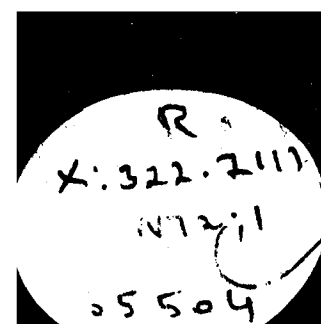
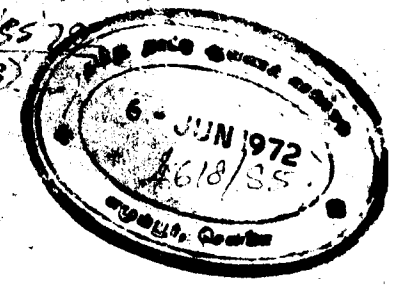






REPORT ON THE SETTLEMENT OF THE LAND REVENUE

IN THE ESTATES TAKEN OVER AND NOT
TAKEN OVER UNDER ACT XXVI OF
1948 IN THE MADRAS STATE

I. Introductory.

The Board submits its report on the settlement of land revenue in the Tamil Nadu for fasli 1376 (1966-67) together with the prescribed statements. A separate report covering the estates dealt with under the Rent Reduction Act, 1947 and the Madras Estates (Abolition and Conversion into Ryotwari) Act, 1948, will be submitted by the Board of Revenue (Settlement of Estates) with reference to the orders in G.O. Ms. No. 1985, Revenue, dated 21st September 1954. The present report does not cover Kanyakumari district and the Shencottah taluk in Tirunelveli district transferred from the former Travancore-Cochin State, as the system of land revenue in force in the transferred areas is different from that obtaining in the rest of this State. A copy of the administration report for Kanyakumari district and for the Shencottah taluk in Tirunelveli district is also enclosed.

II. Main features.

2. The main features of the fasli under review were that—

(i) The seasonal conditions viewed as a whole, as assessed by the Director of Statistics, were fair according to the usually accepted tests (*vide* Part III—Paragraphs 3 to 7 below).

(ii) The total extent of ryotwari holding decreased from 17,475,202 acres to 17,245,087 acres, the decrease being 230,115 acres (*vide* Part VI—Paragraph 11 below).

(iii) The total assessment on ryotwari holdings decreased from Rs. 4,04,50,043 to Rs. 3,99,63,034, the decrease being Rs. 4,87,009 (*vide* Part VIII—Paragraph 12 below).

(iv) The total area cultivated in ryotwari holdings decreased by 0.23 million acres (*vide* Part VII—Paragraph 13 below).

(v) The amount of water rate and second crop charges increased by Rs. 19.22 lakhs (*vide* Part IX—Paragraph 15 below).

(vi) Fixed remissions decreased by Rs. 0.08 lakhs (*vide* Part X—Paragraphs 16 and 17 below).

(vii) Beriz deductions decreased by Rs. 1.25 lakhs (*vide* paragraph 17 (h) below).

(viii) The total remission (occasional as well as special) in the fasli was Rs. 2.34 lakhs as against Rs. 13.82 lakhs in fasli 1375 (*vide* Part X—Paragraph 16 below).

(ix) Miscellaneous revenue increased by Rs. 11,71,726 (*vide* Part XI—Paragraph 18 below).

(x) There was sale of lands for arrears of land revenue during the fasli only in Thanjavur district (*vide* Part XX—Paragraph 35 below).

III. Seasonal conditions.

3. *South-west monsoon period (June 1966 to September 1966).*—Rainfall during this period was above normal in all the districts of the State except Tirunelveli, the Nilgiris and Kanyakumari where it was below normal. The excess of rainfall over normal during this period for the State as a whole was 35.1 per cent.

4. *North-east monsoon period (October 1966 to December 1966).*—The rainfall during this period in Tamil Nadu as a whole, was above normal by 34.5 per cent.

5. *Winter period (January 1967 and February 1967).*—During this period, the rainfall was below normal in all the districts of the State except South Arcot, Salem and Coimbatore. The deficiency of rainfall for the State as a whole was 42.6 per cent.

