**Proceedings—Permanent No. 1520 (T), Land Revenue,
dated 9th November 1966.**

The Board submits its report on the settlement of land revenue in the State of Madras for Fasli 1378 (1963-64) together with the prescribed statements. A separate report covering the estates dealt with under the Rent Reduction Act, 1947 and the Madras Estates (Abolition and Conversion into Ryotwari) Act, 1948, is submitted by the Board of Revenue (Settlement of Estates) with reference to the orders in G.O. Ms. No. 1985, Revenue, dated 21st July 1961. The present report does not cover the Kanyakumari district and the Shenkottah taluk of Tirunelveli district transferred from the erstwhile Travancore-Cochin State, as the system of land revenue in the transferred areas is different from that obtaining in this State. A copy of the administration report for Kanyakumari district and for the Shenkottah taluk of Tirunelveli district is enclosed.

Main features.—The main features of the fasli under review were that :—

(i) the seasonal conditions, viewed as a whole, were less favourable when compared with the previous fasli, as assessed out by the Director of Statistics according to the usually accepted tests. (*Vide paragraph 2 below.*)

(ii) the total extent of ryotwari holdings increased from 17,196,889 acres to 17,238,371 acres, the increase being 41,482 acres. (*Vide paragraph 7 below.*)

(iii) the total assessment on ryotwari holdings increased from Rs. 3,96,84,589 to Rs. 3,98,01,774, the increase being Rs. 1,17,185. (*Vide paragraph 8 below.*)

(iv) the total area cultivated in ryotwari holdings increased by 0.03 million acres. (*Vide paragraph 9 below.*)

(v) the amount of water rate and second crop charges decreased by Rs. 3.26 lakhs. (*Vide paragraph 10 below.*)

(vi) seasonal remission increased by Rs. 2.54 lakhs. (*Vide paragraph 11 (i) below.*)

(vii) fixed remission decreased by Rs. 0.19 lakhs. (*Vide paragraph 11 (ii) below.*)

(viii) beriz deduction increased by Rs. 2.93 lakhs. (*Vide paragraph 11 (iii) below.*)

(ix) the total amount of revenue remitted (ordinary and special) in this fasli under all the heads was Rs. 14.80 lakhs as against 8.68 lakhs for fasli 1372. This excludes fixed remission of Rs. 1,00,889. (*Vide paragraph 11 below.*)

(x) miscellaneous revenue increased by Rs. 8.53 lakhs. (*Vide paragraph 12 below.*)

(xi) lands were sold for arrears of land revenue during the fasli and Rs. 1,551 was realised therefrom. (*Vide paragraph 25 below.*)

2. Seasonal Conditions—South-West Monsoon (June to September 1963).—The South-West Monsoon set in over the Madras State early in June 1963. The rainfall during the South-West Monsoon period extending from June to September 1963 in the Madras as a whole was 24 per cent above the normal.

North-East Monsoon (October to December 1963).—The North-East Monsoon set in over the Madras State in the third week of October 1963. The rainfall during the North-East Monsoon period extending over October to December 1963 in the State as a whole was above the normal by 12.4 per cent. The rainfall was bordering the normal in the Madurai district. It was about the normal in the districts of Ramanathapuram, Tiruchirappalli, Tirunelveli, Salem, South Arcot and Thanjavur, the percentage of excess being 8.1, 12.6, 15.0, 24.6, 38.5 and 50.8 respectively. The rainfall was deficient in other districts of the State, the percentage of deficiency ranging from 2.2 per cent in Madras district to 26.0 per cent in the Kanyakumari district.

Winter Period (January and February 1964).—There was no rain in the districts of Madras, Chingleput, South Arcot, North Arcot, Salem and Coimbatore during the winter period. The rainfall during the winter period in the State as a whole was below the normal by 79 per cent.

Hot weather period (March to May 1964).—The rainfall during the hot weather period in the Madras State as a whole was 45.3 per cent below the normal. It was below the normal in all the districts of the State.

