In continuation of G.O., No. 479, Educational, dated 26th July 1907, the Director of Public Instruction will be informed that the Government of India have sanctioned the grant to M.R.Ry. M. A. Ramunni Panikkar of a State technical scholarship for the study of leather industry at the Leeds University. Ramunni Panikkar should be instructed to proceed to England as early as possible as the next University term opens in the first week of October next.

2. The Director of Public Instruction will be requested to ascertain from Ramunni Panikkar and report to Government the probable date of his departure from India. On receipt of this information, a letter of introduction will be furnished to Ramunni Panikkar for presentation in person at the India Office as soon as he reaches England, and the Accountant-General will be instructed, in consultation with the Director of Public Instruction, to provide him with a second-class passage to England by sea. Ramunni Panikkar will also be required to report his arrival in writing to the India Office.

3. The Director is also requested to submit a roll in the form prescribed in G.O., No. 535, Educational, dated 11th August 1906.
