Resolution—No. 7, Press, dated 13th March 1953.

The Board submits its report on the settlement of land revenue in the State of Madras for fasli 1361 (1951–52) together with the prescribed statements.

Main features.—The main features of the fasli were—

(i) The season during the fasli continued to be unsatisfactory—vide paragraph 2 below.

(ii) The total extent of ryotwari holdings increased by 425,925 acres, i.e., from 28,240,408 acres to 28,666,333 acres—vide paragraph 7 below.

(iii) The total assessment on ryotwari holdings showed an increase of Rs. 6,91,973, i.e., from Rs. 6,17,63,962 (revised figure) to Rs. 6,23,95,935—vide paragraph 8.

(iv) The total area cultivated in ryotwari holdings increased by 522,015 acres—vide paragraph 9.

(v) The amount of water-rate and second-crop charge increased by Rs. 5,56,987—vide paragraph 10.

(vi) Seasonal remissions decreased by Rs. 9,31,758—vide paragraph 11 (i).

(vii) Fixed remissions increased by Rs. 2,70,352—vide paragraph 11 (ii).

(viii) Beriz deductions increased by Rs. 23,414—vide paragraph 11 (iii).

(ix) The total amount of revenue remitted in this fasli under all the heads was Rs. 89,90,680, i.e., 89.9 lakhs as against Rs. 97.4 lakhs (revised figure) in the previous fasli.

(x) Miscellaneous revenue decreased by Rs. 5,32,006—vide paragraph 12.

(xi) There was only a comparatively small extent of land sold in this fasli—vide paragraphs 25 and 26.

2. Seasonal conditions—South-west monsoon—June 1951.—The south-west monsoon set in along the West Coast on the 1st of June, causing widespread and locally heavy rainfall. It was fairly active throughout the month except for a temporary slackening on 17th and 18th of June. Widespread and heavy rainfall occurred during the entire month on the West Coast and light to moderate rainfall in parts of most districts of the State. The rainfall was above the normal in the districts of East Godavari, West Godavari, Krishna, Guntur, Kurnool, Bellary, Anantapur, Tirunelveli, Malabar and South Kanara and below the normal in the other districts of the State.

July 1951.—The monsoon was weak at the beginning of the month, and from about the 6th till about the 18th of the month, except for a few spells of wet weather in parts of Circars. Southern and West Coast districts, there was a slight strengthening of the monsoon along the West Coast between the 12th and 14th when widespread and locally heavy rain occurred along the West Coast. During the rest of July, the activity of the monsoon was associated with the formation of depressions in the Bay of Bengal in a rapid succession and their movement inland. In association with the first depression, the monsoon strengthened over the West Coast and active monsoon conditions prevailed there between the 18th and 24th. The second depression, which formed on the 24th, intensified into a cyclonic storm the next day. Crossing the coast, between Puri and Gopalpur it moved west-north west and became unimportant. Under its influence the rainfall was widespread in Coastal Circars and along the West Coast and has occurred locally elsewhere in the State.

The rainfall during the month was above the normal in all the districts of the State except in Cuddapah, Malabar and South Kanara and normal or bordering on normal in the districts of Chingleput, Coimbatore and Tirunelveli.

August 1951.—The south-west monsoon was generally weak during the entire month of August 1951. Fairly widespread rain occurred in the West Coast districts. Light to moderate showers occurred in the Deccan, the Circars, and the Southern districts of the State. The rainfall during the month was normal or bordering on the normal in the districts of East Godavari (Plains), Salem, Coimbatore, Madurai and Ramanathapuram, above the normal, in the districts of Srikakulam, Visakhapatnam, East Godavari (Agency), West Godavari, Chingleput, South Arcot and Tiruchirappalli and below the normal in the other districts of the State.

September 1951.—The south-west monsoon continued to be weak during September 1951 along the West Coast and it temporarily withdrew from the West Coast by the 16th September. There was a revival of the monsoon towards the end of the month in association with a trough of low pressure in the west Central Bay of Bengal and another in the East Arabian Sea. These were responsible for fairly widespread rain in the Coastal Circars, Southern and the West Coast districts. The rainfall was above the normal in the districts of Visakhapatnam, East Godavari, Bellary, Coimbatore, Madurai, Ramanathapuram, Tirunelveli, Malabar and South Kanara and below the normal in the other districts of the State.

June to September 1951.—The rainfall for the monsoon season was above the normal in the districts of Srikakulam, Visakhapatnam, East Godavari, West Godavari, Krishna, Bellary, Coimbatore, Tiruchirappalli, Madurai, Ramanathapuram and Tirunelveli, normal or bordering the normal in the district of Kurnool, and below the normal in the other districts of the State.

