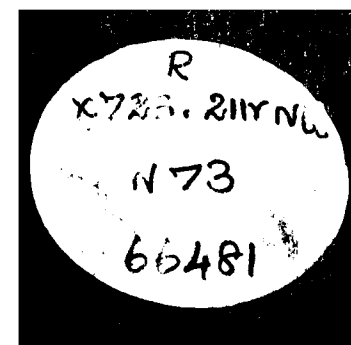
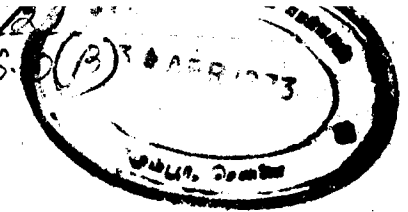

I. Introductory.

The Board submits its report on the settlement of the land revenue in the State of Tamil Nadu for fasli 1378 (1968-69) together with the prescribed statements. A separate report covering the estates dealt with under the Rent Reduction Act XXX of 1947 and the Tamil Nadu Estates (Abolition and Conversion into Ryotari) Act XXVI of 1948 has been submitted by the Board of Revenue (Settlement of Estates) with reference to the orders in G.O. Ms. No. 1985, Revenue, dated

21st July 1954. The present report does not cover Kanyakumari district and Shencottah taluk in Tirunelveli district transferred from the former Travancore State as the system of land revenue in force in the transferred areas is different from that obtaining in the rest of the Tamil Nadu. A copy of the Administration Report for Kanyakumari district and for the Shencottah taluk is enclosed.

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II. Main features.

2. The main features of the Fasli under review were that—

(i) The seasonal condition viewed as a whole was very adverse due to the failure of monsoon and near drought conditions prevailed throughout the State during the fasli. Rainfall in Tamil Nadu during 1968 was the lowest since the drought of 1952. The drought condition in the State was reported to the Government of India and their financial assistance was solicited for implementing a massive programme of relief measures.

(ii) The total extent of ryotwari holdings increased from 18,219,821 acres to 18,856,530 acres, the increase being 636,709 acres.

(x) There was no sale of lands for arrears of land revenue during the fasli.

III.—Seasonal conditions.

3. *South-west monsoon period (June 1968 to September 1968).*—The rainfall during this period was below normal in all the districts of the State. The deficiency of rainfall for the State as a whole was 11.8 per cent.

4. *North-east monsoon period (October 1968 to December 1968).*—The rainfall during this period in Tamil Nadu was below the normal by 30.6 per cent.

5. *Winter period (January 1969 and February 1969).*—During this period the rainfall was below the normal in all the districts of the State. The deficiency of rainfall for the State as a whole was 83.9 per cent.

6. *Hot weather period (March 1969 to May 1969).*—The rainfall during the period for the State as a whole was below the normal with a percentage of deficiency of 33.7 per cent.

7. The rainfall during the year 1968-69 for the State of Tamil Nadu as a whole was below the normal by 27.8 per cent. The seasonal condition during the fasli 1378 viewed as a whole was less favourable than that of the previous year.

IV. The total number of ryotwari villages.

8. The total number of ryotwari villages in the State was 17,280.

V. Sources of land revenue.

9. Land revenue in the State used to be derived from the following sources :—

- (i) Peshkush or revenue from permanently settled estates ;
- (ii) Shrotriyam, jodi or quit-rent ;

(iii) assessment including water-cess on lands held under ryotwari tenure; and

(iv) miscellaneous revenue (including assessment on inam) under the Tamil Nadu Inams (Assessment) Act XL of 1956. Peshkush or revenue from permanently settled estates was 'Nil' as all the estates had been abolished and ryotwari settlement had been introduced and shrotrium jodi and quit-rent were given away subsequent to the levy of full assessment under the Inams Abolition Act.

10. The quit rent payable on villages held on shrotrium on favourable tenure was Rs. 5,246 as against Rs. 15,909 in the previous fasli.

VI. Ryotwari holdings (area).

11. The total extent of ryotwari holdings during the fasli was 18,856,530 acres as against 18,219,821 acres during the fasli 1377 resulting in a net increase of 636,709 acres.

VII. Assessment on ryotwari holdings.

12. The total assessment on these holdings was Rs. 430.19 lakhs as against Rs. 416.51 in the previous Fasli 1377, recording an increase of Rs. 13.67 lakhs.

