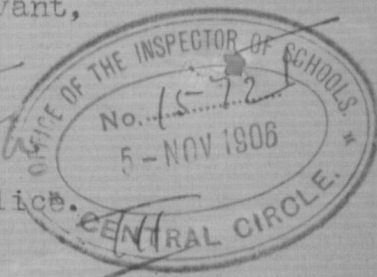
dated 15th October 1906, will expire on the 10th November 1906, and, therefore, this application becomes necessary.
