Resolution—No. 57 (T), dated 11th January 1967.

The Board submits its report on the settlement of land revenue in the State of Madras for Fasli 1374 (1964-65) together with the prescribed statements. A separate report covering the estates dealt with under the Rent Reduction Act, 1947 and the Madras Estates (Abolition and Conversion into Ryotwari) Act, 1948 is submitted by the Board of Revenue (Settlement of Estates) with reference to the orders in G.O. Ms. No. 1985, Revenue, dated 21st July 1964. The present report does not cover the Kanyakumari district and the Shencottah taluk of Tirunelveli district, transferred from the erstwhile Travancore-Cochin State, as the system of Land Revenue in the transferred areas is different from that obtaining in the State. A copy of the administration report for Kanyakumari district and for the Shencottah taluk of Tirunelveli district is enclosed.

Main features.—The main features of the fasli under review were that :—

(i) the seasonal conditions, viewed as a whole, were more favourable than that in the previous year, as assessed by the Director of Statistics according to the usually accepted tests (*vide* paragraph 2 below);

(ii) the total extent of ryotwari holdings increased from 1,72,38,371 acres to 1,73,47,593 acres, the increase being 1,09,222 acres (*vide* paragraph 7 below);

(iii) the total assessment on ryotwari holdings increased from Rs. 3,98,01,774 to Rs. 4,00,68,525 the increase being Rs. 2,66,751 (*vide* paragraph 8 below);

(iv) the total area cultivated in ryotwari holdings increased by 0.11 million acres (*vide* paragraph 9 below);

(v) the amount of water rate and second crop charges increased by Rs. 5.70 lakhs (*vide* paragraph 10 below).

(vi) Fixed remission increased by Rs. 17,661 (*vide* paragraph 11 (ii) below);

(vii) beriz deductions increased by Rs. 2.09 lakhs (*vide* paragraph 11 (iii) below);

(viii) the total remission (occasional as well as special) in this fasli was Rs. 12.01 lakhs as against Rs. 5.31 lakhs for fasli 1373 (*vide* paragraph 11 below);

(ix) miscellaneous revenue increased by Rs. 67.95 lakhs (*vide* paragraph 12 below) and

(x) lands were sold for arrears of land revenue during the fasli and a sum of Rs. 96 was realised therefrom (*vide* paragraph 25 below).

2. Seasonal conditions—South West Monsoon period (June 1964 to September 1964)—June 1964.—Rain or thunder showers had been scattered on the 1st to 3rd, 6th, 15th, 17th, 18th, 20th and the 22nd to 28th. The weather was mainly dry on the remaining days. The rainfall was below the normal in all the districts except Madurai where it was bordering on the normal.

July 1964.—The rainfall was scattered over the State throughout the month except on the 2nd, 6th, 10th, 13th and 22nd when the weather was dry. The rainfall during the month was above the normal in all the districts.

August 1964.—During the month dry weather prevailed on the 13th, 20th and 25th, while there was scattered and widespread rainfall during the remaining days. Rainfall was above the normal in the districts of Madras, Tirunelveli, the Nilgiris and Kanyakumari and below the normal in the remaining districts.

September 1964.—Rainfall was widespread and scattered during the month except on the 17th, 23rd, 26th and the 28th to 30th the dates on which dry weather prevailed. The rainfall was above the normal in Madras, Chingleput, Coimbatore and Kanyakumari districts while it was below the normal in the remaining districts.

June 1964 to September 1964.—The south-west monsoon set in over Madras State on 7th June 1964. The rainfall during the south-west monsoon period extending over June 1964 to September 1964 for Madras State as a whole was above the normal by 12.6 per cent.

North-east monsoon period (October 1964 to December 1964)—October 1964.—The weather was dry over the State on the 1st and 3rd of the month, while on the remaining days the rainfall

was scattered. The rainfall was above the normal in the districts of North Arcot, Salem, Coimbatore and Madurai and it was below the normal in the remaining districts.

November 1964.—Scattered and widespread rainfall prevailed in the State during the month except on the 27th, 29th and 30th when the weather was dry. A depression formed in the Bay about 350 KM east of Madras on 17th November 1964, intensified into a severe cyclonic storm of small extent with hurricane winds and lay centred about 50 K.M. east of Madras on 19th November 1964. Under its influence, the coastal districts of the State received scattered and very heavy rainfall. The rainfall was above the normal in the districts of Madras, Chingleput, North Arcot, Salem, Coimbatore and Kanyakumari, while it was below the normal in the remaining districts of the State.