Sowings.—Sowings of early dry crops were above the average in the Carnatic and below the average in the Circars, the Deccan, the Central, the Southern and the West Coast districts. Sowings of early wet crops were above the average in the Circars, the Deccan, and the West Coast districts and below the average in the Carnatic, the Central and the Southern districts.

Crops.—The condition of standing crops was generally satisfactory except in parts of Deccan, Carnatic and Central districts. In West Godavari district, the paddy crop suffered considerable damage on account of heavy rains and floods during the last week of July 1951. Withering of crops was reported from parts of the Deccan and the Central districts. The crops were affected by pests in the districts of Chingleput, Madurai and in parts of Tanjore district.

October 1951—North-east monsoon.—There was the delayed onset of the north-east monsoon on the 27th; it proved to be weak. In association with a well-marked trough of low pressure over East Arabian Sea, fairly widespread rain occurred along the West Coast during the first four days of the month. Widespread showers occurred there again on the 11th and 12th. There were spells of widespread thunder shower activity in the Central and Southern districts of the State on the 11th and in Deccan on the 15th. Apart from this, scattered evening showers occurred on a number of days in the various parts of the State. Under the influence of a depression formed in the north Bay of Bengal on the 11th, widespread rain occurred in the northern districts of the coastal Circars districts. The rainfall was above normal in Kurnool district and below the normal in the other districts of the State.

November 1951.—Two spells of strong north-east monsoon activity, resulting in well-distributed rainfall over the Central and Southern districts during the periods 7th to 11th and 18th to 21st were the main features of the month. During the latter spell which was associated with unsettled conditions in south-west Bay of Bengal locally very heavy rain occurred in the coastal districts of the Carnatic. Conditions became unsettled in south-east Bay of Bengal on the 22nd. The unsettled conditions concentrated into a depression. In association with this depression, widespread and locally heavy rain occurred in the northern parts of the Circars districts. The rainfall was normal or bordering the

normal in East Godavari (Agency) and Madurai districts, above the normal in the districts of Srikakulam, Visakhapatnam, South Arcot, Coimbatore, Tiruchirappalli, Ramanathapuram, Tirunelveli, Malabar, South Kanara and the Nilgiris.

December 1951.—The month was characterised by a weak north-east monsoon, with very little rain over the State. Except for scattered showers in Central and Southern districts of the State on few days of the month, the weather was for the most part dry. A deep depression which developed in the south-east Bay of Bengal on the 6th December 1951 moved towards north and thereafter it weakened rapidly by December 15. Due to this northward movement of the cyclone, dry northerly air prevailed over the region resulting in almost complete absence of rain in the first half of the month. The rainfall was above normal in the East Godavari (Agency) and the West Godavari districts below the normal in the districts of East Godavari, Krishna, Guntur, Chingleput, South Arcot, Coimbatore, Tiruchirappalli, Tanjore, Madurai, Ramanathapuram, Tirunelveli, Malabar and the Nilgiris and there was no rain in the other districts of the State.

January 1952.—The weather was generally dry except for a few isolated showers in the Southern districts of the State during the first and last weeks of the month. The rainfall was above the normal in the districts of Tanjore and the Nilgiris, below the normal in Chingleput, South Arcot, North Arcot, Salem, Coimbatore, Tiruchirappalli, Madurai, Ramanathapuram and Tirunelveli districts and there was no rainfall in the other districts of the State.

October 1951 to January 1952.—Over the whole period of the north-east monsoon (October 1951 to January 1952), the rainfall was below the normal in all the districts of the State.

Sowings.—Sowings of late dry crops were above the average in the Carnatic, the Southern and the West Coast districts and below the average in the Circars, the Deccan, and the Central districts. Sowings of late wet crops were below the average in the Circars, the Deccan, and the Central districts. Sowings of late wet crops were below the average in the Circars, the Deccan, the Carnatic, the Central, the Southern and the West Coast districts.

Crops.—The condition of the standing crops was reported to be not satisfactory in all districts of the State except in Srikakulam, Visakhapatnam, East Godavari, West Godavari, Krishna, Tiruchirappalli, Tanjore, Malabar and South Kanara. The paddy crop in the upland taluks of Guntur district was reported to have been adversely affected by drought. The paddy crop in parts of Nandyal, Koilkunta, Cumbum, Markapur and Banganapalli taluks of Kurnool district, in Rayadurg taluk of Bellary district and in several parts of Anantapur district failed. Withering of paddy crop was reported from Chingleput, North Arcot, Salem, Coimbatore, parts of Tiruchirappalli in the non-Periyar tracts of Madurai district, in parts of Ramanathapuram and Tirunelveli district. Attacks on paddy crop by insect pests and diseases were also reported in parts of North Arcot, Tiruchirappalli and Tanjore districts. It was reported that ragi in Ramanathapuram district was affected by insect pests.