VIII. Area cultivated.

13. The total area cultivated in ryotwari holdings was 18.86 million in Fasli 1378 as against 18.21 million in Fasli 1377. There was thus an increase of 0.65 million.

IX. Water-cess and second crop charges.

14. The revenue derived from these sources amounted to Rs. 1,01,58,915 against Rs. 1,02,49,938 in the previous fasli leaving a net decrease of Rs. 91,023. There was a decrease of Rs. 5,56,497 in the districts of Chingleput, North Arcot and Ramanathapuram and an increase of Rs. 4,65,474 in Salem, South Arcot, Thanjavur, Tiruchirappalli, Madurai, Tirunelveli, Coimbatore and Dharmapuri.

X. Remissions.

15. The total remission (occasional as well as special) granted during the fasli 1378 was 48.26 lakhs as against Rs. 9.13 lakhs in the previous fasli. The sum of Rs. 48.26 lakhs granted during the fasli 1378 includes the ordinary remissions granted under B.S.O. No. 13 in all the districts.

16. Particulars of remission granted under different items are furnished below :—

(a) *Waste remission*.—The remission under this head of account (waste) was Rs. 10,77,900 as against Rs. 1,50,407 in the fasli 1377. The net increase was Rs. 9,27,493.

(b) *Shavi and loss of crop*.—The amount remitted under this head of Shavi or loss of crop was Rs. 29,94,581 as against Rs. 4,09,330 in the previous fasli. The net increase was Rs. 25,85,251.

(c) *Theevaikammi remission (Remission of the difference between wet and dry rates of assessment on wet lands cultivated with dry crops as a result of insufficiency or failure of water-supply)*.—The amount remitted under this head was Rs. 18,04,970 as against Rs. 4,35,510 in the previous fasli, showing an increase of Rs. 13,69,460. The increase in the remission was marked in the districts of Chingleput, North Arcot, Salem, South Arcot, Tiruchirappalli, Ramanathapuram, Tirunelveli and Coimbatore. It was due to the inadequate rains during the year.

(d) *Remission on account of damage by floods*.—The amount remitted under this head was Rs. 6,399 as against Rs. 25,788 in the previous fasli resulting in a net decrease of Rs. 19,389.

(e) *Remission of second crop Charges*.—A sum of Rs. 46 was remitted under this head during the fasli 1378 as against Rs. 9,712 remitted during the previous fasli resulting in a decrease of Rs. 9,666.

(f) *Faslikammi on second crop not cultivated*.—The amount remitted under this head was Rs. 19,177 as against Rs. 26,297 in the previous fasli.

(g) *Fixed remissions and other deductions dependent on seasons*.—The amount remitted under this head was Rs. 51,06,120 as against Rs. 64,60,066 during fasli 1377 registering a decrease of Rs. 13,53,946.

(h) *Bezir deductions*.—Deduction made in favour of inamdars and religious institutions amounted to Rs. 6,64,526 as against Rs. 7,90,025 in fasli 1377 registering a decrease of Rs. 1,34,499.

XI. Miscellaneous revenue.

17. The miscellaneous revenue derived during the fasli was Rs. 122.93 lakhs as against Rs. 113.91 lakhs recording an increase of Rs. 9.02 lakhs as a result of the increase in levy of enhanced charges for occupation of poramboke, revenue under Inam Assessment Act and other miscellaneous revenues due to the assignment of land with trees, etc. to the landless poor persons.

18. The following are the items of miscellaneous revenues under this head :—

(i) *Jodi and quit-rent on minor inams.*—The revenue realized under this head was Rs. 2,12,893 as against Rs. 3,58,169 in fasli 1377. There was a decrease of Rs. 1,43,214 during this fasli.

(ii) *Second crop charge on minor inams wet lands in ryotwari villages.*—(a) The revenue derived under this head was Rs. 0.31 lakh as against Rs. 0.57 lakhs in the previous fasli, registering a decrease of Rs. 0.27 lakh.

(b) *Water rate on minor inams in ryotwari villages.*—The revenue derived under this head was Rs. 0.52 lakh as against Rs. 0.62 lakh in the previous fasli. There was a decrease of Rs. 0.10 lakh.

(iii) *Charges for water in estates villages including tirvaijasti and fasli-jasti.*—The revenue derived under this head was Rs. 2.85 lakhs as against Rs. 2.47 lakhs during the fasli 1377. There was an increase of Rs. 0.38 lakh.

