To the Chief Secretary to the Government of Madras,

Sir,

In rearranging the pay of the men on the clerical
staff of this Office as per scale sanctioned in para 4 of
W G.O. No. 269 Marine dated 3rd July 1907, I find it necessary
that the pay of the Record Keeper of the Office should be
fixed at Rs. 60 per mensem, in consideration of the care and
attention that have to be paid to maintain the records in
an efficient state. But the present incumbent of that --
appointment C. Casava Pillai, whose pay is Rs. 50 per mensem,
and who has been the permanent record keeper for the last
5 years, and acted in that appointment off and on prior to
his confirmation in the post, and as such has a good knowledge
of the Office records, has not passed the Precis Writing
Examination, and this is a technical objection to his pro-
motion to

to Rs. 60.

Casava Pillai has had 31 years service and is now 52 years of age. The manner in which the records of the Office, as at present maintained, is satisfactory, and this fact is borne out by the Inspecting Officer of the Financial Department in para 14 of his report dealt with in G.O. No. 332 Marine dated 18th August 1904. He has passed the Examinations specified in the margin and has a

The argument at 'A' on the preceding page is one which might be used for dispensing with the Press Test entirely for the Reindeer port, but it is not an argument in favour of the special exemption of the present incumbents.

If it be found necessary to raise the pay of the port, appeal could be given to the proposal in 3 years time when the present incumbent will have retired. It would not be difficult to replace him on R60 to hold the port, and if unpaired men are exempted there is little movement to others to qualify.

The Marine Dept however support the recommendation. The exemption may be granted as a special case, & that Dept. asked whether the press test should be retained for this appointment in future.