3. The total number of Ryotwari Villages.—The total number of ryotwari villages in the State was 14,984 as against 14,972 in fasli 1372. Ryotwari Settlement was introduced in 12 villages during the fasli.

4. *Sources of Land Revenue.*—Land Revenue in the State is derived from the following sources :—

- (i) Peshkush or revenue from permanently settled estates;
- (ii) Shrotrium jodi or quit rent;
- (iii) assessment including water cess on lands held under ryotwari tenure; and
- (iv) miscellaneous revenue (including assessment on inams) under the Madras Inams Assessment Act, 1956.

5. Peshkush or revenue from permanently settled estates was nil, as all the estates have been abolished and ryotwari settlement has been introduced.

6. *Quit Rent.*—The quit rent payable on villages held on Shrotrium on favourable tenure was Rs. 1,06,312 as against Rs. 1,57,740 in the previous fasli.

7. *Ryotwari Holdings.*—The total extent of ryotwari holdings during fasli was 17,238,371 acres as against 17,196,889 acres during fasli 1372 resulting in a net increase of 41,382 acres. This increase was due to the introduction of ryotwari settlement in 4 districts covering 12 villages, during the fasli under review.

8. *Assessment on Ryotwari Holdings.*—The total assessment on these holdings was Rs. 398.02 lakhs as against Rs. 396.85 lakhs in the previous fasli an increase of Rs. 1.17 lakhs. The increase was due to the increase in the area of ryotwari holdings consequent of the progressive introduction of ryotwari settlement.

9. *Area Cultivated.*—The total area cultivated in ryotwari holdings was 17.23 million acres as against 16.85 million acres in Fasli 1372. There was thus an increase of 0.38 million acres. The major part of the increase was in Coimbatore district.

(i) The total area cultivated during the fasli including the area under miscellaneous cultivation was 17.27 million as against 16.97 million acres in the previous fasli. There was a net increase of 0.30 million acres under cultivated extent. There was an increase under miscellaneous cultivation.

10. *Water Cess and Second Crop Charges.*—The revenue derived from this source amounted to Rs. 97.10 lakhs as against Rs. 100.66 lakhs in the previous fasli. There was a total decrease of

Rs. 6,15,250 in the districts of Salem, Tiruchirappalli, Madurai, Ramanathapuram and Coimbatore and a total increase of Rs. 2,89,379 in the districts of Chingleput, North Arcot, South Arcot, Thanjavur and Tirunelveli resulting in a net decrease of Rs. 3.26 lakhs.

11. *Remission.*—The total remissions (ordinary) granted amounted to Rs. 13.85 lakhs as against Rs. 8.68 lakhs in the previous fasli of this amount Rs. 6.05 lakhs related to seasonal remissions. Thus there was an increase of Rs. 5.18 lakhs, when compared with the remissions granted during the previous fasli. The increase was marked in the districts of South Arcot, Thanjavur, Madurai, Ramanathapuram, Tirunelveli and Coimbatore.

(i) *Seasonal Remission.*—The amount under the head Seasonal Remission was Rs. 6,01,519 as against Rs. 3,49,521 in fasli 1372. The increase which was due to adverse seasonal conditions was marked in the following districts :—

(a) *Waste Remission.*—Remission under this head of account (waste) was Rs. 63,891 as against Rs. 13,799 in Fasli 1372. The net increase was Rs. 20,092.

(b) *Shavi and less of crop.*—The amount remitted under this head of Shavi or less of crop was Rs. 3,42,000 as against Rs. 10,799 in the previous fasli. The increase was Rs. 3,01,291.

(c) *Theeravakanni remission.*—Remission of the difference between wet and dry rates of assessment on wet lands cultivated with dry crops as a result of insufficiency or failure of water-supply.