6. *Hot weather period (March 1967 to May 1967).*—The rainfall during the period for the State as a whole was below normal by 25.0 per cent. It was below normal in all the districts except Madras, Chingleput, North Arcot and Kanyakumari where it was above normal.

7. The rainfall during the year 1966-67 for the State as a whole was normal by 22.7 per cent.

IV. The total number of ryotwari villages.

8. The total number of ryotwari villages in the State was 15,656.

V. Sources of Land Revenue.

9 Land revenue in the State used to be derived from the following sources:—

- (i) peshkush or revenue from permanently settled estates;
- (ii) shrotrium, jodi or quit-rent;

(iii) assessment including water-cess on lands held under ryotwari tenure; and

(iv) miscellaneous revenue (including assessment on inam) under the Madras Inams (Assessment) Act, 1956.

Peshkush or revenue from permanently settled estates was 'nil' as all the estates had been abolished and ryotwari settlement had been introduced and shrotrium, jodi and quit-rent were given away subsequent to the levy of full assessment under the Inams Abolition Act.

10. The quit-rent payable on villages held on shrotrium on favourable tenure was Rs. 28,528 as against Rs. 34,687 in the previous fasli.

VI. Ryotwari holdings area.

11. The total extent of ryotwari holding during the fasli was 17,245,087 acres as against 17,475,202 acres during the fasli 1,375, resulting in a net decrease of 230,115 acres. The decrease was due to the wrong inclusion of the estate villages in the return for the previous fasli 1,375 by the District Revenue Officer, Salem.

VII. Assessment on ryotwari holdings.

12. The total assessment on these holdings was 399.63 lakhs as against Rs. 404.50 lakhs in the previous fasli 1375, recording a decrease of Rs. 4.87 lakhs. The decrease was due to the fact that the demand for the estate villages was wrongly included in the demand for ryotwari villages in the last fasli by the District Revenue Officer, Salem.

VIII. Area cultivated.

13. The total area cultivated in ryotwari holdings was 17.24 million acres in fasli 1376 as against 17.47 million acres in fasli 1375. There was thus a decrease of 0.23 million acres. The major part of the decrease was in Salem district.

14. The total area cultivated during fasli 1,376 including the area under miscellaneous cultivation, was 17.26 million acres as against 17.49 million acres in the previous fasli. (This includes the area mentioned in paragraph 13 above). There was thus a decrease of 0.23 million acres. The major part of the decrease was in Salem district.

IX. Water-cess and second crop charges.

15. The revenue derived from these sources amounted to Rs. 94,20,312 against Rs. 74,97,479 in the previous fasli. There was an increase of Rs. 19,49,385 in the districts of Chingleput, North Arcot, South Arcot, Salem, Tiruchirappalli, Madurai, Ramanathapuram and Coimbatore, and a decrease of Rs. 26,552 in Thanjavur district, resulting in a net increase of Rs. 19.22 lakhs. The increase was due to timely rains and adequate supply in all the irrigation sources.

X. Remissions.

16. The total remission (occasional as well as special) granted hearing the fasli was Rs. 2.34 lakhs as against Rs. 13.82 lakhs in the previous fasli. The sum of Rs. 2.34 lakhs granted during fasli 1376 includes the ordinary remissions granted under B.S.O. No. 13 in all districts.

17. Particulars of remission granted under different items are furnished below:—

(a) *Waste remission*.—Remission under this head of account (waste) was Rs. 20,698 as against Rs. 1,84,699 in fasli 1375. The net decrease was Rs. 1,64,001.

(b) *Shavi and loss of crop*.—The amount remitted under this head of shavi or loss of crop was Rs. 1,34,833 as against Rs. 7,28,011 in the previous fasli. The net decrease was Rs. 5,93,178.

(c) *Theervai kammi remission*.—(Remission of the difference between wet and dry rates of assessment on wet lands cultivated with dry crops as a result of insufficiency or failure of water-supply.)

The amount remitted under this head was Rs. 71,984 as against Rs. 6,19,565 in the previous fasli, showing a decrease of Rs. 5,47,581. The decrease was marked in the districts of Chingleput, North Arcot, Salem, Tiruchirappalli, Madurai, Ramanathapuram, Tirunelveli, Coimbatore and Dharmapuri. It was due to normal seasonal conditions and rains.