February 1952—Hot weather period.—The chief feature of the month was a spell of well-distributed rainfall over the State between 21st and 25th. During this period Central and the Southern districts experienced widespread and locally heavy rains on two days and local showers on the remaining three days. The rainfall was below the normal in the districts of Visakhapatnam, East Godavari (Agency), Krishna, Guntur, Bellary and there was no rainfall in the districts of Kurnool and Anantapur. It was normal in the districts of Cuddapah, Nellore and South Kanara and above normal in the other districts of the State.

March 1952.—The weather in March 1952 was mainly dry except for a few thunder showers which occurred in parts of the Deccan, Central, Southern and West Coast districts of the State. The total rainfall for the month was above the

normal in Srikakulam and East Godavari (Plains) districts and below normal in the other districts of the State except East Godavari (Agency), West Godavari, Krishna, Guntur, Kurnool, Bellary, Anantapur, Cuddapah, Nellore, North Arcot and South Kanara where there was no rainfall.

April 1952.—Dry weather prevailed over the region during the first three days of the month, after which the pre-monsoon thunder storm activity commenced. Fairly widespread thunder showers occurred in West Coast and in parts of Southern districts. Slight and scattered showers also occurred in other districts of the State on a few days of the month. The total rainfall for the month was above the normal in the districts of Srikakulam, Visakhapatnam, Bellary, Tirunelveli and South Kanara and below the normal in other districts of the State.

May 1952.—During the first fortnight of the month the thunder storm activity continued and fairly widespread rain fell in all districts of the State. About the 16th of May, a depression was formed in the south-east Bay of Bengal and moving north-north-eastwards, it became unimportant by the eighteenth. Another depression was formed in the West Central Bay of Bengal on the 20th and it concentrated into a severe cyclonic storm. It weakened into a deep depression by the 23rd and by 25th it further weakened and became unimportant. Under its influence widespread and heavy rain fell in Madras City, Deccan, Circars and in parts of Carnatic districts of the State. It was above the normal in the districts of Visakhapatnam, East Godavari, West Godavari, Krishna, Guntur, Kurnool, Bellary, Anantapur, Cuddapah, Nellore, Chingleput, Chittoor and North Arcot while it was below the normal in the other districts of the State.

On the whole the seasonal conditions during the fasli continued to be unsatisfactory, as in the previous year.

3. Number of ryotwari villages.—The total number of ryotwari villages in the State was 21,591 as against 21,579 in the previous fasli, resulting in an increase of 12 villages. The increase is due to the following reasons:—

(i) Two enclave villages from Mysore State were attached to Coimbatore and Salem districts; and

(ii) Ten enclave villages from Hyderabad were attached to Krishna district in fasli 1359 but they were omitted to be shown in the reports relating to the previous faslis. The total number of ryotwari villages given above does not include the villages in estates taken over under Act XXVI of 1948 (Abolition Act).

4. Sources of land revenue.—The land revenue of the State is derived from the following sources:—

(i) peshkash or revenue from permanently-settled estates;

(ii) shrotriyam jodi or quit-rent levied on inam villages;

(iii) assessment including water-rate on lands held under ryotwari tenure and

(iv) miscellaneous revenue.

5. Peshkash or revenue from permanently-settled estates.—The total amount of peshkash payable during the fasli was Rs. 8,24,702 as against Rs. 16,47,554 during the previous fasli, the decrease being Rs. 8,22,852. The bulk of the decrease is in Salem district where it is Rs. 50,159 against Rs. 4,26,549 in the previous fasli. The decrease occurs in almost all the districts except in the ceded districts of Cuddapah, Kurnool, Bellary, Anantapur and the districts of South Kanara, Malabar and the Nilgiris where there are no zamin estates and therefore no arrears of peshkash to be collected. The demand under peshkash in respect of the estates taken over ceased to accrue with effect from fasli 1359 in respect of certain villages from fasli 1360 in respect of some and from fasli 1361 in respect of others.

6. Quit-rent.—The quit-rent payable on villages held on shrotriyam or on favourable tenure was Rs. 4,03,050 as against Rs. 7,26,862 in fasli 1360 resulting in a decrease of Rs. 3,23,812. There is a decrease of Rs. 38,501 in Tanjore district and a decrease of Rs. 49,830 in Krishna district. The Collectors report that the decrease is due to the reduction in the demand of some villages taken over by the Government. There is decrease under this item of revenue in almost all the districts.