The amount remitted under this head was Rs. 1,47,516 as against Rs. 2,45,579 in the previous fasli showing decrease of Rs. 98,033. The decrease was marked in the districts of the

North Arcot, Salem, Madurai, Ramanathapuram and Tirunelveli as shown below :—

(d) *Remission on account of damage by floods.*—The amount remitted under this head was Rs. 28,797 as against Rs. 5,121 in the previous fasli resulting in a net increase of Rs. 23,676.

(e) *Remission of Second crop charges.*—No amount was remitted under this head during this fasli. During Fasli 1372 Rs. 300 was remitted.

(f) *Faslikammi or Second crop not cultivated.*—The amount remitted under this head was Rs. 22,225 as against Rs. 13,926 in the previous fasli. There was an increase of Rs. 8,299 in the districts of North Arcot, South Arcot, Thanjavur, Ramanathapuram and Tirunelveli.

(ii) *Fixed Remission, i.e.*—abatment of demand for reasons un-connected with the season. The amount remitted under the head was Rs. 1,00,889 as against Rs. 1,19,889 during Fasli 1372. There was decrease of Rs. 19,000.

(iii) *Beriz Deductions.*—Deductions made in favour of Inamdars and religious institutions amounted to Rs. 6,91,517 as against Rs. 3,98,235 in Fasli 1372. There was an increase of Rs. 2,93,282.

(iv) *Special Remission.*—The loss of revenue by the grant of special remission in the Fasli 1373 in Ramanathapuram district was Rs. 2,71,322.

12. *Miscellaneous Revenue.*—The revenue realised under this head was Rs. 106.91 lakhs as against Rs. 98.85 lakhs in Fasli 1372. There was a total increase of Rs. 13,14,356 in the districts of

Chingleput, North Arcot, Salem, Thanjavur, Tiruchirappalli and the Nilgiris and a total decrease of Rs. 5,01,031 in the other districts, as shown below :—

The net increase was thus Rs. 8.13 lakhs. The discrepancy of Rs. 0.79 lakh in due to postings in District Statements.

The following are the various items of revenue under this head :—

(i) *Jodi and quit rent in minor inams.*—The revenue realised under this head was Rs. 14,11,735 as in the previous fasli.

(ii) (a) *Second crop charge on minor inam wet lands in ryotwari villages.*—The revenue derived under this head was Rs. 1.48 lakhs as against Rs. 1.92 lakhs in the previous fasli. There was a decrease of Rs. 0.44 lakh.

(b) *Water rate on minor inams in ryotwari villages.*—The revenue derived under this head was Rs. 5.96 lakhs as against Rs. 5.65 lakhs in the previous fasli. There was an increase of Rs. 0.31 lakh.

(iii) *Charges for water in estate village including Triuvaja si and Fasli Jasthi.*—The revenue realised under this head was Rs. 5.59 lakhs as against Rs. 4.18 lakhs in the previous fasli. There was an increase of Rs. 1.41 lakhs.

(iv) *Enhanced water cess on land irregularly irrigated.*—The revenue realised under this head was Rs. 11.56 lakhs as against Rs. 11.32 lakhs in the previous fasli showing the decrease of Rs. 2.76 lakhs.

(v) *Charges levied for occupation (with or without permission of assessed and unassessed lands).*—The revenue realised under this head was Rs. 8.11 lakhs as against Rs. 10.70 lakhs in the previous fasli resulting in a decrease of Rs. 2,59,319.

(vi) *Charges levied for occupation of poramboke lands.*—The revenue derived under this head was Rs. 23.19 lakhs as against Rs. 19.81 lakhs in the previous fasli showing the increase of Rs. 3,38,091. The taram assessment was levied on 32,187 acres in the previous fasli.

(vii) *Revenue from taxed trees.*—The revenue under this item was Rs. 8.47 lakhs as against Rs. 7.35 lakhs in the previous fasli resulting in a increase of Rs. 1,12,451.

(viii) *Commission for estates under the Court of Wards.*—A sum of Rs. 1,738 was realised during the Fasli as against Rs. 978 in the previous fasli.

