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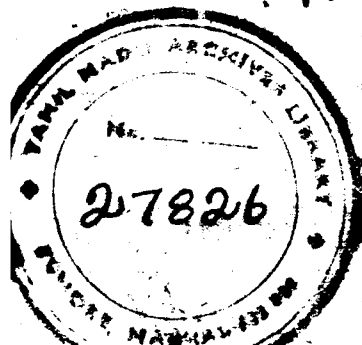
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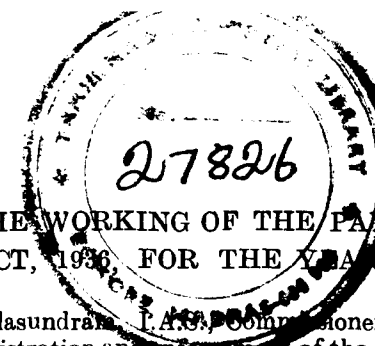
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REPORT ON THE WORKING OF THE PAYMENT OF
WAGES ACT, 1936, FOR THE YEAR 1956.

1. *Personnel.*—Sri V. Balasundaram, I.A.S., Commissioner of Labour, continued to be in charge of the administration and enforcement of the provisions of the Payment of Wages Act, 1936, during the year 1956, and he was assisted in this work, by Sri P. V. Viswanathan, Chief Inspector of Factories, 5 Inspectors of Factories (Grade I), 9 Inspectors of Factories (Grade II) and 126 Assistant Inspectors of Labour.

Sri K. V. Parthasarathy, M.A., B.L., Personal Assistant to the Commissioner of Labour and the Additional Commissioner for Workmen's Compensation [Notified as the Authority under section 15 (1) of the Payment of Wages Act, 1936, in G.O. Ms. No. 4132, Industries, Labour and Co-operation, dated 8th December 1955] continued to be the Authority to hear and decide all claims arising out of deductions from wages or delay in the payment of wages of persons employed or paid in Madras City during the year 1956. Sri K. Srinivasan, B.A., Assistant Commissioner of Labour and the Additional Commissioner for Workmen's Compensation continued to be the Authority in respect of such claims arising in the areas outside Madras City.

During the year under report, the Kanyakumari district and the Shencottah taluk of the Tirunelveli district were merged with the Madras State consequent on the reorganisation of States, with effect from 1st November 1956. The Inspector of Factories, Tirunelveli, has been placed in charge of the newly formed areas for the purpose of enforcing the provisions of this Act. The Government also sanctioned the appointment of an additional Assistant Inspector of Labour for the Kanyakumari district with headquarters at Nagercoil. In G.O. Ms. No. 4666, Industries, Labour and Co-operation, dated 31 October 1956, the Assistant Commissioner of Labour, Madras, has been notified as the Authority under section 15 of the Payment of Wages Act to hear the claims arising out of deductions from the wages or delay in the payment of wages of persons employed or paid in these places from 1st November 1956.

2. *Extent of application.*—The Payment of Wages Act, 1936, applies to the payment of wages to persons employed in all factories covered by section 2 (m) (i) and 2 (m) (ii) of the Factories Act and to the establishments notified by the Government under section 85 (1) of the Factories Act in G.O. No. 4036, Industries, Labour and Co-operation, dated 13th September 1956, and to the persons employed upon any railway. The Act has also been extended and made applicable to all classes of persons employed in plantations and motor omnibus services in the State.

3. *Fixation of wage periods.*—The provision of section 4 of the Act were generally complied with.

4. *Time of Payment of Wages.*—The provisions of section 5 of the Act regarding disbursement of wages on the date fixed, were generally complied with and in cases where the dates were not adhered to, the person responsible for payment of wages under section 3 of the Payment of Wages Act were warned and directed to adhere strictly to the dates fixed for payment of wages.

5. *Deduction from wages.*—Deduction from wages of the workers made under section 7 (2) of the Payment of Wages Act were authorised.

6. *Claims arising out of deduction from wages and delay in payment of wages disposed of by the authorities appointed under section 15 of the Payment of Wages Act, 1936.*—There were 272 claims arising out of deduction from wages and delayed payment of wages pending with the authorities under section 15 of the Payment of Wages Act, at the commencement of the year. Four hundred and eleven cases were filed during the year 1956. Of these 683 cases, 397 were disposed of during the year and 67 cases were transferred to the Kerala and Mysore States consequent on the reorganization of States with effect from 1st November 1956. Two hundred and nineteen cases were pending at the end of the year. The total amount claimed as non-payment of wages and unauthorised deduction from wages was Rs. 1,81,792-7-0. The amounts directed to be paid in the 397 cases disposed of during the year was Rs. 21,369-12-1 by way of wages, Rs. 458 by way of compensation and Rs. 43 by way of costs. Particulars showing the number of cases received and disposed of during the year are furnished in Forms B-1 and B-2.

7. *Recovery of the amounts directed to be paid by the authorities under section 15 or 17 of the Act.*—At the commencement of the year 1956, 59 cases of recovery of the amounts awarded by the Authorities under section 15 of the Act were pending. Twenty-five cases were instituted during the year. Of these 84 cases, 59 were disposed of during the year. Two cases were transferred to the Kerala State and 23 cases were pending at the end of the year. Detailed particulars are furnished in Forms B (1) and B (2).

8. *Registers and notices.*—The provisions of sections 25 and 26 (3) (a) and (b) of the Act relating to display of notices and the maintenance of registers were generally complied with.

9. *Inspections.*—The factories and other industrial establishments to which the provisions of the Act were applicable were inspected by Inspectors of Factories, Assistant Inspectors of Labour and Inspectors of Plantations, with a view to checking whether the provisions of the Act have been strictly complied with by the employers. Special visits were also made by the Inspectors to enquire into the complaints of non-payment of wages, delayed payment of wages and irregular deduction from the wages of the workers.

10. *Prosecutions.*—During the year under report, 29 prosecutions were taken against the employers for their failure to submit the annual return for the year 1955 and for the non-maintenance of registers and for failure to display the required notices. Twenty three cases were disposed of during the year and 6 cases were pending at the end of the year. The amount of fines collected in the 23 cases disposed of was Rs. 340.

11. *Returns.*—The employers of only 4,253 factories out of 4,765 factories covered by the Act submitted the annual returns. Similarly, out of 185 plantations and 189 motor omnibus services covered by the Act, the employers of

only 123 plantations and 103 motor omnibus services respectively submitted their returns. Necessary action is being taken against the managers of factories and establishments who have failed to submit the returns without any sufficient cause. The particulars regarding the percentage of returns received are furnished below:—