7. Ryotwari holdings.—The total extent of ryotwari holdings during the fasli was 28,666,333 acres as against 28,240,408 acres in the previous fasli, resulting in an increase of 425,925 acres. There was an increase in the following districts:—

East Godavari (868 acres), West Godavari (197,709 acres), Guntur (7,732 acres), Bellary (45,919 acres), Anantapur (52,897 acres), Chittoor (95 acres), Nellore (1,003 acres), Chingleput (259 acres), North Arcot (1,547 acres), South Arcot (26,387 acres), Tanjore (7,566 acres), Tiruchirappalli (60,123 acres), Madurai (191 acres), Ramanathapuram (205 acres), Coimbatore (13,337 acres), Salem (2,623 acres). The Nilgiris (163 acres), Malabar (3,675 acres) and South Kanara (2,661 acres).

The increase in Anantapur, Chittoor, Chingleput and Salem districts is due to the fresh assignments made, while in West Godavari, North Arcot, Tiruchirappalli and Coimbatore, it is due to the taking over of estates under the Estates Abolition Act, while in Malabar it is due to the classification of lands. The collectors of the remaining districts have not specifically reported the reasons for the increase.

8. Assessment of ryotwari holdings.—The total assessment on holdings was Rs. 623.96 lakhs as against Rs. 617.04 lakhs (revised figure) in the previous fasli, showing a net increase of Rs. 6.92 lakhs.

9. Area cultivated.—(1) The total area cultivated in ryotwari holdings was 21.54 million acres as against 21.02 million acres in the previous fasli. There was a net increase of 522,015 acres.

(2) The total area cultivated during the fasli including the area under miscellaneous cultivation was 23.04 million acres against 22.52 million acres in the previous fasli, the net increase being 519,994 acres or 0.52 million acres. There was an increase of 233,835 acres under waste charged.

10. Water-rate and second-crop charge.—The revenue derived from this source amounted to Rs. 54.9 lakhs against Rs. 49.3 lakhs in the previous fasli. There was an increase of Rs. 7,82,719 in some districts while there was a decrease of Rs. 2,25,732 resulting in a net increase of Rs. 5,56,987. There was an increase in all the districts except in the following, where there was a decrease:—

Visakhapatnam (Rs. 23,526), East Godavari (Rs. 90,624), Kurnool (Rs. 1,122), Anantapur (Rs. 49,647), Cuddapah (Rs. 12,785), Chittoor (Rs. 5,064), Nellore (Rs. 36,390) and Chingleput (Rs. 6,574).

11. Remissions.—The total remission granted was Rs. 89.9 lakhs as against Rs. 97.4 lakhs (revised figure) in the previous fasli, of which Rs. 74.7 lakhs relate to seasonal remissions. There was a decrease of Rs. 7.5 lakhs during this fasli when compared with the remission granted during the previous fasli. There was a decrease in certain districts while the increase was marked in the following districts:—

East Godavari (Rs. 15,156), West Godavari (Rs. 2,22,078), Guntur (Rs. 89,524), Kurnool (Rs. 50,066), Anantapur (Rs. 3,83,171), Cuddapah (Rs. 2,62,867), Chittoor (Rs. 2,97,481), Nellore (Rs. 3,62,470) and Chingleput (Rs. 3,24,026).

(i) **Seasonal remissions.**—The amount remitted under this head was Rs. 74,65,804 as against Rs. 83,97,562 in the previous fasli, resulting in a net decrease of Rs. 9,31,758. There was an increase in some districts while there was a decrease in other districts.

The decrease in certain districts was due generally to the more favourable seasonal conditions in those districts.

(a) *Waste remission.*—The amount remitted under this head was Rs. 13.46 lakhs against Rs. 13.97 lakhs (revised figure) in the previous fasli, resulting in a net decrease of Rs. 0.51 lakh.

(b) *Shavi or loss of crop.*—The amount remitted under this head was Rs. 26,42,920 against Rs. 33,15,499 in the previous fasli resulting in a decrease of Rs. 6,72,579. The decrease was marked in some districts while there was an increase in other districts.

(c) *Tirvakammi remissions*, i.e., remissions of the difference between the wet and dry rates of assessment on wet lands cultivated with dry crops owing to insufficiency or failure of water-supply. The amount remitted under this head was Rs. 15,76,637 as against Rs. 12,40,875 in the previous fasli, resulting in a net increase of Rs. 3,35,762. There was an increase in all the districts except the following where there was a decrease :—

Visakhapatnam (Rs. 22,302), East Godavari, (Rs. 12,674), West Godavari (Rs. 185), Guntur (Rs. 2,646), Cuddapah (Rs. 12,111), Tiruchirappalli (Rs. 2,983), Ramanathapuram (Rs. 69,177), Tirunelveli (Rs. 40,141), Coimbatore (Rs. 3,215) and Srikakulam (Rs. 1,283).