(ix) *Revenue from process service fees.*—The revenue derived under this head was Rs. 5,252. But no revenue was realised in the previous fasli.

(x) *Sale proceeds of lands sold.*—The revenue under this head was Rs. 2.75 lakhs as against Rs. 28.117 in the previous fasli showing an increase of Rs. 2,47,258.

(xi) *Rent on lankas.*—The revenue derived under this head was Rs. 2,679 as against as Rs. 1,511 in the previous fasli resulting in an increase of Rs. 1,168.

(xii) *Quit rent and ground rent.*—The revenue derived under this head was Rs. 1.61 lakhs as against Rs. 1.59 lakhs in the previous fasli. There was an increase of Rs. 0.05 lakh.

(xiii) *Other items.*—The revenue derived under this head was Rs. 23.20 lakhs as against Rs. 18.58 lakhs in the previous fasli. There was an increase of Rs. 4,62,521.

13. *Net Ryotwari Demand.*—The net ryotwari demand was Rs. 495.41 as against Rs. 497.50 lakhs during Fasli 1372. The net decrease was due to increase in assessment by Rs. 1.17 lakhs and to decrease by Rs. 3.26 lakhs under Water Cess and second crop charge.

14. *Total Land Revenue—Demand (Current).*—The demand under the revenue heads is compared below with that of the previous fasli :—

15. *Total Demand under Cess (Current).*—The demand under cesses arises from the local Cess and local Cess Surcharge leviable under the Panchayat Act. The figures are included in the Land Revenue Demand Collection and Balance and are not exhibited in the Jamabandi statements.

16. *Demand Collection and Balance on Land Revenue and Cesses.*—The current demand under land revenue ryotwari and Miscellaneous and cesses for fasli 1373 was Rs. 1,037.25 lakhs as against Rs. 876.80 lakhs in the previous fasli. The increase was due to the introduction of settlement in 12 taken over estates and miscellaneous income under charge for water, etc. A sum of Rs. 969.50 lakhs was collected during fasli 1373. The variation between the total Land Revenue demand of Rs. 602.66 lakhs shown in paragraph 14 and the sum of Rs. 1,037.25 lakhs shown in under "Cesses" in paragraph 15.

17. *Demand Collection and Balance of Land Revenue and Cesses and Arrears.*—The total arrears demand under all (heads) for Fasli 1373 amounted too Rs. 211.04 lakhs. As against this, an amount of Rs. 124.82 lakhs was collected leaving a balance of Rs. 86.22.

18. *Balance (Arrears and Current).*—The balance outstanding of the end of the fasli 1373 was Rs. 153.98 lakhs (both arrears and current) as against Rs. 1,83.95,646 in the previous fasli 1372.

19. *Adjustment of cesses to local board during fasli 1373.*—Land Revenue and Cesses are collected together and the distribution of the total collection between land revenue and cesses is effected in the district after the compilation of the accounts relating to the fasli year.

20. *Charges debitable to Land Revenue.*—These charges are shown in the accounts under "the 19—General Administration—District Administration and Miscellaneous". The district administration charges excluding those of villages establishment amount to Rs. 188.92 lakhs for Fasli 1373 as against Rs. 192.40 lakhs in Fasli 1372 was Rs. 216.24 lakhs in Fasli 1371.

The village service charges including those of proprietary estate village were Rs. 205.02 lakhs as against Rs. 195.22 in fasli 1372 and Rs. 202.29 lakhs in Fasli 1371.

The expenditure shown above does not relate solely to Collection of land revenue. The revenue department is responsible for various items of work, of which collection of land revenue is only one. Village establishments as well as the district establishment are not only attending to collection of land revenue but also to several items relating to other departments of Government. Much of the time of collectors and their subordinates is taken up by the various schemes such as the National Extension Scheme, local development work, Panchayat Development and community project, etc., and also by other schemes relating to rural development and welfare undertaken by the Government as part of National Planning. The actual cost of collection of land revenue is therefore a less than the total expenditure shown above and the exact quantum cannot be assessed with any degree of accuracy. The detailed statement of expenditure under the various heads of accounts is given below :—

21. *Process under Act 11 of 1961.*—Statement No. 12 gives particulars of coercive process employed for realising the Government dues. The number of processes issued during the fasli is compared below with that of the previous fasli.

