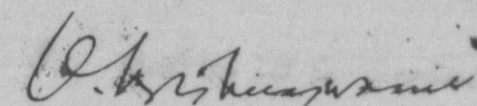

In his despatch no 4 Public dated 14th June 1907 the Secy of state intimated that he had appointed Mr. William Erlam Smith, who was acting as temporary Professor of Natural Science at the Govt. College, Rangoon, to be a member of the Indian Educational Service and to fill the post of Professor of Chemistry in the Presidency College, Madras. In the despatch no information was furnished regarding the age of Mr. Smith, his places of education, university degrees and other special qualifications, such as are usually furnished in similar cases. This was probably due to the fact that they had already been furnished when Mr. Smith was first appointed to the Rangoon college.

2. The Director now requests that he may be furnished with particulars regarding Mr. Smith's qualifications. Under Go. no. 90 Edd dated 6th Feb. 1904, this Govt have also to furnish the same particulars to the Govt. of I.