December 1964.—Rain or thundershowers were widespread over the State except on the 1st, 4th to 6th, 8th to 14th, 16th to 20th and 28th to 30th, when dry weather prevailed. A severe cyclonic storm formed on 21st December 1964 in the Bay about 1200 KM South-East of Madras, weakened subsequently influencing fairly widespread rainfall in the State as a whole. The rainfall was above the normal in the districts of Salem, Coimbatore, Tiruchirappalli, Madurai, Ramanathapuram and the Nilgiris, while it was below the normal in the remaining districts of the State.

October 1964 to December 1964.—The north-east monsoon set in over Madras State on the 4th October 1964. The rainfall during the north-east monsoon period extending over October 1964 to December 1964 in the State as a whole was below the normal by 11.9 per cent.

Winter period (January 1965 and February 1965).—*January 1965.*—The weather was dry over the State throughout the month except on the 2nd, 3rd, 11th, 17th when there was scattered rainfall. The rainfall during the month was much below the normal in all the districts of the State. There was not even a trace of rainfall in North Arcot and Coimbatore districts.

February 1965.—The weather was dry throughout the month except on the 11th, 12th, 13th, 14th and 16th when there was scattered rainfall. The rainfall during the month was below

the normal in all the districts of the State except Thanjavur where it was above the normal. There was no rainfall in North Arcot and Salem districts during the month.

January 1965 and February 1965.—The rainfall during the winter period extending over January 1965 and February 1965 was below the normal in all the districts of the State. The percentage of departure from the normal was as high as 83.7 for the State as a whole.

Hot weather period (March 1965 to May 1965).—*March 1965.*—Dry weather prevailed over the State during the month except on the 3rd to 5th and 23rd and 30th when there was scattered rainfall. The rainfall during the month was 'nil' in respect of Madras, Chingleput and North Arcot district and below the normal in all the other districts of the State.

April 1965.—Rain or thundershowers were scattered during the month except from the 8th to 14th and from the 26th to 28th, when the weather was dry. The rainfall during the month was above the normal in Madras, North Arcot, Salem, Coimbatore, Thanjavur, Madurai, Ramanathapuram and Tirunelveli districts, while it was below the normal in the remaining districts.

May 1965.—Rain or thunder showers were scattered and local, during the month except on the 4th, 5th, 6th, 12th, 20th, 22nd, 26th and 28th to 30th, when the weather was dry. The rainfall during the month was below the normal in all the districts of the State except Kanyakumari, where it was above the normal.

Hot weather period (March 1965 to May 1965).—The rainfall during the hot weather period extending from March 1965 to May 1965 was below the normal in all the districts of the State, except Coimbatore where it was bordering on the normal. During this period, the rainfall for the State as a whole was below the normal by 27.2 per cent.

3. *The total number of ryotwari villages.*—The total number of ryotwari villages in the State was 14,984.

4. *Sources of land revenue.*—Land revenue in the State is derived from the following sources:—

- (i) Peshkush or revenue from permanently settled estates;
- (ii) Shrotrium, Jodi or quit rent;

(iii) assessment including water cess on lands held under ryotwari tenure; and

(iv) miscellaneous revenue (including assessment on inams) under the Madras Inams Assessment Act, 1956.

5. Peshkush or revenue from permanently settled estates was 'nil' as all the estates have been abolished and ryotwari settlement has been introduced.

6. *Quit rent*.—The quit rent payable on villages held on shrotrium on favourable tenure was Rs. 65,719 as against Rs. 1,06,312 in the previous fasli.

7. *Ryotwari holdings*.—The total extent of ryotwari holdings during the fasli was 17,347,593 acres as against 17,238,371 acres during fasli 1373, resulting in a net increase of 109,222 acres. This increase was due to the introduction of ryotwari settlement, during the fasli under review.

8. *Assessment on ryotwari holdings*.—The total assessment on these holdings was Rs. 400.68 lakhs as against Rs. 398.02 lakhs in the previous fasli thus recording an increase of 2.66 lakhs. The increase was due to the increase in the area of ryotwari holdings consequent of the progressive introduction of ryotwari settlement.

