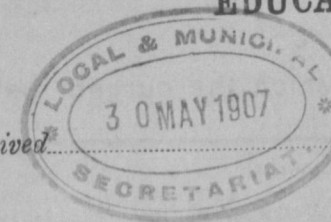

Funds for the maintenance of rural
schools opened during the current
year in the Guntur District.

The D.P.I. submits a letter from the Vice-President, District Board, Guntur, applying for funds to maintain the rural schools opened during the current year and requests that Government may be pleased to sanction the charge pending their formal orders on the distribution of the 5 lakhs grant.

2. No information has been furnished as to the number of rural schools opened during the current year, the date of their opening and the amount ~~that will~~ ^{annually} required ^{be} for their maintenance. It has been ascertained that no information is available on these points in the Local and Municipal Department also.

P 3. In G.O. No.395, Edl., dated 20th June 1907, orders have already been passed distributing ^{among St. Boards} a sum of Rs.1,24,447 from the provision of five lakhs under "Adjusting heads - Contribution from Provincial to Local" ~~to the District Boards~~ to enable them to revise, in accordance with rules 81 and 82 of the Educational Rules, the establishment of their elementary schools, other than those which have been newly opened with the help of the special grant of six lakhs. The Government have further stated in paragraph 4 of the above order that separate orders

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will

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will issue on the subject of grants which may be made for the maintenance of rural schools newly opened in 1906-07 and 1907-08, for the equipment of new schools and for the completion of buildings commenced in 1906-07 and also, should funds be available, for the provision of new buildings for Board schools which at present possess no buildings of their own or for which the existing accommodation is defective. The Government have also requested the D.P.I. to expedite his proposals on these matters.

4. In these circumstances it is submitted that there appears to be no necessity to separately deal with the application of the Guntur District Board for funds to maintain its rural schools opened during the current year, especially when no information has been furnished as to the amount required. The funds available from the provision of five lakhs should be distributed among all the District Boards in proportion to their requirements; and the claims of one District Board alone should not therefore be taken into consideration separately.

5. The current may, it is submitted, be recorded with reference to paragraph 4 of G.O. No. 395, Edl., dated 20th June 1907.
