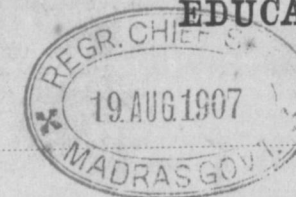

The I. G. of Police, Mr. Cowie, requests that Mir Hyder Ali, son of Mir Abbas Ali, a retired Tahsildar of Tanjore District, may be exempted from passing the matriculation examination for enlistment as a Sub. Inspector of Police.

2. Mir Hyder Ali is now employed as an acting clerk in the Army Clothing Factory, Madras. He is 23 years old and has passed only the Lower Secondary examination.

3. Mr. Cowie says that he submits Mir Hyder Ali's case to Govt. for favourable consideration, as Mir Hyder Ali has obtained the commendation of his present superior officers and his father was a good public servant.

4. The matriculation examination is the minimum educational qualification for direct appointment as Sub. Inspector. Please see letter from the Govt of I. dated 18th Sept 1905 with G.O. no. 1578, Judicial, dated 2nd Oct. 1905.