9. *Area cultivated*.—The total area cultivated in ryotwari holdings was 17.34 million acres as against 17.23 million acres in fasli 1373. There was thus an increase of 0.11 million acres. The major part of the increase was in Chingleput district.

The total area cultivated during the fasli including the area under miscellaneous cultivation was 17.37 million as against 17.27 million acres in the previous fasli. There was thus a net increase of 0.10 million acres. There was an increase under miscellaneous cultivation.

10. *Water cess and second crop charges*.—The revenue derived from these sources amount to Rs. 103.10 lakhs as against Rs. 97.40 lakhs in the previous fasli. There was an increase of Rs. 8.44.063 in the districts of North Arcot, Salem, Tiruchirappalli, Madurai and Coimbatore, and a total decrease of Rs. 2.74.666 in the districts of Chingleput, South Arcot, Thanjavur, Ramanathapuram and Tirunelveli, resulting in a net increase of Rs. 5.7 lakhs.

11. *Remission*.—The total remission (occasional as well as special) granted during the fasli was Rs. 12.01 lakhs as against Rs. 5.31 lakhs in fasli 1373. The sum of Rs. 12.01 lakhs granted during fasli 1374 included the ordinary remission granted under Board Standing Order No. 13 in all the districts.

Particulars of remission granted under different items are furnished below :—

(a) *Waste Remission*.—Remission under this head of account (waste) was Rs. 2,65,870 as against Rs. 63,891 in fasli 1373. The net increase was Rs. 2,01,979.

(b) *Shavi and loss of crop*.—The amount remitted under this head of Shavi or loss of crop was Rs. 9,14,180 as against Rs. 3,42,090 in the previous fasli. The net increase was Rs. 5,72,090.

(c) *Theervaiikkammi remission*.—(Remission of the difference between wet and dry rates of assessment on wet lands cultivated with dry crops as a result of insufficiency or failure of water supply)

The amount remitted under this head was Rs. 2,83,277 as against Rs. 1,47,546 in the previous fasli showing an increase of Rs. 1,35,731. The increase was marked in the districts of Chingleput, South Arcot, Tiruchirappalli, Ramanathapuram and Tirunelveli as shown below :—

(d) *Remission of account of damages by floods*.—The amount remitted under this head was Rs. 1,462, as against Rs. 28,797 in the previous fasli, resulting in a net decrease of Rs. 27,335.

(e) *Remission of second crops charges*.—No amount was remitted under this head during the fasli as well as in fasli 1373.

(f) (i) *Faslikammi or second crop not cultivated.*—The amount remitted under this head was Rs. 10,958 as against Rs. 22,225 in the previous fasli. There was a decrease of Rs. 11,267 in the districts of North Arcot, South Arcot, Thanjavur and Ramanathapuram.

(ii) *Fixed remission and other deductions dependant on season.*—The amount remitted under this head was Rs. 1,18,550 as against Rs. 1,00,889 during fasli 1373. There was an increase of Rs. 17,661.

(iii) *Beriz deduction.*—Deductions made in favour of inamdars and religious institutions amounted to Rs. 9,00,556 as against Rs. 6,91,517 in fasli 1373. There was an increase of Rs. 2,09,039.

12. *Miscellaneous Revenue.*—The Miscellaneous Revenue derived during the fasli was Rs. 174.14 lakhs, as against Rs. 106.19 lakhs; thus recording an increase of Rs. 67.95 lakhs. Of this, a sum of Rs. 47.52 lakhs was derived under "other items" and the balance of Rs. 20.43 lakhs is accounted for by the increase in Chingleput, North Arcot, Salem, South Arcot, Madurai and Coimbatore districts and by the decrease in Thanjavur, Tiruchirappalli, Tirunelveli and Nilgiris districts.

The following are the items of miscellaneous revenue under this head :—

(i) *Jodi and quit rent in minor inams.*—The revenue realised under this head was Rs. 13,41,348 as against Rs. 14,14,735 in fasli 1373. There was a decrease of Rs. 73,387.