The number of demand, sale and distraint notices and of sales have decreased considerably during Fasli 1373. The sales related to personal and real properties.

23. *Sale notices.*—During the fasli, a large number of sale notices were issued in the districts of Chingleput, Thanjavur and Ramanathapuram and a few in the districts of North Arcot, Salem, South Arcot, Madurai, Coimbatore and Nilgiris.

24. The percentage of sale (i.e.) amount realised to sale notices was 8.02 for Fasli 1373 as against 47 in Fasli 1372.

25. *Extent of land sold.*—Lands were sold for arrears of land revenue during the Fasli. The details are furnished in the statement No. 12 enclosed.

26. Value realised by lands for arrears of land revenue during Fasli 1373, Rs. 1,551.

27. *Process Service Establishment.*—Statement No. 13 shows the particulars of processes served. The number served by village and special establishments was 19,308 and 25,098 respectively as against 30,922 and 8,676 respectively in Fasli 1372.

28. *Civil suits.*—A sum of Rs. 12,319 was awarded to Government as costs during Fasli 1373. The balance outstanding at the close of the previous Fasli 1372 was Rs. 27,415. Out of the total demand of Rs. 39,764 a sum of Rs. 7,826 was collected and a sum of Rs. 1,068 was written off as irrecoverable. Of the balance of Rs. 30,870 a sum of Rs. 54 relates to irrecoverable arrears but not written off. The net recoverable balance at the end of the Fasli was Rs. 30,186.

29. *Interest on arrears of land revenue.*—Statement No. 14 gives the demand collection and balance under this item. The total demand including the opening balance was Rs. 1,81,341 of which a sum of Rs. 23,395 was collected and a sum of Rs. 178 was remitted, leaving a balance of Rs. 1,56,768.

30. *Sale of land under Board's Standing Order Nos. 15, 16, 21, 22, 24, 25, 45, 90, 81 and 197.*—An extent of 31.11 acres of land assessed at Rs. 25.99 was sold for Rs. 14,945 under Board's Standing

Order No. 15 and an extent of 31.06 acres and 37 square feet with an assessment of Rs. 22.61 was sold for Rs. 6,277 under Board's Standing Order No. 21. There was no disposal of land under Board's Standing Order Nos. 16, 22, 24, 90, 91 and 197.

31. *Sub-division of quit rent.*—There were no cases of sub-division of the point liability of share holders in enfranchised inams in regard to quit rent under Board's Standing Order No. 58 in the Fasli under report.

32. *Jamabandi by Collectors.*—The Jamabandi was conducted by Collectors, District Revenue Officers and Revenue Divisional Officers with reference to the instructions contained in Board's Standing Order Nos. 12 (2) and 12 (3).

33. *Advances under the Land Improvement Loans Act and the Agricultural Loans Act.*—During Fasli 1373 a sum of Rs. 168.26 lakhs has been disbursed as loans under Land Improvement Loans and Agricultural Loans Act as against a sum of Rs. 190.45 lakhs during the Fasli 1372.

34. *Loans Demand Collection and Balance (Principal).*—The total amount repayable during the fasli under Land Improvement Loans and Agricultural Loans Act was Rs. 215.93 lakhs. This amount includes the balance left uncollected at the end of previous fasli. Out of the amount a total sum of Rs. 155.33 lakhs was collected leaving a balance of Rs. 60.60 lakhs. The percentage of collection during the Fasli 1373 was 72 as against 63 in the previous Fasli.

Under the Agriculturists Loans (Madras Amendment) Act, 1935, an amount of Rs. 0.31 lakh was to be repaid and a sum of Rs. 0.11 lakh was collected leaving a balance of Rs. 0.20 lakh.