(d) *Remissions for damages caused by floods.*—The amount remitted under this head was Rs. 60,691 against Rs. 1,55,979 in the previous fasli resulting in a decrease of Rs. 95,288.

(e) *Remission of second-crop charge.*—The amount remitted under this head was Rs. 47,713 against Rs. 23,159 in the previous fasli resulting in an increase of Rs. 24,554.

(f) *Short crop or poor harvest.*—The amount remitted under this head was Rs. 9,34,958 against Rs. 18,28,611 in the previous fasli resulting in a net decrease of Rs. 8,93,653.

(ii) *Fixed remissions*, i.e. (Abatement of demand on account of reasons unconnected with season).

The amount remitted under this head was Rs. 5,59,960 against Rs. 2,89,608 in the previous fasli, resulting in a net increase of Rs. 2,70,352.

(iii) *Beriz deductions.*—Deductions made in favour of inamdars and religious institutions amounted to Rs. 9,74,493 against Rs. 9,51,079 in the previous fasli resulting in a net increase of Rs. 23,414.

(iv) *Special remissions.*—In view of the widespread failure of wet and dry crops in many districts of the State, special remissions under B.S.O. No. 14 in addition to the ordinary seasonal remission were granted during the fasli (1361).

12. *Miscellaneous revenue.* The revenue realized under this head was Rs. 156.65 lakhs against Rs. 161.97 lakhs in the previous fasli. There was a decrease of Rs. 16,73,559 in certain districts while there was an increase of Rs. 11,41,553 in other districts resulting in a decrease of Rs. 5,32,006.

The following are the various items of revenue under this head :—

(i) *Jodi and quit-rent on minor inams.*—The revenue under this head was Rs. 22.75 lakhs against Rs. 24.67 lakhs in the previous fasli, showing a net decrease of Rs. 1,92,793.

(ii) (a) *Second-crops charge on minor inam wet lands in ryotwari villages.*—The revenue realized under this head was Rs. 2.84 lakhs against Rs. 2.13 lakhs in the previous fasli, showing an increase of Rs. 71,08.

(b) *Water-rate on minor inams in ryotwari villages.*—The revenue derived under this head was Rs. 20.25 lakhs against Rs. 23.48 lakhs in the previous fasli, showing a net decrease of Rs. 3,23,244.

(iii) *Charge for water in villages in estates including tirvajasti and fasal jasti.*—The revenue under this head was Rs. 28.73 lakhs against Rs. 25.61 lakhs in the previous fasli, resulting in a net decrease of Rs. 6,88,143.

(iv) *Enhanced water-cess on lands irregularly irrigated.*—The revenue under this head was Rs. 6.48 lakhs against Rs. 5.37 lakhs in the previous fasli, showing a net increase of Rs. 1,10,741.

(v) *Charges levied for occupation (with or without permission) of assessed and unassessed lands.*—The revenue realized under this head was Rs. 10.33 lakhs against Rs. 10.73 lakhs in the previous fasli, showing a decrease of Rs. 39,006.

(vi) *Charges levied for occupation of poramboke lands.*—The revenue derived under this head was Rs. 16.06 lakhs against Rs. 15.19 lakhs in the previous fasli, showing a net increase of Rs. 86,287.

Taram assessment was levied on an extent of 266,995 acres against 2,28,357 acres in the previous fasli. Such occupation was extensive in Krishna, Guntur, Kurnool, Bellary, Anantapur, Chittoor, Nellore, South Arcot, and Salem.

(vii) *Revenue from taxed trees.*—The revenue under this head was Rs. 3,97,219 against Rs. 4,75,418 in the previous fasli, showing a decrease of Rs. 78,199.

(viii) *Commission for estates under the Court of Wards.*—The revenue under this head was Rs. 2,098 against Rs. 7,503 in the previous fasli, showing a decrease of Rs. 5,405.

(ix) *Revenue from process fees.*—The revenue under this head was Rs. 16,937 against Rs. 2,260 in the previous fasli, showing a net increase of Rs. 14,677.

(x) *Sale-proceeds of lands sold.*—The revenue under this head was approximately Rs. 0.5 lakh against Rs. 0.3 lakh in the previous fasli showing an increase of about Rs. 16,890.

(xi) *Rent on lankas.*—The revenue under this head was Rs. 14.97 lakhs against Rs. 14.24 lakhs in the previous fasli, showing a net increase of Rs. 72,877.

(xii) *Quit-rent and ground rent.*—The revenue under this head was Rs. 4.07 lakhs against Rs. 3.58 lakhs in the previous fasli, resulting in an increase of Rs. 48,952.