(ii) (a) *Second crop charge on minor inam wet lands in ryotwari villages.*—The revenue derived under this head was Rs. 1.83 lakhs as against Rs. 1.48 lakhs in the previous fasli. There was an increase of Rs. 0.35 lakhs.

(b) *Water rate on minor inams in ryotwari villages.*—The revenue derived under this head was Rs. 5.23 lakhs as against Rs. 5.95 lakhs in the previous fasli. There was a decrease of Rs. 0.73 lakhs.

(iii) *Charges for water in estate villages including tiruvai jasti and fasli jasti.*—The revenue derived under this head was Rs. 4 lakhs as against Rs. 5.59 lakhs in the previous fasli. There was a decrease of Rs. 1.59 lakhs.

(iv) *Enhanced water cess on lands irregularly irrigated.*—The revenue realised under this head was 16.97 lakhs as against Rs. 11.56 lakhs. There was an increase of Rs. 5.41 lakhs.

(v) *Charges levied for occupation (with or without permission) of assessed and unassessed lands.*—The revenue realised under this head was Rs. 8.36 lakhs as against Rs. 8.11 lakhs in previous fasli showing the increase of Rs. 0.25 lakhs.

(vi) *Charges levied for occupation of poramboke lands.*—The revenue derived under this head was Rs. 30.39 lakhs as against Rs. 23.19 lakhs in the previous fasli showing the increase of Rs. 7.20 lakhs. The taram assessment was levied on an extent of 185,806 acres.

(vii) *Revenue from taxed trees.*—The revenue under this claim was Rs. 14.16 lakhs as against Rs. 8.47 lakhs in the previous fasli resulting in an increase of Rs. 5.69 lakhs.

(viii) *Commission for estates under the Court of Wards.*—A sum of Rs. 181 was realised during the fasli as against Rs. 1,738 in the previous fasli.

(ix) *Revenue from process service fees.*—No revenue was realised in this fasli. In the last fasli, the revenue derived was Rs. 5,252.

(x) *Sale proceeds of lands sold.*—The revenue under this head was Rs. 1.36 lakhs as against Rs. 2.75 lakhs in the previous fasli showing a decrease of Rs. 1.39 lakhs.

(xi) *Quit rent and ground rent.*—The revenue derived under this head was Rs. 1.66 lakhs as against Rs. 1.64 lakhs in the previous fasli. There was an increase of 0.02 lakhs.

(xii) *Rent on lankas.*—The revenue derived under this head was Rs. 2,604 as against Rs. 2,679 in the previous fasli showing a decrease of Rs. 75.

(xiii) *Other items.*—The revenue derived under this head was Rs. 70.72 lakhs as against Rs. 23.20 lakhs in the previous fasli. There was an increase of Rs. 47.52 lakhs.

13. *Net ryotwari demand.*—The net ryotwari demand was Rs. 503.78 lakhs as against Rs. 495.41 lakhs during fasli 1373 as shown below—

15. *Total demand under cess (current).*—The demand under cesses arises from the local cess and local cess surcharge leviable under the Panchayats Act. The figures are included in the Land Revenue Demand Collection and Balance and are not exhibited in the Jamabandi statements.

16. *Demand, collection and balance on land revenue and cesses.*—The current demand under land revenue ryotwari and miscellaneous and cesses (including Inam Assessment and Additional Assessment and Water Cess) for fasli 1374 was Rs. 1,166.68 lakhs as against Rs. 1,037.25 lakhs in the previous fasli (1373). A sum of Rs. 1,088.82 lakhs was collected during fasli 1374.

17. *Demand, collection and balance of land revenue and cesses and arrears.*—The total arrear demand under land revenue for fasli 1374 had amounted to Rs. 240.53 lakhs. As against this, an amount of Rs. 124.23 lakhs was collected, leaving a balance of Rs. 116.30 lakhs.

18. *Balance (arrears and current).*—The balance outstanding at the end of fasli 1374 was Rs. 194.16 lakhs (both arrears and current) as against Rs. 153.98 lakhs in the previous fasli 1373.

19. *Adjustment of cesses to local boards during fasli 1374.*—Land revenue and cesses are collected together and the distribution of the local collection between land revenue and cesses is effected in the districts after the compilation of the accounts relating to the fasli year.