(d) *Remission on account of damage by floods*.—The amount remitted under this head was Rs. 18,798 as against Rs. 15,805 in the previous fasli, resulting in a net increase of Rs. 2,993.

(e) *Remission of second crop charges.*—A sum of Rs. 638 was remitted under this head during the fasli 1376. No amount was remitted in the previous fasli.

(f) *Fasli kammi or second crop not cultivated.*—The amount remitted under this head was Rs. 8,149 as against Rs. 18,123 in the previous fasli.

(g) *Fixed remission and other deductions dependent on season.*—The amount remitted under this head was Rs. 72,763 as against Rs. 81,504 during fasli 1375 registering a decrease of Rs. 8,741.

(h) *Beriz deduction.*—Deductions made in favour of inamdars and religious institutions amounted to Rs. 5,68,660 as against Rs. 6,94,438 in fasli 1375 registering a decrease of Rs. 1,25,778.

XI. Miscellaneous revenue.

18. Miscellaneous revenue derived during the fasli was Rs. 106·97 lakhs as against Rs. 95·26 lakhs, recording an increase of Rs. 11·71 lakhs, as a result of the increase in levy of enhanced charge for occupation of porambokes, revenue under Inam Assessment Act and other miscellaneous revenue due to assignment of land with trees, etc.

19. The following are the items of miscellaneous revenue under this head :—

(i) *Jodi and quit-rent on minor inams.*—The revenue realised under this head was Rs. 5,92,936 as against Rs. 4,43,095 in fasli 1375. There was an increase of Rs. 1,49,841.

(ii) *Second crop charge on minor inam wet lands in ryotwari villages.*—(a) The revenue derived under this head was Rs. 0·58 lakh as against Rs. 0·47 lakh in the previous fasli. There was an increase of Rs. 0·11 lakh.

(b) *Water rate on minor inams in ryotwari villages.*—The revenue derived under this head was Rs. 0·73 lakh as against Rs. 0·77 lakh in the previous fasli. There was a decrease of Rs. 0·4 lakh.

(iii) *Charge for water in estate villages including Tirva jasti and Fasli jasti.*—The revenue derived under this head was Rs. 2·42 lakhs as against Rs. 1·42 lakhs in the previous fasli. There was an increase of Rs. 1·00 lakh.

(iv) *Enhanced water-cess on lands irregularly irrigated.*—The revenue realized under this head was Rs. 16·95 lakhs as against Rs. 10·55 lakhs in the previous fasli. There was an increase of Rs. 6·40 lakhs.

(v) *Charges levied for occupation (with or without permission) of assessed and unassessed lands.*—The revenue realised under this head was Rs. 9·82 lakhs as against Rs. 9·72 lakhs in the previous fasli showing an increase of Rs. 0·10 lakh.

(vi) *Charges levied for occupation of poramboke lands.*—The revenue derived under this head was Rs. 30·64 lakhs against Rs. 29·36 lakhs in the previous fasli, showing an increase of Rs. 1·28 lakhs. Taram assessment was levied on an extent of 3·61 lakhs of acres.

(vii) *Revenue derived from taxed trees.*—The revenue under this head was Rs. 13·14 lakhs as against Rs. 12·16 lakhs in the previous fasli, resulting in an increase of Rs. 0·97 lakh.

(viii) *Commission for estates under the Court of Wards.*—No amount was realized during this fasli as against Rs. 1,40,119 in the previous fasli.

(ix) *Revenue from process-service fees.*—The revenue derived under this head was Rs. 520 as against Rs. 7,295 in the previous fasli.

(x) *Sale-proceeds of lands.*—The revenue under this head was Rs. 1·00 lakh as against Rs. 1·81 lakhs in the previous fasli, showing a decrease of Rs. 0·81 lakh.

(xi) *Quit-rent and ground-rent.*—The revenue derived under this head was Rs. 1·31 lakhs as against Rs. 1·20 lakhs in the previous fasli. There was an increase of Rs. 0·11 lakh.

(xii) *Rent on lankas.*—The revenue derived under this head was Rs. 4,087 as against Rs. 3,798 in the previous fasli showing an increase of Rs. 289.