13. *Net ryotwari demand.*—The net ryotwari demand including water-rate, second-crop charge and miscellaneous revenue was Rs. 745.58 lakhs against Rs. 730.9 lakhs in the previous fasli, resulting in an increase of Rs. 14,67,378. The details for the net increase are given below :—

16. *Demand, collection and balance of land revenue and cesses.*—The current demand under the land revenue and cesses during the fasli was Rs. 10,49,81,558. A sum of Rs. 9,57,84,216 was collected with in the fasli a sum of Rs. 4,83,019 was written off the accounts.

17. *Demand and collection of arrears.*—The total arrear demand under all the heads amounted to Rs. 1,96,16,632. A sum of Rs. 81,20,171 was collected and a sum of Rs. 4,72,861 was written off the accounts.

18. *Balance.*—The balance outstanding at the end of the fasli including both the arrears and current was Rs. 1,96,88,748 as against Rs. 1,95,77,044 in the previous fasli.

As reported by the Collectors in their demand, collection and balance statements for December 1952, the balance at the beginning of fasli 1362 was Rs. 2,60,93,258 up to the end of December 1952, a sum of Rs. 1,07,73,095 was collected and a sum of Rs. 1,85,667 was written off the accounts. A sum of Rs. 10,80,834 was collected or adjusted after the close of the treasury month, and a sum of Rs. 49,95,183 was covered by orders of suspension or postponement. Further, a sum of Rs. 65,06,826 is due on estates under attachment or Government management but not yet adjusted for want of funds and a sum of Rs. 43,673 is considered irrecoverable or of doubtful recovery. Deducting these amounts, the net collectable balance was Rs. 25,07,944 at the end of December 1952.

19. *Adjustment to local boards of cesses collected during the fasli.*—Land revenue and cesses are collected together and the distribution of the total collections between land revenue and cesses is effected in the Collector's office after the compilation of the accounts relating to the fasli year.

The statements showing the amounts collected during fasli 1360 on behalf of the local boards, the payments made to them during the fasli and the amount to be finally adjusted either to their credit or debit are received from the Collectors after verification by the Accountant-General of the amounts shown by the Collectors as payments made to the local boards, the recovery of the overpayments, if any, is being watched in accordance with the instructions contained in paragraph 3 of G.O. No. 5197, L. & M., dated 7th December 1926.

20. *Charges debitable to land revenue.*—The charges in the Land Revenue department are shown in the accounts under the head "25. General Administration—District Administration and Miscellaneous." The District Administration charges excluding Village establishments amounted to Rs. 217.79 lakhs during fasli 1361 as against Rs. 210.75 lakhs during fasli 1360. The village service charges including those of the proprietary estates during the fasli under review were Rs. 250.65 lakhs as against Rs. 241.74 lakhs in the previous fasli. The total charges during fasli 1361 amounted to Rs. 468.44 lakhs.

In this connexion it may be mentioned that the above expenditure does not represent merely the cost of collecting land revenue dues only. The Revenue Department performs multifarious duties, of which the control and collection of land revenue is one. The village establishment of the Revenue Department in particular, serves all Government departments. In addition a considerable portion of the time of the Collectors and his subordinate officers is occupied with Magisterial work (mainly executive in most districts with judicial functions also attached in the "non separation" district) Civil Supplies work, and the many post-war reconstruction schemes launched by the Government. The actual cost of collecting land revenue alone cannot be assessed with any degree of accuracy, but it must be obviously far less than the amount of expenditure shown :—

The numbers of sales and sale notices have increased. All the sales relate to personal property only.

The Government in G.O. Ms. No. 41, Revenue (Famine Relief), dated 18th June 1952, directed that no coercive steps should be taken for the realization of land revenue and cesses in the drought affected areas. Consequently a sum of Rs. 67,09,245-12-0 representing the unremitted land revenue and cesses of fasli 1361 in the affected areas was formally postponed to fasli 1362 in G.O. Ms. No. 3302, Revenue, dated 16th December 1952.

22. *Percentage of attachment to demand*—

The percentage has risen up considerably in the fasli under report.

23. *Sale notices.*—This year also, large number of sale notices were issued in East Godavari (459) and Malabar (307). Out of 124,862 defaulters, all except 1,282 paid the dues before the issue of sale notices.

24. *Sales.*—The percentage of sales to sale notices has increased to 12.56 from 4.3 of last fasli. The percentage of sales to the total holdings also rose to .0022 from .0006 in last fasli.

25. *Extent of lands sold.*—There were land sales only in East Godavari.

26. *Value of the land sold.*—Immovable property estimated at Rs. 25 was sold to realize Rs. 22. Only one acre of land was sold and it was purchased by a private person.

