Respected Sir,

I most humbly beg to submit that my late husband
 Resaldar Gazaffer Beg Sahab submitted to Government an applica-
 tion dated the 30th May 1907 for the reinstatement into the
 Medical School, Royapuram of my son Ghulam Murtuza Beg.

My husband died on the 3rd instant leaving a family
 of about 10 souls entirely helpless, and as the pension of Rs. 80
 which my late husband was getting ceased with his death.

I beg to submit that my husband served in the Great
 Indian Mutiny of 1857 and discharged his work most faithfully
 for which he received medals.

I am an old widow now, and have nothing to make happy
 in my old age except the welfare of ^{my} children. My only prayer
 is that you will be pleased to consider my late husband's appli-
 cation favourably.

If you consider that it is against the rules to re-
 instate my son who appeared and failed at the Matriculation
 Examination, I beg that you will at least exempt him from the
 operation of the Examination rules, so that he may eke out a
 livelihood in any department of the Public service.