(xiii) *Other items.*—The revenue derived under this head was Rs. 24·77 lakhs as against Rs. 21·88 lakhs in the previous fasli. There was an increase of Rs. 2·89 lakhs.

XII. Net ryotwari demand.

20. The net ryotwari demand was Rs. 493.83 lakhs as against Rs. 479.74 lakhs during fasli 1375 as shown below :—

XIV. Total demand under cess (current).

22. The demand under cesses arises from the local cess surcharge leviable under the Tamil Nadu Panchayats Act, 1958. The figures are included in the Land Revenue D.C.B. and are not exhibited in the jamabandi statements. Therefore, the total ryotwari demand of Rs. 493.83 lakhs excludes the cess, etc., collected under the Panchayats Act.

XV. Demand, collection and balance of land revenue and cesses (current).

23. The current demand under land revenue, ryotwari and miscellaneous and cesses (including inam assessment, additional assessment and additional water-cess) for fasli 1376 was Rs. 1,256.62 lakhs as against Rs. 1,140.28 lakhs in the previous fasli 1375. A sum of Rs. 1,134.91 lakhs was collected during fasli 1376 as against the collection of Rs. 1,066.44 lakhs during the previous fasli.

XVI. Demand, collection and balance of land revenue cesses (arrears).

24. The total arrear demand under land revenue for fasli 1376 had amounted to Rs. 228.56 lakhs, and out of this a sum of Rs. 97.89 lakhs was collected leaving a balance of Rs. 130.67 lakhs.

XVII. Balance (arrear and current).

25. The balance outstanding at the end of fasli 1376 was Rs. 252.38 lakhs (both arrears and current) as against Rs. 176.86 lakhs in the previous fasli 1375.

XVIII. Adjustment of cesses to Panchayat Unions during fasli 1376.

26. Land revenue and cesses are collected together and the distribution between land revenue and cesses is effected in the districts while compiling accounts.

XIX. Charges debitable to Land Revenue.

27. These charges are shown in the accounts under "19. General Administration—E. District Administration and Miscellaneous". The district administration charges, excluding those of village establishments, amounted to Rs. 267.29 lakhs for fasli 1376 as against Rs. 235.89 lakhs for fasli 1375 and Rs. 206.04 lakhs for fasli 1374.

28. The village service charges including those of proprietary estate village service were Rs. 359.70 lakhs for fasli 1376 as against Rs. 353.07 lakhs in fasli 1375 and Rs. 312.38 lakhs in fasli 1374.

29. The expenditure shown above does not relate solely to collection of land revenue. The Revenue Department is responsible for various items of work, of which collection of land revenue is one. Village establishment as well as the district establishment are not only attending to collection of land revenue but also to several items relating to other departments of Government. Much of the time of the Collectors and their subordinates is taken by various schemes relating to rural development and common welfare undertaken by Government as a part of nation building activity. The actual cost of collection of land revenue is, therefore, much less than the total expenditure shown above and the exact quantum of cost of collection cannot be assessed with any degree of accuracy. The detailed statement of expenditure under the various heads of account is given below :—

30. Statement No. 12 gives the particulars of exercise process applied for realizing Government dues. The number of processes issued during the fasli is compared below with that of the previous fasli :—

33. Sale notices.—During the fasli, a large number of sale notices were issued in the districts of Chingleput, Thanjavur and Ramanathapuram.

34. The percentage of sale amount realized to sale notices was 2.92 per cent for fasli 1376 as against 1.74 per cent in fasli 1375.

35. Extent of land sold.—Lands were sold in South Arcot district for arrears of land revenue during the fasli. This information has been furnished in Statement No. 12 enclosed.

36. Value realized by sale of lands for arrears of land revenue during fasli 1376 was Rs. 1,375.

37. Process-service establishment.—Statement No. 13 shows the particulars of processes served. The number served by the village and special establishments was 28,633 and 6,673 respectively as against 36,721 and 5,254 respectively in fasli 1375.