27. *Process service establishment.*—Statement No. 13 shows the particulars of the processes served. 59,652 and 72,322 were served by village and special establishments against 39,897 and 3,627 in the previous fasli.

28. *Civil suits.*—A sum of Rs. 43,161-7-9 was awarded to Government as costs. Including the opening balance, the total demand was Rs. 93,990-14-3 of which Rs. 27,465-3-6 were collected and Rs. 1,039-1-11 were written off as irrecoverable. The not recoverable balance at the end of the fasli was Rs. 65,090-7-10.

29. *Interest on arrears of land revenue.*—Statement No. 14 gives the Demand, Collection and Balance under this item. The balances are heavy in West Godavari, Madurai and Sriakulam. The total demand including opening balance was Rs. 1,14,574 of which a sum of Rs. 16,148 was collected and Rs. 7,421 was remitted leaving a balance of Rs. 91,005.

30. *Sale of lands under Board's Standing Order Nos. 15, 16, 21, 22, 24, 45, 90, 91 and 197.*—An extent of 884.96 acres of land assessed at Rs. 1,201-12-0 was sold for Rs. 22,778-15-0 under Board's Standing Order No. 15 and 3.67 acres of house-sites and town-sites with a ground-rent of Rs. 90-12-0 were sold for Rs. 8,176-5-0 under Board's Standing Order No. 21. An extent of 149.60 acres of land bought in by Government for arrears of land revenue was sold under

Board's Standing Order No. 45 for Rs. 6,341-8-0. An extent of 21.37 acres of land acquired for public purposes, but subsequently relinquished, was sold under Board's Standing Order No. 90 for Rs. 1,982.

There were no disposals of tank-bed lands under Board's Standing Order No. 16 or sales of lands under Board's Standing Order Nos. 22, 24, 91 and 197.

31. *Subdivision of quit-rent.*—There were no cases of subdivision of the joint liability of the share holders in enfranchised inam to the payment of quit-rent under Board's Standing Order No. 58 in the fasli under report.

32. *Jamabandi by Collectors.*—The jamabandi was conducted by the Collectors with reference to the instructions in Board's Standing Order No. 12 (2) and the orders of the Government in G.O. No. 356, Revenue, dated 14th February 1949, fixing time-limits for the conduct of jamabandi.

33. *Advances under the Loans Acts.*—The advances made under the Land Improvement and Agriculturists' Loans Acts during the fasli amounted to Rs. 2,682 lakhs as against Rs. 223.41 lakhs in the previous year. The increase is attributed to the large demands from the people in the affected districts, where large amounts were disbursed under 'Subsistence Loans'.

34. *Loans—Demand, Collection and Balance (principal).*—The total amount repayable during the year under Land Improvement Loans and Agriculturists' Loan Acts including the balance left at the end of previous year is Rs. 120.37 lakhs. Out of this a sum of Rs. 14.71 lakhs has been suspended during the year, leaving a sum of Rs. 105.66 lakhs to be collected. Out of this a total sum of Rs. 62.17 lakhs, including a sum of Rs. 7.16 lakhs representing the payments which were not due for collection in the year, under review, has been collected. The percentage of collection during the year is 46 as against 41 in the previous year.

The amount repayable during the year under Agriculturists' Loans (Madras Amendment) Act 1935, is Rs. 1.63 lakhs. Of this a sum of Rs. 1.05 lakhs has been collected.

35. *Loans—Demand, Collection and Balance (interest).*—Out of the amount of Rs. 16.23 lakhs due for collection under interest during the year including the amount outstanding at the beginning of the year, under Land Improvement Loans and Agriculturists' Loans Acts, a sum of Rs. 4.76 lakhs was collected and a sum of Rs. 4.14 lakhs was suspended during the year.

Under Agriculturists' Loans Madras Amendment (Act), 1935, an amount of Rs. 1.01 lakhs was due for collection. Of this Rs. 0.16 lakh was suspended and Rs. 0.62 lakh was collected during the year, leaving a balance of Rs. 0.23 lakh.

36. *Debt Conciliation Boards.*—There were no Debt Conciliation Boards working in any of the districts during the fasli.

37. *Enhanced water-cess on irregular irrigation.*—The system of publishing a general or collective notice in each village with reference to B.P. No. 58, Settlement, dated 10th April 1919, is reported to have worked satisfactorily. The ryots were well aware of the rules and made representations in time to the Jamabandi Officers which resulted in prompt investigation of objections and reduction in the number of water-rate appeals. In cases where Government water was taken without permission, deterrent penalties were imposed except in cases covered by Grow More Food concessions.

