—The special departments like Pharmacy and Research and the clinics, viz., Toxicology, Anti-Rabic, Ante-natal, etc., continued to function during the period under review.

8. *Finance.*—The entire expenditure for the Hospital of Indigenous Medicine was borne by the Government and the statement of receipts and expenditure is included in Statement 'F'.

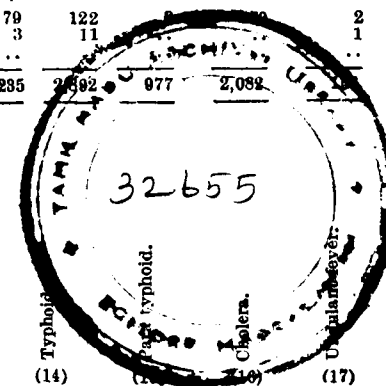

2. *Medical institutions.*—The total number of institutions of Indigenous Medicine working up to 30th September 1953 in the composite State of Madras was 869 as against 851 in 1952. At the end of the year, the total number actually working in Madras State was 396. The only hospital and the dispensary of Indigenous Medicine wherein in-patients were admitted and treated were the Hospital of the Indigenous Medicine, Madras and the Ayurvedic dispensary of the Devakottai Municipality. All other dispensaries in the State were attended to out-door patients only.

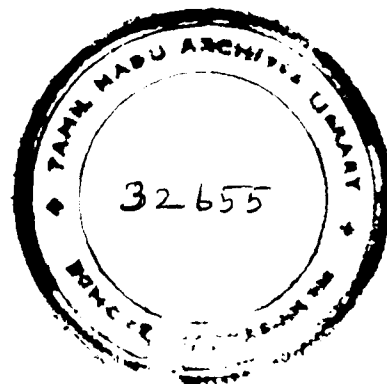
3. *Medical attendance*.—The daily average attendance of in-door patients in the Hospital of Indigenous Medicine increased from 192 in 1952 to 195 in 1953. There was however a marked decrease in the daily average attendance of out-patients.

4. *Mortality*.—The ratio of death per cent to the total of in-patients treated during the year under review was 2 as against 4 in 1952.
