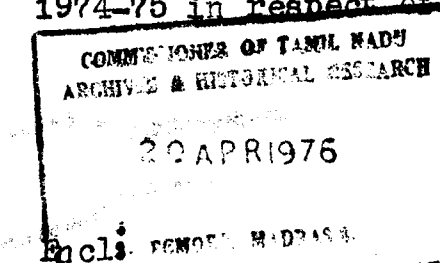

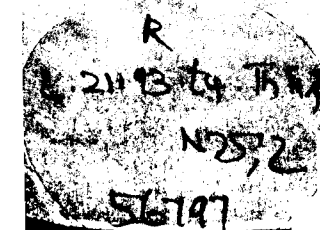

ADMINISTRATION REPORT.

Administration Report of Thanjavur Medical college, Thanjavur for the year 1974-75 (1-4-74 to 31.3.1975).

College Council.

All the Heads of Departments are the members of the Council and the Council will be convened as and when necessary.

Buildings and Accommodation:

The College is situated nearly 5 KMs. away from the Thanjavur Town. The total area of College grounds including provision made for Hostel and Play-grounds is 228.17 Acres. A new Lecture hall has been constructed near the Anatomy. Research Laboratory sanction was accorded for the construction of another Lecture hall over the existing one at a cost of Rs.1,50,000/- and the work is in progress. A pavilion-cum-stage has been constructed at a cost of Rs.1,45,000/.

COURSES OF STUDY.:

There is no change in regard to the admission to the courses. The Course for the Post-Graduate study in General Medicine and General Surgery has been introduced in this college with effect from 1.4.75 with an intake as follows:

Every room can accommodate 2 students. Students are charged room rent at the rate of Rs.10/- per head per month if two students are accommodated in a room. A rent of Rs.7/- per head per month is charged, if the rooms are allotted for more than 2 members. Common messes for the students are available in each hostel which are run by the Students themselves on a cost sharing system.

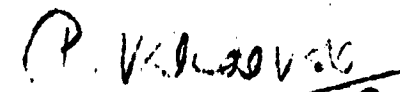
ENDOWMENTS.
