Note regarding the appointment of an acting Superintendent, Reformatory school, Chingleput, during Lt. Col. Marsden's leave.

25 Oct 07
With this office endorsement N.R.C.No.7343/07, dated, 8th October 1907, the application of Lt.Col. Marsden, District Medical and Sanitary officer and Superintendent, Reformatory school, Chingleput, for privilege leave for one month and 29 days from the 25th instant has been submitted to Government. In the absence of a Commissioned Medical officer the Surgeon-General intends recommending Lt.Col.Marsden's Assistant to act as District Medical and Sanitary officer. As this Assistant is junior in status to J.W. Coombes, B.A., L.T., the present Deputy Superintendent of the Reformatory school and has no knowledge of the working of that institution I beg to propose that Coombes be appointed to act as Superintendent of the school in addition to his ^{own} duties during the absence of Lt.Col. Marsden on leave or until further orders.

Similar arrangements have more than once been sanctioned on previous occasions. The Surgeon-General is quite in favour of the proposal.

Please see paragraph 3 of the report on the working of the Reformatory School, Chingleput for the year 1906, and paragraph 2 of the report for 1905. It will be observed from these that Mr. Coombes, the Deputy Superintendent of the School, was in charge of the institution from the 20th February to the 3rd March 1905, and again from the 16th to the 25th May 1906. No Gov. Sanctioning the arrangement under which Mr. Coombes was appointed to be in charge of the School can be traced in the records of this office. A further search is being made. In the meantime, the following telephonic message may, it is submitted, be despatched to the D.P.S.:-

- "Your note No. 21 dated 9th October 1907 regarding appointment of Mr. Coombes to be in charge of the Reformatory School, during Col. Marsden's absence. Please say whether similar arrangements made on previous occasions in 1905 + 1906. Were sanctioned by Government or were made by the D.P.S. himself. If sanctioned by Govt. please refer me to the orders of Govt."