38. *Cultivation of tank-bed lands.*—There were cultivations of tank-bed lands and abandoned tanks. Objectionable cases were dealt with under the provisions of the Madras Land Encroachment Act. The Grow More Food concessions relating to the cultivation of tank-bed lands, were withdrawn in the beginning of the fasli. In their order G.O. Ms. No. 2618, Revenue, dated 28th September 1950.

the Government modified their previous orders and directed that the cultivation of tank-bed lands might be allowed to continue in cases where cultivation had been carried on for the last five years with the permission of the authorities subject to certain conditions.

39. *Cowles*.—During the fasli 415·22 acres of land were held on cowle, on Rs. 928-6-0 as against 301·22 acres on Rs. 418-6-0 in the previous fasli.

40. *Examination of village and taluk accounts*.—The maintenance of these registers was generally satisfactory in all the districts. The accounts were checked at the time of jamabandi by the Jamabandi Officers and by Revenue Divisional Officers at the time of inspection of taluk offices. Minor defects noticed were rectified then and there.

41. *Taluk and village statistical registers*.—The taluk statistical registers prescribed in the Manual of Taluk Accounts (Special) were maintained in the Nilgiris, Malabar and South Kanara districts. The village statistical registers were maintained in all the ryotwari villages.

42. *Minor irrigation*.—Statement No. 19 shows for each district the number of minor irrigation works in charge of the Revenue Department, the number repaired and the amount spent on them during the official year ending 31st March 1952. Four thousand and five minor irrigation works were repaired in the fasli out of 40,920 works in the State. The statement also shows the number of minor irrigation works proposed for repairs during the official year ending 31st March 1953. Four thousand nine hundred and sixteen works have been proposed for repairs in fasli 1362.

43. *Ryots' conferences*.—Ryots' conferences were held in all the districts except in Chingleput and Malabar. Such conferences enabled the ryots to come into personal contact with the Revenue, Public Works Department and Agricultural Department Officers who explained to them the various aspects of the Government policy.

44. *Extent to which inspection of subordinate offices has been carried out*.—Subordinate offices in all the districts have been inspected by the Collectors and the Revenue Divisional Officers. The inspection of offices of the Revenue Divisional Officers by the Collectors during the year under review was generally thorough. The Board examined the inspection notes submitted by Collectors and issued suitable instructions wherever necessary and took disciplinary action wherever it was called for.

During the fasli, the members of the Board inspected the Collectors, offices in the following 12 districts with references to the instructions in G.O. No. 2086, Revenue, dated 17th September 1942, and G.O. Ms. No. 2954, Revenue, dated 22nd November 1943, and found that the administration of the districts continued to be efficient:

(1) East Godavari, (2) Guntur, (3) Cuddapah, (4) North Arcot, (5) Tanjore, (6) Ramanathapuram, (7) Madurai, (8) Chittoor, (9) South Arcot, (10) Bellary, (11) Malabar, and (12) South Kanara.

45. *Administration of charitable and religious inams*.—The administration of charitable and religious inams continued to be satisfactory and there were no complaints from any districts. Action for resumption of inams on the ground of alienation of inam lands was taken where necessary.

One hundred and six acres and fourteen cents of religious and charitable inam lands bearing an assessment of Rs. 207-8-0 were resumed in the fasli on the ground of alienation. There were no cases of resumption due to disappearance of institutions.

Of the net assessment a sum of one hundred and fifty three rupees, fifteen annas and eleven pies was re-assigned to the working incumbents and a sum of fifty-two rupees and ten annas was credited to general revenues.

46. The New Well Subsidy Scheme has not been extended to 1952-53 as the Government of India refused to bear their share of the cost of subsidy and also for the reason that the scheme is not useful now, the water table having gone down on account of continued years of drought. In areas which have been affected by adverse seasonal conditions, the time for the completion of the wells under the 1948-49 and 1949-50 schemes has been extended till 30th June 1953. In the case of wells subsidised under the 1950-51 and 1951-52 schemes time for completion of the wells in all the districts has been extended till 30th June 1953 to enable the grantees to complete as many wells as possible.

Complete statistics showing the progress of work done under the various well-subsidy schemes mentioned above during fasli 1361 are furnished in the Annexures A to D.

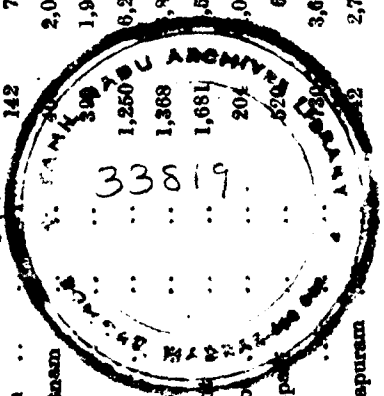