35. *Loans Demand Collection Balance (Interest).*—The amount due for collection under "interest" during the Fasli 1372 including the amount outstanding at the beginning of the year under Land Improvement Loans and Agricultural Loans Act was Rs. 50.38 lakhs, out of which a sum of Rs. 38.66 lakhs was collected during the fasli leaving a balance of Rs. 11.72 lakhs.

Under the Agriculturists Loans (Madras Amendment) Act, 1935, an amount of Rs. 0.13 lakh was due for collection under interest during the fasli and a sum of Rs. 1.10 lakh was collected leaving a balance of Rs. 0.03 lakh.

36. *Debt Conciliation Board.*—There was no Debt Conciliation Board in any of the districts during Fasli 1373.

37. *Enhanced water cess on irregular irrigation.*—The system of publishing a general or collective notice in each village with reference to B.P. 58 Settlement, dated 10th April 1919 is reported to have been working satisfactorily. The ryots were kept informed of the irrigation facilities afforded by the Government and the rules for levying water cess.

38. *Cultivation of tank bed lands.*—Cultivation of tank bed lands was noticed in the districts of Tiruchirappalli (352.88 acres) and Coimbatore (189.88 acres). Objectionable cases were dealt with under the provisions of the Madras Land Encroachment Act by ordering eviction and by imposition of penalty.

39. *Cowles.*—During the fasli, an extent of 2.13 acres were held on Cowles in the districts of Coimbatore.

40. *Examination of village and taluk accounts.*—The maintenance of the registers were generally satisfactory in all the districts except Thanjavur for which the report under this item has not been received. The accounts were checked at the time of Jamabandi by the Jamabandi Officers and by the Revenue Divisional Officers and Sub-Collectors at the time of inspection of Taluk Accounts.

41. *Taluk and Statistical Registers.*—The Taluk Statistical Registers prescribed in the Manual of Taluk Accounts (Special) were maintained in the Nilgiris district. The Village Statistical Registers were maintained in all the ryotwari village of other districts.

42. *Minor irrigation.*—Statement No. 19 shows for each district the number of minor irrigation works in charge of the Revenue Department, the number repaired and the amount spent on them up to the 31st March 1964. Out of 16,448 works in the State, 1,375 minor irrigation works requiring repairs and included in the programme drawn up for 1963-64 were repaired at a cost of Rs. 24,10,488. The statement also shows the number of works proposed for repairs during the year ended 31st March 1965. 2,154 minor irrigation works have been proposed for repairs in Fasli 1374.

43. *Ryots Conference.*—Ryots Conference were held in Chingleput, North Arcot, Tiruchirappalli and Nilgiris districts. Officers of other Departments were also present during the conference. The conference enabled the ryots to come into personal contact with the officers of the Revenue and other departments who explained to them the several activities undertaken by the Government.

Collectors of other districts have not specifically reported whether ryots conference were held after Jamabandi and if so with what result.

44. *Extent to which the inspection of the subordinate officers have been carried out.*—Subordinate officers in the districts, viz., all Divisional offices and the offices of the Special Deputy Collectors (Land Acquisition), Special Deputy Collectors functioning as Revenue Courts, and District Welfare Officers were inspected by the Collectors and District Revenue Officers and by the Joint Collector, Coimbatore in the respective areas of their jurisdictions which the offices of the Authorised Officers were inspected by the Director of Settlements. The revenue (general) branches of divisional offices were inspected by the District Revenue Officers and the Panchayat Development Branches were inspected by the Collectors, according to programmes drawn up in advance. The annual inspection conducted by these officers have generally been thorough summaries of the notes of inspection by the District Revenue Officers and Collectors were examined by the Board critically and suitable instructions issued, wherever necessary.

During the Fasli under report, members of the Board of Revenue inspected the offices of Collectors of the following districts with reference to the instructions in G.O. Ms. No. 2086, Revenue, 17th September 1943.