20. *Charges debitable to land revenue.*—These charges are shown in the accounts under "19. General Administration, District Administration and Miscellaneous", the District Administration charges excluding those of villages establishment amount to Rs. 206.04 lakhs for Fasli 1374 as against Rs. 188.92 lakhs in Fasli 1373 and Rs. 192.40 lakhs in 1372.

The Village service charges including these of proprietary Estate Village were Rs. 312.33 lakhs in Fasli 1374 as against Rs. 205.02 lakhs in Fasli 1373 and Rs. 195.22 lakhs in Fasli 1372.

The expenditure shown above does not relate solely to the collection of land revenue. The revenue department is responsible for various items of work, of which collection of Land revenue is only one. Village establishments as well as the district establishment are not only attending to the collection of land revenue but also to several items relating to other departments of Government. Much of the time of the Collectors and their subordinates is taken by various schemes such as the National Extension Scheme, Local Development Work, Panchayat Development and Community Project, etc., and also by other schemes relating to Rural Development and Welfare undertaken by the Government as part of National Planning. The actual cost of collection of land revenue is therefore less than the total expenditure shown above and the exact quantum cannot be assessed with any degree of accuracy. The detailed statement of expenditure under the various heads of account is given below :—

23. *Sale notices.*—During the fasli, a large number of sale notices were issued in the districts of Chingleput, Thanjavur and Ramanathapuram and a few in the districts of South Arcot, Coimbatore and the Nilgiris.

24. The percentage of sale (i.e.) amount realised to sale notices was 8 for fasli 1374 as against 8.02 in fasli 1373.

25. *Extent of land sold.*—Lands were sold for arrears of land revenue during the fasli. The details are furnished in the statement No. 12 enclosed.

26. Value realised by lands for arrears of land revenue during fasli 1374 Rs. 96.

27. *Process service establishment.*—Statement No. 13 shows the particulars of processes served. The number served by village and special establishments was 29,291 and 9,921 respectively as against 19,308 and 25,098 respectively in Fasli 1373.

28. *Civil suits.*—A sum of Rs. 12,021 was awarded to Government as costs during Fasli 1374. The balance outstanding at the close of the previous Fasli 1373 was Rs. 30,816. Out of the total demand of Rs. 42,837 a sum of Rs. 8,214 was collected and a sum of Rs. 148 was written off as irrecoverable. Of the balance of Rs. 34,475 a sum of Rs. 621 relates to irrecoverable arrears but not written off. The net recoverable balance at the end of the Fasli was Rs. 33,854.

29. *Interest on arrears of land revenue.*—Statement No. 14 gives the demand collection and balance under this item. The total demand including the opening balance was Rs. 1,93,416 of which Rs. 18,854 was collected and a sum of Rs. 66 was remitted leaving a balance of Rs. 1,74,496.

30. *Sale of land under Board's Standing Order Nos. 15, 16, 21, 22, 24, 45, 90, 91 and 197.*—An extent of 2,054.99 acres of land assessed at Rs. 3,536.43 was sold for Rs. 2,28,860.78 under Board Standing Order No. 15 and an extent of 0.15 acres with an assessment of Rs. 1.68 was sold for Rs. 1,095 under Board Standing Order No. 21. There was no disposal of land under Board Standing Order Nos. 16, 22, 24, 25, 90, 91 and 197.

31. *Sub-division of Quit rent.*—There was no cases of sub-division of the joint liability of share holders in enfranchised inams in regard to quit rent under Board's Standing Order No. 58 in the fasli under report.

32. *Jamabandi by Collectors.*—The Jamabandi was conducted by Collectors, District Revenue Officers and Revenue Divisional Officers with reference to the instructions contained in Board's Standing Orders 12(2) and 12(3).

33. *Advance under the Land Improvement Loans Act and the Agricultural Loans Act.*—During Fasli 1374, a sum of Rs. 121.6 lakhs has been disbursed as loans under L.I.L. and A.L. Act as against a sum of Rs. 168.26 lakhs during Fasli 1373.

34. *Loans demand collection and balance (principal).*—The total amount repayable during fasli under L.I.L. and A.L. Act was Rs. 276.55 lakhs. This amount includes the balance left uncollected at the end of previous fasli. Out of the amount, a total sum of Rs. 163.65 lakhs was collected leaving a balance of Rs. 112.90 lakhs. The percentage of collection during the Fasli 1374 was 40.

