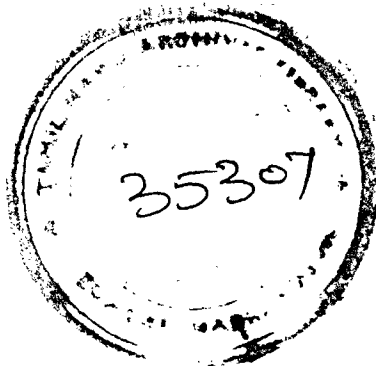

In continuation of this office letter under reference, I am submitting herewith the 'F' statement in two parts, that is, one for the period from 1st January to 31st October 1956 and the other for the period from 1st November to 31st December 1956. I request that the 'F' statements may kindly be added to the annual reports already submitted and forwarded to the Government.

PART I.

ANNUAL REPORT OF THE HOSPITALS AND DISPENSARIES OF INTEGRATED MEDICINE IN THE MADRAS STATE FOR THE PERIOD FROM 1st JANUARY TO 31st OCTOBER 1956.

The total number of Hospitals and Dispensaries of Integrated Medicine at the end of 31st October 1956 was 461. Excepting the Hospital of Integrated Medicine at Madras and the dispensary under Devakottai Municipality, Ramanathapuram, other dispensaries are only for the treatment of out-door patients. The details of the number of dispensaries and hospitals are shown in Statement A.

The Hospital of Integrated Medicine at Madras and the Ayurvedic Dispensary at Pudukkottai are maintained entirely from State Funds. The rest of the dispensaries are maintained by Local Bodies, the Government paying the subsidy to about 184 rural dispensaries.

2. *Distribution of Medical Officers.*—A detailed statement is furnished in Statement B.

3. *Number of in-door and out-door patients.*—The number of in-door patients treated at the Hospital of Integrated Medicine, Madras, was 6,019 with a daily average attendance of 273. The total number of out-door patients treated in all dispensaries of Integrated Medicine as far as information was received was 2,821,145. Further details are given in Statement C.

4. *Diseases treated.*—This is shown in Statement D. The order of prevalence of diseases accounting for large number of cases is given below:—

5. The details regarding operations performed are given in Statement E.

6. *Labour cases.*—The total number of labour cases conducted was 8,181.

7. *Inspection.*—The dispensaries of Integrated Medicine were inspected both by the respective District Health Officers, and Inspecting Medical Officers. The District Medical Officers also inspected some regular Municipal dispensaries during the period under review.

In spite of repeated reminders issued, many of the Medical officers in charge of the dispensaries of Integrated Medicine have not cared to send statistical returns and particulars due from the Executive Officers of the local bodies have not been received. The response this year has slightly improved than last year. The non-co-operative attitude of the Medical Officers and executive authorities causes not only undue delay in the preparation and submission of the statistics report to Government in time but also the return does not serve the purpose for which it is intended as full particulars cannot be incorporated therein.

SPECIAL REPORT OF THE HOSPITAL OF INTEGRATED MEDICINE FOR THE PERIOD FROM 1st JANUARY TO 31st OCTOBER 1956.

1. *Accommodation.*—The in-patient wards were located in the Government buildings. The patients were accommodated in the new hospital buildings. The improvised college buildings continued to be utilised for accommodating patients during this year also.

2. *Staff.*—The Medical staff attached to the College of Integrated Medicine continued to do collateral work in the hospital. The post of the Honorary Surgeon was discontinued.

3. *Average treated.*—The sanctioned bed strength was 270 and the daily average attendance during the past three years are as follows:—

The total number of cases treated during the period mentioned above in the in-patient department was 6,019, while in the out-patient was 142,677.

4. *Mortality.*—The ratio of death per cent to the total treated during the period was 1.

5. *Classes and diseases treated.*—The diseases for which patients were treated are included in Statement D along with the figures for other dispensaries of integrated medicine.

6. *Training of Medical students.*—The L.I.M. and G.C.I.M. students of the College of Integrated Medicine continue to be posted to the out-patient and in-patient departments for clinical training.

7. *Working of special departments.*—The special departments, viz., Pharmacy and Research and the Clinics, viz., Toxicology, Anti-rabic and Anti-natal continued to function during the period under review. The Dental departments has been included along with the other special departments during the above period.

8. *Finance.*—The entire expenditure for the Hospital of Integrated Medicine was borne by the Government.