(iv) *Enhanced water-cess on lands irregularly irrigated.*—The revenue realized under this head was Rs. 27.68 lakhs as against Rs. 17.28 lakhs in the previous fasli. There was an increase of Rs. 10.40 lakhs.

(v) *Charges levied for occupation (with or without permission) of assessed and unassessed lands.*—The revenue realized under this head was Rs. 9.15 lakhs as against Rs. 11.80 lakhs in the previous fasli. There was a decrease of Rs. 2.61 lakhs.

(vi) *Charges levied for occupation of poramboke lands.*—The revenue derived under the head was Rs. 39.79 lakhs as against Rs. 34.21 lakhs during the previous fasli showing an increase of Rs. 5.58 lakhs due to the levy of the assessment.

(vii) *Revenue derived from taxed trees.*—The revenue under this head was Rs. 14.48 lakhs as against Rs. 14.47 lakhs during the fasli 1377. There was practically no deviation in the fasli.

(viii) *Commission for estates under the Court of Wards.*—A sum of Rs. 9,999 was realized during this fasli under this head as against Rs. 27 in the previous fasli. There was an increase of 0.01 lakh in the fasli.

(ix) *Revenue from process-service fees.*—The revenue derived under this head was Rs. 1,988 as against Rs. 17,204 during the previous fasli, registering a decrease of Rs. 15,216.

(x) *Sale-proceeds of lands.*—The revenue realized under this head was Rs. 81,700 as against Rs. 45,788 showing an increase of Rs. 35,912.

(xi) *Quit-rent and ground rent.*—A sum of Rs. 1.46 lakhs was derived under this head during this fasli as against Rs. 1.11 lakhs during the previous fasli thus registering an increase of Rs. 0.35 lakh.

(xii) *Rent on lankas.*—The revenue derived under this head was Rs. 505 as against Rs. 2,912 showing a decrease of Rs. 2,317.

(xiii) *Other items.*—The revenue derived under this head was Rs. 24.17 lakhs as against Rs. 25.48 lakhs during the fasli 1377 registering a decrease of Rs. 31 lakhs.

XII. Net ryotwari demand.

(19) The net ryotwari demand was Rs. 532.15 lakhs as against Rs. 519 lakhs during fasli 1377 as shown below :—

XIV. Total demand under cess (current).

The demand under cesses arises from the local cess and local cess surcharge leviable under the Tamil Nadu Panchayat Act XXXV of 1958.

The figures are included in the Land Revenue Demand, Collection and Balance Statement.

XV. Demand, Collection and Balance of land revenue and cesses (current).

(22) The current demand under the Land Revenue Ryotwari, miscellaneous and cesses (including Inam assessment and additional assessment and additional water-cess) for fasli 1378 was Rs. 1,110.89 lakhs as against Rs. 1,130.63 lakhs in the previous fasli 1377. A sum of Rs. 941.15 lakhs was collected during the fasli 1378.

XVI. Demand, Collection and Balance of land revenue cesses, etc.(arrears).

(23) The total arrear demand under Land Revenue for fasli 1378 had amounted to Rs. 310.15 lakhs. As against this, a sum of Rs. 113.25 lakhs was collected, leaving a balance of Rs. 196.90 lakhs.

XVII. Balance (arrear and current).

(24) The balance outstanding at the end of fasli 1378 was Rs. 366.63 lakhs (both arrear and current) as against Rs. 267.12 lakhs in the previous fasli 1377.

XVIII. Adjustment of cess to Panchayat Unions during fasli 1378.

(25) Land Revenue and cesses are collected together and the distribution between land revenue and cesses is effected in the districts while compiling accounts.

XIX. Charges debitable to Land Revenue.

(26) These charges are shown in the accounts under '19 G.A.E.—District Administration and Miscellaneous'. The District Administration charges excluding those of village establishment amount to Rs. 306.11 lakhs for fasli 1378 as against Rs. 279.79 lakhs for fasli 1377 and Rs. 267.29 lakhs for fasli 1376.

(27) The village service charges including those of proprietary Estates Village Service were Rs. 350.44 lakhs in fasli 1378 as against Rs. 350.25 lakhs in fasli 1377 and Rs. 350.70 lakhs in fasli 1376.