Under the Agriculturists Loans (Madras Amendment) Act, 1935, an amount of Rs. 19,212 was to be repaid and a sum of Rs. 2,182 was collected leaving a balance of Rs. 17,030.

35. *Loans demand collection and balance (Interest).*—The amount due for collection under "interest" during the fasli 1374 including the amount outstanding at the beginning of the year under L.I.L. and A.L. Acts was 86.04 lakhs, out of which a sum of Rs. 40.04 lakhs was collected during the Fasli, leaving a balance of Rs. 46 lakhs.

Under the Agriculturists Loans (Madras Amendment) Act, 1935 an amount of Rs. 14,999 was due for collection during the Fasli and a sum of Rs. 2,982 collected leaving a balance of Rs. 12,017.

36. *Dept conciliation board.*—There was no debit conciliation board in any of the districts during Fasli 1374.

37. *Enhanced water cess on irregular irrigation.*—The system of publishing a general or collective notice in each village with reference to B.P. 58 Settlement, dated 10th April 1919 is reported to have been working satisfactorily. The ryots were kept informed of the irrigation facilities afforded by the Government and the rules for levying water cess.

38. *Cultivation of tanks bed lands.*—Cultivation of tank bed lands was noticed in the districts of Tiruchirappalli (278.23) and Coimbatore (63-94 acres) Objectionable cases were dealt with under the provisions of the Madras Land Encroachment Act by Ordering eviction and by the imposition of penalty.

39. *Cowles.*—During the Fasli 1374, an extent of 2.43 acres were held on cowle in the district of Coimbatore.

40. *Examination of village and taluk accounts.*—The Maintenance of the registers was generally satisfactory in all the districts. The accounts were checked at the time of Jamabandi by the Jamabandi Officers and by the Revenue Divisional Officers and Sub-Collectors at the time of inspection of taluk accounts.

41. *Taluk and statistical register.*—The taluk statistical registers prescribed in the Manual of taluk accounts (Special) were maintained in the Nilgiris District. The Village statistical registers were maintained in the ryotwari villages of other districts.

42. *Minor irrigation.*—Statement No. 19 shows for each district the number of minor irrigation works in the charge of the Revenue Department, the number repaired and the amount spent on them up to 31st March 1965. Out of 14,798 works in the State, 1,804 Minor Irrigation works requiring repairs and included in the programme drawn up for 1964-65 were repaired at a cost of Rs. 2324,714. The statement also shows the number of works proposed for repairs during the official year ending 31st March 1966. Two thousand and sixty-nine Minor Irrigation works have been proposed for repairs in Fasli 1375.

43. *Ryotwari conference.*—Ryots conference was held in Tiruchirappalli, North Arcot and the Nilgiris districts. Officers of other Departments were also present during the conference. The

conference enabled the ryots to come into personal contacts with the officers of the Revenue and other Departments, who explained to them the several activities undertaken by the Government.

Collectors of other districts have not specifically reported whether the ryots conference was held after Jamabandi and, if so, with what result.

44. *Extent to which the inspection of the subordinate officers have been carried out.*—Subordinate officers in the districts, viz., all divisional offices and offices of the Special Deputy Collectors, (Land Acquisition) Special Deputy Collectors functioning as Revenue Courts and Authorised Offices were inspected by the Collector, as the District Revenue Officers and by the Joint Collector, Coimbatore in the respective areas of their jurisdiction. The (General) branches of the Divisional Offices (Revenue side) were inspected by the District Revenue Officers and the Panchayat Development branches were inspected by the Collectors, according to a programme drawn up in advance. The annual inspection conducted by these officers have been generally thorough. Summaries of the notes of inspection by the District Revenue Officers and Collectors were examined by the Board critically and suitable instructions issued, wherever necessary.

During the fasli year under report, Members of the Board of Revenue inspected the offices of Collectors of the following districts with reference to the instructions in G.O. Ms. No. 2086, Revenue, dated 17th September 1943 :—

(1) North Arcot, (2) South Arcot, (3) Thanjavur, (4) The Nilgiris and (5) Madurai.

The administration of the districts by the Collectors and by the District Revenue Officers continued to be generally satisfactory.