38. Civil Suits.—A sum of Rs. 18,238 was awarded in favour of State Government as costs during fasli 1376. The balance outstanding at the close of the previous fasli 1375 was Rs. 33,692 out of the total demand of Rs. 51,930; a sum of Rs. 1,306 was written off as irrecoverable. Out of balance of Rs. 36,452 a sum of Rs. 1,133 relates to irrecoverable arrears but not written off. The net recoverable balance at the end of the fasli was Rs. 35,319.

39. Interest on arrears of land revenue.—Statement No. 14 gives the demand, collection and balance under this item. The total demand including the opening balance was Rs. 2,01,173 of which Rs. 13,391 was collected, and a sum of Rs. 928 was remitted leaving a balance of Rs. 1,86,854.

40. Sale of land under Board's Standing Order Nos. 15, 16, 21, 22, 24, 45, 90, 91 and 197.—An extent of 1,878.50 acres of land assessed at Rs. 2,545.49 was sold for Rs. 1,08,496.40 under B.S.O. No. 15 and an extent of 0.21 acre was sold for Rs. 420 under B.S.O. No. 21. There was no sale of land under the other Board's Standing Orders.

XXI. Subdivision of quit-rent.

41. There were no cases of subdivision of the joint liability of share-holders in enfranchised inams in regard to quit-rent under B.S.O. No. 58 during the fasli under report.

XXII. Jamabandi by Collectors.

42. The jamabandi was conducted by Collectors, District Revenue Officers and Revenue Divisional Officers with reference to the instructions in B.S.O. Nos. 12 (2) and 12 (3).

XXIII. Advances under the Land Improvement Loan and the Agricultural Loan Act.

43. During fasli 1376, a sum of Rs. 150.81 lakhs has been disbursed as loans under the Land Improvement Loan and Agriculturists' Loan Acts as against a sum of Rs. 137.06 lakhs during fasli 1375.

*XXIV. Loans, Demand, Collection Balance.**A. ARREAR.*

44. The total amount repayable during fasli 1376 under the Land Improvement Loan and Agriculturists' Loan Act was Rs. 123.05 lakhs amount includes the balance left uncollected at the end of previous fasli. Out of this amount, a total sum of Rs. 34.30 lakhs was collected leaving a balance of Rs. 88.75 lakhs. The percentage of collection during the fasli 1376 was 28 per cent.

45. Under the Agriculturists' Loan (Madras Amendment) Act, 1935, a sum of Rs. 4,239 was collected out of the demand of Rs. 20,709 leaving a balance of Rs. 16,470.

B. CURRENT.

46. The amount due for the collection under 'current' during the fasli 1376 under the Land Improvement Loan and Agriculturists' Loan Act was Rs. 197.80 lakhs and out of which a sum of Rs. 153.15 lakhs was collected during the fasli leaving a balance of Rs. 44.65 lakhs.

47. Under the Agriculturists' Loan (Madras Amendment) Act, 1935, a sum of Rs. 514 fell due for collection during the fasli and out of it, Rs. 146 were collected leaving a balance of Rs. 368.

XXV. Debt conciliation.

48. There was no Debt Conciliation Board in any of the districts during fasli 1376.

XXVI. Enhanced water-cess on irregular irrigation.

49. The system of publishing a general or collective notices in each village with reference to B.P. No. 58, Settlement, dated 10th April 1971 is reported to have been working satisfactorily. The ryots were kept informed of the irrigation facilities afforded by Government and the rules for levying water-cess.

XXVII. Cultivation of tank-bed lands.

50. Cultivation of tank-bed lands was noticed in the districts of Chingleput and Tiruchinappalli. Objectional cases were dealt with under the provisions of the Madras Land Encroachment Act by ordering eviction and imposition of penalty.

XXVIII. Cowles.

51. During the fasli 1376, there was no case of cowles.

XXIX. Village and Taluk Accounts.

52. The maintenance of the registers was generally satisfactory in all the districts. The accounts were checked at the time of jamabandi by the jamabandi. Officers and by the Revenue Divisional Officers and Sub-Collectors at the time of inspection of taluk accounts.

53. Taluk and Village Statistical Registers.—The Taluk Statistical Registers prescribed in the Manual of Taluk Accounts (Special) were maintained in the Nilgiris district. The Village Statistical Registers were maintained in all the ryotwari villages of the other districts.

