The Supt, Archaeological Survey, states
that it is unnecessary that the Manager of this office
^{be required to} should pass the précis-writing test. But since,
however, prescribed the précis-writing test as a
qualification for all ministerial officers ^{who} hold
appointments the maximum pay of which is not less
than Rs 60 per mensem. So long as that rule stands,
the Manager of Mr. Red's office should, it is submitted,
pass the précis-writing test.

2. The Supt. also states that the clerk intends to
appear for the examination to be held in October
next. Perhaps it will suffice if exemption is granted
till the results of the October examination are published,
further exemption for another year being granted if
necessary.