45. *Administration of charitable and religious inams.*—The administration of charitable and religious inams continued to be satisfactory. Action for the resumption of inams on the ground of alienation of inam lands was taken wherever necessary.

There were no case of resumption of religious and charitable inam lands in the fasli on the ground of inability to continue the service. There were also no cases of resumption as a result of closure of the institution.

46. *New well subsidy scheme.*—The scheme of advancing loans convertible partly into subsidy for sinking new wells, revived during 1958-59, continued to be in force in 1964-65, in order to give a fillip to increased food production. The maximum amount of loan admissible under the scheme was Rs. 2,000 per well except in Thalavadi firka in Coimbatore district where it was Rs. 3,000. The loan was payable in two equal instalments, the first instalment immediately after the sanction of the loan and the second instalment after the full utilisation of the first instalment. After due completion, 25 per cent of the cost of the well work subject to a maximum of Rs. 500 would be treated as subsidy in all the areas except in Thalavadi firka of Coimbatore district where subsidy would be allowed up to 50 per cent of the cost of the work subject to a maximum of Rs. 1,500 per well. The sanction of subsidy was subject to the condition that food crops or any other irrigated crop should be raised in the ayacut of the well in not less than one acre for three years from the date of utilisation of the well water for irrigation. Previously the condition was that only food crops should be raised and this was relaxed by the Government in July 1964 so as to allow the cultivation of any other irrigated crop as well.

ADMINISTRATION REPORT ON JAMABANDI FOR FASLI 1374 IN TIRUNELVELI DISTRICT.

Main features.—The seasonal condition of this District was very bad in Fasli 1374. Remission was granted to tune of Rs. 4,05,444 besides fixed remission, viz., baling remissions, alienation remission, etc., amounting to Rs. 47,277 totalling in all Rs. 4,52,721. In Fasli 1373 ordinary remission was granted for Rs. 43,006 only when the seasonal conditions were generally satisfactory. The collection of dry assessment, cesses and loan instalments was postponed in Sankarankoil and Koilpatti Taluks and Land Revenue Cesses in loan instalments in Nanguneri Taluk and Sattankulam Sub-Taluk as per G.O. Ms. No. 1314, Revenue, dated 20th April 1965.

Ryotwari villages.—There is no change in the total number of villages in Fasli 1374. The number continues to remain as 1373.

Ryotwari holdings.—The extent of ryotwari holdings in Fasli 1374 was 1,911,602 acres as against 1,911,936 acres in Fasli 1373. The decrease of 334 acres is due to relinquishment, acquisition for public purposes, etc.

Assessment.—The total assessment on holdings in Fasli 1374 is Rs. 35,79,474 as against Rs. 35,96,289 in the previous Fasli. The difference is due to the decrease in the extent of total holdings.

Area cultivated.—Due to adverse seasonal conditions, only 1,052,523 acres of lands were cultivated in Fasli 1373 whereas 1,124,191 acres were cultivated in Fasli 1373. There was a decrease of 71,668 acres in the total area cultivated on that account.

Water rate and second crop cultivation.—The local cess at 45 P. per rupee on Land Revenue, Local Surcharge at 25 to 50 P. per rupee and additional wet assessment at 13 P. were levied as follows :—

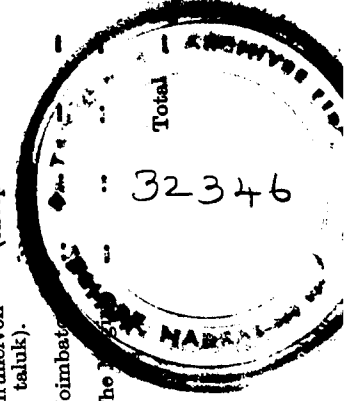

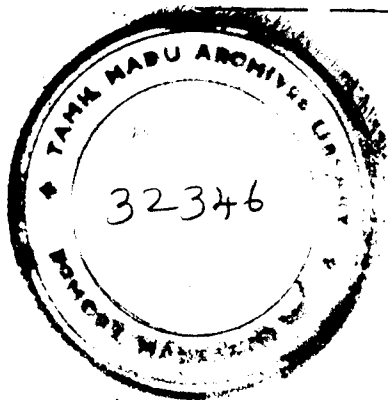