PART II

ANNUAL REPORT OF THE HOSPITALS AND DISPENSARIES OF INTEGRATED MEDICINE IN THE MADRAS STATE FOR THE PERIOD FROM 1ST NOVEMBER TO 31ST DECEMBER 1956.

The total number of Hospitals and Dispensaries of Integrated Medicine at the end of 31st December 1956 was 426. Excepting the Hospital of Integrated Medicine at Madras and the dispensary under Devakkottai Municipality, Ramana-thapuram, other dispensaries are only for the treatment of out-door patients. The details of number of dispensaries and hospitals are shown in Statement "A".

The Hospital of Integrated Medicine at Madras and the Ayurvedic Dispensaries at Pudukkottai, Shencottah, Edalakudy, Thiruppathrisaram and Pudukkada are maintained entirely from State funds. The rest of the institutions are maintained by local bodies, the Government paying the subsidy to about 184 rural dispensaries. About 23 rural dispensaries in Kanyakumari district are maintained by grant-in-aid system.

2. *Distribution of Medical Officers.*—A detailed statement is furnished in Statement "B".

3. *Number of in-door and out-door patients.*—The number of in-door patients treated at the Hospital of Integrated Medicine, Madras, was 1,493 with a daily average attendance of 272. The total number of out-door patients treated in all dispensaries of Integrated Medicine as far as information was received was 5,85,390. Further details are given in Statement "C".

4. *Diseases treated.*—This is shown in Statement "D". The order of prevalence of diseases accounting for large number of cases is given below:

5. The details regarding operations performed are given in Statement "E".

6. *Labour cases.*—The total number of labour cases conducted was 1,482.

7. *Inspection.*—The dispensaries of Integrated Medicine were inspected both by the respective District Health Officers and Inspecting Medical Officers. The District Medical Officers also inspected some regular Municipal Dispensaries during the period under review.

In spite of repeated reminders issued, many of the Medical Officers-in-charge of dispensaries of Integrated Medicine have not cared to send the statistical returns and particulars due from the Executive Officers of the local bodies have not been received. The response this year has slightly improved than last year. The non-co-operative attitude of the Medical Officers and executive authorities causes not only undue delay in the preparation and submission statistics and report to Government in time, but also the return does not serve the purpose for which it is intended as full particulars could not be incorporated there in.

SPECIAL REPORT OF THE HOSPITAL OF INTEGRATED MEDICINE FOR THE PERIOD FROM 1st NOVEMBER TO 31st DECEMBER 1956.

Accommodation.—The in-patient wards were located in the new hospital buildings. The patients were accommodated in the new hospital buildings. The improvised college buildings continued to be utilized for accommodating patients during this year also.

2. Staff.—The Medical staff attached to the College of Integrated Medicine continued to do collateral work in the hospital. The post of Honorary Surgeon was discontinued.

3. Average treated.—The sanctioned bed-strength was 270 and the daily average attendance during the past three years are as follows:—

4. The total number of cases treated during this period in the in-patient department was 1,493 while in the out-patient was 29,641.

Mortality.—The ratio of death per cent to the total treated during the period was 2.

6. Training of Medical students.—The L.I.M. and G.C.I.M. students of the College of Integrated Medicine continue to be posted to the out-patient and in-patient departments for clinical training.

7. Working of special departments.—The special departments, viz., Pharmacy and Research and the clinics, viz., Toxicology, Anti-rabic and Anti-natal continued to function during the period under review. The Dental department has been included along with the other special departments during the period.

8. Finance.—The entire expenditure for the Hospital of Integrated Medicine was borne by the Government.

2. The report is in two parts, the first relating to the composite State for the period from 1st January 1956 to 31st October 1956 and the second part relating to the new State for the period from 1st November 1956 to 31st December 1956.

3. *Medical attendance.*—The number of in-patients treated in the Hospital of Integrated Medicine, Madras, during the periods from 1st January to 31st October 1956 and from 1st November to 31st December 1956 was 6,019 and 1,493 with a daily average attendance of 273 and 272 respectively. The daily average attendance of out-patients was 806 during the period from 1st January to 31st October 1956 and 850 during the period from 1st November to 31st December 1956.

4. *Mortality.*—The ratio of death percentage to the total number of patients treated in the Hospital of Integrated Medicine was 1 during the period from 1st January to 31st October 1956 and 2 during the period from 1st November to 31st December 1956.