XXX. Minor Irrigation.

54. Statement No. 19 shows for each district the number of Minor Irrigation Works in charge of the Revenue Department, the number repaired and the amount spent on them up to 31st March 1966. Out of 12,024 Minor Irrigation Works in the State, 855 Minor Irrigation Works requiring repairs and included in the programme drawn up for 1966-67 were repaired at a cost of Rs. 21,04,832. The statement also shows the number of works proposed for repairs during the official year ending 31st March 1968. Two thousand three hundred and fifty-six Minor Irrigation Works have been proposed for repairs in fasli 1377.

XXXI. Ryots' Conferences.

55. Ryots' conferences were held in North Arcot, Tiruchirappalli and the Nilgiris districts. Officers of other departments were also present during the conferences. The conferences enabled the ryots to come into personal contact with the officers of the Revenue and other departments, who explained to them the several activities undertaken by Government.

56. Collectors of the other districts have not specifically reported whether the ryots' conferences were held after jamabandi and, if so, with what result.

XXXII. Inspection of the Subordinate Officers has been carried out.

57. Subordinate offices in the districts, viz., all divisional offices and offices of the Special Deputy Collectors (L.A.). Special Deputy Collectors functioning as Revenue Courts and Authorized Officer (Land Ref rms) were inspected by the Collectors and the District Revenue Officers in the respective areas of their jurisdiction. The general branches of the Divisional Officers (Revenue side) were inspected by the District Revenue Officers and the Panchayat Development branches were inspected by the Collectors, according to a programme drawn in advance. The annual inspections conducted by these officers have been generally thorough. Summaries of the notes of inspection by the Collectors and the District Revenue Officers were examined by the Board critically and suitable instructions issued wherever necessary.

58. During the fasli year under report, Members of the Board of Revenue inspected the offices of the Collectors of the following districts with reference to the instructions in G.O. Ms. No. 2086, Revenue, dated 17th September 1943 :—

- (1) North Arcot.
- (2) Salem.
- (3) Ramanathapuram.
- (4) Thanjavur.

59. The administration of the districts by the Collectors and by the District Revenue Officers continued to be generally satisfactory.

XXXIII. Administration of charitable and religious inams.

60. The administration of charitable and religious inams continued to be satisfactory. Action for the resumption of inams on the ground of alienation of inam lands was taken wherever necessary.

61. There was no case of resumption of religious and charitable inam lands during the fasli on the ground of inability to continue the service. There were also no cases of resumption as a result of closure of the institutions.

XXXIV. New Well Subsidy Scheme.

62. The new Well Subsidy Scheme under which loans are sanctioned for sinking new wells continued to be implemented during fasli 1376. The maximum amount of loan that can be advanced for a well is Rs. 5,000. The loan is disbursed in two equal instalments, the first instalment immediately on sanction of the loan and the second after the first instalment has been fully utilized on the well work. After due completion, 25 per cent of the cost of the well work subject to a maximum of Rs. 500 in all areas except Thalavadi firka in Coimbatore district is treated as subsidy. In Thalavadi firka, however, the subsidy portion is 50 per cent of the cost of the work subject to a maximum of Rs. 1,500 per well. The loanee is expected to raise irrigated crops in not less than one acre for a period of three years immediately after the completion of the work. The benefit of subsidy at 25 per cent of the cost of well subject to a maximum of Rs. 500 in each case available under the scheme is also available to open wells constructed by farmers from their own resources. The progress registered under this scheme during fasli 1376 (1966-67) is as follows :—

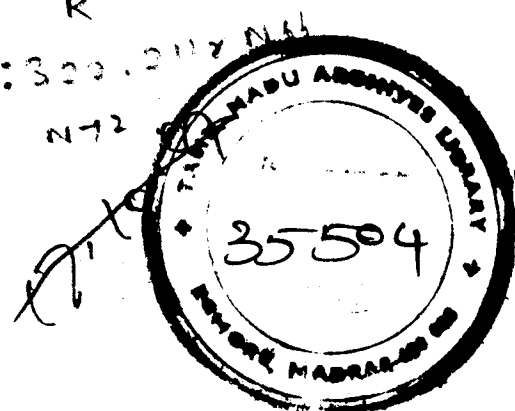