- (1) Chingleput;
- (2) Madras;
- (3) Tiruchirappalli;
- (4) Coimbatore;
- (5) Tirunelveli;
- (6) Salem; and
- (7) Kanyakumari.

The administration of the districts by the Collectors and by the District Revenue Officers continued to be generally satisfactory.

45. *Administration of charitable and religious inams.*—The administration of charitable and religious inams continued to be satisfactory. Action for resumption of inams in the ground of alienation of inam lands was taken wherever necessary.

There was no case of resumption of religious and charitable inam lands in the fasli on the ground of inability to continue the service. There were also no cases of resumption as a result of closure of the institution.

46. *New Well Subsidy Scheme.*—The scheme of advancing loans convertible party into subsidy for sinking new wells review during the year 1958-59 continued to be in force in 1963-64 in order to give a fillip to increased food production. The maximum amount of loan admissible under the scheme was Rs. 2,000 per well in areas other than Talavadi firka in Coimbatore district where it was Rs. 3,000. The loan is payable in two equal instalments, the first instalment immediately after sanction of the loan and the second instalment after the full utilisation of the first instalment. After due completion, 25 per cent of the cost of the well work subject to a maximum of Rs. 500 would be treated as subsidy in all areas except Talavadi firka of Coimbatore district where subsidy was allowed up to 50 per cent of the cost of the work subject to a maximum of Rs. 1,500 per well.

The Administration Report for Fasli 1373 is submitted herewith.

1. *Main features.*—The seasonal conditions were generally good throughout in the fasli except for certain rain-fed areas where there were witherings for which remission was granted. The remission is Rs. 17,622.00 besides fixed remission such as baling remission, alienation remission, etc.

2. *Ryotwari villages.*—During fasli 1372, the total number of ryotwari village in this district was 972. During fasli 1373, settlement was introduced in Veerapandianpulikulam village under the jurisdiction of the Additional Tahsildar, Ettayapuram and as such the total number of ryotwari villages is 973 at present.

3. *Ryotwari holdings.*—The total extent of ryotwari holdings showed an increase of 3,827 acres which is due to the introduction of Settlements.

6. *Water-rate and second crop cultivation.*—The amount to be realised under this head showed an increase of Rs. 43,482. The increase is due to favourable seasonal conditions under Tambaraparani and Manimuthar Irrigation System.

According to the instructions contained in the Panchayats Act, levy of land cess, education cess and additional surcharges has already been abolished and in its place local cess at the rate of 45 nP. per rupee and local cess surcharge at the rate ranging from 25 nP. to 50 nP. per rupee on land revenue has been levied, for the area covered by the Panchayat Act. Levy of additional surcharge at the rate of 13 nP. per rupee on land revenue has been levied in the municipal areas as was done in the previous years.

The remission granted during this fasli is Rs. 43,006 as against Rs. 1,21,058 in the last fasli.

The total demand under miscellaneous revenue has decreased by Rs. 48,970 which is due to the conditions stated in the preceding paragraphs.

Enhanced water-cess on irregular irrigation.—The area under unauthorised cultivation is on the increase in spite of publication of notice prohibiting such cultivation. The ryots are well aware of the rules now in force but they resort to such cultivation when the seasonal conditions are good. They made representations to the Jamabandi officers for reduction of penalties and suitable orders were passed by the Jamabandi officers according to the rules now in vogue.

Examination of the taluk and village accounts.—The village and taluk accounts are being checked by the concerned Revenue Divisional Officers during Jamabandi and office inspection of subordinate officers. The maintenance of accounts is reported to be generally satisfactory.

Taluk and village statistical registers.—The registers have been posted up to the end of fasli 1373.

Inspection of subordinate officers.—All the taluk and the sub-taluk officers are being inspected by the respective Revenue Divisional Officers and the Divisional Officers by the Collector and District Revenue Officer.

Religious and charitable inams.—The administration of religious and charitable inams in this district was generally satisfactory.
