Excluding the above articles the cost of the indent comes to about Rs. 787 and I request you to be so good as to obtain the sanction of Government under rules 57 and 60 of the Grant-in-aid Code to an amount not exceeding Rs. 393 or one half of the actual cost of the articles, whichever may be less, to be paid on receipt of the necessary vouchers before 1st February next.

2. The grant if sanctioned will be paid from the balance of Rs. 11541 in the current year's budget provision for grants for furniture, apparatus and other special objects.

3. It is requested that the enclosures may be returned when no longer required.

SUBJECT. Furniture grant for the Hindu High School, masulipatam.

The Correspondent of the Hindu High School, masulipatam asks for a total grant of Rs 546-12-0. The total cost of the articles amounts to Rs 1093-8-0 - furniture, Rs 402 and Books, Rs 691-8-0.

2. The S.P.S. has made the following deductions from the total of Rs 1093-8-0

(1) Reversible benches (to be replaced by a more satisfactory type) - 210-0

(2) Back benches (quite useless from teaching & hygienic point of view) } 90-0

(3) Cost of certain books. 5-5-0

Total Rs. 305-15-0

Balance. Rs. 787-9-0

He recommends a grant of $\frac{1}{2}$ of 787-9-0 (about Rs 393.) which is admissible under Article 57 of the Grant-in-Aid Code (1906 Edition).