(28) The expenditure shown above does not relate solely to collection of land revenue. The Revenue Department is responsible for various items of work of which collection of land revenue is one of the items. The village establishment as well as the district establishment are not only attending to collection of land revenue but also to several items relating to other departments of Government. Much of the time of the Collectors and their subordinates is taken by the various schemes such as Panchayat Development and Community Project, etc. and also by other schemes relating to Rural Development and Welfare undertaken by the Government as part of National Planning. The actual cost of collection of land revenue is therefore much less than the total expenditure shown above and the exact quantum cannot be assessed with any degree of accuracy. The detailed statement of expenditure under the various heads of account is given below:—

(29) Statement No. 12 gives the particulars of coercive process applied for realizing Government dues. The number of processes issued during the fasli is compared below with that of the previous fasli:—

(30) During both the faslis concerted and effective action was taken to apply the provisions of the Tamil Nadu Revenue Recovery Act of 1864 to realize the land revenue arrears.

(32) *Sale notices.*—During the fasli, a large number of sale notices were issued in the districts of Chingleput, Thanjavur and the Nilgiris.

(33) The percentage of sale amount realized to sale notices was 4.31 per cent for fasli 1378 as against 1.7 per cent for fasli.

(34) *Extent of land sold.*—No lands were sold for arrears of land revenue in any of the districts during the fasli 1378.

(35) Since there were no sale of lands for arrears of revenue, the value realized by sale of lands was 'Nil'.

(36) *Process Service Establishment.*—Statement No. 13 shows the particulars of process served. The number served by the villages and special establishment was 27,817 and 16,843 respectively as against 29,062 and 4,305 respectively in fasli 1377.

(37) *Civil Suits.*—A sum of Rs. 5,366 was awarded in favour of State Government as costs during the fasli 1378. The balance outstanding at the close of the previous fasli 1377 was Rs. 46,097. Out of the total demand of Rs. 51,463 a sum of Rs. 12,416 was collected and a sum of Rs. 3,515 was written off as irrecoverable. The net recoverable balance at the end of the fasli was 35,532.

(38) *Interest on arrears of land revenue.*—Statement No. 14 gives the demand, collection and balance under this item. The total demand for the fasli 1378 including the opening balance was Rs. 2,08,420 of which Rs. 20,136 was collected and a sum of Rs. 22 was remitted leaving a balance of Rs. 1,88,262.

(39) *Sale of land under B.S.O. Nos. 15, 16, 21, 22, 24, 25, 45, 90, 91 and 197.*—An extent of 1,174 acres of land assessed at Rs. 2,620 was sold for Rs. 1,29,665 under B.S.O. No. 15 and an extent of 0.01 acre of land was sold for Rs. 886 under B.S.O. No. 21. There was no sale of land under the other B.S.Os.

(40) *Subdivision of quit-rent.*—There was no case of subdivision of the joint liability of share-holders in enfranchised inams in regard to quit-rent under B.S.O. No. 58 during the fasli 1378.

XXII.—Jamabandi by Collectors.

(41) The jamabandi was conducted by the Collectors, District Revenue Officers and Revenue Divisional Officers with reference to the instructions contained in Board's Standing Orders.

XXIII. *Advance under the Land Improvement Loan and the Agriculturist's Loan Act.*

(42) During the fasli 1378, a sum of Rs. 145.61 lakhs was disbursed as loans under the Land improvement and Agriculturists Loan Act as against a sum of Rs. 145.83 lakhs during fasli 1377.

XXIV. (a) *Loans, demand, collection and balance (arrear).*

(43) The total amount repayable during fasli 1378 under the Land Improvement Loan and Agriculturists' Loan Act was Rs. 129.15 lakhs. This amount includes the balance left uncollected at the end of the previous fasli. Out of the amount, a total sum of Rs. 42.04 lakhs has been collected, leaving a balance of Rs. 87.11 lakhs. The percentage of collection during fasli 1378 was 32.5 percent.

(44) Under the Agriculturists' Loan (Tamil Nadu Amendment) Act, 1935 an amount of Rs. 10,058 was to be collected and a sum of Rs. 2,474 was collected, leaving a balance of Rs. 7,584.

(45) (b) *Current.*—The amount due for collection under 'current' during the fasli 1378 under the Land Improvement Loan and Agriculturists' Loan Act was Rs. 195.91 lakhs out of which a sum of Rs. 116.06 lakhs was collected during the fasli 1378, leaving a balance of Rs. 79.85 lakhs.

(46) Under the Agricultural Loan (Tamil Nadu Amendment) Act 1935, no amount was due for collection during the fasli 1378.

XXV. *Debt conciliation.*

(47) There was no Debt Conciliation Board in any of the districts during fasli 1378.

XXVI. *Enhanced water-cess on irregular irrigation.*

(48) The system of publishing a General or collective notice in each village with reference to B.P. No. 58, Settlement dated 10th April 1919, is reported to have been working satisfactorily. The ryots were kept informed of the irrigation facilities afforded by Government and the rules for levying water-cess.

XXVII. *Cultivation on tank-bed lands.*

(49) Cultivation of tank-bed lands was noticed in certain districts and all the objectionable cases were dealt with under provisions of Tamil Nadu Land Encroachment Act by ordering eviction and imposition of penalty for the irregular engagement of the tank-bed lands.

XXVIII. *Cowles.*

(50) During the fasli 1378, there was no case of cowles.

XXIX. *Village and Taluk Accounts.*

(51) The maintenance of the registers and accounts was generally satisfactory in all the districts. The accounts were checked at the time of jamabandi by the Jamabandi Officers and by the Revenue Divisional Officers and Sub-Collectors at the time of inspection of the taluk accounts.

(52) *Taluk and Village Statistical Register.*—The Taluk Statistical Registers prescribed in the Manual of Taluk Accounts (Special) were maintained in the Nilgiris District. The Village Statistical Registers were maintained in all the ryotwari village of the other districts.

XXX. *Minor irrigation.*

(53) The minor irrigation sources in-charge of the Revenue Department have been transferred to the Panchayat Unions. A very few ~~exam~~ sources, after bringing into standard, have also been transferred to the Panchayat Unions.

XXXI. *Inspection of the subordinate offices by Collectors and District Revenue Officers.*

(54) Subordinate offices in the district, viz., all divisional offices and offices of the Special Deputy Collector (Land Acquisition) and Special Deputy Collectors functioning as Revenue Courts were inspected by the Collectors in the respective areas of their jurisdiction. The annual inspections conducted by the Collectors have been generally thorough. The brief summaries of the notes of inspection by the Collectors were examined by the Board of Revenue critically and suitable instructions issued wherever necessary.

(55) During the fasli year under report, Members of the Board of Revenue inspected the offices of the Collectors of the following districts with reference to the instructions in G.O. Ms. No. 2086, Revenue, dated 17th September 1943:—

1. Chingleput.
2. North Arcot.
3. Salem.
4. Thanjavur.

5. Ramanthapuram.
6. Kanyakumari.
7. Madras.

(56) The administration of the districts by the Collectors and by the District Revenue Officers continued to be generally satisfactory.

XXXII. The Administration of Charitable and Religious Inams.

(57) The general administration of charitable and religious inams continued to be satisfactory. Action for the resumption of inams on the ground of alienation of inam lands was taken wherever necessary.

(58) There was no case of resumption of religious and charitable inam lands during the fasli on the ground of inability to continue the service. There were also no case of resumption as a result of closure.

(59) *New Well Subsidy Scheme.*—The New well subsidy scheme under which loans are sanctioned for sinking new wells continued to be in force up to 31st March 1968. The maximum amount that could be advanced for a well was Rs. 5,000. The loan was disbursed in two equal instalments, the first instalment immediately on sanction of the loan and the second after the first instalment had been fully utilized on the well work. After due completion 25 per cent of the well work subject to a maximum of Rs. 500 in all areas except Thalavadi firka in Coimbatore district is treated as subsidy. In Thalavadi firka, the subsidy portion is 50 per cent of the cost of the work subject to a maximum of Rs. 1,500 per well. The loanee is expected to raise food crops only in not less than one acre for a period of five years, immediately after the completion of the work. The benefit of subsidy at 25 per cents of the cost of the well subject to a maximum of Rs. 500 in each case was available to open wells constructed by farmers from their own resources. With effect from 1st April 1968, the Government have since directed that new loans for sinking open wells should be given wholly by the Land Mortgage Banks. The issue of new loans directly by the Government under New Well Subsidy Scheme was stopped with effect from 1st April 1968. The allotment of funds made in the budget under the New Well Subsidy Scheme for 1968-69 is to be utilised only for sanction of second instalment in respect of wells for which first instalment had already been sanctioned prior to 31st March 1968.

(60) From 1st April 1968, second instalment loan due in eligible cases alone is being disbursed by the Government besides adjustment of subsidy in respect of all spill over cases. From 1st April 1968 loans for sinking of new open wells are being granted by the Land Development Banks.
